

## BACK AT PURCELL WITH 3-0 RECORD

Notre Dame passed its first major test of the season -- win on the road. It was an obstacle last season in which they went 2-10. However, this is a much different group and they proved it at Georgetown with an 84-63 route. It was the 31st all-time meeting between the two and it marked Notre Dame's biggest victory over the Hoyas since March 4, 2000.

Thus, Notre Dame is off to a 3-0 start and will look to keep the good vibes flowing with two games in Purcell Pavilion this week. The Fighting Irish will first host North Dakota on Tuesday, Nov. 19, at 7 p.m. ET. Then, the Irish will cap the week with Elon on Friday, Nov. 22, at 7:30 p.m.

The only time Notre Dame and North Dakota have squared off on the hardwood, it was a 46-38 victory back in February of 1941.

## **FULL TEAM EFFORT**

"We shot 60 percent from the field, we shot 43 perent from three, 92 percent from the free-throw line. We are a really an elite offensive team when we move the ball like this. We had 20 assists on 32 made field goals. That's hard to deal with. It was everybody too and that's what we need to be successful." - Coach Shrews

Game three was the Matt Allocco breakout/spotlight performance. The graduate guard picked up the Irish when they needed him the most in the first half. He went 5-for-6 from the field, 4-for-5 from three, to earn 15 first-half points. Allocco ultimately finished the game with 17 points, a team-high seven assists and five rebounds.

Markus Burton picked up the torch in the second half where he scored 12 of his 16 points. Burton was a perfect 8-for-8 from the free-throw line and dished out five

assists.

That duo shone the brightest but everyone had their moment. Braeden Shrewsberry had a solid second half and finished with nine points. Tae Davis continued his strong start to the season with 13 points and eight rebounds. Then there's Kebba Njie with eight points and five boards. Nikita Konstantynovskyi came off the bench and tied Davis for the team-high in rebounds with eight, plus eight points. Burke Chebuhar came off the bench and went 3-for-3 from deep for nine points.

## **NOT LAST YEAR'S OFFENSE**

An offseason emphasis, familiarity with Coach Shrews' system, comfortability with your returning teammates - this is not last year's offense and the Irish have proven that through three games.

W, 89-60, over Stonehill W, 86-77, over Buffalo W, 84-63, over Georgetown

The Irish have already tied the amount of games they recorded 80+ points last season with three consecutive 80+ point wins to start the year.

If the Irish can replicate that against North Dakota and Elon this week, they'll tie the program's all-time record for consecutive 80+ point games to start the season. It's happened on four occasions: 1962-63, 1964-65, 1978-79, 2009-10.

## TAE'S HOT START

What a week for Tae Davis. In the Buffalo victory he poured in a career high 27 points on 7-of-13 shooting. Plus he drained a career best 12-of-13 from free-throw line. Davis got it done in crunch time as well, scoring 13 of Notre Dame's final 15 points. He followed that up with 13 points on 5-of-6 shooting in the Georgetown road win. He grabbed a team high eight boards.

Through three games, Davis is averaging 16.3 points and 6.3 rebounds. He's shooting 56.0 percent from the field and 86.4 percent from the free throw line.

KenPom's offensive rating for Davis ranks him seventh nationally. They also rank him 13th in the country in Fouls Drawn/40 minutes with 9.5. Davis has improved every year at the free throw line.

## ONE OF BEST STARTING FIVE IN THE COUNTRY

Did a deep dive on EvanMiya.com which looks at lineup productivity. Notre Dame's starting five of Burton, Shrewsberry, Allocco, Davis and Njie ranks as the second highest Adjusted Offensive Efficiency group in the country. In addition, they rank sixth nationally in Efficiency Margin. Top lineups are featured in the picture below.

Furthermore, according to CBB Analytics, the ND starting five have +26 in +/-, which ranks in the 98th percentile this season.

## ANALYTICS TO KEEP AN EYE

Three straight games with not only 80+ points, but all above 50 percent shooting as well. The Irish are shooting 53.4 percent from the field which ranks 13th nationally. They are also shooting a blistering 61.8 percent from two, which ranks 24th in the country.

Diving deeper - Notre Dame is shooting 55 percent from the mid-range jumper (two-point range outside of paint) which ranks 17th in the nation.

CBB Analytics has Notre Dame's offensive rating at 125.5 which ranks 25th nationally.

After the Georgetown victory, the Irish jumped from 76 on KenPom to No. 53. That website has the Irish offense at 50 and the defense at 71.

With all that said, Notre Dame's current highest national ranking on NCAA Statistics - defensive rebounds per game. The Irish are averaging 34.3 per game which ranks sixth nationally and first in the ACC.

### INTRODUCING MUSH

If Irish fans weren't familiar with Matt Allocco's game, they were after the Georgetown game. A team high 17 points, team-high seven assists, plus five rebounds. He was nearly a perfect 4-for-5 from three in the first half.

Allocco is both the vocal leader and vet guidance for this young squad. He's a gamer and super competitor. He boasts a true shooting percentage of 88.3 which ranks fifth nationally. He owns an effective field goal percentage of 92.3 which ranks fourth in the country. He's shooting 9-of-13 from the field (.692) and 6-of-10 from three (.600).

And it's not just his shooting. Allocco ranks fifth in the nation and first in the ACC with his 11.0 assist/turnover ratio.

## PRESEASON ACCOLADES FOR BURTON

Point guard Markus Burton looks to continue his ascent in collegiate basketball for his sophomore season. He went from winning Mr. Indiana Basketball as a high school senior to stepping on his home court in Purcell Pavilion and making an immediate

impact with the Irish. He won the 2024 ACC Freshman of the Year Award (the first ND player to do so) and also took home Third Team All-ACC honors.

Before the 2024-25 season has officially gotten underway, Burton has collected more awards/recognition. First, the ACC named him a Preseason First Team selection.

Burton's 17.5 ppg is the third highest returning scoring average in the ACC behind North Carolina's RJ Davis (21.2) and Wake Forest's Hunter Sallis (18.0 ppg).

Next, it was the Naismith Starting 5 - Bob Cousy Point Guard of the Year Top 20 Preseason Watch List. This prestigious award honors the best point guards in men's college basketball and is presented by the Basketball Hall of Fame. Burton is the first Irish point guard to be named to the Bob Cousy Top-20 Preseason Watch List since Matt Farrell (2017-18 Watch List).

Shortly after, ESPN.com announced its top-100 players ahead of the 2024-25 season. Burton landed at No. 40. They stated: "(Burton) averaged 17.5 PPG as a freshman, finishing with 20 points or more in 11 games. If he can become a consistent threat from the 3-point line (30%), the All-ACC third team pick could mature into one of the expanded conference's best players."

Last but not least, the Naismith Trophy added Burton to their College Player of the Year Watch List. A total of 50 players were named to the preseason list.

## SHREWSBERRY SIGNS HIGHEST-RATED ND RECRUITING CLAS IN THE MODERN ERA

When Micah Shrewsberry became the Glenn & Stacey Murphy Notre Dame Men's Basketball Head Coach he told fans to jump on now because the train was taking off. Said recruiting train built massive momentum that ultimately materialized in Notre Dame's highest-rated recruiting class in the modern era.

Tommy Ahneman, Ryder Frost, Jalen Haralson and Brady Koehler all signed their Athletic Aid Agreement on Wednesday and officially became Irish. The class is ranked fourth in the nation by 247Sports, fifth by ESPN, fifth by Rivals and sixth by ON3. It's also the top-rated class in the state of Indiana; second overall in the ACC.

"We are very proud of the four who signed with us this morning. They are all tremendous young men and fantastic basketball players who will represent Notre Dame on and off the court at a high level. When we as a staff began focusing on this class, we had a clear vision for what we wanted. We were looking to improve our skill level, size, and athleticism, and we were able to land four of our top priority recruits, in what can only be described as an elite recruiting class." - Coach Shrews

## FROM LEAST TO MOST

When Coach Shrewsberry took over the Notre Dame job, he had to start at the ground-level. In fact, Notre Dame only returned 35 points at this point last year, which equated to 1.6% of scoring returning. That number ranked in the bottom five of Division-I schools. However, this year is quite a different story.

The Irish return the most scoring in the ACC by a landslide. With a solid young core of seven returnees (Markus Burton, Braeden Shrewsberry, Tae Davis, Julian Roper II, J.R. Konieczny, Kebba Njie, Logan Imes), Notre Dame returns 85.6 percent of its scoring. The next highest is Wake Forest at 59.8 percent.

In addition, the Irish return the third highest percentage of minutes in the country at 83.9 percent. Navy (91.3) and Wofford (84.3) hold the top two spots.

## COACH SHREWS LOOKS TO RECREATE YEAR TWO MAGIC

Last year, Notre Dame was projected to finish dead last in the conference. The Coach Shrewsberry led squad came together and ultimately doubled its ACC win total from the 2022-23 season, finishing 7-13 in league play to earn the 12-seed in the conference tourney. Coach Shrewsberry received several votes for ACC Coach of the Year. This year, the Irish are picked to finish tenth in the ACC and look to defy expectations again.

Now, the rebuild at Notre Dame is obviously quite different from the one at Penn State, but let's look at the year one to year two improvement that Coach Shrews accomplished in Happy Valley.



## **ARTICLES & STORIES**

After a 14-17 first season, Shrewsberry produced a 23-14 mark in 2022-23, just the 12th 20-win season in the 127-year history of Penn State basketball. The Nittany Lions then made their first appearance in the NCAA Tournament since 2011.

Statistically speaking, the 2022-23 squad set the BIG and Penn State single-season team record for three-pointers made in a season with 385. The Nittany Lions compiled a total of five top-15 national statistical rankings.

### **IRISH GO 3-0 IN SPAIN**

Every four years at Notre Dame the program is allowed to go on a Foreign Tour. That time had come for the Irish men's hoops squad, as they went on a 10-day trip to Spain. They made stops in Madrid, Valencia and Barcelona and played a game in each city vs. a semi-pro all-star squad. Notre Dame went 3-0 on the trip and here are some highlights:

- Burton recorded 58 points, 12 assists, 11 steals and 17 rebounds in three games
- Sundra 18 points, 24 rebounds
- Davis 20 points, 20 rebounds
- Shrewsberry 32 points with eight made triples
- · Njie 24 points, 21 rebounds

## ACC ROOKIE OF THE YEAR RETURNS FOR MORE

The 2024 ACC Rookie of the Year Markus Burton has trained hard this summer to make year two even better. Last spring, Burton brought home the program's first ACC Rookie of the Year award and third ever Rookie of the Year award of any con-

ference, joining Chris Thomas (2002) and Troy Murphy (1999) - who each won it in the Big East.

Below is a short recap of Burton's stellar and historic rookie campaign:

- His 17.5 ppg led all ACC freshmen
- He ranked 3rd nationally amongst DI freshmen in scoring
- HIs 577 points set a new ND freshman scoring record, surpassing the previous holder Troy Murphy and his 519 points (1998-99).
- Burton's 17.5 ppg ranked 3rd all-time for a freshman behind Troy Murphy (19.2) and Adrian Dantley (18.3)
- His 63 steals tied Jerian Grant for third most in a single season
- ACC play only rankings: 17.5 points (6th), 2.2 steals (1st), 4.8 assists (3rd).
- Dished out 95 assists in ACC play ranked as the 4th most by an ND player
- Produced two games with 15+ point, 5+ assists, 5+ steals. Since 1996, only one other Irish player (Chris Thomas) had produced two games in the same regular season with at least 15-5-5.
- Burton averaged the 2nd most points in the ACC from Feb. 24 on aka to the end of the season, averaging 22.1 ppg in that span (over five games). Burton produced a whopping 6 20+ point games in that span, with one of 30+.
- Four-time ACC Rookie of the Week set a new ND record.

## BEST YOUNG BACKCOURT IN THE ACC

Freshman guards Markus Burton and Braeden Shrewsberry showed no fear in the first year in the ACC. Burton averaged 17.5 points both on the season and in league play, while Shrewsberry was the lone other Irish to finish in double figures, averaging 10.2 points on the year and 11.3 points in ACC play.

With that said, Burton and Shrewsberry became the 9th ACC freshmen duo in league history to rank No. 1 and No. 2 for their team in scoring, proving the future is bright in South Bend.

There is only one scoring duo in the ACC that returns a higher combined number than Burton's and Shrewsberry's 27.7 ppg and that's Wake Forest's Hunter Sallis and Cameron Hildreth. That duo return a combined 31.8 ppg.

Burton and Shrewsberry also proved they aren't afraid of a hostile environment. In true road games, Burton and Shrewsberry averaged 16.3 points and 12.8 points, respectively.

Lastly, don't forget that this duo went off in the nation's capital for the first round of the ACC Tournament in the win over Georgia Tech. Shrewsberry scored a team-high 23 points, shooting 8-of-12 from the field, including 5-of-8 from three-point range. Four of Shrewsberry's threes came in the second half. It marked his third game of 20+ that season. Next, Burton followed right behind with 21 points on 8-of-15 shooting. Burton also tied his season high in assists with eight.

## **SHARPSHOOTER SHREWS**

Speaking of Braeden Shrewsberry, he joined Burton in the Notre Dame record book after lighting it up from three in ACC play last year.

Shrewsberry knocked down 55 three-pointers in league play, breaking the Notre Dame ACC record. The previous record was 51 held by Prentiss Hubb, Matt Farrell and V.J. Beachem.

Those 55 threes in ACC play also tied for the fourth most amongst league players for the 2023-24 season.

Shrewsberry ultimately converted 78 made threes on the year which were the 2nd most nationally by a freshman. His 2.4 made threes/game were 2nd nationally by a freshman as well.

As far as individual games - Shrewsberry tied the program record for made three-pointers by a freshman after draining seven against the Louisville Cardinals. He tied the likes of Pat Connaughton, Chris Thomas and Ryan Hoover

## NON-STOP SUMMER FOR SHREWS

There was no time off or time wasted for Coach Shrewsberry this summer. We've already broached his recruiting efforts, but he also found time to serve as an assistant coach on the U.S. U18 squad during their gold medal run at the 2024 FIBA U18 Americup. The U18 USA squad spent the first week in June competing in Buenos Aires, ultimately downing Brazil to take the top seed in Group B. The U.S. then cruised past Canada in the semifinals to soar right into the gold-medal game where they defeated



Argentina 110-70.

A day after landing back in the States, Coach Shrews hopped on a plane to Boston to catch game five of the NBA Finals. Coach got to celebrate with his former players and staff in the locker room afterwards and has the championship goggles hanging in his office. You can find a video on the NDMBB social accounts of Coach Shrews congratulating his former protegee and NBA Finals MVP Jalen Brown.

## SHREWSBERRY/STEVENS CONNECTION

Celebrating Boston's NBA Title is a great segue into the long-standing friendship between the Shrewsberry and Stevens family.

The connection with Brad Stevens and Micah Shrewsberry dates back to their days at Butler. Then again for six years together with the Boston Celtics. Braeden Shrewsberry states he's been friends with Brady Stevens (Brad's son and now freshman walk-on on the team) for as long as he can remember. Braeden also claimed to be Notre Dame's top recruiter when Brady was deciding on a college.

### THE NEW ADDITIONS

Now let's talk about the new pieces starting with the incoming freshman class. ESPN's final recruiting class rankings had the incoming Irish trio at 19th in the country and 1st in the state of Indiana.

## Cole Certa

(6-5, Guard, from Le Roy, IL)
Certa was ranked 89th overall in the country by ESPN. He transferred to IMG Academy in Florida for his senior year, where he averaged 8.3 points, 3.0 rebounds and 1.5 assists. He helped IMG achieve a 20-9 overall record.

## Sir Mohammed

(6-6, Guard, from Charlotte, NC)
Mohammed is Coach Shrewsberry's
highest rated recruit, coming in at No. 43
nationally by 247 Sports and 57th by ESPN.
Mohammed led Myers Park to a 27-3 overall
record on his way to a Second-Team AllState honor. He averaged 13.5 points, 6.5
rebounds, 5.0 assists and 2.3 steals in 20.5
minutes over 24 games as a senior.

#### **Garrett Sundra**

(6-11, Forward, from Ashburn, VA) Sundra ranked 131st nationally and 29th in his position. He was a key contributor on a loaded Paul VI Catholic squad who achieved a 35-3 overall record and a No. 1 ranking by MaxPreps. Sundra averaged 8.3 points, 6.8 rebounds, 2.3 assists and 2.0 steals per game as a senior.

## **VETERAN ADDITIONS**

From the youth movement to the veteran leadership and experience added with three grad transfers.

### **Matt Allocco**

(6-4, Guard, from Princeton)

A two-time All-Ivy League honoree, Allocco has inserted himself as a vocal leader on this team. He brings NCAA Tournament experience, helping Princeton not only reach the Big Dance in 2023, but also earn two wins, knocking off two-seed Arizona and seven-seed Missouri. Last season, Allocco was the only player in the nation to shoot at least 50% from the field, 40% from three and 90% from the free throw line while appearing in at least 25 games, averaging at least 10 points-per-game and playing least 25 minutes-per-game. In addition, he ranked 29th in the nation in true shooting percentage (64.6).

## Nikita Konstantynovskyi

(6-10, F, from Monmouth)

Konstantynovskyi spent last season at Monmouth where he averaged 9.3 points and 8.1 rebounds per game. He notched six double-doubles and ranked fourth in the CAA in rebounds per game, as well as second in offensive boards (2.9). His top game was an impressive 22-point, 20-rebound performance against Stony Brook.

## Burke Chebuhar

(6-8, F, from Lehigh)

Chebuhar arrives from Lehigh where he saved his best season for last. He averaged 7.5 points and 5.0 rebounds. He played in all 32 games with 22 starts. Chebuhar shot 46.2 percent from the floor and produced four double-doubles.

## **DEFENSE / NEVER GIVE UP**

The year one Coach Shrewsberry stamp on the program was the squad's defensive intensity and never give up attitude. 20 ACC games and 14 different ACC opponents - all but three (Virginia Tech on March 9, UNC on March 5 & Syracuse on Feb. 24) were held under their season average, with Miami, Duke and Louisville each held to season low point totals.

Of the 20 ACC matchups only 6 opponents reached the 70-point park against the Irish defense.

Notre Dame's scoring defense of 67.2 finished with a national ranking of 49th, plus 3rd in the ACC. According to KenPom, Notre Dame's defensive efficiency ranked 39th.

In ACC play, Notre Dame ranked 2nd in scoring defense (66.4) and 2nd in field goal percentage defense (.417).

## RETURNEE BREAKDOWN

#### **Tae Davis**

(6-9, Junior, Forward)

- Played in 32 games with 31 starts
- 15 games in double-figures, plus 3 double-doubles
- Led the team in shooting percentage (.484)
- Finished the season on the best stretch of his career: 7 straight double-digit scoring performances. He averaged 13.3 points on 52.5 percent shooting, plus 5.1 rebounds as well.
- Averaged 9.2 points (3rd most on team) & 5.2 rebounds (2nd most) in ACC play.
- Notable game: Davis scored all 18 of his points in the 2nd half in the win over Clemson on March 2.

### Kebba Njie

(6-10, Junior, Forward)

- Played in 29 games with 27 starts
- Led team in rebounding (5.4) and offensive boards (2.0).
- Averaged 4.5 points & 5.5 rebounds in ACC play.
- Notable game: season high 11 points, plus 9 boards, in ACC Tournament win over Georgia Tech.

## J.R. Konieczny

(6-7, Senior, Guard)

- Played in 32 games with 19 starts
- Shot 40.6 percent from three in ACC play
- Averaged 7.4 points and 4.0 rebounds in league play
- Led the team with 4 double-doubles
- Most notable game: 574 Day vs. Virginia started 4-for-4 from three and 6-for-6 from the field, scoring all 17 of his points in the



first half

#### **Logan Imes**

(6-4, Sophomore, Guard)

- Played in 31 games with 3 starts
- Averaged less than a turnover per game with a 1.1 A/TO ratio
- Scored all 8 of his season-high points in the 2nd half in the win vs. Virginia Tech on Feb. 10. Went 3-fof-4 from the line (final 1:14 of the game) and hit a pivotal three-pointer with 7:23 left.

#### Julian Roper II

(6-4, Senior, Guard)

- Played in 31 games with 12 starts
- 11 points at Virginia Tech in ACC regularseason finale.
- Finished 33.7 percent from three, which ranked as the 2nd highest on the team
- Career high 14 points against Western Michigan, going 6-for-8 from the field.

## COACH SHREWS CULTURE TAKES SHAPE

Coach Shrewsberry achieved two of his priorities in the 2023-24 season: establish the right culture at Notre Dame and have the team playing its best basketball at the end of the year.

The 13 ACC losses certainly don't reflect how close Notre Dame really was in almost every league game. Case in point, Notre Dame recorded an early ACC stretch in which they had been in eight straight tight battles, with the average margin of defeat of 7.5. To sum it up, Notre Dame played in 18 games in which the margin of victory was 10 points or less and went 8-10 in those instances. Diving deeper, the Irish were 4-5 in games decided by five points or less.

There were two moments during the season which could have broken the Irish, but instead they learned from it and grew. The first instance was a 20-point loss to Citadel. The Irish then rebounded with an emphatic 76-54 win over Virginia. What Shrews' crew accomplished had never been done by an Irish team against Virginia .. ever. It was the largest margin of victory against the Cavaliers in the all-time series. In addition, the 76 points were the most scored by an Irish squad against the Cavaliers in regulation in program history. Furthermore, right after the Virginia contest, the Irish almost pulled off the upset to two teams who made the Elite Eight in NC State and Duke.

The second instance was the seven-game losing streak. They rallied together and won five of their next six, which included the final four at home:

- W, 74-66, vs. Virginia Tech
- W, 58-55, vs. Georgia Tech
- W, 72-50, at Louisville
- L, 85-88, at Syracuse
- W, 70-65, vs. Wake Forest
- W, 69-62, vs. Clemson

Here's a stat to conclude it all - when the first NET rankings came on Dec. 4, the Irish were 238. On March 10, the Irish were up to 126.

### **IN-STATE TALENT**

The Irish boast 5 players from the state of Indiana on the 2024-25 roster. That marks the most in-state talent since the 2015-16 Notre Dame squad, who also had five.

The Indiana ties go even further. Coach Shrewsberry grew up right outside of Indianapolis and has coaches all over the state. Kebba Njie played high school ball in Indiana at La Lumiere. Juilan Roper II played in AAU ball in Indy. Brady Stevens spent some time here as a kid when his dad coached at Butler. Plus, Development & Recruiting Coordinator Grady Eifert played at Purdue.

## **2024-25 SCHEDULE NOTES**

The biggest highlight of Notre Dame's schedule will be its Thanksgiving week tournament in Las Vegas. The Fighting Irish were invited to compete in the Players Era Festival, specifically the Impact Tournament alongside Houston and Rutgers. In ESPN's Way Too Early Top-25 rankings, Houston is No. 4 and Rutgers is No. 25.

The 2024 Players Era Festival introduces an entirely new structure for early season competition, coinciding with the opportunity for athletes on each participating team to engage in more than \$1 million in NIL opportunities outside of competition.

In the SEC/ACC Challenge, Notre Dame will have to hit the road yet again, this time traveling to Athens on December 3 to take on the Georgia Bulldogs. It'll mark Notre Dame's first appearance inside Stegeman Coliseum. Notre Dame and Georgia have squared off four times, with the series tied at 2-2. All four matchups have gone down on neutral floors. The Irish will look to claim their first SEC/ACC Challenge victory after coming up short at South Carolina a year ago.

The Fighting Irish will get to tip off ACC play at home on Dec. 7 when they host Syracuse. The bulk of Notre Dame's league schedule will start on New Year's Eve.

For Notre Dame, its home/away repeaters are Syracuse, Boston College and Georgia Tech. The full breakdown is below.

**Home/Away:** Syracuse, Boston College, Georgia Tech

**Home**: North Carolina, Virginia Tech, Louisville, SMU, Pitt, Stanford, Cal

**Away**: NC State, Duke, Virginia, Florida State, Miami, Clemson, Wake Forest

In terms of the T.V. breakdown of the 20-game ACC slate, the Irish will play seven on the ESPN network channels, four on the CW, plus eight on the ACC Network. Notre Dame vs. North Carolina inside Purcell Pavilion on Jan. 4 has been picked up by CBS with a Noon ET tip time.

## 2nd Season at Notre Dame 4th as a Head Coach at the DI Level

On March 24, 2023, an Indiana native came home to kickstart a new era of Notre Dame men's basketball. Vice President and James F. Rohr Notre Dame Director of Athletics Jack Swarbrick announced Micah Shrewsberry as the 18th head coach in Fighting Irish men's basketball history.

Shrewsberry brought a wealth of experience and success to the helm of the Notre Dame program. All-in-all he's coached in six NCAA Tournaments, two NCAA Final Fours, five NBA Playoffs and two NBA Conference Finals - in addition to coaching all-NBA honorees Jayson Tatum and Jaylen Brown.

#### Year One with the Irish

Coach Shrewsberry achieved two of his priorities in the 2023-24 season: establish the right culture at Notre Dame and have the team playing its best basketball at the end of the season. It was a program that returned 1.6% of its scoring and was projected to finish dead last in the ACC. The young Irish team came together and doubled its ACC win total from the year prior, finishing 7-13 in league play. Coach Shrewsberry even received several votes for ACC Coach of the Year. Notre Dame finished with a 13-20 overall record and won one game (First Round vs. Georgia Tech) in the ACC Tournament.

The first key moment of the season included an emphatic 76-54 win over Virginia. What Shrews' crew accomplished had never been done by an Irish team against the Cavaliers .. ever ... it was the largest margin of victory against UVA in the all-time series. In addition, the 76 points were the most scored by an Irish squad against the Cavaliers in regulation in program history. Furthermore, right after the Virginia contest, the Irish almost pulled off the upset to two teams who made the Elite Eight in NC State and Duke.

Next, the Irish bonded together by winning five of six during the final portion of the regular season, which included the final four at home (Georgia Tech, Virginia Tech, Wake Forest, Clemson). From Feb. 1 to March 1, Notre Dame was the biggest mover in kenpom AdjEM across the Power-Five conferences. Another fun stat: when the first NET rankings came on Dec. 4, the Irish were 238. On March 10, the Irish were up to 126.

An early Coach Shrewsberry stamp on the program was the defensive intensity. Notre Dame scoring defense of 67.2 finished with a national ranking of 49th in the country, plus 3rd in the ACC. According to KenPom, Notre Dame's defensive efficiency ranked 39th nationally. In ACC play, Notre Dame

ranked 2nd in scoring defense (66.4) and 2nd in field goal percentage defense (.417). Of the 20 ACC games – all but three (Virginia Tech on March 9, UNC on March 5 & Syracuse on Feb. 24) were held under their season average, with Miami, Duke and Louisville each held to season-low point totals.

Lastly – two freshman guards flourished under Coach Shrewsberry in Markus Burton and Braeden Shrewsberry. Burton became the program's first ACC Rookie of the Year. He also broke the program freshman scoring record after dropping 577 points. Burton averaged 17.5 points both on the season and in league play, leading the Irish. Shrewsberry was the lone other Irish to finish in double figures, averaging 10.2 points on the year and 11.3 points in ACC play. With that said, Burton and Shrewsberry became the 9th ACC freshmen duo in league history to rank No. 1 and No. 2 for their team in scoring, proving the future is bright in South Bend.

#### **Prior to Notre Dame**

Prior to Notre Dame, Shrewsberry produced a historic turnaround as the head coach at Penn State. After a 14-17 first season, Shrewsberry produced a 23-14 mark in 2022-23, just the 12th 20-win season in the 127-year history of Penn State basketball. Furthermore, he collected more Big Ten wins (17) in his first two seasons than any other Penn State head coach.

Shrewsberry certainly captured the nation's attention in late February and into March, going 9-3 over their last 12 games. Shrewsberry then made plenty of noise in the 2023 Big Ten Tournament in Chicago, defeating No. 7 Illinois, No. 2 Northwestern and No. 3 Indiana to reach the championship game as the No. 10 seed. It marked the program's second-ever Big Ten title game appearance. Penn State was just the third double-digit seed to reach the Big Ten Tournament championship game and the first since 2008.

The Nittany Lions then made their first appearance in the NCAA Tournament since 2011. In the first round, Shrewsberry and the Nittany Lions knocked off No. 7 seed and SEC Tour-nament runner-up Texas A&M, winning the program's first NCAA Tournament game since 2001.

In year one at Penn State, Shrewsberry engineered the Big Ten's best scoring defense and guided the squad to their best defensive season (65.0 points allowed per game) in 11 years. The Nittany Lions advanced to the quarterfinal round of the Big Ten Tournament after winning two postseason games, making Shrewsberry one of just two first-year Big Ten coaches since 2008 to win two Big Ten Tournament games.

Recruiting-wise, Shrewsberry made an instant splash in Happy Valley. In his first year, Shrewsberry signed the highest-ranked recruiting class in program history, a consensus top-30 class. A year later, he signed his second-straight top-30 recruiting class, marking the first time in program history that the Nittany Lions had signed back-to-back top-30 recruiting classes.

Development-wise, Shrewsberry proved himself there as well, turning Jalen Pickett and Seth Lundy into 2nd Round NBA Draft picks. It marked the first time in program history that two Nittany Lions were selected.

Statistically speaking the 2022-23 squad set the BIG and Penn State single-season team record for three-pointers made in a season with 385. The Nittany Lions compiled a total of five top-15 national statistical rankings. In addition, Shrewsberry tutored an Associated Press All-American in Jalen Pickett and a total of three All-Big Ten players during the 2022-23 season.

Prior to his time with Penn State, Shrewsberry experienced two separate stints at Purdue - one as assistant coach from 2011-13 and another as associate head coach from 2019-21. Highlights include the 2020-21 season, in which Shrewsberry helped lead the Boilermakers to a 13-6 fourth-place finish in the Big Ten and an 18-10 overall mark, culminating in an NCAA Tournament at-large bid. Trevion Williams claimed first-team All-Big Ten honors, while Zach Edey and Jaden Ivey were All-Freshman Team selections. Shrewsberry played a major role in recruiting Ivey, who grew up in South Bend and is the son of Karen and Kevin Keyes Family Head Women's Basketball Coach Niele Ivev.

Another highlight from his time in West Lafavette includes the 2011-12 squad that produced a 22-13 record and reached the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Under Shrewsberry. Terone Johnson was one of the most improved players in the BIG, netting accolades from conference and national entities.

In between his Purdue stints, Shrewsberry spent six seasons (2013-19) with the NBA's Boston Celtics as an assistant coach under Brad Stevens. During his tenure, the Celtics reached the playoffs in five consecutive seasons, including back-to-back appearances in the Eastern Conference Finals in 2017 and 2018.

Shrewsberry played a key role in the development of current NBA stars Brown and Tatum, who were the No. 3 picks in the 2016 and 2017 NBA Drafts, respectively. Tatum was an NBA All-Rookie Team first-team selection, while Brown earned second-team All-Rookie honors.

The Brad Stevens connection was previously made at Butler University, where Shrewsberry spent one year as the director of operations then three as an assistant coach. With Shrewsberry on the sidelines, the Bulldogs compiled an 87-21 record, won two Horizon League regular-season championships and two Horizon League Tournament titles and made three NCAA Tournament appearances - which included back-to-back runs to the national championship game in 2010 and 2011.

Also at Butler, he aided in the development of Gordon Hayward, who was the 2009 Horizon League Newcomer of the Year, the 2010 Horizon League Player of the Year and a 2010 Final Four All-Tournament Team selection. Hayward was the ninth overall pick in the 2010 NBA Draft by the Utah Jazz.

Continuing on Shrewsberry's basketball journey, he spent time as the director of basketball operations at Marshall University (2003-05) and an assistant coach at DePauw University (2001-03) and Wabash College (2000-01). At DePauw, Shrewsberry led the Tigers to a 42-12 record with a pair of conference championships.

Shrewsberry was also the first men's basketball head coach at Indiana University South Bend. Shrewsberry started his coaching career as a graduate assistant at the University of Indianapolis in 1999-2000.

An Indianapolis area native, Shrewsberry earned his bachelor's degree from Hanover College in 1999 and a master's degree from Indiana State in 2003. As a player at Hanover, Shrewsberry was a three-year starting guard and team tri-captain.

He and his wife, Molly, have four children, Braeden, Nicholas, Caitlin and Grace

- Averaging 6.0 assists/game which ranks 34th nationally and fourth in the ACC.
- Shooting 44.1 percent from two-point range.
- A quiet first half at Georgetown (11/16), but turned it on in the second when he scored 12 of his 16 points. He was a perfect 8-for-8 from the free-throw line.
- Burton flirted with what would have been just the program's second ever triple-double. The sophomore recorded 19 points, a career high nine rebounds and a career-high tying eight assists.
- Burton did Burton things in the season opener, posting 18 points & 5 assists against Stonehill.

## Freshman Season (2023-24)

- His 17.5 ppg led all ACC freshmen. Ranked 3rd nationally amongst DI freshmen
- Burton's **577 points** set a new ND freshman scoring record, surpassing the previous holder Troy Murphy and his 519 points (1998-99).
- Only rookie in the country who averaged at least 17 points, 4 assists and 1.9 steals. In fact, he's just 1-of-2 P5 players (other is Syracuse's Judah Mintz)

- Dished out 95 assists in ACC play ranked as the 4th most by an ND player
- Career high 31 points in the win over Wake Forest on Feb. 27. Dropped 19 in the first half. Career high 11-for-11 from the free-throw line. Now 1-of-4 freshmen in program history to record a 30-point game: Troy Murphy, Chris Thomas and Adrian Dantley.
- Double-digit points in all but 3 games.
- Stat line vs. Virginia Tech (2/10) 16 points, eight assists and six steals, as the latter tied for the 3rd most steals in a single game in program history.
- Since 1996, only one other Irish player had produced two games in the same regular season with at least 15 points, 5 assists and 5 steals. His name was Chris Thomas back in the 2001-02 season. Burton has not only achieved this feat but did it in back-to-back games.
- Averaged 18.1 points at home, shooting 44.5 percent.
- Set the program record for most points in a freshman debut, pouring in 29 to lift the Irish to a 70-63 win over Niagara. Laphonso Ellis previously held the record with 27 set back in 1988. Burton took over the end of the Niagara game - from 8:38-2:20 in the second half, Burton recorded 16 points on 6-for-6 shooting.


