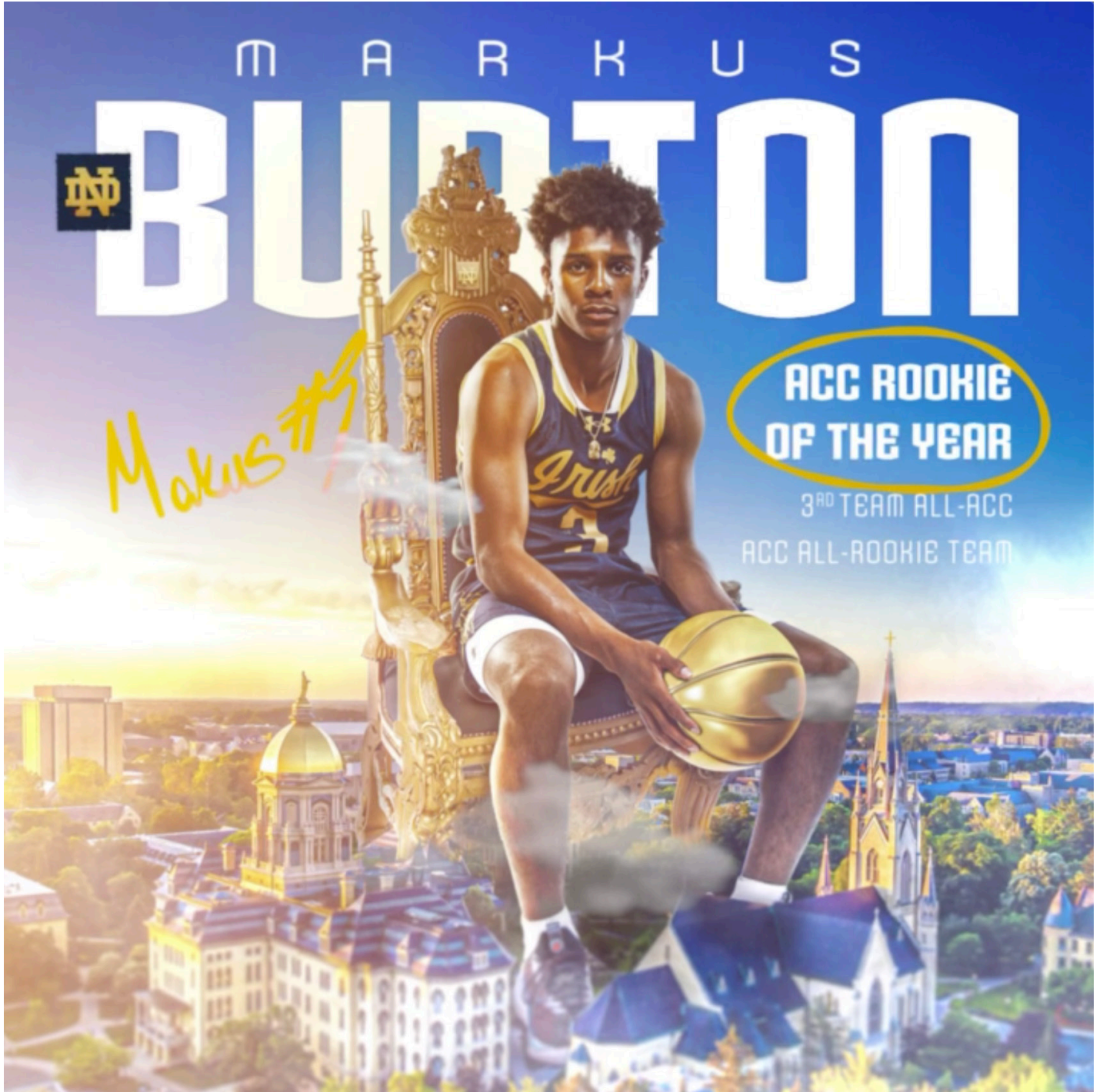

COACH SHREWS CULTURE TAKES SHAPE

Coach Shrewsberry achieved two of his priorities in the 2023-24 season: establish the right culture at Notre Dame and have the team be playing its best basketball at the end of the season.

It was a program that returned 1.6% of its scoring and was projected to finish dead last in the conference. This young team came together and emptied their tanks for their head coach and the Fighting Irish fans. As a result, Notre Dame doubled its ACC win total from the year prior, finishing 7-13 in league play. Coach Shrewsberry even received several votes for ACC Coach of the Year.

In fact, Notre Dame was in just about every single league contest during the 2023-24 season. Case in point, Notre Dame recorded an early ACC stretch in which they had been in eight straight tight battles in which the average margin of defeat was 7.5: Pitt, Virginia, BC x2, Miami, FSU, Duke and NC State. In both Boston College games, the Irish had a three-point attempt to either tie or win the game in the closing seconds. Same goes for the 88-85 loss at Syracuse. The NC State loss came down to the final possession.

Overall on the year, Notre Dame had played in 18 games in which the margin of victory was 10 points or less and went 8-10 in those instances. Diving deeper, the Irish were 4-5 in games decided by five points or less.

There were two moments during the season which could have broke the Irish, but instead they learned from it and grew. The first instance was a 20-point loss to Citadel.

The Irish then rebounded with an emphatic 76-54 win over Virginia. What Shrews' crew accomplished had never been done by an Irish team against Virginia .. ever. It was the largest margin of victory against the Cavaliers in the all-time series. In addition, the 76 points were the most scored by an Irish squad against the Cavaliers in regulation in program history. Furthermore, the Irish handed Virginia its biggest loss to an ACC opponent since 2017 (65-41 loss to No. 10 UNC on Feb. 18, 2017). Furthermore, right after the Virginia contest, the Irish almost pulled off the upset to two teams who made the Elite Eight in NC State and Duke.

The second instance was the seven-game losing streak. They bonded together and inspired the fanbase behind them by winning five of their next six, which included the final four at home:

- W, 74-66, vs. Virginia Tech
- W, 58-55, vs. Georgia Tech
- W, 72-50, at Louisville
- L, 85-88, at Syracuse
- W, 70-65, vs. Wake Forest
- W, 69-62, vs. Clemson

From Feb. 1 to March 1, Notre Dame was the biggest mover in kenpom AdjEM across the Power-Five conferences. Another fun stat: when the first NET rankings came on Dec. 4, the Irish were 238. As of March 10, the Irish were up to 126.

Lastly, Notre Dame was 6-0 this past season when limiting their turnover total to single digits. They have produced single-digit turnovers five times over the final nine games, improving upon their early season mistakes.

ACC ROOKIE OF THE YEAR

Notre Dame brought home its first ACC Rookie of the Year award courtesy of Markus Burton. He proved to be one of the most dynamic freshman guards, not just in the ACC, but in the entire country. Burton became the program's third ever Rookie of the Year award winner (of any conference) joining Chris Thomas (2002) and Troy Murphy (1999) who each won it in the Big East.

For those that missed Burton's stellar first year, here's the TLDR version:

- His 17.5 ppg led all ACC freshmen
- He also ranked 3rd nationally amongst DI freshmen in scoring
- His 577 points set a new ND freshman scoring record, surpassing the previous holder Troy Murphy and his 519 points (1998-99).
- Burton's 17.5 ppg ranked 3rd all-time for a freshman behind Troy Murphy (19.2) and Adrian Dantley (18.3)
- Only rookie in the country who averaged at least 17 points, 4 assists and 1.9 steals. In fact, he was just 1-of-2 P5 players (other was Syracuse's Judah Mintz)
- ACC freshman rankings: 1st in scoring, 2nd in assists/game, 1st in steals/game
- Burton finished the year strong: He averaged the 2nd most points (22.1 ppg) in the ACC from Feb. 24 on. Burton produced a whopping 6 20+ point games in that span, with one of 30+
- His 63 steals tied Jerian Grant for third most in a single season
- ACC play only rankings: 17.5 points (6th), 2.2 steals (1st), 4.8 assists (3rd).
- Dished out 95 assists in ACC play - ranked as the 4th most by an ND player
- Produced two games with 15+ point, 5+ assists, 5+ steals. Since 1996, only one

other Irish player (Chris Thomas) had produced two games in the same regular season with at least 15-5-5.

• Four-time ACC Rookie of the Week - set a new ND record.

FRESHMAN SCORING RECORD

In the final game of the regular season, Markus Burton etched his name in the Notre Dame record book once more, breaking the program's freshman scoring record. Burton surpassed ND great Troy Murphy and his 519 points for the No. 1 spot. Burton ended the year with 577 points.

From a scoring average perspective, Burton's 17.5 ppg ranked 3rd all-time behind Troy Murphy (19.2) and Adrian Dantley (18.3).

BURTON - MORE THAN A SCORER

Burton nearly made more history until the ACC Tournament dropped his steals per game average below 2.0. Before that, he was eyeing to achieve two things - the first to average at least 17.0 points, 4.0 assists and 2.0 steals in ND history. ND great Chris Thomas had the closest final season averages to that with 15.6 points, 7.6 assists and 2.2 steals in 2001-02.

He would have also been the 4th player in program history to average at least 2.0 spg in a season, joining Chris Thomas, David Rivers and Jerian Grant.

Yet the final two games of the season in Washington D.C., dropped the freshman's spg average to 1.9 (collected just one steal in each). Still impressive all the same. No other rookie in the country this past season averaged at least 17 points, 4 assists and 1.9 steals.

Burton finished with 63 steals on the year which tied Jerian Grant for the third most at Notre Dame. His 1.9 spg tied for fifth highest for a single season at ND.

Lastly, Burton dished out 95 assists during ACC play, which ranked as the fourth most by a ND player. Burton ultimately recorded 123 assists in year one.

DEFENSE / NEVER GIVE UP

The year one Coach Shrewsberry stamp on the program was the squad's defensive intensity and never give up attitude. 20 ACC games and 14 different ACC opponents - all but three (Virginia Tech on March 9, UNC on March 5 & Syracuse on Feb. 24) were held

under their season average, with Miami, Duke and Louisville each held to season low point totals.

Of the 20 ACC matchups only 6 opponents reached the 70-point park against the Irish defense.

Notre Dame's scoring defense of 67.2 finished with a national ranking of 49th in the country, plus 3rd in the ACC. According to KenPom, Notre Dame's defensive efficiency ranked 39th nationally.

In ACC play, Notre Dame ranked 2nd in scoring defense (66.4) and 2nd in field goal percentage defense (.417).

Now, on the never give up part. In the times Notre Dame trailed an ACC opponent, the common theme from the media and fans afterwards was that the Irish kept fighting and were in every game. There was no greater example of this than the Syracuse game on Feb. 24 in New York. It would have been the greatest comeback in not just school history but by an ACC member institution as well. Syracuse went up 29 points late in the first half only for Notre Dame to rally, have two shots at a tie, but fell one possession short, 88-85. The Irish scored a season-high 56 points in the second half. That's the most points the program has ever scored in a half of any ACC game.

DYNAMIC DUO

Freshman guards Markus Burton and Braeden Shrewsberry showed no fear in the first year in the ACC. Burton averaged 17.5 points both on the season and in league play, leading the Irish. Shrewsberry was the lone other Irish to finish in double figures, averaging 10.2 points on the year and 11.3 points in ACC play.

With that said, Burton and Shrewsberry became the 9th ACC freshmen duo in league history rank No. 1 and No. 2 for their in scoring, proving the future is bright in South Bend.

Burton and Shrewsberry also proved they aren't afraid of a hostile environment. In true road games, Burton and Shrewsberry averaged 16.3 points and 12.8 points, respectively.

Road games since February 3 for Burton - 24 points at Virginia Tech, 9 points at UNC, 28 points at Syracuse, 16 points at Louisville, 17

points at Pitt, 19 points at Duke.

For Shrewsberry, he caught fire with 18 points in the 2nd half at Syracuse and his 23-point showing at Louisville with seven made threes. Both of those were outdone by his season high 25-point effort in the OT win at Georgia Tech. On the road, Shrewsberry shot 48.2 percent from the field and 42.2 percent from three, averaging 2.9 made threes/game.

SHARPSHOOTER SHREWS

Braeden Shrewsberry joined Burton in the Notre Dame record book after lighting it up from three in ACC play.

Shrewsberry knocked down 55 three-pointers in ACC play, breaking the Notre Dame ACC record. The previous record was 51 held by Prentiss Hubb, Matt Farrell and V.J. Beachem.

Those 55 threes in ACC play also tied for the fourth most amongst league players for the 2023-24 season.

Shrews ultimately converted 78 made threes on the year which were the 2nd most nationally by a freshman. His 2.4 made threes/game were 2nd nationally by a freshman as well.

As far as individual games - Shrewsberry tied the program record for made three-pointers by a freshman after draining seven against the Louisville Cardinals. He tied the likes of Pat Connaughton, Chris Thomas and Ryan Hoover.

Lastly, Shrewsberry shot 41.4 percent from deep in ACC play - that number ranked 6th amongst ACC players and ranked 7th all-time in Notre Dame ACC program history.

ENDING STRONG

Burton averaged the 2nd most points in the ACC from Feb. 24 on aka to the end of the season, averaging 22.1 ppg in that span (over five games). Burton produced a whopping 6 20+ point games in that span, with one of 30+.

There there was Tae Davis who produced the best stretch of his young career over the final seven games of the season. You guessed it, 7 straight double-digit scoring performances in which he averaged 13.3 points (2nd most to Burton in that span) on 52.5 percent shooting.

Some end-of-year notables for Davis include: 28 total points on a combined 8-for-15 from the field, plus 11-for-15 from the free-throw line, over 2 ACC Tournament games. In addition, Davis scored all 18 of his points in the 2nd half in the win over Clemson on March 2. Lastly, with the Irish only up 2 vs. Wake Forest on Feb. 27, Davis got the ball in his hands and beat his defender 1-v-1 in a crucial take with 22 seconds left. Davis finished with 11 points.

IRISH ACC TOURNEY HISTORY

The Fighting Irish are now 13-9 all-time in the ACC Tournament. They have reached the title game twice and took home the tournament crown in 2015.

Thus, Shrewsberry is now 7-3 in league tournament action as a head coach.

LEGENDS CLASSIC TAKEAWAYS

A couple of Irish standouts from two games in Brooklyn during the Legends Classic. First, let's look at All-Tournament Team selection Markus Burton. The freshman took over the end of the Oklahoma State game scoring 16 of his team-high 20 points in the second half plus overtime (10 in 2H + 6 in OT). He averaged 16.0 points over the two games.

Next, it was a breakout week for Konieczny, as he produced back-to-back double-doubles, averaging 14.5 points and 10.5 rebounds. He also earned his first career start in the win over Oklahoma State (11/17). J.R. entered the Legends Classic week with 15 points and 3 rebounds to his name thru 8 career ND games. Then over those 2 games, he produced a total of 29 points and 21 rebounds. J.R. constantly attacked the offensive glass, grabbing 8 O-Boards over the 2 games.

Last but not least, there was Tae Davis who averaged 10.0 points on 57.1 percent shooting (8-14 FG), along with 5.0 rebounds per game. Davis recorded a career high 13 points against the Auburn Tigers.

HISTORIC DEBUT FOR BURTON

Not only did freshman point guard Markus Burton ball out in a historic debut in the season opener, but he got to do it in front of his hometown crowd and family. Burton poured in 29 points to lift the Irish to a 70-63 win over Niagara, marking the most points in program history in a freshman debut. The previous record was 27 points from Laphonso Ellis back in 1988. Now a few other notes on Burton's performance.

- 1-of-5 freshmen in the history of the program to score 29 points or more, joining David Graves, Troy Murphy, Chris Thomas and Adrian Dantley.
- Burton absolutely took over the end of the game. From 8:38-2:20 in the second half, Burton recorded 16 points on 6-for-6 shooting.

THE FOUNDATION GROWS

Coach Shrewsberry continued to build the foundation of Irish hoops by announcing three Class of 2024 signees. Cole Certa, Sir Muhammed and Garrett Sundra all signed their National Letters of Intent and officially became Irish on Nov. 6.

Shrewsberry, who started this current season with a talented four-member freshman class that was ranked in the top-30, has now built upon that with a 2024 class that is ranked as high as No. 19 by 247Sports. The trio of Cole Certa (6-5 guard from Le Roy, Illinois), Sir Muhammed (6-6 guard from Charlotte, North Carolina) and Garrett Sundra (6-11 forward from Ashburn, Virginia) also rank as the fifth best class in the ACC by 247Sports.

"We are thrilled to welcome three tremendous young men into the Notre Dame family. I am very proud of the job we were able to do on the recruiting trail in this class by landing Cole Certa, Sir Muhammed and Garrett Sundra. When we got the job here, we put a premium on bringing in players who fit our team on the court as well as off the court. All three of these young men are not only tremendous basketball players, as evidenced by the fact that this is ranked as one of the top recruiting classes not only in the ACC, but in the country as well, but they are also excellent students who fit the mission and the culture of Notre Dame."

1st Season at Notre Dame
3rd as a Head Coach at DI Level

An Indiana native has come home to kick start a new era of Notre Dame men's basketball. Vice President and James E. Rohr Notre Dame Director of Athletics Jack Swarbrick announced Micah Shrewsberry as the 18th head coach in Fighting Irish men's basketball history on March 23, 2023.

"We are so excited to have Coach (Shrewsberry) join the Notre Dame family," Swarbrick said. "Throughout this process, it reaffirmed for me that this job was among the best in the country as we had many great candidates express interest."

"During our two month process, we weekly reviewed our candidate pool and each week he (Micah) stayed at the top of our list due to his fit at the University and his commitment to the student-athlete experience. Not only do his personal & family values align with the University, but his dedication to the development of each member of his program as well."

Shrewsberry is fresh off a historic turnaround as the head coach at Penn State. After a 14-17 first season, Shrewsberry produced a 23-14 mark in 2022-23, just the 12th 20-win season in the 127-year history of Penn State basketball. Furthermore, he collected more Big Ten wins (17) in his first two seasons than any other Penn State head coach.

Shrewsberry brings a wealth of experience and success to the helm of the Notre Dame program. All-in-all he's coached in six NCAA Tournaments, two NCAA Final Fours, five NBA Playoffs and two NBA Conference Finals – in addition to coaching all-NBA honorees Jayson Tatum and Jaylen Brown.

"I'm very excited to be joining the University of Notre Dame family," Shrewsberry said. "The combination of top notch academics, plus a long storied history of success on the basketball court, made this a very attractive job for me. The power of the Notre Dame brand, and the passionate alumni family, will allow us to recruit the brightest student-athletes from coast to coast. I can't wait to get to campus and begin connecting with the students, faculty and staff which make this place special."

Shrewsberry and Penn State captured the nation's attention in late February and into March, going 9-3 over their last 12 games, which included six Quad 1 wins. Shrewsberry then made plenty of noise in the 2023 Big Ten Tournament in Chicago, defeating No. 7 Illinois, No. 2 Northwestern and No. 3 Indiana to reach the championship game as the No. 10 seed.

It marked the program's second-ever Big Ten title game appearance. Penn State was just the third double-digit seed to reach the Big Ten Tournament championship game and the first since 2008.

The Nittany Lions then made their first appearance in the NCAA Tournament since 2011. In the first round, Shrewsberry and the Nittany Lions knocked off No. 7 seed and SEC Tournament runner-up Texas A&M, winning the program's first NCAA Tournament game since 2001.

In year one at Penn State, Shrewsberry engineered the Big Ten's best scoring defense and guided the squad to their best defensive season (65.0 points allowed per game) in 11 years. The Nittany Lions advanced to the quarterfinal round of the Big Ten Tournament after winning two postseason games, making Shrewsberry one of just two first-year Big Ten coaches since 2008 to win two Big Ten Tournament games.

Recruiting-wise, Shrewsberry made an instant splash in Happy Valley. In his first year, Shrewsberry signed the highest-ranked recruiting class in program history, a consensus top-30 class. A year later, he signed his second-straight top-30 recruiting class, marking the first time in program history that the Nittany Lions had signed back-to-back top-30 recruiting classes.

Statistically speaking, the 2022-23 squad set the B1G and Penn State single-season team record for three-pointers made in a season with 385. The Nittany Lions compiled a total of five top-15 national

statistical rankings. In addition, Shrewsberry tutored an Associated Press All-American in Jalen Pickett and a total of three All-Big Ten players during the 2022-23 season.

Prior to his time with Penn State, Shrewsberry experienced two separate stints at Purdue – one as assistant coach from 2011-13 and another as associate head coach from 2019-21. Highlights include the 2020-21 season, in which Shrewsberry helped lead the Boilermakers to a 13-6 fourth-place finish in the Big Ten and an 18-10 overall mark, culminating in an NCAA Tournament at-large bid. Trevion Williams claimed first-team All-Big Ten honors, while Zach Edey and Jaden Ivey were All-Freshman Team selections. Shrewsberry played a major role in recruiting Ivey, who grew up in South Bend and is the son of Karen and Kevin Keyes Family Head Women's Basketball Coach Niele Ivey.

Another highlight from his time in West Lafayette includes the 2011-12 squad that produced a 22-13 record and reached the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Under Shrewsberry, Terone Johnson was one of the most improved players in the B1G, netting accolades from conference and national entities.

In-between his Purdue stints, Shrewsberry spent six seasons (2013-19) with the NBA's Boston Celtics as an assistant coach under Brad Stevens. During his tenure, the Celtics reached the playoffs in five consecutive seasons, including back-to-back appearances in the Eastern Conference Finals in 2017 and 2018.

Shrewsberry played a key role in the development of current NBA stars Brown and Tatum, who were the No. 3 picks in the 2016 and 2017 NBA Drafts, respectively. Tatum was an NBA All-Rookie Team first-team selection, while Brown earned second-team All-Rookie honors.

The Brad Stevens connection was previously made at Butler University, where Shrewsberry spent one year as the director of operations then three as an assistant coach. With Shrewsberry on the sidelines, the Bulldogs compiled an 87-21 record, won two Horizon League regular-season championships and two Horizon League Tournament titles and made three NCAA Tournament appearances – which included back-to-back runs to the national championship game in 2010 and 2011.

Also at Butler, he aided in the development of Gordon Hayward, who was the 2009 Horizon League Newcomer of the Year, the 2010 Horizon League Player of the Year and a 2010 Final Four All-Tournament Team selection. Hayward was the ninth overall pick in the 2010 NBA Draft by the Utah Jazz.

Continuing on Shrewsberry's basketball journey, he spent time as the director of basketball operations at Marshall University (2003-05) and an assistant coach at DePauw University (2001-03) and Wabash College (2000-01). At DePauw, Shrewsberry led the Tigers to a 42-12 record with a pair of conference championships.

Shrewsberry was also the first men's basketball head coach at Indiana University South Bend. Shrewsberry started his coaching career as a graduate assistant at the University of Indianapolis in 1999-2000.

An Indianapolis area native, Shrewsberry earned his bachelor's degree from Hanover College in 1999 and a master's degree from Indiana State in 2003. As a player at Hanover, Shrewsberry was a three-year starting guard and team tri-captain.

He and his wife, Molly, have four children, Braeden, Nicholas, Caitlin and Grace.

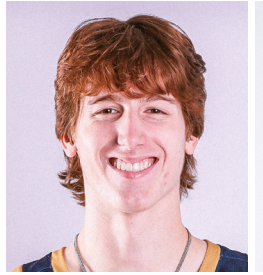
