| 5 | Notre Dame's five road wins are its most since recording six wins on the road in 2014 (also six in 2012). The last time the Irish won seven or more games on the road was in 2010, when it won eight and won the national championship. |
| 6 | Notre Dame concluded the ACC regular season in sixth place in the conference with a record of 5-3-2. |
| 9 | Sophomore Jennifer Westendorf owns a career-high nine goals, three more than her previous single-season career high (six). Westendorf's nine goals are tied for the sixth-most in the ACC. |
| 10 | Notre Dame's Natalie Jacobs (10 G) has scored 10 of Notre Dame's 37 goals this season. The 10 goals are the most by an Irish player since 2015 and rank tied for the fourth-most goals in the ACC this season. |
| 13 | Notre Dame has competed against an NCAA tournament team 13 times this season, going 5-5-3 in those contests. |
| 14 | The Irish check in at No. 14 in this week's RPI. The Irish own the third-best RPI in the ACC behind North Carolina (No. 2) and Duke (No. 4). |
| 19 | Graduate student Sandra Yu's 19 points in 2017 are a career high. The midfielder has totaled seven goals and five assists so far this season. Yu has more than doubled her previous career high in points (eight), set in 2015. |
| 24 | The Irish have totaled 24 second-half goals and have limited their opponents to 17 goals in the period. |
| 25 | The Irish will make their 25th straight NCAA Championship appearance. Notre Dame owns 12 trips to the College Cup and three NCAA titles. |
| 30 | Notre Dame celebrates its 30th anniversary this season. The Irish have gone 542-116-40 in program history. |
| 37 | Notre Dame's 37 goals this season are 11 more than it recorded in 2016, when it finished with 26. |
| 50 | Irish head coach Theresa Romagnolo, who is in her fourth season with the Irish, won her 50th game at Miami on Oct. 22. The Washington graduate owns a record of 50-20-12 at Notre Dame. |

AT A GLANCE

Notre Dame is set to compete in the NCAA tournament for the 25th straight season. The Irish will meet the Jaguars in the first round of the tournament at 6 p.m. ET on Saturday at Alumni Stadium. The winner of Saturday's match will advance to the second round to face the winner of Lamar and Texas A&M.

SERIES HISTORY: JAGUARS

Notre Dame has faced IUPUI once in program history on Nov. 13, 2009 in the first round of the NCAA Championships. The Irish defeated IUPUI 5-0 in the match.

30TH ANNIVERSARY

Notre Dame women's soccer celebrates its 30th anniversary during the 2017 season. In the program's history, the Irish have gone 542-116-40. Over the past 29 seasons, Notre Dame has made 24 appearances in the NCAA Championship. The Irish have competed in 12 College Cups and have won three national titles.

STORYLINES

CHECKING THE RPI

Notre Dame checked in at No. 14 in the most recent RPI. The Irish faced seven ranked opponents -- all in the ACC -- from Sept. 16 to Oct. 26 and went 3-2-2 in those games. Notre Dame lost to then-No. 11 South Carolina in double-overtime.

25TH STRAIGHT

Notre Dame received its 25th straight bid in the NCAA Championship. The Irish will look to advance to their 13th College Cup and ultimately win their fourth national title. The Irish have gone 67-20-2 in 24 trips to the NCAA Championship. Notre Dame has played host to at least one match in 22 of its 24 tournament appearances thus far.

ACC ACCOLADES

Four Irish received All-ACC accolades, including Sandra Yu (first team), Natalie Jacobs (second team), Jennifer Westendorf (third team) and Sammi Fisher (freshman team). Yu's honor comes in the midst of a career season just one year after she was named to the All-ACC third team. Jacobs adds the all-conference honor to a resume that also includes a nod to the All-Freshman team in 2015. The honor marks the second in as many years for Westendorf. In 17 games played, Fisher has recorded seven points on three goals with one assist.

ROAD WARRIORS

Notre Dame has played nine true road games this season and one in postseason play. The Irish own a 5-2-2 record on the road thus far and are 5-2-3 away from home. Notre Dame has gone 4-1-2 in its last seven road games. In 2016, the Irish concluded their season with a 3-1-4 record on the road.

COSIDA ACADEMIC ALL-DISTRICT

Notre Dame's Jennifer Westendorf and Sandra Yu each were named to the CoSIDA Academic All-District first team on Thursday. The honor marks the first of their respective careers. Yu owns career highs in nearly every category, including goals (7) and assists (5). Westendorf has surpassed her 2016 point total with 25 and her single-season career high in goals (six) with nine.

SECOND-HALF MAGIC

Notre Dame has outscored its opponents 24-17 in the second half this season. The Irish have entered halftime in a scoreless tie nine times and in a 1-1 tie twice in 2017. Notre Dame has scored four goals in the second half three times this season against Ball St., Santa Clara and Toledo.

SCORING IN BUNCHES

Notre Dame has gone 7-2 in games decided by two-plus goals. The Irish offense has scored four goals on six occasions this season, turning in dominant performances in such matches. Notre Dame has surpassed its 2016 scoring total (26 goals) with a sum of 37 goals this season. As a team, the Irish have been most successful in regulation, with all nine of their wins coming in the first 90 minutes.

THE ACC LEADERBOARD

Nineteen matches into the season, the Irish rank among the leaders in several offensive statistical categories. Notre Dame ranks third in the ACC in goals (37) and tied for third with 33 assists and 107 points.

SUNDAY FUNDAY

Notre Dame owns a 7-2 record on Sunday in 2017. The Irish have played on Thursday four times (1-1-2), on Friday five times (0-3-2), on Saturday once (1-0) and on Sunday nine times (7-2). All seven of Notre Dame's Sunday victories have come in the afternoon, four of which were at home (Ball St., Santa Clara, NC State and Syracuse) and three of which were on the road (at Iowa, at Toledo and at Miami).

TOPDRAWERSOCCER.COM HONOR

Sophomore Jennifer Westendorf was named to TopDrawerSoccer.com's Women's Preseason Best XI Second Team. Westendorf was a 2016 All-ACC Freshman Team and 2016 All-ACC Second Team selection. Westendorf has started 39 games and tallied 38 points in two seasons at Notre Dame.

CAREER YEAR FOR YU

After missing her first two seasons due to injury, Sandra Yu returned to the program as a graduate student and has recorded a career-high 19 points in 2017. Yu already has doubled her previous career high in points (eight), set in 2015. Yu has started all of Notre Dame's contests over the past two-plus seasons (2015-17), tallying 31 points on 12 goals and seven assists in her career. In 2016, Yu totaled 45 shots, including 21 shots on goal (.467). Yu also competed on the United States U-23 Women's National Team this past summer.

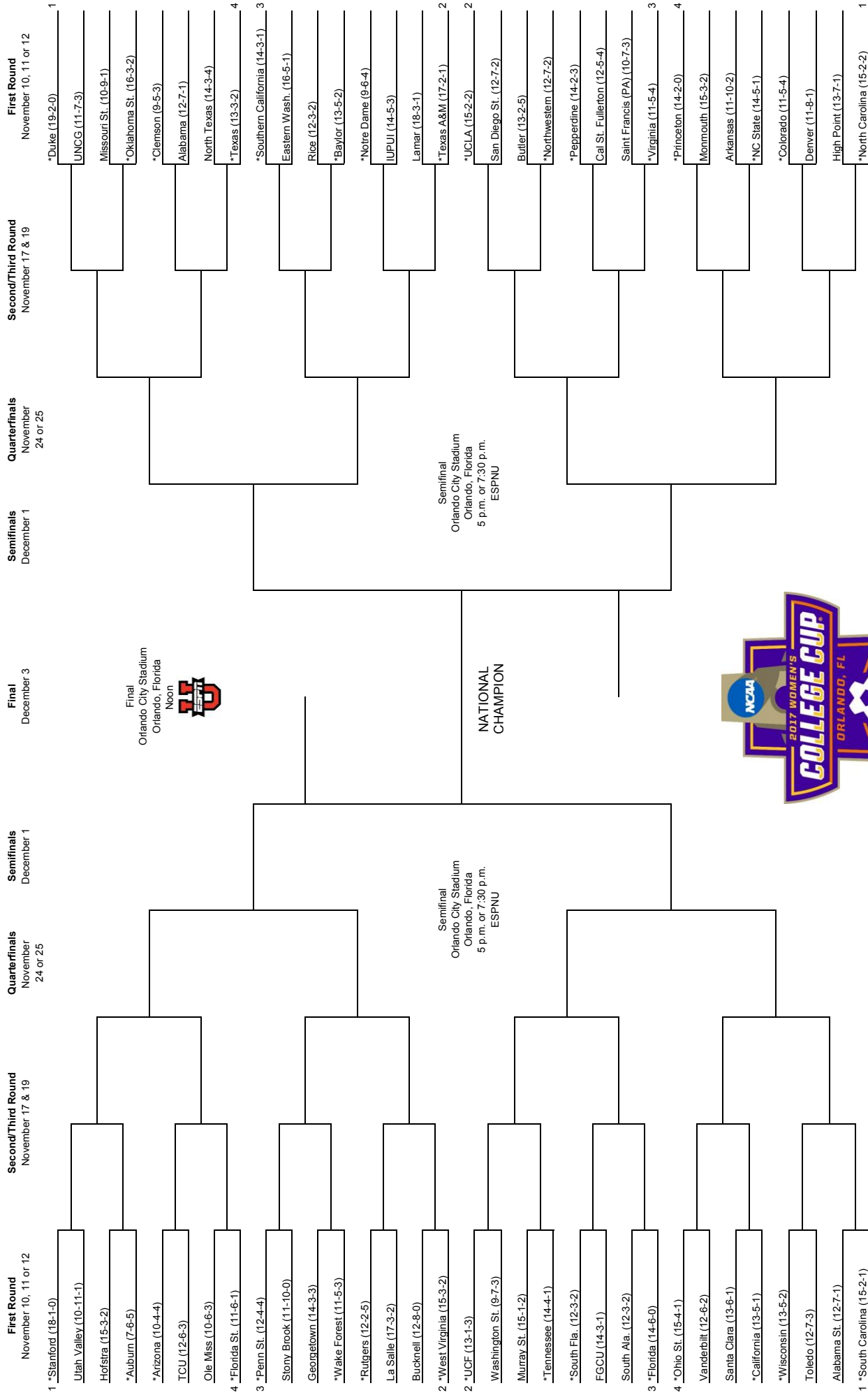
