## MATCH NOTES

### SCOUTING NOTRE DAME:

Last season, Notre Dame finished with an overall record of 17-14 and made it all the way to the Big East Finals before losing to Louisville 3-1. The Irish return six seniors - including all-BIG EAST performers Christina Kaelin and Serinity Phillips - to go along with fellow all-league choice Kellie Sciacca. Joining the 12 letterwinners returning on this year's team are three nationally-recognized freshmen. In her 18th season as head coach, Debbie Brown will look to add to her career record total of 541-246.

### SCOUTING LSU:

In her 12th season at LSU, Head Coach Fran Flory has amassed an overall record of 198-132 and is coming off an 18-10 season and an NCAA Tournament appearance. Picked to win the SEC West this season, the Tigers return five starters from last year's squad, including senior middle blockers Brittnee Cooper and Lauren DeGiralamo. Also returning for LSU is libero Lauren Wacławczyk. This will be the first meeting between the Pioneers and the Tigers.

### SCOUTING STANFORD:

In his ninth season as head coach at Stanford, John Dunning is boasting a 239-37 career record with the Cardinals. Last season, he led the team to a 31-4 overall record, 17-1 in conference action and a second-place finish. The Cardinals reached the NCAA Finals, losing to Penn State 3-0, making it their 18th Final Four appearance. Stanford returns three starters and its libero from last season, and welcomes four newcomers to the fold. Top returner for the Cardinals is junior Alix Klineman, who is a two-time AVCA All-American and two-time Volleyball Magazine First Team All-American.

## WHAT'S NEXT:

The DU volleyball team will open the 2009 season this coming weekend at the Shamrock Invitational, hosted by Notre Dame in South Bend, Ind. The Pioneers' first opponent at the Shamrock Invitational will be host Notre Dame, a team that finished with an overall record

of 17-14 and made it all the way to the Big East Finals before losing to Louisville 3-1. The Irish return six seniors - including all-BIG EAST performers Christina Kaelin and Serinity Phillips - to go along with fellow all-league choice Kellie Sciacca. Next up for Denver is LSU, a team that finished 18-10 a season ago. The Tigers return four starters and eight letter winners, while welcoming four newcomers to the team. The final match for the Pioneers this weekend will be against Stanford, a squad that was picked fifth in the AVCA Preseason Poll. In 2008, Stanford posted a 31-4 record and won an unprecedented 12th Pac-10 title. This is the first time the Pioneers will face either of these opponents.

### WHAT'S AHEAD:

The Pioneers return home to host back-to-back-to-back tournaments in Hamilton Gymnasium. Action will begin with the DU Invitational on Sept. 4-5, as the Pioneers will host Air Force, Eastern Illinois, Southern Utah and West Virginia over the course of two days. Next up will be the CU-DU Tournament, a co-hosted tournament with the University of Colorado. The Pioneers, Cal Poly, San Diego and Colorado will split time between Boulder and Denver for the two-day tournament. The final tournament hosted by the Pioneers is the Pioneer Classic that will see top competition from Minnesota, Oregon and Georgia Tech.

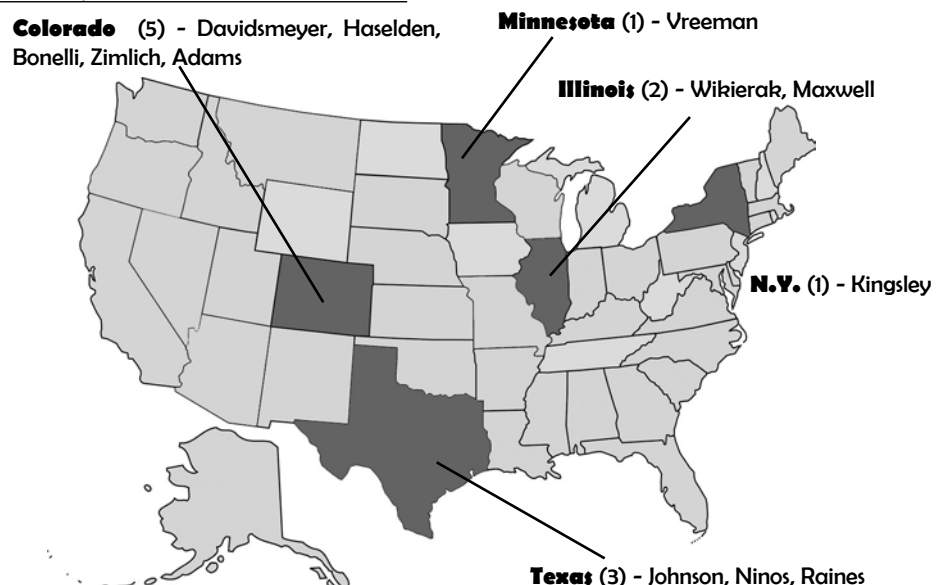

# 2009 DU VOLLEYBALL MATCH NOTES

## RETURNING EXPERIENCE

The 2009 Pioneer squad returns four starters from last season's SBC West Division Championship team, including All-SBC First Team selection Emmy Davidsmeyer and Preseason Defensive Player of the Year Kacie Wikierak. Davidsmeyer finished second on the team last season with 327 kills, and led the team with a .340 hitting percentage. Wikierak led the team with 445 digs for a 3.94 digs per set average. Also returning is senior setter Clare Maxwell who finished last season with 1,219 assists and became just the second player in Pioneer history to record over 3,000 assists.

## MISS 3,000

Last season, senior Clare Maxwell became just the second setter in Pioneer history to break 3,000 assists during a career as she finished the season with 3,399 assists. Maxwell is just 135 assists away from tying the all-time career assists mark in the DU record books, which is currently held by Rachel Runka. Runka was a member of the Pioneer squad from 1992-94).

## CAN YOU DIG IT?

Junior libero Kacie Wikierak was once again tabbed as the Sun Belt Conference Preseason Defensive Player of the Year, an honor that she received at the start of the 2008 season after earning the regular season Defensive Player of the Year honor her freshman season. Last season, she was honored as the Defensive Player of the Week twice for her efforts. In just two seasons, Wikierak has tallied 1,081 digs and is just 1,045 digs away from securing the top spot in the record books for career digs.

## TABBED SECOND:

Defending West Division Champions, the University of Denver volleyball team, received 80 points from Sun Belt Conference institutions in the preseason poll to finish behind New Orleans in the West Division standings. The Privateers grabbed the top spot with 87 points. The Pioneers are followed by UALR (57 points), Arkansas State (51 points), Louisiana (38 points), North Texas (36 points) and ULM (15 points).

## SEASON REWIND:

The Pioneers are coming of a highly successful season, finishing with an overall record of 25-7 for the best record in program history through 32 matches. Its 16-1 record in Hamilton Gymnasium was the best mark at home since the program turned Division I. Earlier this week, the defending West Division Champions were selected to finish second in the West behind New Orleans and junior Kacie Wikierak (Crystal Lake, Ill.) was selected for the second-straight season as the Preseason Defensive Player of the Year.

## COMPETING AGAINST THE TOP TEAMS

Arguably one of their toughest schedules, the Pioneers will face eight teams that competed in last year's NCAA Tournament, including one NCAA Tournament finalist and three SBC teams. (FIU, Oregon, Minnesota, San Diego, LSU, Stanford, Middle Tennessee, Western Kentucky) The Pioneers start off the season on the road in South Bend, Ind., as they take part in the Shamrock Invitational hosted by Notre Dame. Along with facing the Fighting Irish, Denver will also meet LSU and Stanford, two teams that competed in the 2008 NCAA Tournament. Stanford finished last season ranked No. 2 in the final Bison/AVCA DI Coaches Top-25 Poll with a 31-4 overall record. Denver will also face four teams that finished in last season's top-25 and two that were receiving votes at the conclusion of their seasons. The Pioneers' home schedule includes 11 non-conference and eight conference matches, while the away schedule lists three non-conference and 10 conference matches.

## HEAD COACH BETH KUWATA:

Beth Kuwata begins her 14th season as the head coach of the DU Pioneer volleyball program, bringing with her a record of 211-186. During her time with the Pioneers, Kuwata has led the program from Division II to Division I and from the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference to the Sun Belt Conference. She has secured four SBC West Division Championships, the first of which came during the 2000 season. Last season, Kuwata guided the Pioneers to their second-consecutive West Division title.

## CAREER ACHIEVEMENTS

In her 15 years of coaching, Beth Kuwata has compiled a career record of 238-219 and is just 12 wins away from securing her 250th win.

## KUWATA'S KREW

The Denver Pioneer volleyball team is inviting children, ages 13 years and under, to the third annual "Kuwata's Krew" Club during the Pioneers' season. There will be three clinics held following Sunday matches, all of which are against teams from the Sun Belt Conference. ## BETH KUWATA

HEAD COACH • 14TH SEASON

DENVER, COLO.

DENVER (1988), NORTHERN COLORADO (1993)

Beth Kuwata concluded her 13th season at the helm of the University of Denver volleyball team as the program's all-time winningest head coach. On Sept. 17, 2004, Kuwata led her team to a 3-0 win over Syracuse and passed Jerrie McGahan to become the school's all-time leader in wins and cement

her name in the Denver record books. Kuwata has 211 career wins at Denver, 115 more than McGahan's 96.

In 2008, Kuwata led the Pioneers to an overall record of 25-7, marking the best record in program history through 32 matches. DU's 16-1 record in Hamilton Gymnasium was the best mark at home since the program turned Division I.

After being selected in the preseason poll as the favorite to win the Sun Belt Conference West division, the Pioneers delivered and captured their second consecutive title, fourth in program history, with their 3-0 defeat of Arkansas State on Sunday, Nov. 16 in Hamilton Gymnasium. Denver finished regular season conference play with an impressive 14-4 record.

Kuwata took over the program in 1996 and has overseen its progression from the Division II level to a perennial Sun Belt Conference contender. In 2008, she guided the Pioneers to their eighth-consecutive appearance in the Sun Belt Conference tournament, and led her team to a Sun Belt Conference championship in 2000 and again in 2007. Kuwata's overall record now stands at 238-219 (.501) in 14 years as a head coach and 211-186 (.531) in 13 seasons at Denver.

Kuwata earned her 150th victory Sept. 16, 2006 against Wright State. Her 100th career victory came as part of Denver's 12-4 league record in 2000, good for the Sun Belt West Division title. It was the Pioneer volleyball program's first-ever conference championship and was also the University's first Sun Belt title in any sport since it joined the league in 1999. This year, DU once again captured the West Division title with a 14-4 conference mark, the third division title in Kuwata's 11 years in the Sun Belt.

She has placed 17 players on the SBC's all-conference teams in her tenure, including the unanimous selection of setter Clarice Golesh-Burch in 2000, Freshman of the Year Lisa Hunter in 2003 and Defensive Player of the Year Kacie Wikierak in 2007.

Kuwata marked Denver's first year in the Sun Belt in 1999 with a stellar 13-3 league mark and an 18-11 record overall - Denver's ninth season of double-digit wins in 10 years.

When Kuwata arrived at Denver in 1996, she was in charge of moving the Pioneers to the Division I ranks. After a rocky first season in which the team recorded an 11-24 overall record, she quickly turned the corner in her second season, the final in Division II, to finish with a 21-11 record, the second-best record in the history of Pioneer volleyball. This season, Kuwata led Denver to its best overall record under her direction with a 25-7 season mark.

Kuwata, who played for the Pioneers from 1984-87, came to Denver from Wyoming where she served as the Cowgirls' head coach for the 1994 and 1995 seasons. During her two seasons with the Cowgirls, Kuwata amassed a 27-33 (.450) overall record, including a 17-13 overall mark her first season. That finish gave , a fourth-place 8-6 WAC record (the best WAC record

in Wyoming history at the time), and a berth in the NCAA Tournament. In addition, her team earned a top-25 ranking for four consecutive weeks (Sept. 20-Oct. 11). For her achievements she was honored by her peers, along with Brigham Young's Elaine Michalis, as the WAC's co-coach of the year.

Prior to her stint at Wyoming, Kuwata served as an assistant coach under Rich Feller at

Colorado State from 1991-92. While at CSU she was involved in all facets of the program including recruiting, match preparation, coaching and administration. In addition to her collegiate coaching experience, Kuwata served as head coach for the Colorado Springs Junior Volleyball club team (1988-91), was an assistant coach at Coronado High School in Colorado Springs (1988-91) and was an assistant coach for the NORCO Junior Volleyball Club team in Fort Collins, Colo. from 1992-93. As an assistant at Coronado she helped guide the team to the 1988 Colorado state championship. She also helped guide the NORCO Junior club team to the Rocky Mountain regional title in 1993.

During Kuwata's four-year playing career at Denver, she was selected as the team's most valuable player four times, was named to the All-Continental Divide Conference first-team three consecutive seasons, and was named CDC player of the week once. She still ranks as the Pioneers' all-time leader in service aces with 192, ranks third in career assists (2,850) and attack percentage (.233) and fourth in assists per game (7.09). She also ranks in the top-eight on Denver's career records lists in six other statistical categories and holds several top-10 single season records.

Kuwata earned a bachelor's degree in business administration from Denver in 1988 and completed her master's degree in physical education with an emphasis in sports administration at Northern Colorado in 1993. She is single and resides in Denver.
