| 5 | Notre Dame's five road wins are its most since recording six wins on the road in 2014 (also six in 2012). The last time the Irish won seven games on the road was in 2010, when it won eight and won the national championship. |
| 6 | Notre Dame concluded the ACC regular season in sixth place in the conference with a record of 5-3-2. |
| 9 | Sophomore Jennifer Westendorf owns a career-high nine goals, three more than her previous single-season career high (six). Westendorf's nine goals are tied for the fifth-most in the ACC. |
| 10 | Notre Dame's Natalie Jacobs (10 G) has scored 10 of Notre Dame's 35 goals this season. The 10 goals is the most by an Irish player since 2015 and ranks tied for the third-most goals in the ACC this season. |
| 15 | The Irish check in at No. 15 in this week's RPI. The Irish own the fourth-best RPI in the ACC behind North Carolina (No. 3), Duke (No. 4) and Florida State (13). |
| 19 | Graduate student Sandra Yu's 19 points in 2017 are a career high. The midfielder has totaled seven goals and five assists so far this season. Yu has more than doubled her previous career high in points (eight), set in 2015. |
| 23 | The Irish have totaled 23 second-half goals and have limited their opponents to 13 goals in the period. |
| 24 | Notre Dame ranks No. 24 in this week's United Soccer Coaches Poll. The Irish appeared in the weekly rankings for the first time since Sept. 29, when they were No. 22. |
| 25 | The Irish are looking to appear in their 25th straight NCAA Championship. Notre Dame owns 12 trips to the College Cup and three NCAA titles. |
| 30 | Notre Dame celebrates its 30th anniversary this season. The Irish have gone 542-115-40 in program history. |
| 36 | Notre Dame's 36 goals this season are 10 more than its 2016 season scoring total (26). |
| 50 | Irish head coach Theresa Romagnolo, who is in her fourth season with the Irish, won her 50th game at Miami on Oct. 22. The Washington graduate owns a record of 50-19-12 at Notre Dame. |

BACK IN ACTION

For the second straight season, the Irish and the Wolfpack will meet in the ACC quarterfinal round, this time squaring off at Dail Soccer Field in Raleigh, N.C. Notre Dame will look to extend its unbeaten streak on the road as it goes for its seventh straight game without a loss. A victory would send the Irish to Charleston, S.C., at 8 p.m. on Nov. 3, for a matchup against the winner of No. 2 seed North Carolina and No. 7 seed Florida State.

SERIES HISTORY: WOLFPACK

Notre Dame owns a 5-1 all-time record against NC State, including a 4-0 shutout victory on Sept. 24 at Alumni Stadium. The Irish have gone 2-1 in Raleigh, N.C. The teams met in the ACC Championship quarterfinal in 2016, where the Irish defeated the Wolfpack 1-0 at Alumni Stadium.

30TH ANNIVERSARY

Notre Dame women's soccer celebrates its 30th anniversary during the 2017 season. In the program's history, the Irish have gone 542-115-40. Over the past 29 seasons, Notre Dame has made 24 appearances in the NCAA Championship. The Irish have competed in 12 College Cups and have won three national titles.

THE SENIOR CLASS

Twelve Irish seniors were recognized as part of Sunday's Senior Day pregame ceremony. As a class, the seniors have combined to play in 533 career games and record 133 points on 46 goals and 45 assists. The Irish, behind goalkeeper Lexi Nicholas, also are responsible for 28 saves and nine wins in goal.

RPI RANKING

Notre Dame checked in at No. 15 in the most recent RPI. The Irish have faced seven ranked opponents -- all in the ACC -- from Sept. 16 to Oct. 26 and gone 3-2-2 in those games. Notre Dame lost to then-No. 11 South Carolina in double-overtime.

CONFERENCE CHAMPIONSHIPS

Notre Dame owns 11 conference championship titles, all coming in the BIG EAST Championship. The Irish have made 13 appearances in the BIG EAST Championship tournament final. In ACC Championship history, Notre Dame owns a .250 winning percentage with its lone tournament victory coming in the quarterfinal round against NC State in 2016. The Irish will try to win their first ACC Championship and their first conference tournament since 2009 (2-1 victory over Marquette), the last time they won two games in the conference tournament.

2016 ACC TOURNAMENT REWIND

Following its 2016 regular-season ACC title, the Irish hosted NC State in the first round of the ACC Championships. Notre Dame topped the Wolfpack 1-0, picking up its first win in ACC Championship history and advancing to face North Carolina. The Irish fell 2-1 to the Tar Heels at MUSC Health Stadium.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN

Notre Dame hits the road for its ninth true road game of the season and its first in postseason play. The Irish own a 5-1-2 record on the road thus far and are 5-1-3 away from home. Notre Dame has not lost in six straight road games, going 4-0-2 in those contests. In 2016, the Irish concluded their season with a 3-1-4 record on the road.

ACC PRESEASON PREDICTIONS

After winning the regular-season ACC Championship in 2016, Notre Dame was predicted to finish fifth overall in the conference's preseason coaches' poll. Sandra Yu and Jennifer Westendorf were selected to the Preseason All-ACC Team, leaving the Irish tied with North Carolina for the second-most selections (trailing only Florida State's four).

SECOND-HALF MAGIC

Notre Dame has outscored its opponents 23-13 in the second half this season. The Irish have entered halftime in a scoreless tie eight times and in a 1-1 tie twice in 2017. Notre Dame has scored four goals in the second half three times this season against Ball St., Santa Clara and Toledo.

SCORING IN BUNCHES

Notre Dame has gone 7-1 in games decided by two-plus goals. The Irish offense has scored four goals on six occasions this season, turning in dominant performances in such matches. Notre Dame has surpassed its 2016 scoring total (26 goals) with a sum of 36 goals this season. As a team, the Irish have been most successful in regulation, with all nine of their wins coming in the first 90 minutes.

THE ACC LEADERBOARD

Eighteen matches into the season, the Irish rank among the leaders in several offensive statistical categories. Notre Dame ranks tied for second with 33 assists and third in the ACC with 280 shots, 105 points and 36 goals.

SUNDAY FUNDAY

Notre Dame owns a 7-1 record on Sunday in 2017. The Irish have played on Thursday four times (1-1-2), on Friday five times (0-3-2), on Saturday once (1-0) and on Sunday eight times (7-1). All seven of Notre Dame's Sunday victories have come in the afternoon, four of which were at home (Ball St., Santa Clara, NC State and Syracuse) and three of which were on the road (at Iowa, at Toledo and at Miami).

TOPDRAWERSOCCER.COM HONOR

Sophomore Jennifer Westendorf was named to TopDrawerSoccer.com's Women's Preseason Best XI Second Team. Westendorf was a 2016 All-ACC Freshman Team and 2016 All-ACC Second Team selection. Westendorf has surpassed her 2016 point total (17) with 25 and her single-season career high in goals (six) with nine.

CAREER YEAR FOR YU

After missing her first two seasons due to injury, Sandra Yu returned to the program as a graduate student and has recorded a career-high 19 points in 2017. Yu already has doubled her previous career high in points (eight), set in 2015. Yu has started all of Notre Dame's contests over the past two-plus seasons (2015-17), tallying 31 points on 12 goals and seven assists in her career. In 2016, Yu totaled 45 shots, including 21 shots on goal (.467). Yu also competed on the United States U-23 Women's National Team this past summer.
