The Marquette University men's basketball team (11-5, 2-1 BIG EAST) returns to the Bradley Center Monday night to host No. 14/15 Notre Dame at 6 p.m. CT. ESPN2 will feature the matchup as part of its "Big Monday" broadcast, with Dave Pasch (play-by-play), Jay Bilas (analyst) and Bill Raftery (analyst) calling the action from courtside. Monday's meeting will be the 114th all-time meeting between Marquette and Notre Dame in a series that dates back to the 1919-20 campaign. Following the contest against the Fighting Irish, MU hits the road to face Louisville on Jan. 15.

Strength Of Schedule To Receive Upgrade

In possession of three contests (vs. Duke, vs. Gonzaga, at Vanderbilt) in non-league play this season against programs ranked in the top-25 at the time of the matchup, the Golden Eagles will see that total multiply quickly in the coming weeks.

Beginning with the trip to Pittsburgh, seven of the team's eight conference matchups will come against programs currently ranked in at least one of the national polls. That span includes four outings versus top-10 squads and a total of four contests on the road against top-25 opponents.

The Golden Eagles remain in search of the program's 100th victory against a top-25 program. MU is 99-151 all-time versus nationally ranked squads and 7-18 under third-year head coach Buzz Williams.

Based on the most recent Jan. 3 polls, 10 of Marquette's 16 league games will feature a top-25 squad.

Monday night's matchup with No. 14/15 Notre Dame will mark the 114th meeting between the two teams in a series that dates back to the 1919-20 campaign.

Marquette claimed the first meeting, earning a 23-22 road victory in the program's third season of competition. MU will face the Fighting Irish as a nationally ranked opponent for the 18th time on Monday, with the Golden Eagles owning an 8-9 record in those contests. Marquette has claimed five of the eight meetings since the team joined the BIG EAST Conference in 2005-06.

Rival Wisconsin is the only opponent Marquette has face on more occasions (117) than Notre Dame.

Johnson-Odom Picks Up Scoring In League Play

Struggling with his perimeter shot for a majority of the non-conference campaign, junior Darius Johnson-Odom has picked up his offensive production in recent weeks.

That trend has magnified itself through the first three BIG EAST games this season. The Raleigh, N.C., native is averaging a team-best 23.3 points per game in the last three outings. He is shooting 53.2 percent (25-of-47) from the field and 42.1 percent (8-of-19) from behind the 3-point line. He has also found time to chip in 3.0 assists and 2.3 rebounds in an average of 33.3 minutes per contest.

Through games of Jan. 8, Johnson-Odom ranks tied for third in scoring in league games and is seventh in 3-pointers made per game (2.67).

MU Protects The Ball At Pittsburgh

Against one of the better defensive units in the BIG EAST, Marquette was forced into just a pair of turnovers at Pittsburgh Saturday afternoon.

The first miscue didn't occur until almost midway through the second half. Thanks to 16 assists on 27 baskets, the squad's assist-to-turnover ratio (1.45) is now 11th in the nation and fourth in the league.

The two miscues marked the lowest single-game total since turning it over on just three occasions in a 70-68 victory at Connecticut in 2009-10. Prior to the UConn contest, the last time MU finished with less than three turnovers (1 total) came in a 90-70 win over Butler on March 3, 1990. Former MU standout Tony Smith had 43 points in that contest.

Starters Looking For Bench Help In BIG EAST Action

Marquette's offense enjoyed a tremendous amount of success during the non-conference portion of the schedule thanks in large part to consistent across-the-board production from the Golden Eagle reserves.

Unfortunately for MU, that trend hasn't continued through three games of league play. The bench corps have yet to feature a player with double figures in points and the five-player group has combined to shoot just 31.3 percent (10-of-32) from

the field and 7-of-14 (50 percent) from the charity stripe. As a result, the starting five is currently accounting for 87.5 percent of the offense in BIG EAST competition.

One reason for the production dropoff has been the move to the starting lineup by junior forward Jae Crowder, who has started each of the last six games. He is averaging 12.7 points and 6.6 rebounds per game in 2010-11.

Buycks Featuring Improved Shooting Touch In 2010-11

Guard Dwight Buycks struggled offensively in 2009-10, his first campaign with Marquette after transferring from junior college. He shot just 41.8 percent from the field and 27.3 percent from behind the 3-point line.

So far in 2010-11, Buycks is knocking down 51.9 percent of his shots from the floor and 37.5 percent from long distance. He has also improved his free throw effort to 75.0 percent.

Cadougan Makes Most Of Minutes At Rutgers

Pressed into increased action at Rutgers because of an injury to senior Dwight Buycks, sophomore guard Junior Cadougan responded by effectively running Marquette's offensive attack.

He dished out a career-best eight assists and turned the ball over just once in 29 minutes at the point guard position. He also chipped in three rebounds and a steal off the bench for the Golden Eagles. Cadougan added three assists without a turnover at Pittsburgh in 10 minutes of action.

His previous personal-best assist total (7) came earlier this year against Duke in the CBE Classic (Nov. 22).

MU Follows Crowder's Lead In Win Over WUU

A 5 a.m. wakeup call on New Year's Day didn't keep junior forward Jae Crowder from making an impressive league debut in Marquette's victory over West Virginia in the BIG EAST opener.

Crowder, the 2009-10 junior college player of the year at Howard College, netted a career-high 29 points on 12-of-14 shooting to lead all scorers. In 39 minutes of action, he also found time to chip in eight rebounds, five assists, four steals and a block. His final steal led to an intentional foul by WVU and sealed the MU win in the closing seconds.

Balanced Scoring Leading Offensive Attack

Marquette ranks sixth in the nation (through games of Jan. 5) in field goal percentage (.504) and 17th in scoring (80.8 ppg.) thanks in large part to a well-balanced offensive attack.

The Dec. 29 outing at Vanderbilt marked the third time this season Marquette has had five players finish with double figures in points, and in nine of the squad's 16 contests at least four players have reached the 10-point plateau. A season-best six scorers netted 10-or-more points in the win over Green Bay.

Senior Jimmy Butler has reached double figures in all but one game (Longwood) in 2010-11 and has been joined on at least one occasion by Vander Blue, Dwight Buycks, Jae Crowder, Davante Gardner, Darius Johnson-Odom, Jamail Jones, Chris Otule and Erik Williams.

Free Throw Line Continues To Provide Advantage

The ability to consistently get to the free throw line, as well as convert on those opportunities, has been a team focus since third-year head coach Buzz Williams took over prior to the 2008-09 campaign.

The focus has been evident early in 2010-11, where once again the Golden Eagles have made more free throws (277) than their opponents have even attempted (238). As a result, MU is outscoring its opponents by an average of over eight points per game (17.3-9.1) from the line. The Dec. 21 outing against Mississippi Valley State provided a perfect example of the trend. Marquette finished 26-of-31 from the charity stripe and the Delta Devils were 16-of-20 for the game.

In 2008-09, the Golden Eagles knocked down 668 free throws, while opponents attempted just a total of 600 in 35 outings. Last season, Marquette made a total of 489 charity tosses and enemy shooters attempted 542 as a group, but MU was able to average almost four more points per outing at the free throw line.

Since the start of the 2008-09 season, Marquette is 1,434-of-1,980 (72.4 percent) from the free throw line and opponents are 919-of-1,380 (66.6 percent).

Offense Produces Impressive Halftime Total

The Golden Eagles shot 57.1 percent (20-of-35) from the field in the first half against Mississippi Valley State, finishing the opening 20 minutes with 56 points.

The squad's point total marked the highest in any half since the team netted 57 points in the second half at Villanova on Jan. 9, 2010. The Dec. 21 effort was the best first-half score since Marquette collected 54 points prior to halftime against Eastern Illinois on Nov. 26, 2002 in a 97-74 victory.

Is Key To Victory Field Goal Percentage?

Head coach Buzz Williams has stressed defense since he took over the reigns of the program and that focus, along with offensive efficiency, has played a key role in the team's success during his tenure.

Dating back to the start of 2008-09, the Golden Eagles are 42-3 when finishing the game with a field goal percentage even-or-better than their opponents. That includes an 11-2 mark thus far in 2010-11 and a 14-1 record in 2009-10. The only losses came March 6, 2010 versus Notre Dame, Dec. 11, 2010 against Wisconsin and Dec. 29 at Vanderbilt.

Since 2008-09, MU has finished 50 percent-or-better from the field on 29 occasions and owns an 26-3 record (at Villanova in 2008-09, vs. Washington in 2009-10, at Vanderbilt in 2010-11) in those outings.

Otule's Shooting Is Perfect From The Field Us. LU

Sophomore center Chris Otule finished a perfect 9-of-9 from the field in the victory over Longwood on Dec. 4, finishing just one basket away from matching former teammate Wesley Matthews' school-best mark (10-of-10 vs. Rutgers, 1/7/09).

The Richmond, Texas, native finished with a career-best 19 points in just 19 minutes of action and was also able to chip in five rebounds and three blocked shots. His efforts earned him a place on the BIG EAST Conference Honor Roll for the week of Dec. 6.

Otule's perfect streak from the field extended to a total of 13 shot attempts and three games before missing against A&M-Corpus Christi.

Golden Eagles Use 24-0 Run To Rally Past Bison

Trailing 57-45 with 10:22 remaining in the second half against Bucknell, the Golden Eagles put together an impressive 24-0 run to take control of the game.

A layup by junior forward Jae Crowder got things started for MU, which didn't allow the Bison to add to their game total until netting a free throw with 1:41 left in regulation and the Golden Eagles up 12 points.

Freshman Davante Gardner scored eight of his 11 points during that time frame and senior Dwight Buycks, who scored a game-high 17 points, chipped in seven. Newcomer Vander Blue hit a big 3-pointer to close the gap to one point after scoring a layup.

Singleton and Wilson To Sit & Watch In 2010-11

Transfers Dave Singleton and Jamil Wilson will redshirt in 2010-11 after transferring from High Point and Oregon, respectively.

Singleton, who will have two seasons of eligibility beginning in 2011-12, was a two-year letterwinner at HPU and appeared in 60 career games. He averaged 5.2 points, 3.4 rebounds and 2.1 assists per game under head coach Bart Lundy, who is now the director of operations at MU.

Wilson, a native of Racine, Wis., appeared in 26 games as a freshman with the Ducks and earned 14 starting assignments. He averaged 4.7 points and 3.2 rebounds per game, helping Oregon to a 16-win campaign.

Anderson, Wilson Latest To Join MU Family

Marquette head coach Buzz Williams announced the signing of a pair of prep standouts in Juan Anderson (Castro Valley, Calif./Castro Valley HS) and Derrick Wilson (Anchorage, Alaska/The Hotchkiss School) for the 2011-12 campaign.

As a junior at Castro Valley High School under head coach Nick Jones, Anderson averaged 14.0 points, 8.0 rebounds and 2.9 assists per game. He helped the Trojans to a 23-7 overall record and was named honorable mention all-metro. Anderson served as team cocaptain and the squad made its first-ever appearance in the state playoffs. He was also a unanimous first-team all-conference selection.

Anderson, who was recently named to the 15-member Long Beach Press-Telegram's 32nd Annual Best in the West squad, is rated 69th in the country by Rivals.com among all 2011 recruits.

Wilson averaged 23.0 points, 8.0 assists, 8.0 rebounds and 5.0 steals per game as a junior at The Hotchkiss School in Lakeville, Conn., under head coach Fred Benjamin. He was named first team all-league in 2009-10 for the third time in his career and claimed player of the year accolades in the tri-state area for the second-straight season.

As a sophomore, Wilson chipped in 19.0 points, 10.0 rebounds and 6.0 assists per outing and helped lead the team to the semifinals of the tri-state tournament. He was tabbed to the tri-state first team squad and claimed a pair of most valuable player honors during regular season tourney action.

Those two words have served as the foundation of the Marquette University men's basketball team under third-year head coach Buzz Williams ever since he was officially

named program mentor on April 8, 2008.

The 2009-10 Golden Eagles were a perfect illustration of Williams' core system of values, working hard on a daily basis to ensure the team's accomplishments on the court and in the classroom would bring a sense of pride to all of the University's supporters.

The team's character was tested from start to finish, beginning with low preseason expectations from the national pun-

the squad from collecting the program's fifth-straight NCAA Championship appearance and 20-win season. Marquette finished 22-12 overall, including an 11-7 mark in the BIG EAST Conference, which was good enough for fifth-place in the 16-team league.

Lazar Hayward (Second Team All-BIG EAST) finished second all-time in scoring at MU and four of the program's top-10 all-time scorers have now graduated within the past two seasons. Junior forward Jimmy Butler was one of the most improved players in the country and as a result was tabbed honorable mention allleague.

Williams directed MU to a 25-10 overall record in 2008-09, which included a school-record 12 BIG EAST victories. The Golden Eagles advanced to the second round of the NCAA Championship and were ranked among the nation's top-25 teams the entire campaign. A pair of players, Jerel McNeal and Wesley Matthews, claimed all-league accolades and McNeal also claimed All-America honors.

Off the court, Williams and his staff assembled a consensus top-25 recruiting class in each of the last two years, including a group rated as high as No. 1 in the country by HoopScoopOnline.com (2008-09). The program's community service efforts have also reached new heights under Williams, highlighted by "Buzz's Bunch." This group, founded by Williams, focuses on providing opportunities for special needs children to attend games and summer camps. The Golden Eagles have also continued and strengthened their long-standing relationships with Children's Hospital as well as Special Olympics.

In 2007-08, Williams served as an assistant coach with the Golden Eagles in his first season at Marquette. MU concluded the year 25-10 and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2003.

His coaching career has included stints as an assistant, associate head and head coach. He has over 15 years of experience at the NCAA Division I level. Williams has recruited and coached over 20 players who have earned all-conference accolades, including one league player of the year, two conference freshmen of the year and two Associated Press All-Americans (McNeal and Hayward).

Williams arrived in Milwaukee after serving for one season as the head coach at the University of New Orleans. He guided the Privateers to a 14-win campaign in 2006-07 and his roster featured Bo McCalebb, the Sun Belt Conference Player of the Year. UNO claimed fourth place in the Sun Belt's Western Division and advanced to the league tournament quarterfinals. The squad claimed as many victories on the road that season as it had in the previous three seasons combined. His recruiting class for the 2007-08 season was ranked in the top 50 nationally by HoopScoopOnline.com.

Prior to UNO, Williams served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Texas A&M for two seasons (2004-05/2005-06) under head coach Billy Gillispie. Both of his recruiting classes with the Aggies were ranked among the best in the nation and featured some of the top-ranked talent at the prep level. The squad made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 25 years in 2005-06 and the previous team posted the top turnaround in the nation, improving its win total in 2004-05 by 14 games compared to 2003-04.

Williams spent four seasons (2000-01/2003-04) at Colorado State, serving as an assistant the first three seasons before being promoted to associate head coach in 2003-04. Two of his recruiting classes were ranked among the 40-best in the nation, including the 2003 group, which was tabbed No. 1 in the Mountain West Conference.

Colorado State made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 13 years during his tenure and he was named one of the top assistants in the country by HoopScoopOnline.com. Williams was previously an assistant at Northwestern State (1999-2000), Texas A&M-Kingsville (1998-99) and Texas-Arlington (1994-98).

Williams signed the highest-rated recruiting class in the history of the Southland Conference while at Northwestern State. The Demons advanced to their first ever NCAA tourney the following season and two of his recruited players were named all-conference, while one was tabbed Southland Conference Tournament MVP.

His accomplishments at Texas A&M-Kingsville include signing the 1998-99 Lone Star Conference Freshman of the Year and a third team All-America guard. At Texas-Arlington, Williams recruited a Southland Conference Freshman of the Year and signed the first Academic All-American in the school's history. Williams Williams' Career Record

The Van Alstyne, Texas, native earned a bachelor's degree in kinesiology from Oklahoma City University in 1994 before completing his master's work in the same field at Texas A&M-Kingsville in 1999.

Williams is married to the former Corey Norman and the couple has two daughters, Zera (8) and Addyson (1), and two sons, Calvin (7) and Mason (4).
