QUICK HITS ON THE UCONN HUSKIES

• The UConn baseball team will hit the road for its first BIG EAST Conference series away from J.O. Christian Field. The Huskies will take on Notre Dame in South Bend, Ind. beginning on Friday night.

• UConn is 15-10-1 on the year entering the weekend and are 5-1 in BIG EAST Conference action. The Huskies swept St. John's last weekend in league play before downing UMass 7-1 on Wednesday afternoon in Storrs, Conn.

• Leading the way on the hill for the Huskies is **Matt Barnes** with 54.0 innings thrown and a team-best 49 strikeouts. He also has an ERA on 1.00 in seven starts.

• The 2011 season marks the 116th season of baseball at the University of Connecticut.

• UConn is coming off a successful season in 2010 as the Huskies finished the year with a 48-16 record. The Huskies also hosted the Norwich Regional as a No. 2 seed in the NCAA Tournament.

• UConn's 48 wins are the most produced by the program in a single season in the team's 115-year history, surpassing the Huskies' 39 victories in 2006.

THROWING THE FIRST PITCH

UConn's veterans man the hill for the Huskies this weekend as all three starting pitchers for the UConn ballclub have 14 or more career wins, 150 or more career strikeouts and over 189 career innings pitched.

and has hit three home runs to lead the Huskies in that category as well. **Nick Ahmed** has scored 24 times, a team-best tally, and has recorded 30 hits on the year.

Mike Nemeth is batting .340 in 26 games with a team-ghi 36 hits along with five doubles and 20 RBI.

Despite earning two losses in his first two starts of the season, **Matt Barnes** has struck out 49 batters in seven games thrown. He struck out 11 batters in UConn's 3-2 loss to Minnesota (2/19) and nine in UConn's 3-1 loss to Indiana. He is currently 5-2 on the year with a 1.00 ERA.

WEEKLY HONORS

Nick Ahmed was named BIG EAST Player of the Week on Monday after leading UConn to a 4-0 week including a sweep of conference rival St. John's. The junior hit .429 (6-for-14) with four doubles and a .714 slugging percentage. He also scored seven runs while driving in six. It was his first major weekly honor of the season.

IN THE RECORD BOOKS

Mike Nemeth is UConn's all-time leader in hits (274) and doubles (60). Nemeth owns the UConn single-season records for doubles (22), hits (98) runs batted in (84) and games played (64), all of which were tallied in 2010.

George Springer ranks first in runs scored in the UConn career record books with 178. Springer ranks tied for fourth in home runs with 37 in his career. He is knotted in the fourth spot with Jerry LaPenta (1983-86).

Kevin Vance ranks fourth in career saves with 11. He is seven away from tying Matt Karl's tally of 18 career saves.

HOME SWEET HOME

UConn finished the regular season 19-4 at J.O. Christian Field in 2010.

The Huskies are 6-2-1 at home in 2011 after sweeping the St. John's Red Storm last weekend in BIG EAST Conference play.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN

UConn finished the 2010 regular season with a 21-6 record on the road, while being 3-2 in neutral site games. On the year, the Huskies were 7-4 at neutral sites, which includes 2010 BIG EAST postseason play.

In 2011, UConn is 2-6 in neutral site games and 7-2 on an opponent's home field.

UConn vs. Opponent Conferences

• **A-10** - UConn is 193-148-5 against Atlantic 10 teams. The Huskies lost to URI on Friday, March 18 in Mount Pleasant, S.C. and downed UMass 7-1 on April 6 in Storrs, Conn.

• **America East** - UConn is 1-0 in 2011 against America East programs after shutting out Hartford 11-0 on March 29. The Huskies are 98-61 all-time vs. America East opponents.

• **Big Ten** - UConn is 12-22 all-time against Big Ten opponents. The Huskies are 1-3 vs. Big Ten teams in 2011.

• **Big West** - UConn is 3-3 against Big West opponents after falling to UC Irvine 5-4 in the programs' first ever meeting.

• **Conference USA** - The Huskies are 8-27 against Conference USA opponents after dropping a 6-3 decision to Southern Mississippi on March 20.

• **Mountain West** - UConn is 2-1 against Mountain West opponents after facing Air Force in 2008 and 1999. In the first meeting with San Diego State UConn downed the Aztecs 9-3.

• **Northeast** - UConn is 51-17 against NEC schools. UConn fell to Sacred Heart on March 15 and will face Quinnipiac, CCSU and Bryant in 2011 as well.

• **Pac-10** - UConn is 2-9 against Pac-10 opponents, picking up a very key win against the nationally-ranked Cal Bears on March 6, 2011.

• **Patriot League** - UConn is 0-0-1 against Patriot League programs in 2011 after battling Holy Cross to a 2-2 tie in 16 innings back on March 22. UConn is 51-31-4 all-time against the league.

• **Southern** - UConn is 16-18 against Southern Conference opponents after downing College of Charleston 3-1 on March 19 in the first-ever meeting between the two programs.

• **Southland** - The Huskies are 1-2 against Southland opponents after defeating Texas A&M-Corpus Christi on Feb. 27, 2011.

• **West Coast Conference** - UConn faced San Diego for the first time in program history in 2011 to mark the first meeting with a West Coast Conference program. UConn is now 3-1 against WCC opponents after downing San Diego in three of its four games played against the Toreros this season.

The Huskies also have 14 games against teams that finished in the top-50 RPI in 2010. UConn will host 17 games at J.O. Christian Field this season, including five BIG EAST Conference series. Two games will be played at Dodd Stadium in Norwich, Conn. and one game will be played at New Britain Stadium in New Britain, Conn.

MAKING THE JUMP INTO THE RANKINGS

UConn was ranked No. 25 in *Baseball America* Top-25 Poll in its debut into the national polls on April 12, 2010. It was the first time UConn was ranked in the BA Top 25, while it was the first regular season ranking for the Huskies since the 1979 season, when the Huskies advanced to the College World Series.

PENDERS' CLIMB

Head Coach Jim Penders earned his 200th career win in UConn's 11-2 victory over Cal State Northridge on Saturday, March 6, 2010. He earned his 250th career win against San Diego on March 10, 2011 in a 6-4 defeat over the Toreros in California.

He currently boasts an overall record of 252-173-3 in his eighth year at UConn. Penders, who took over the reigns of the UConn baseball team in 2004 for former head coach Andy Baylock, has been a player, assistant coach and now head coach for the UConn baseball program.

BASEBALL AMERICA'S TOP-100 DRAFT PROSPECTS

Three UConn players were named to the Top-100 Draft Prospects list by *Baseball America*.

George Springer (No. 5), **Matt Barnes** (No. 7) and **Nick Ahmed** (No. 53) were the three Huskies tagged for the list, while Rice's Anthony Rendon was selected as the top choice among all college baseball players.

FOLLOWING THE LEADER

The 2011 Huskies are being led this season by captains **Elliot Glynn** and **Nick Ahmed**. Glynn, a senior left-hander, began the 2011 season with 13 career wins in 38 appearances on the hill for the Huskies. Ahmed, the Huskies' junior shortstop, entered the year with 135 hits, 91 runs and 63 RBI in his career.

THE BEST OF THE BIG EAST

Since head coach Jim Penders took over the UConn baseball program in 2004, UConn has boasted a record of 93-84-1 in BIG EAST Conference games. In the last two seasons, the Huskies are 34-19.

In BIG EAST Championship Tournament action UConn is 11-7 in four appearances since 2004 and has battled its way into the championship game in three of the last four years. In 2010, UConn was a half-game away from taking home the BIG EAST Regular Season title as Louisville won the crown, then the Huskies dropped a 3-0 heart-breaker to St. John's in the championship in Clearwater, Fla.

2011 PRESEASON BIG EAST COACHES' POLL

The Connecticut baseball team was chosen as the 2011 BIG EAST Conference favorite as voted on by the league's 12 head coaches. The Huskies' received nine out of a possible 11 first-place votes in the preseason poll.

Junior **George Springer** was chosen as the BIG EAST Preseason Player of the Year, while junior **Matt Barnes** was selected as the Preseason Pitcher of the Year.

The first-place prediction is the highest during head coach **Jim Penders'** tenure at UConn as the team was previously selected to finish third in 2010, a season in which the Huskies finished a half-game behind the first-place Louisville Cardinals.

First baseman **Mike Nemeth** joined Springer and Barnes as unanimous Preseason All-BIG EAST selections, while designated hitter/pitcher **Kevin Vance** was named to the team as well.

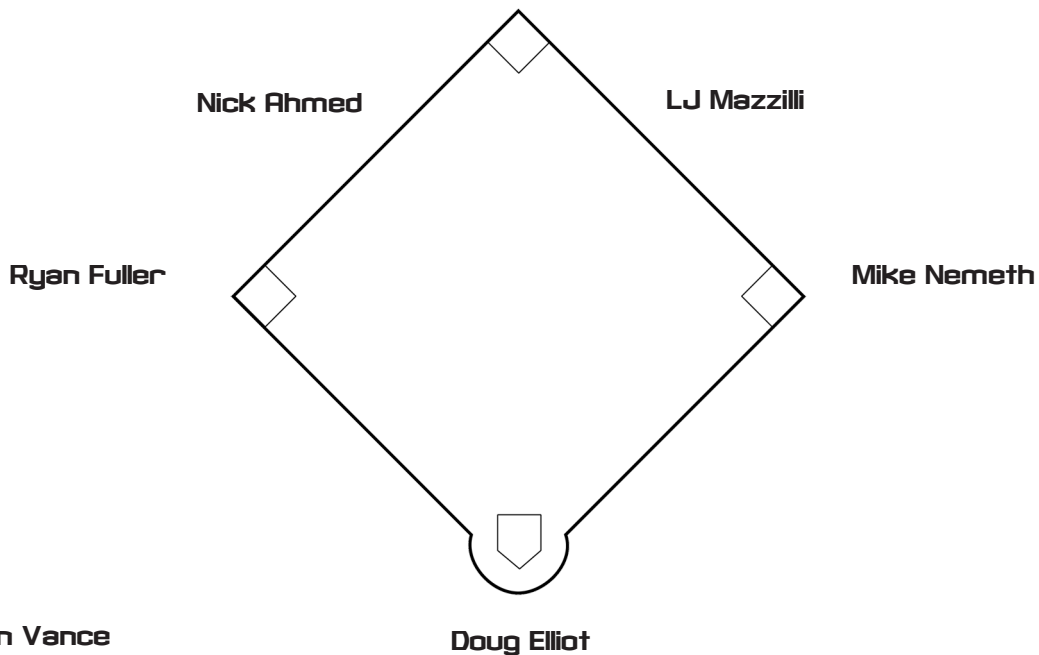

Head Coach

Eighth Season
Connecticut '94, '98



Jim Penders has worked with the University of Connecticut baseball program in 19 of the last 21 years, being associated with the Huskies as a student-athlete, an assistant coach and now head coach. He enters his eighth season at the helm of the program in 2011 after leading the UConn ball club to one of its most successful seasons in program history.

Last season, Penders' guided the Huskies to a program-best 48-win season as his club finished the season with a 48-16 overall record. After being nationally ranked for the first time since 1979, the Huskies' earned an NCAA Tournament berth for the first time since 1994 and hosted the Norwich Regional at Dodd Stadium in Norwich, Conn.

Prior to their NCAA Tournament bid, UConn battled its way into the BIG EAST Championship final game for the second straight year but fell to St. John's 3-0. The Huskies earned their way into the postseason conference tournament, finishing the regular season in second place with a 20-6 record in the BIG EAST.

Along with the team success, including a program-best 22-game win streak, Penders earned multiple coaching accolades as he was named BIG EAST, ECAC, and NEIBA Coach of the Year. He was also named ABCA/Diamond Northeast Coach of the Year.



UConn began the season winning two of three games at the BIG EAST/Big Ten Challenge before taking three of four from Cal State Northridge as the Huskies made their farthest road trip in program history to California. During the Huskies' West Coast visit, they also defeated USC 5-4 in Los Angeles.

After opening BIG EAST play on the road at Louisville and dropping the first two games by one run a piece, UConn bounced back with a 6-3 victory over the nationally-ranked Cardinals, which sparked a 22-game win streak. The run for the Huskies included BIG EAST series sweeps of West Virginia, Villanova, Georgetown and Rutgers.

After Central Connecticut halted UConn's streak with a 7-3 non-conference win, the Huskies split their series with Pittsburgh as the final game of the series was cancelled due to poor weather and field conditions in the Steel City. The Huskies followed by taking 2-of-3 games from Cincinnati, USF and Seton Hall to finish with a 20-6 BIG EAST Conference record and a second-place seeding in the conference championship tournament which was held in Clearwater, Fla. for the third straight year. The 20 conference victories marked the most for the Huskies since joining the BIG EAST Conference in 1985.

Penders was named 2010 BIG EAST Coach of the Year as his team had one of the most successful seasons in program history. Eight members of his squad earned spots on All-BIG EAST Teams, including Matt Barnes who was named to the First Team.

Elliot Glynn, Mike Nemeth, George Springer and Kevin Vance were named to the Second Team, while Mike Olt, the winner of the 2010 BIG EAST Home Run Derby, Pierre LePage and

Nick Ahmed earned Third Team honors.

Despite falling short of the conference crown, Springer and Nemeth were named to the All-Tournament Team, along with teammates Dan Feehan and Billy Ferriter. At season's end, Nemeth was given national recognition as he was named to the ABCA/RAWLINGS NCAA DI All-American Third Team.

In 2009, Penders led the Huskies to a 36-24 overall record and an appearance in the BIG EAST Championship final against Louisville. UConn recorded 14 conference victories, and in so doing, won seven of their nine total BIG EAST series on the year. The Huskies took two of three games from South Florida, Seton Hall, Rutgers, Georgetown, Notre Dame, Pittsburgh, and Villanova.



Entering the 2009 BIG EAST Baseball Championship as the sixth seed, the Huskies beat West Virginia 6-1 in their opening game, before eliminating South Florida with two wins in back-to-back games. Despite falling to Louisville in the Championship final, the Huskies picked up multiple accolades en route to the title game, including freshman George Springer being named the 2009 BIG EAST Rookie of the Year, becoming UConn's first-ever player to earn that honor in program history.

In 2008, Penders guided the young UConn ball club to a 27-28 overall performance as the Huskies picked up 11 BIG EAST Conference wins, including a three-game sweep of Pittsburgh to end the 2008 season. In 2007, Penders and the Huskies earned a spot in the BIG EAST Championship game after battling their way through the BIG EAST Tournament by upsetting three higher-seeded teams.

UConn's appearance in the title game as the eighth-seed marked the lowest seed in BIG EAST Tournament history to reach the final game. In addition, Penders guided the Huskies to their third straight season with 34 or more wins, as his 2006 and 2007 squads ended the year with 39 and 34 victories, respectively.

After the 2006 season, a year in which the Huskies went 39-18-1, Penders led his program to a second place finish in the BIG EAST and earned BIG EAST Coach of the Year, and NEIBA Coach of the Year honors, while his team was named the NEIBA Team of the Year.

In July of 2003, Penders became just the fifth head coach in the program's history since 1924 joining Summer Dole (1924-35), J.O. Christian (1936-61), Larry Panciera (1962-79) and Andy Baylock (1980-2003). Penders was an assistant coach for the Huskies for seven years from 1997-2003 as UConn posted winning seasons in each of those campaigns. As an assistant coach, Penders coordinated the Huskies recruiting of student-athletes, served as a hitting coach and worked with the catchers and outfielders.

A standout on the baseball field for Connecticut during his undergraduate career, Penders was a four-year letter winner as a Husky. He was co-captain of the 1994 UConn squad that won the BIG EAST Conference tournament, and the Huskies advanced to the NCAA Championship in both his junior and senior years. He hit .354 with seven home runs and 46 runs batted in as a senior in 1994.

He earned First Team All-Northeast, All-New England and All-BIG EAST in his senior year as a catcher. During his UConn career, the Huskies played in the championship game of the BIG EAST Tournament three times. Penders helped the Huskies to 99 wins over his four seasons, including a 30-18 record in 1994. He also excelled in the classroom as a three-time BIG EAST Academic All-Star.

Penders was a four-year member of the UConn Captains' Council and served as that group's president during his senior year. Penders graduated from UConn in 1994 with a degree in political science and added a master's degree from UConn in 1998 from the School of Education. Penders worked in Washington, D.C., from 1994-96 as a political fund raiser for U.S. Senator Tom Harkin of Iowa.

Penders returned to UConn for the 1997 season as a graduate assistant baseball coach and became a full-time assistant coach for the 1999 season. He also founded and directs the Connecticut Baseball

School. The popular camp holds sessions during the summer and winter vacation periods, along with a one-day fall session in October every year.



The connection between the Penders family and UConn athletics runs deep. Penders' father, Jim, and uncle, Tom, both graduated from UConn and played on the Huskies' 1965 College World Series team. Jim is a 1966 UConn graduate and has been the baseball coach at East Catholic High School since 1969, where he coached his three sons.

He was an infielder for the Huskies and had a career batting average of .279, including a .323 mark his senior year. He was a captain of the '65 squad and the only player to hit over .300 for the Huskies that season. Jim has won four Connecticut high school state championships at East Catholic and was named the national high school coach of the year in 1996. In the summer of 2008 he was inducted into the National High School Coaches Association Hall of Fame, and in June of 2009, the baseball field at East Catholic was named in his honor.

Tom, a 1967 UConn graduate, was the head men's basketball coach at Tufts (1971-74), Columbia (1974-78), Fordham (1978-86), Rhode Island (1986-88), Texas (1988-98), George Washington (1998-2000) and Houston (2004-10). He currently is the head coach at the University of Houston. Tom was a two-sport star at UConn in baseball and basketball as he played in two NCAA tournaments (1965 and 1967) and the 1965 College World Series. Penders' extended family also includes a prominent former Husky. His former classmate, teammate, battery-mate and 1994 Lawrence R. Panciera Most Valuable Player, Aaron Quinn, is now his brother-in-law. Quinn pitched for the Huskies from 1991-94 and married Penders' sister-in-law, Courtney in 1999.

Penders' younger brother Rob is the head coach of Division II St. Edward's University of Austin, Texas. His grandfather Jim was the longtime baseball coach at Stratford (Conn.) High School from 1931-68 and won four state championships, a record matched by Penders' father at East Catholic. He was also the head of the physical education department and the town's recreation director. The Stratford High School baseball and football complex is named in his honor.

Penders is also actively involved with several baseball clinics around the globe as he has presented as a featured clinician in Regensburg, Germany to German baseball coaches for International Sports Group/Major League Baseball International.

In addition to Germany, in January of 2008, he ventured overseas to instruct Swedish coaches in a three-day national clinic in Leksand, Sweden. In January of 2009, he flew to the Czech Republic for more presentations. Penders has also spent several years working at the World Baseball Convention in Uncasville, Conn., the Be The Best You Are Clinic in Cherry Hill, N.J., as well as conducting a catching clinic at the ABCA National Convention in Nashville, Tenn. in 2004.

In addition, Penders contributed a chapter in the published book, Gold Glove Baseball, in which he dissects catching techniques.

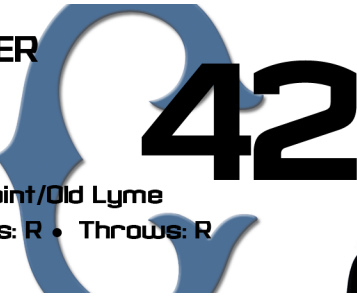
