3	Notre Dame's three ACC wins are tied for the fourth-most in the league. The Irish are 3-2-1 in ACC play and are tied for fifth overall in the standings.
4	Irish head coach Theresa Romagnolo is in her fourth season with the Irish. The Washington graduate owns a record of 48-18-11 at Notre Dame.
6	Sophomore Jennifer Westendorf has totaled six goals in 2017, matching her single-season career high.
11	Notre Dame checks in at No. 11 in the most recent RPI. The Irish own the third-best RPI in the ACC behind North Carolina (No. 3) and Duke (No. 4).
16	Notre Dame's Natalie Jacobs (9 G) and Sandra Yu (7 G) have combined to score 16 of Notre Dame's 28 goals this season.
18	Graduate student Sandra Yu's 18 points in 2017 are a career high. The midfielder has totaled seven goals and four assists so far this season. Yu has doubled her previous career high in points (eight), set in 2015.
20	The Irish have totaled 20 second-half goals and have limited their opponents to eight goals in the period.
22	Irish sophomore Natalie Jacobs leads the Irish with a career-high 22 points on nine goals and four assists this season.
25	The Irish are looking to appear in their 25th straight NCAA Championship. Notre Dame owns 12 trips to the College Cup and three NCAA titles.
28	Notre Dame's 28 goals this season are two more than its 2016 season scoring total (26).

#### **WEEKEND ACTION**

The Irish are scheduled to host Virginia Tech for a 7 p.m. ET matchup on Senior Day on Saturday at Alumni Stadium. Notre Dame will wrap up its regular-season home slate against the Hokies as they look to build upon their 4-3-1 record at home this season.

#### **SERIES HISTORY: HOKIES**

Notre Dame has gone 3-2-1 all-time against Virginia Tech, including a 2-0 mark at home. The Irish and the Hokies last met on Oct. 20, 2016, when they battled to a 0-0 draw in Blacksburg, Va. Notre Dame defeated Virginia Tech 3-0 in its last match at Alumni Stadium, coming on Oct. 30, 2015.

#### **30TH ANNIVERSARY**

Notre Dame women's soccer celebrates its 30th anniversary during the 2017 season. In the program's history, the Irish have gone 540-114-39. Over the past 29 seasons, Notre Dame has made 24 appearances in the NCAA Championship. The Irish have competed in 12 College Cups and have won three national titles.

#### **CELEBRATING SENIORS**

Twelve Irish seniors will be recognized as part of Saturday's Senior Day pregame ceremony. As a class, the seniors have combined to play in 502 career games and record 127 points on 43 goals and 41 assists. The Irish, behind goalkeeper Lexi Nicholas, also are responsible for 12 saves and seven wins in goal.

## **STORYLINES**

#### **RPI RANKING**

Notre Dame checked in at No. 11 in the most recent RPI. The Irish faced five consecutive ranked opponents -- all in the ACC -- and went 2-2-1 in those games. Notre Dame's match against Virginia Tech is its second game against an unranked team since Sept. 10 at Toledo. Notre Dame has four remaining regular-season contests, including two against top-25 teams.

#### **CAREER YEAR FOR YU**

After missing her first two seasons due to injury, Sandra Yu returned to the program as a graduate student and has recorded a careerhigh 18 points in 2017. Yu already has doubled her previous career high in points (eight), set in 2015. Yu has started all of Notre Dame's contests over the past two-plus seasons (2015-17), tallying 30 points on 12 goals and six assists in her career. In 2016, Yu totaled 45 shots, including 21 shots on goal (.467). Yu also competed on the United States U-23 Women's National Team this past summer.

#### **SECOND-HALF MAGIC**

Notre Dame has outscored its opponents 20-8 in the second half this season. The Irish have entered halftime in a scoreless tie seven times and in a 1-1 tie twice in 2017. Notre Dame has scored four goals in the second half three times this season against Ball St., Santa Clara and Toledo.

#### **HOME SWEET HOME**

Notre Dame will play its fifth home game in six contests and final of nine home matches this season. The Irish, which host five conference affairs in 2017, own a 4-3-1 record at Alumni Stadium. Over the last three-plus seasons, the Irish are 32-9-2.

#### ACC PRESEASON PREDICTIONS

After winning a regular-season ACC Championship in 2016, Notre Dame was predicted to finish fifth overall in the conference's preseason coaches' poll. Sandra Yu and Jennifer Westendorf were selected to the Preseason All-ACC Team, leaving the Irish tied with North Carolina for the second-most selections (trailing only Florida State's four).

#### **SCORING IN BUNCHES**

Notre Dame has gone 7-1 in games decided by two-plus goals. The Irish offense has scored four goals on five occasions this season, turning in dominant performances in such matches. With its two goals against Syracuse, Notre Dame has surpassed its 2016 scoring total (26 goals) with a sum of 28 goals this season. As a team, the Irish have been most successful in regulation, with all seven of their wins coming in the first 90 minutes.

#### THE ACC LEADERBOARD

Fourteen matches into the season, the Irish rank among the leaders in several offensive statistical categories. Notre Dame ranks second in the ACC with 230 shots. The Irish are second in the conference in assists (28) and third in points (84) and goals (28).

#### **SUNDAY FUNDAY**

Notre Dame owns a 6-0 record on Sunday in 2017. The Irish have played on Thursday twice (0-1-1), on Friday five times (0-3-2), on Saturday once (1-0) and on Sunday six times (6-0). All six of Notre Dame's Sunday victories have come in the afternoon, four of which were at home (Ball St., Santa Clara, NC State and Syracuse) and two of which were on the road (at lowa and at Toledo).

#### TOPDRAWERSOCCER.COM HONOR

Sophomore Jennifer Westendorf was named to TopDrawerSoccer. com's Women's Preseason Best XI Second Team. Westendorf was a 2016 All-ACC Freshman Team and 2016 All-ACC Second Team selection. Westendorf has passed her 2016 point total (13) and has equaled her single-season career high in goals (six).
