big east highlights

- the irish have won nine big east tournament championships with four runner-up finishes, posting a 27-5 (.844) mark in the event while reaching the final match in its first 12 tournaments.
- the completion of the 2008 big east championship saw the irish earn a spot in the final match for the 13th time in 14 seasons since joining the league in 1995.
- the irish have faced louisville in each of the last four conference tournaments while falling to the cardinals in three of those matches - and twice in the finale ... notre dame downed louisville for its last title in 2005, which was also played at the kentucky international convention center.
- notre dame has also dominated the league's postseason awards, winning player-of-the-year honors six times and coach-of-the-year award on five occasions.
- on nine occasions, irish players have been named the league tournament's most outstanding player.
- notre dame student-athletes have garnered 50 all-conference accolades - including 26 first-team honors - which accounted for nearly one-third of the total first-team honors handed out during the span.
- four notre dame players - christina kaelin, serinity phillips, justine stremick and kellie sciacca - were named to the all-big east second team in 2008 while kristen dealy found spots on the league's all-tournament squad.
- notre dame's senior class is 5-3 in the big east championship with a pair of trips to the final match (2006 and 2008) ... louisville defeated the irish in each of those contests as well as a second-round matchup in 2007.
- kellie sciacca's .632 hitting percentage (14-2-19) posted against louisville during the 2007 tournament showdown in milwaukee is the highest clip of any irish player in postseason league play ... she enters this year's tournament with a .422 average in 18 career sets played in the event.
- christina kaelin (21) and megan fesi (21) have each posted 20+ kill performances in the league tournament ... kaelin did so against st. john's in 2008 with fesi doing the deed versus cincinnati in 2007.
- kaelin leads notre dame with a career average of 3.77 kills/set ... she has played in 22 sets with 83 kills and a .274 hitting percentage in the conference tournament.
- without a title since 2005, notre dame's three-year streak without bringing home the final trophy is the longest in program history.
- the irish have compiled a 164-21 (.886) regular-season big east mark and conference winning streaks of 45 and 35 consecutive matches.
- notre dame once earned 58-straight victories at home in big east regular-season play.
- irish volleyball squads carried a home conference winning streak of 74 straight matches from 1991 to 2004, which includes wins over both midwestern conference and big east opponents.

bump, set, spike ...

- notre dame is off to its best start since 2005 when that squad was 22-2 through the first 24 matches of the campaign ... notre dame is the only team in the big east to finish the regular season without a conference loss (14-0) ... the team's last loss came sept. 20 at florida state, 3-2.
- notre dame has won 14 in a row - all against league foes - and 17 of its last 18 matches ... seven times since joining the league in 1995, the irish have streaked through the conference schedule without a loss ... the last time was in 2001 (12-0) ... the irish are now 102-7 (.936) in their home confines against conference foes.
- irish head coach debbie brown has shelved over 400 wins with notre dame and won five big east conference coach of the year awards since joining the league in 1995 ... the 2009 season is her 19th at the helm of the fighting irish program ... with a career record of 561-250 (.691) in her 25th season as a head coach, brown has a 444-167 (.727) mark at notre dame.

cracking the poll ...

after receiving votes in the avca top 25 poll for nine consecutive weeks, the irish found themselves ranked 24th on nov. 9 and bumped ahead to no. 23 this past week ... the irish were last ranked for the first two weeks of the 2006 season (21st) ... richkern.com deemed notre dame the 22nd-best team in the nation according to its nov. 16 poll while the irish are no. 26 in the pablo rankings ... volleyball magazine ranks notre dame as its 23rd-best team in the nation ... the irish have an rpi of 14 ... notre dame is the highest ranked big east conference team in each poll.

streaking across the nation ...

the 14-straight wins put together by the irish is the nation's fifth-best active streak behind penn state (28), northern iowa (24), florida international (21) and hawaii (21).

it's becoming a regularity ...

one week after securing the no. 1 seed for the upcoming big east conference championship, notre dame powered past georgetown (nov. 13) to clinch the league's regular-season title for the 11th time in program history ... it was the first outright title for the irish since 2004 after tying for first in 2005 ... notre dame received 12 kills from kellie sciacca and overcame deficits in each of the three periods to sweep the hoyas for the eighth consecutive time ... the irish improved to 14-0 against big east opponents and extended the nation's fifth-longest winning streak to 14 matches with a 3-1 win over usf (nov. 15) ... notre dame became the second team in league history to win each of its 14 regular-season conference contests as st. john's accomplished the feat in 2006, the first season in which the big east extended the league slate to 14 games ... now with seven undefeated big east regular-season efforts under its belt, notre dame last went unscathed in big east play in 2001 (12-0) ... the victory also earned the program its 18th 20-win season in 30 years of varsity competition.

nationwide ...

notre dame ranks 21st nationally with a .265 team hitting percentage ... the irish are 25th overall with 14.07 kills/set and 33rd with 12.84 assists/set ... jamel nicholas is 21st nationally with 11.21 assists/set and kellie sciacca ranks 25th with a .369 hitting pct.

inside the big east ...

in conference-only play, notre dame finished the regular season first in opponent hitting percentage (.147) and kills (14.32), second in assists (13.12), and third in blocks (2.92) and hitting percentage (.263) ... kellie sciacca took the hitting percentage title (.429) ... christina kaelin tied for sixth with 3.65 kills/set and jamel nicholas was third with 11.42 assists/set ... tara enzweiler was seventh overall with 1.28 blocks/set and serinity phillips was seventh with 4.49 points/set.
 or more kills ... the effort tied her for sixth all-time in that category with kristy kreher (1998-2001).

kaelin cops big east player of the week award ...

christina kaelin became the fourth fighting irish player to be named big east player of the week this season, earning the honor on nov. 9 ... kaelin shouldered much of the offensive load for notre dame in a pair of conference road wins at marquette (nov. 6) and syracuse (nov. 8) ... she registered double-digit kills in both matches with 17 versus the golden eagles and 13 versus the orange ... the win over syracuse snapped a 10-match home winning streak for the orange.

cleaning up on the road ...

syracuse recorded eight blocks and held notre dame to a season-low 15 points in the opening frame of a nov. 8 match but the irish rallied back to sweep the remaining sets while snapping the orange's 10-match home winning streak ... notre dame kept its own streak alive by winning its 12th consecutive match ... notre dame is now 7-0 in four-set matches this season and has won eight of nine contests on the road ... thirty ties and 13 lead changes marked notre dame's victory at marquette to snap a two-match skid to the golden eagles ... notre dame was aided by 15.0 blocks in the win including eight apiece from hilary eppink and serinity phillips.

nicholas earns academic all-district honor ...

senior setter jamel nicholas was named espn the magazine second-team academic all-district v, as announced nov. 5 by the college sports information directors of america (cosida) ... to be nominated for the distinction, a student-athlete must be a starter or important reserve with at least a 3.30 cumulative grade point average (on a 4.0 scale) at her current institution ... in addition, nominated student-athletes must have participated in at least 50 percent of the team's games at their respective positions ... nicholas, a co-captain for this year's team, was named the big east player of the week on oct. 12. she also earned nods on the notre dame / adidas all-tournament team and the xavier invitational all-tournament team earlier this season.

notre notes

punctuated performances at purcell pavilion ...

notre dame started last weekend with a 3-1 win over seton hall (oct. 31) in the opening match of the newly renovated purcell pavilion at the joyce center ... kristen dealy had 18 digs and accounted for 18.0 points with 16 kills (.483), two blocks and a service ace to open the match ... the win gave notre dame a 7-0 record in the month of october ... the sixth big east sweep of the season for notre dame came against rutgers (nov. 1) as the irish sent the scarlet knights home with a 3-0 defeat and held the visitors without a service ace ... it was the 17th consecutive win over rutgers and the 100th win for notre dame on its home floor against league opponents ... the victory gave notre dame another feather in its cap as the irish have now registered 10 or more big east regular-season wins for the 11th time since joining the league in 1995.

dealy headlines honor roll ...

sophomore outside hitter kristen dealy has been a steady force throughout the season for notre dame and most recently appeared on the big east honor roll (nov. 2) ... dealy led the irish in kills against seton hall (16) and rutgers (11) and also had a match-high 18 digs versus the pirates while chipping in six more versus the scarlet knights.

phillips picks up big east player of the week award ...

senior outside hitter serinity phillips was named the big east volleyball player of the week on oct. 19 ... phillips led notre dame to wins at pittsburgh (oct. 17) and west virginia (oct. 18) to improve the team's big east record to 7-0 ... phillips made sure there was no letdown one week after recording her 1,000th career kill against cincinnati (oct. 10) ... she had an all-around effort at pittsburgh by helping notre dame to a victory with 11 kills, seven digs and five blocks ... against west virginia, phillips hit .351 while racking up 18 kills and adding five digs and five blocks ... the valley center, calif., native led all big east players that week with 5.67 points/set.

nicholas notches big east's weekly award ...

senior captain jamel nicholas came through with big play after big play while helping maintain her team's flawless big east record with wins over two of the conference's top squads in cincinnati (oct. 10) and louisville (oct. 11) ... the efforts earned her the big east player of the week award on oct. 12 ... nicholas led the irish past the bearcats with 52 assists, three kills, eight digs and two blocks ... each of her three clutch aces in the fifth set of that win were part of a 6-0 irish run to close the books ... she went for 45 assists and 14 digs against louisville.

serinity hits 1,000 ...

senior outside hitter serinity phillips recorded her 1,000th career kill against cincinnati (oct. 10), finishing with 17 kills (.298), seven digs, six blocks and 20.0 points in that match ... phillips became the 18th player in program history to record at least 1,000 career kills ... the last to do so was irish volunteer assistant coach adrianna stasiuk ... she accomplished the feat during her senior season in 2007.

20+ for kaelin ... again ...

notre dame got 20 kills from senior outside hitter christina kaelin versus the cincinnati (oct. 10) ... it was the ninth match of her career with 20 or more kills ... the effort tied her for sixth all-time in that category with kristy kreher (1998-2001).

brown reaches milestones ...

when irish head coach debbie brown guided her team to a 3-0 win against villanova on oct. 4 it marked her 800th overall match on the sideline as a head coach and 600th with the irish ... to top the cake, it was brown's 550th career win.

i know what you did that weekend ...

big east conference play started with the irish posting a four-set win at connecticut (sept. 25) to improve to 14-1 all-time in big east openers ... senior outside hitter serinity phillips posted outrageous numbers in that match and nearly clinched a triple-double ... phillips had 16 kills, 12 digs and nine blocks for 21.5 points against the huskies to open big east play (she was also one block shy of a triple-double against marquette in 2008) ... senior outside hitter christina kaelin led notre dame to a 3-0 win at st. john's with 13 kills and a .500 hitting percentage as the irish posted their first sweep over the red storm since 2004.

conquering the cardinal ...

for just the second time in program history - and the first since 1993 - notre dame earned a win over a top-five opponent, as the irish dealt no. 5 stanford a 3-0 loss on aug. 29 ... notre dame's last win over a ranked opponent came at home against louisville on nov. 11, 2007, while the lone win versus a top-five opponent came on sept. 25, 1993, when the 14th-ranked irish defeated no. 3 nebraska at the joyce center ... the irish and cardinal last met in 2003 with stanford pulling out a 3-0 win ... the 2008 ncaa championship runner-up had never dropped a match to notre dame in six tries until this season ... the irish have earned 32 wins against ranked teams and 13 victories over top-10 teams ... furthermore, the 1,843 fans in attendance was the 15th-largest crowd in irish history.

preseason honors ...

senior outside hitter christina kaelin and junior middle blocker kellie sciacca both earned all-big east preseason nods, as voted upon by the league's coaches ... the duo brought home second team all-big east honors at the conclusion of last year's regular season ... kaelin went on to rack up all-region and honorable mention all-america honors from the avca in 2009 ... notre dame was picked alongside cincinnati to finish second in the big east standings.
