HEAD COACH JEFF JACKSON

Opening statement: "I'm extremely proud of our guys. They've been resilient all year long. They call them the cardiac kids for a reason. Hopefully it's not my cardiac, but they find a way to win. Regardless of the situation, they find a way to win."

On the competitiveness of the NCAA Tournament field: "Frankly every one of these regionals is scary good, in my opinion. I know the teams in each one of these regionals. They're all good. Michigan Tech was on a roll. They played us hard as any team we played all season long. Gave us everything that we could handle. Providence, I thought going into this game, may have been the hottest team, or one of the better teams playing the game. I have a lot of respect for Nate."

On how last year's Frozen Four experience may be beneficial this year: "I don't know if it's unfinished business. I think the biggest thing is that we were mesmerized by the moment last year...That group of kids had never been there before. We played a team in Denver that had played the year before in it. That experience is hopefully going to help us as we move forward.
