irish in the ncaa tournament

- notre dame has been a staple in the ncaa division i women's volleyball championship under the watch of head coach debbie brown after making just one visit to the tournament before her arrival.
- the irish earned 15 consecutive bids to the ncaas from 1992-2006 to become just one of eight schools that appeared in each of the 15 ncaa tournaments over that stretch (along with stanford, penn state, uc santa barbara, nebraska, long beach state, usc and florida).
- the irish have an all-time record of 14-16 in ncaa championship play, highlighted by six trips to the round of 16 and a finish in the 1993 quarterfinals.
- the irish made the most of their first-ever ncaa berth in 1988 by upsetting no. 20 penn state in the opening round. notre dame then traveled to no. 4 illinois and took the illini to the wire before falling in five sets.
- the 1993 squad put together the school's deepest postseason run compliments to a win over no. 8 nebraska at home in three sets and a five-set win at minnesota to reach the quarterfinals ... that team's run ended at the hands of no. 7 penn state. the irish also were among the final 16 in each of the next two seasons (1994-95) and completed a stretch of four round-of-16 appearances in five years with a second-round win over no. 18 arkansas in 1997.
- notre dame returned to the final 16 in 2005, beating dayton and northwestern at home before losing in five sets to no. 12 wisconsin.
- notre dame has played host to ncaa tournament action on seven occasions, going 8-2 on its home court. the irish stayed at home for first-round play in 1988 and 1993-1995 before hosting first- and second-round action in 1996, 2002 and 2005.

- notre dame has won 16 of its last 18 matches, including 15-straight from sept. 25-nov. 21 ... the 15-match winning streak matched the second-longest in school history ... the irish also won 15 in a row in 2005 and 17-straight in 1986.
- the irish have secured their 19th consecutive winning season in 30 years of varsity competition ... each of the last 19 winning seasons have come under the tutelage of head coach debbie brown.
- irish head coach debbie brown has shelved over 400 wins with notre dame and won six big east conference coach of the year awards since joining the league in 1995 ... the 2009 season is her 19th at the helm of the fighting irish program ... with a career record of 562-252 (.691) in her 25th season as a head coach, brown has a 445-169 (.727) mark at notre dame.

[in-season interview policy] all requests for notre dame player or coach interviews must be made through alan george at 574.631.3397. please provide at least 24 hours notice for all interview requests and be aware that the student-athlete's academic obligations will always take precedence. interviews may also be done in person before or after practice. since practice times vary, please contact alan george for an updated schedule. on game days, no interviews will be granted prior to competition.

[joyce center] notre dame plays all of its home games at the joyce center on the university of notre dame campus.

[post-game press conferences] notre dame head coach debbie brown and players, along with the visiting head coach and players, will be available to the media following a 10-minute "cooling off" period ... media members should submit player requests for post-match interviews to alan george within an appropriate time frame.

[photo credentials] photo passes will be issued by alan george to accredited members of the media and those individuals on special assignment ... all requests must be made at least 24 hours prior to each match ... during live action photographers are not allowed to shoot while stationed in front of or behind team benches, the scorer's table or press row ... photographers wishing to use strobes must contact alan george at least 72 hours prior to each match to obtain approval.

[radio broadcasts] visiting radio stations planning to originate from the joyce center must contact alan george at least 72 hours prior to each match in order to obtain approval for the broadcast and proper credentials ... additional broadcast lines should be ordered through notre dame telecommunications (carolyn rush - 574.631.7205) ... und.com provides live audio for selected home matches.

notre notes

the blurb on the bobcats ...

ohio won the mid-american conference tournament with a four-set victory over western michigan, claiming the trophy for the sixth time in seven seasons ... sarah petrulic was named tournament mvp ... this will be the fourth meeting between the irish and the bobcats ... ohio took the last meeting, 3-1, in 2007 ... the bobcats lead the all-time series, 2-1 ... the programs first met in 1992, when 24th-ranked notre dame pulled out a 3-0 win at the midwestern / mid-american challenge in notre dame, ind. ... this will be the first time neither team has entered the matchup nationally ranked ... four ohio natives have played for the irish ... notre dame is 41-18 against the mac conference, and debbie brown is 21-5 against the league during her 19 seasons at notre dame.

cracking the poll ...

notre dame dropped out of the latest avca top 25 poll, but received 47 votes (the most of any team outside of the top 25) ... notre dame's rpi ranks 14th ... richkern.com deemed notre dame the 24th-best team in the nation according to its nov. 30 poll ... each of notre dame's six losses have come to teams ranked in the avca's top 40.

irish against the field ...

notre dame has faced nine of the 64 teams in the 2009 ncaa tournament this season (cincinnati, florida, florida state, louisville, lsu, miami, michigan, stanford and tennessee) while posting four wins against those squads ... for the first time since 2006, three big east conference teams have advanced to the ncaas (notre dame, louisville and cincinnati).

jam on ...

senior setter jamel nicholas currently has 3,054 career assists, the fifth-most in school history ... her 7.29 assists/set average ranks ninth all-time ... she ranks 27th nationally with 11.16 assists/set as notre dame's team hitting percentage sits 25th at .259.

big east in the bluegrass state ...

meeting in the big east championship for the fifth time in as many seasons, top-seeded notre dame and fourth-seeded louisville went head-to-head and put on a show in the semifinals of the 2009 big east volleyball championship on nov. 21 at the kentucky international convention center ... with the home crowd behind them, louisville upset the fighting irish, 3-2, eliminating notre dame from the tournament for the fourth time in five years ... no. 23 notre dame saw its 15-match winning streak snapped ... the streak tied for second all-time in program history and was the longest since 2005 ... the irish received a solid outing from kristen dealy, who led the team with 23 kills ... louisville native christina kaelin added 17 kills and frenchy silva scooped 17 shots for the irish ... big east freshman of the year lola arslanbekova totaled 21 kills and 16 digs for louisville while justine landi posted five kills in the final set, including the match-winner ... kaelin and serinity phillips each pounded 12 kills as notre dame picked up a 3-0 win over seton hall during quarterfinal action ... it was the 11th sweep of the season for the irish, whose defense held seton hall to a .094 hitting percentage ... dealy finished the day with seven kills on 17 attempts, the first match of her career without an error, and added a team-high 11 digs and two aces ... dealy was named to the all-tournament team for the second straight year.

debbie brown was named the big east conference volleyball coach of the year, announced nov. 19 during the league tournament banquet at the louisville hyatt regency ... in addition, four irish players earned all-big east citations ... brown's honor was her 10th overall and sixth since notre dame joined the big east in 1995 ... she last won the award in 2005 ... in 2009, brown guided the irish into the big east championship after finishing the regular season with a perfect 14-0 league record and the conference's regular-season title ... a trio of irish seniors - christina kaelin, serinity phillips and jamel nicholas - earned first-team all-big east honors while junior middle blocker kellie sciacca was named to the second team ... kaelin finished in a tie for sixth in league play with 3.65 kills/set including 11 double-figure kill outputs ... the all-american averaged 3.92 points/set with a .268 hitting percentage and pounded cincinnati for 20 kills on oct. 10 ... nicholas ranked 21st nationally with 11.21 assists/set and steered the irish to the league's overall kills title (14.32) ... notre dame ranked second in assists (13.12) and hitting percentage (.263) ... the dynamic phillips did it all for notre dame during the conference slate and finished seventh with 4.49 points/set ... she posted at least 16 kills in five league matches and accounted for 3.56 kills/set, 1.94 digs/set and 1.27 blocks/set ... leading the big east in individual hitting percentage was sciacca (.429) ... she also averaged 1.21 blocks/set in league play, and a season-high seven of her 52.0 conference blocks came against cincinnati.

it's becoming a regularity ...

one week after securing the no. 1 seed for the upcoming big east conference championship, notre dame powered past georgetown (nov. 13) to clinch the league's regular-season title for the 11th time in program history ... it was the first outright title for the irish since 2004 after tying for first in 2005 ... notre dame received 12 kills from kellie sciacca and overcame deficits in each of the three periods to sweep the hoyas for the eighth consecutive time ... the irish improved to 14-0 against big east opponents and extended the nation's fifth-longest winning streak to 14 matches with a 3-1 win over usf (nov. 15) ... notre dame became the second team in league history to win each of its 14 regular-season conference contests as st. john's accomplished the feat in 2006, the first season in which the big east extended the league slate to 14 games ... now with seven undefeated big east regular-season efforts under its belt, notre dame last went unscathed in big east play in 2001 (12-0) ... the victory also earned the program its 18th 20-win season in 30 years of varsity competition.

notre notes

kaelin cops big east player of the week award ...

christina kaelin became the fourth fighting irish player to be named big east player of the week this season, earning the honor on nov. 9 ... kaelin shouldered much of the offensive load for notre dame in a pair of conference road wins at marquette (nov. 6) and syracuse (nov. 8) ... she registered double-digit kills in both matches with 17 versus the golden eagles and 13 versus the orange ... the win over syracuse snapped a 10-match home winning streak for the orange.

cleaning up on the road ...

syracuse recorded eight blocks and held notre dame to a season-low 15 points in the opening frame of a nov. 8 match but the irish rallied back to sweep the remaining sets while snapping the orange's 10-match home winning streak ... notre dame kept its own streak alive by winning its 12th consecutive match ... notre dame is now 7-0 in four-set matches this season and has won eight of nine contests on the road ... thirty ties and 13 lead changes marked notre dame's victory at marquette to snap a two-match skid to the golden eagles ... notre dame was aided by 15.0 blocks in the win including eight apiece from hilary eppink and serinity phillips.

nicholas earns academic all-district honor ...

senior setter jamel nicholas was named espn the magazine second-team academic all-district v, as announced nov. 5 by the college sports information directors of america (cosida) ... to be nominated for the distinction, a student-athlete must be a starter or important reserve with at least a 3.30 cumulative grade point average (on a 4.0 scale) at her current institution ... in addition, nominated student-athletes must have participated in at least 50 percent of the team's games at their respective positions ... nicholas, a co-captain for this year's team, was named the big east player of the week on oct. 12. she also earned nods on the notre dame / adidas all-tournament team and the xavier invitational all-tournament team earlier this season.

punctuated performances at purcell pavilion ...

notre dame started last weekend with a 3-1 win over seton hall (oct. 31) in the opening match of the newly renovated purcell pavilion at the joyce center ... kristen dealy had 18 digs and accounted for 18.0 points with 16 kills (.483), two blocks and a service ace to open the match ... the win gave notre dame a 7-0 record in the month of october ... the sixth big east sweep of the season for notre dame came against rutgers (nov. 1) as the irish sent the scarlet knights home with a 3-0 defeat and held the visitors without a service ace ... it was the 17th consecutive win over rutgers and the 100th win for notre dame on its home floor against league opponents ... the victory gave notre dame another feather in its cap as the irish have now registered 10 or more big east regular-season wins for the 11th time since joining the league in 1995.

phillips picks up big east player of the week award ...

senior outside hitter serinity phillips was named the big east volleyball player of the week on oct. 19 ... phillips led notre dame to wins at pittsburgh (oct. 17) and west virginia (oct. 18) to improve the team's big east record to 7-0 ... phillips made sure there was no letdown one week after recording her 1,000th career kill against cincinnati (oct. 10) ... she had an all-around effort at pittsburgh by helping notre dame to a victory with 11 kills, seven digs and five blocks ... against west virginia, phillips hit .351 while racking up 18 kills and adding five digs and five blocks ... the valley center, calif., native led all big east players that week with 5.67 points/set.

nicholas notches big east's weekly award ...

senior captain jamel nicholas came through with big play after big play while helping maintain her team's flawless big east record with wins over two of the conference's top squads in cincinnati (oct. 10) and louisville (oct. 11) ... the efforts earned her the big east player of the week award on oct. 12 ... nicholas led the irish past the bearcats with 52 assists, three kills, eight digs and two blocks ... each of her three clutch aces in the fifth set of that win were part of a 6-0 irish run to close the books ... she went for 45 assists and 14 digs against louisville.

serinity hits 1,000 ...

senior outside hitter serinity phillips recorded her 1,000th career kill against cincinnati (oct. 10), finishing with 17 kills (.298), seven digs, six blocks and 20.0 points in that match ... phillips became the 18th player in program history to record at least 1,000 career kills ... the last to do so was irish volunteer assistant coach adrianna stasiuk ... she accomplished the feat during her senior season in 2007.

brown reaches milestones ...

when irish head coach debbie brown guided her team to a 3-0 win against villanova on oct. 4 it marked her 800th overall match on the sideline as a head coach and 600th with the irish ... to top the cake, it was brown's 550th career win.

conquering the cardinal ...

for just the second time in program history - and the first since 1993 - notre dame earned a win over a top-five opponent, as the irish dealt no. 5 stanford a 3-0 loss on aug. 29 ... notre dame's last win over a ranked opponent came at home against louisville on nov. 11, 2007, while the lone win versus a top-five opponent came on sept. 25, 1993, when the 14th-ranked irish defeated no. 3 nebraska at the joyce center ... the irish and cardinal last met in 2003 with stanford pulling out a 3-0 win ... the 2008 ncaa championship runner-up had never dropped a match to notre dame in six tries until this season ... the irish have earned 32 wins against ranked teams and 13 victories over top-10 teams ... furthermore, the 1,843 fans in attendance was the 15th-largest crowd in irish history.
