

Notre Dame has had more vol-leyball players from California (22) than from any other state, also including current senior Kelly Corbett (Mountain View, near San Jose) ... in the '93 match, Notre Dame's Christy Peters had 24 kills, which is tied for the second-most for an Irish player in a three-game match ... Jillian Mazzarella was 37th in Division I in assists (12.58) in 2003, while Erika Chidester was 46th in kills (4.55) ...

In three NCAA tournament matches, Lauren Kelbley has averaged 3.50 kills and 1.50 blocks on .333 hitting.
