## STARTING FIVE

1. Georgia Tech begins its final four games of the regular season making the return trip to Notre Dame for a Sunday matinee at 1 p.m. The game will be broadcast on RSN, locally on Fox Sports South in Atlanta.
2. The Jackets and Fighting Irish have met nine times in program history with Notre Dame leading the all-time series, 9-0. Notre Dame has taken all four meetings in South Bend, including last year's 90-69 decision.
3. The Jackets picked up their second straight ACC win of the season on Thursday, defeating Boston College, 67-43 behind a strong fourth quarter. Tech will look to push its win streak to three straight and pick up its first-ever program win over ND on Sunday.
4. Georgia Tech is led in scoring this season by Francesca Pan who is averaging 13.0 points per game. Elo Edeferioka continues to lead the Jackets on the boards, pulling down 6.4 rpg.
5. Head coach MaChelle Joseph is in her 15th season on The Flats and carries an all-time career record of 289-187. Joseph is the all-time winningest coach in program history and holds the highest winning percentage in Yellow Jacket history at 60.9 percent.

## A WIN WOULD....

- Be the first-ever program win over Notre Dame and snap a nine-game streak the Fighting Irish hold over the Jackets
- Mark the first win over a top-25 team since Tech defeated No. 24 Syracuse last season on Jan. 15, 2017
- Be the first win over a top-10 program since Jan. 6, 2011 when the Jackets defeated No. 8 North Carolina, 71-70
- Mark the 290th win of Coach Joseph's career
- Be the 665th all-time program win in Georgia Tech women's basketball history and move the Yellow Jackets to 665-614 overall

## SERIES HISTORY

Georgia Tech and Notre Dame first met in 1996 as part of the Comfort Inn Downtown Classic in Atlanta. The Fighting Irish have been ranked in the top 10 in all nine meetings in program history and come into Sunday's contest carrying a No. 5 national ranking. Tech has visited Notre Dame four times with the Fighting Irish taking all four decisions. In the first meeting between the foes this season in Atlanta, Notre Dame used a 62.3 percent (33-53) shooting clip from the field to pick up a 77-54 win as the No. 2 ranked program in the country. Kaylan Pugh posted a team-high 17 points, but the Jackets were held to a 30.8 percent shooting efficiency for the game.

## LAST TIME OUT

Georgia Tech picked up its second straight ACC win on Thursday, defeating Boston College, 67-43, for the 10th program win over the Eagles. The Jackets held the Eagles to single digits in the first two quarters and used a strong fourth frame to pull away with the victory. Imani Tilford posted a season-high 16 points followed by Kierra Fletcher with 14 points and nine rebounds, nearly missing a double-double. Tech won the battle on the glass, 41-23, paced by Lorela Cubaj's 10 boards. BC committed 35 turnovers, marking the most by a Tech opponent this season.

**BROWN IN A STARTING ROLE**

Graduate student Breanna Brown has earned the past two starts as a Yellow Jacket and put together two solid games. The Oakland, Calif., native has averaged 25.0 minutes per game to account for 7.5 ppg and 7.0 rpg averages. She has shot 6-of-9 from the field (.667), 3-of-4 from the charity stripe (.750) and recorded three steals. On the season, Brown is averaging 2.4 ppg and 3.0 rpg.

**TILFORD POSTS SEASON-HIGH**

In Tech's win over Boston College (2/8), senior Imani Tilford posted a season-high 16 points to lead the Jackets' offensively. The senior shot 5-of-9 from the field and 5-of-6 from the charity stripe. Additionally, Tilford recorded three steals and a pair of assists in 27 minutes off the bench.

**CUBAJ ON THE BOARDS**

In the past three games for Tech, freshman Lorela Cubaj has been a force on the glass, leading the Jackets on the boards, pulling down 25 rebounds (eight offensive, 17 defensive) for an 8.3 rpg average. Against Boston College (2/8), Cubaj pulled down a personal-best 10 rebounds to mark her first game in double-figure rebounding numbers. She started the streak with seven at Duke followed by eight at Clemson. On the season, Cubaj is averaging 4.0 rpg.

**BAREFOOT COACHING**

Georgia Tech head coach MaChelle Joseph coached the Boston College game (2/8) barefoot for the Samaritan's Feet Barefoot Coaching campaign. This was the second year Coach Jo has participated in the effort and also the second year the Jackets have collected sneakers in a Samaritan's Feet Shoe Drive. Redshirt senior Elo Edeferioka inspired the shoe drive from her experiences growing up in Warri, Nigeria where many children did not have proper shoes.

**PERESSON SHINES IN CAMERON**

Senior Antonia Peresson likes the confines of Cameron Indoor Stadium in her career. In Tech's meeting this season at Duke, Peresson led the Jackets offensively with 17 points, hitting five three-pointers, marking a season-high. Her 14 three-point attempts this season marked a new career-high for the senior who also earned her first start this season against the Blue Devils. The Italian native was three points shy of matching her career-high of 20 points, which she set against Duke on 2/21/16 - also in Cameron Indoor.

**TILFORD COLLECTS THE STEALS**

Senior Imani Tilford has led the Jackets in steals as a sophomore, junior and senior (2017-18: 55; 2016-17: 92; 2015-16: 61). In her four-year career, she has collected 250 steals, ranking 6th in the all-time record book. Tilford needs 22 steals to surpass Jill Ingram (272) to become 5th all-time in career steals. Jacqua Williams holds the all-time record with 370 career steals. Tilford's 92 steals as a junior ranked second in the all-time junior class in steals for a season.

**NO LUCK FROM LONG DISTANCE**

In Tech's game against Virginia on Jan. 28, the Jackets did not hit a three-point field goal, marking the first time since Dec. 20, 2015 against IUPUI the Jackets did not record a three-pointer. Tech was 0-for-9 against the Cavaliers and suffered a six-point setback, 62-56. Francesca Pan was 0-for-7 from long distance, marking the first time this season the sophomore has not hit a three-pointer in a contest.

**FIVE IN DOUBLE-FIGURES**

Georgia Tech used balance on both ends of the floor to pick up a win over Wake Forest. Five Yellow Jackets scored in double-figures, marking the second time this season five have posted double-figures in a game (Georgia State). Tech has had four Jackets in double-figures four times (SC State, KSU, CSU, Southern Miss).

**SCORING RUNS DEEP**

Given Tech's depth this season, the Jackets' bench has out-scored its opponent in all but four contests this year. Amongst those four contests, two were in league play - at Syracuse and at Pitt. Tech utilized the same starting five through the first 18 games of the season before changing the lineup at Pitt.

**REBOUNDING IN THE ACC**

In ACC games only, seniors Zaire O'Neil and Elo Edeferioka lead the Jackets, pulling down on average, 5.8 and 6.6 rpg, respectively. Freshman Kierra Fletcher has moved into a tie with O'Neil in league games only, also pulling down 5.8 rpg. Edeferioka is tied for 14th in ACC games only. Myisha Hines-Allen (UL) leads the league with 11.0 rpg in conference only games. O'Neil is 7th in the league in offensive rebounds, pulling down 3.2 rpg (ACC only).

**POINTS IN THE PAINT**

No. 2 Notre Dame posted 56 points in the paint against the Jackets on Jan. 7, winning the edge 56-22 (56 marks a season-high this season by either Tech or an opponent). Tech has won the battle in the paint 13 times this season. Last season, Notre Dame won both battles in the paint against the Jackets, 32-18 in Atlanta on Jan. 2 and 58-28 in South Bend on Feb. 12. Tech gave up 50-plus PIPs twice last season with Michigan recording 50 on Dec. 1.

**PAN SETS PERSONAL BEST**

Sophomore Francesca Pan posted a career-night at Syracuse, scoring a team-high 26 points. The Italian native was 5-of-11 from three-point range, tying her career-high in triples. In 37 minutes of playing time, Pan recorded three assists, was 7-for-10 from the charity stripe and finished 7-of-15 from the field. Pan leads the Jackets offensively this season, averaging 13.0 ppg, and has scored in double-figures 15 times.

**KEEPING IT LOW**

In Tech's win over Clemson on Dec. 31, the Tigers were held to just 12 points in the first half, marking the first time since Dec. 30, 2010 an opponent has scored 12 points or less in the first half - Tennessee State scored just three points. Additionally, the Tigers scored just three points in the second quarter marking the lowest offensive total by an opponent in a quarter since the quarter system began in 2015-16. Tech has held an opponent to five points or less in a quarter three times this season.

**FLETCHER BATTLES**

Through her first 12 collegiate ACC contests, freshman point guard Kierra Fletcher has not let the competitiveness impact her. The freshman is Tech's is averaging 8.4 ppg and an impressive 5.8 rpg (tied with O'Neil) in conference games only. Fletcher is one of four freshmen in the league to have started all games for their team this season.

**TO THE WIRE**

In the ACC opener for both teams, Tech took No. 3/4 Louisville down to the wire, tying the game with 5.5 seconds left on the clock. The Cardinals scored the game-winning shot with 1.9 ticks left. Kaylan Pugh led the offense for the Jackets, scoring a season-high 17 points. Zaire O'Neil played a season-high 30 minutes and contributed 15 points, along with Francesca Pan. Tech outscored Louisville in three-of-four quarters, with the Cardinals taking the second game, 33-14.

**OPENING THE ACC SLATE**

The Jackets open the ACC slate with a pair of home games, marking the only back-to-back home games until the middle of Feb. The Jackets have opened at home eight times since Joseph took over the program in 2003-04, including last year's ACC home-opener against Notre Dame. Since Joseph has taken over the program, Tech has been victorious in the

### JOSEPH VS. THE RANKED

Since MaChelle Joseph took the reigns of the Yellow Jacket program prior to the 2003-04 season, Tech has beaten 14 ranked opponents. All-time, Georgia Tech has 35 wins against AP ranked teams with eight of those coming on the road.

### LAST WIN VS. RANKED OPPONENT

Tech's last win against a ranked opponent came vs. #24 Syracuse, 75-66, in McCamish Pavilion on Jan. 15, 2017. The win marked the first-ever against Syracuse in program history. Prior to that, the last victory over a ranked opponent was on Feb. 26, 2015 over #16/17 Duke, also at home.

ACC opener four times, the last occurring at NC State in 2012.

### HOME COMFORT

Tech headed into the ACC opener on Dec. 28 with a perfect 8-0 mark in home games this season. The last time the Jackets opened the season 8-0 was in 2015-16 when Tech and won all home non-conference games. Under head coach MaChelle Joseph, Tech has opened at home going 9-0 or better five times since 2002-03: 2009-10 - 11-0, 2007-08 - 10-0, 2005-06 - 9-0, 2004-05 - 9-0, 2002-03 - 9-0.

### LEAGUE SWIPES

Georgia Tech is first in the ACC in steals per game, with 266 steals for 10.6 spg. Duke is second in the conference with 258 steals (10.3 spg). On the national level as of the latest rankings, the Jackets ranked 19th in steals. Additionally, Imani Tilford is the 74th-ranked player in the nation in steals, leading the team with 55 (she is 7th in the ACC).

### WELCOME TO PARADISE

Georgia Tech opened the Junkanoo Jam with a 69-55 victory over Penn on Thanksgiving Day and advanced to the championship game for the second-straight season. The Jackets fell in the championship game to No. 8/9 Baylor, 80-57.

Elo Edeferioka was named to the all-tournament team after leading the Jackets, averaging 14.5 ppg and 8.0 rpg. She finished the tournament hitting 73.3 percent (11-15) from the field. Tech took part in the Junkanoo Jam last season and captured the Freeport Division title with wins over Dayton and Missouri.

### GREAT SCOTT!

In Tech's win at Princeton, Chanin Scott recorded a career night, finishing with a double-double behind 16 points and 13 rebounds - marking a career-high in rebounding. The double-double marked the second in her career and first this season. Since then, Scott set a new personal-best, scoring 17 points against Charleston Southern (12/19). She matched her career-high of 17 points against Southern Miss (12/21).

### HAPPY HOMECOMING

When Tech visited Princeton, three Jackets had a homecoming of sorts. Seniors Zaire O'Neil (Newark, N.J.) and Imani Tilford (Greenburgh, N.Y.) grew up outside of New York City, while junior Martine Fortune grew up just south of Princeton in Philadelphia, Pa.

### OH HIGH

Georgia Tech lists eight Yellow Jackets on their roster at 6'0" or above, making the squad one of the tallest in the ACC. Only Duke lists more players on their roster at 6'0" or taller with 11 Blue Devils. Also listing eight players at 6'0" or taller are: Miami, Notre Dame, Virginia and Wake Forest. The remaining teams with players listed at 6'0" or taller are as follows: UNC - 7; Pittsburgh - 7; NC State - 7; Louisville - 6; Clemson - 5; Syracuse - 5; Virginia Tech - 5; Boston College - 4; Florida State - 4.

### OPENING ON THE ROAD

Tech's season-opening contest marked only the fourth time since Coach Joseph took over the helm 15 seasons ago that the Jackets opened the season on the road - Tech opened at Appalachian State on Nov. 10. The Jackets opened on the road in her debut game at Florida Atlantic in 2003-04, at UAB in 2005-06 and at Loyola Chicago in 2014-15. Tech has won all four games when they opened on the road.

## SCORING TO THE FUTURE

Tech returns the core of its scoring from last season through its nine returning letterwinners. Amongst the nine returning letterwinners, Tech brings back 85% of its scoring led by its top three leading scorers from last season paced by senior Zaire O'Neil who averaged a team-best 12.9 ppg in 2016-17. Francesca Pan finished second on the team in scoring last year (11.5 ppg) and Kaylan Pugh rounded out the Tech's trio averaging double-figures last year with a 10.3 ppg average.

## O'NEIL BECOMES NO. 30

Senior Zaire O'Neil became the 30th Georgia Tech women's basketball player in program history to cross the 1,000-career point plateau on Nov. 12 against SC State. The senior accomplished the milestone in 94 games. She hit the mark scoring her second field goal of the game against the Lady Bulldogs.

## REBOUNDING RETURNING

Tech returns 85% of its scoring from last season and 81% of its rebounding. Leading Tech on the glass last season was Elo Edeferioka who pulled down 6.0 rpg. She was followed by O'Neil with a 5.7 rpg average.

## WHAT'S NEW?

Even though Tech returns the core of its roster from last season, the Jackets welcomed five newcomers to the squad. The Jackets welcomed four freshmen and a graduate transfer in 2017-18.

**Taja Cummings** - A local native, Cummings competed in basketball, track and softball at Saint Francis High School in Alpharetta...led high school to two consecutive Georgia High School Association (GHSA) Class A private state championships in 2015 and 2016.

**Daijah Jefferson** - Graduated from Hopewell High School in Hopewell, Va. where she helped school to conference, district and region championships in 2017...Tabbed 2017 conference and regional player of the year.

**Lorela Cubaj** - Ranked No. 2 international player by ProspectsNation.com...14th-ranked player in Italy...Wealth of international playing experience with Italian National Team including FIBA World and European Championships.

**Kierra Fletcher** - A two-time MLive Detroit Player of the Year, Fletcher helped lead Warren Cousino to first-ever state championship in 2016...Tabbed first team all-county four times and all-state three times.

**Breanna Brown** - Graduate transfer from Oregon State where she played three seasons...Named Pac-12 Defensive Honorable Mention last season...Member of Oregon State that reached NCAA Sweet 16 last season and Final Four in 2015-16.

## STRENGTH IN SCHEDULE

Tech has a competitive 2017-18 awaiting as 18 teams on the schedule reached postseason play last year. Ten teams reached the NCAA Tournament last season (depending on Tech's second opponent in the Junkanoo Jam), including four teams that advanced to the Sweet 16 and three to the Elite 8. Eight teams competed in the WNIT.

## ACC PREDICTIONS

In the ACC Preseason polls, Georgia Tech was picked to finish sixth by the league's head coaches and ninth by the Blue Ribbon Panel. Notre Dame was the preseason favorite in both polls. Francesca Pan was named to the Preseason All-ACC team and freshman Lorela Cubaj was named to the Newcomer Watch List.

## MAKING HISTORY

Last season, freshman Francesca Pan produced an incredible campaign. The Italian native became just the second Yellow Jacket in Georgia Tech women's basketball history to be named the ACC Freshman of the Year. During the season, Pan also picked up five ACC Rookie of the Week honors. She became the first Jacket since Ty Marshall (2010-11) to earn five Rookie of the Week honors in a season. She finished the season earning a spot on the ACC All-Freshman Team (media and coaches) and being named freshman of the year by both the coaches and media. Additionally, she was named to the All-ACC Academic Team.

## HOME SWEET HOME

All time, the Yellow Jackets are 351-209 (.620) when playing at home. Under Joseph's direction, Georgia Tech has gone 170-61 (.735) playing on The Flats.

## PERESSON BEYOND THE ARC

Senior Antonia Peresson attempted 193 three-pointers last season. The Pordenone, Italy native is 196-of-577 from three-point range in her career which makes her for fifth in the all-time record book in three-point field goals made. Additionally, Peresson is 4th in the record book in three-point attempts.

Redshirt-senior Elo Edeferioka (Warri, Nigeria), senior Antonia Peresson (Pordenone, Italy), sophomores Anne Francoise Diouf (Dakar, Senegal), and Francesca Pan (Bassno del Grappa, Italy), and freshman Lorela Cubaj (Terni, Italy) are Georgia Tech's five international student-athletes.

This past summer, Tech had two student-athletes representing their home countries on their National Teams. Sophomore Francesca Pan and freshman Lorela Cubaj both competed for the Italian National Team. Pan took part in the FIBA U20 Women's European Championship, while Cubaj saw action in both the FIBA U19 Women's Basketball World Cup and FIBA U18

European Championships.

Last summer, Pan represented Italy in the 2016 U20 European Championships, helping her country to a second-place finish.

During the 2015 summer, Peresson represented her home country at the U20 European Championship in Lanzarote, Spain. Edeferioka competed with the Nigerian National Team during the end of September, beginning of October in the Afrobasket for a chance to qualify for the Olympics. The Nigerian national team took third place which secured them a spot in the Olympic Qualifying tournament.

## HEAD COACH MACHELLES JOSEPH

15th Season • Purdue '92 • Auburn, Ind.

Georgia Tech signed head women's basketball coach MaChelle Joseph to a two-year contract extension through the 2019-20 season, as announced on Oct. 21, 2014. Joseph has had unprecedented success at the helm of the Yellow Jackets during the past 14 seasons. Joseph is just the second head coach in Yellow Jacket history to hit 200 career wins and is the all-time winningest coach at GT. Her 61 percent career winning percentage is the highest in Georgia Tech history. Currently, Joseph has nine 20-win seasons and seven NCAA tournament appearances, including six-straight from 2007 through 2012. Under Joseph's direction, 19 Yellow Jackets have garnered All-ACC accolades and four Jackets have been named All-ACC First Team members since Joseph became the head coach in 2003. Seven freshmen have been named to the All-ACC Freshman Team, including one a year from 2011 to 2014. Tyaunna Marshall was named an AP honorable mention All-American in both 2013 and 2014. Joseph has coached six Jackets that were selected in the WNBA Draft. Both Alex Montgomery and Sasha Goodlett were chosen in the first round of the WNBA Draft in 2011 and 2012, respectively. Aaliyah Whiteside was tabbed an honorable mention WBCA All-American last season, becoming just the sixth All-American Yellow Jacket in program history.
