49	Jordan Gross enters the weekend with 49 shots on goal, which is tied for third in the country and ranks first among defensemen.
21	Half (21) of Notre Dame's 42 goals this season have been scored in the second period. The 42 goals rank tied for second in the NCAA.
19	Jake Evans enters the weekend with an NCAA leading 19 points on four goals and an NCAA best 15 assists.
13	Head coach Jeff Jackson is in his 13th season behind the Notre Dame bench. He has led the Irish to eight NCAA tournament appearances and three Frozen Fours.
12	With 12 points, Jordan Gross (4-8-12) and Bobby Nardella (3-9-12) enter the weekend tied for third in the NCAA in scoring among defensemen.

FOR STARTERS

- Notre Dame and RPI will be meeting for the first time since the 2014 Ice Breaker Tournament at the Compton Family Ice Arena and for just the ninth and 10th times in series history.
- It will mark the final regular season non-conference games for the Irish, who enter the weekend with a 4-3-1 record outside of Big Ten play.
- Notre Dame is on a five-game winning streak, its first such streak since Dec. 3, 2016 Jan. 6, 2017.
- Notre Dame also had a seven game unbeaten streak last year from Feb. 3-24, 2017 (5-0-2).
- The Irish last won six games in a row down the stretch of the 2013–14 season, from Feb. 15 - March 14.
- The current five-game winning streak is tied for the second longest winning streak in the country and the fourth longest unbeaten streak.
- The Irish have also won six of their last seven games.
- Notre Dame opened Big Ten play with a 4-0-0-0 record to become the first team in league history to win each of its first four games (in 2013–14, Minnesota started 3-0-1-0 en route to an 8-0-2-0 start in B1G play).
- Cale Morris has started each game in the five-game winning streak and he has moved his save percentage to .935 for the season, which ranks sixth in the country.
- The Irish rank tied for second in the nation with 42 goals, while their 3.50 goals-per game mark is tied for ninth.
- Half of Notre Dame's goals this season (21-of-42) have come in the second period, the
 most second period goals of any team in the country.
- Dennis Gilbert (0-2-2) and Mike O'Leary (0-2-2) are on two-game point streaks.

AMONG THE NCAA LEADERS

- Jake Evans enters the weekend as the NCAA leader in points (19), assists (15) and faceoff wins (176), while his 1.58 points per game average ranks seventh.
- Evans also leads the country with 13 even strength points and he has the most games with at least three points (4).
- Jordan Gross (4–8–12) and Bobby Nardella (3–9–12) are tied for third in the country in scoring by defensemen.
- Nardella's seven power-play points (1-6-7) are tied for the lead among defensemen.
- Gross' 49 shots on goal lead all defensemen and rank tied for third overall, while his

- 4.08 shots on goal per game average ranks second among defensemen.
- Cale Morris' .935 save percentage ranks sixth in the country (minimum 33% team minutes played), while his seven wins are tied for second.

MORRIS EARNS B1G FIRST STAR

- Goaltender Cale Morris was named the Big Ten's First Star of the Week the conference announced on Tuesday morning (Nov. 14).
- Morris led the Irish to a weekend home sweep of Penn State, starting both games and posting a 2-0-0 record to go along with a 1.50 goals-against average and an impressive .961 save percentage.
- In game one of the series (Nov. 10), Morris totaled a career-high 40 saves.
- Then in Notre Dame's 1-0 win in game two (Nov. 11), Morris turned aside all 33 shots he faced to post his first career shutout as he became the first goaltender to blank Penn State this season.
- It marks the second consecutive weekly Big Ten award for Morris, who is now 7-1-0 on the year with a .935 save percentage and a 2.05 goals against average.
- His .935 save percentage ranks seventh in the country and first in the Big Ten.

THE SERIES (COMPLETE SERIES HISTORY ON PAGE 8)

- Notre Dame and Rensselaer will be meeting for the ninth and 10th times, with the series currently tied at 4-4-0 through eight games.
- The teams most recently played on October 10, 2014 in the opening game of the 2014 Ice Breaker Tournament at the Compton Family Ice Arena.
- After Jordan Gross tied the game, 2-2, at 3:41 of the third period, RPI came away with a 3–2 win on Mark Miller's game-winning goal at 4:32 of the third.
- In addition to Gross, current seniors Dawson Cook, Jake Evans, Justin Wade, and Luke Ripley also played in the game.
- The teams' meeting on October 21, 2011 marked the first ever game in the Compton Family Ice Arena and Notre Dame posted a 5-2 victory on that day.
- In front of a capacity crowd (5,022), Anders Lee netted a hat trick, while Sean Lorenz and Riley Sheahan also added goals for the Irish.
- Notre Dame is 1-2-0 all time at the Houston Field House.
- The Irish defeated RPI 4-3 on Nov. 24, 2007 which marked their most recent trip to Trov. N.Y.
- The game was part of the Engineers' Holiday Tournament, which the Irish won with victories over Alabama Huntsville and RPI.

RENSSELAER AT A GLANCE

- The Engineers are coming off a home ECAC weekend split with Quinnipiac (w, 5-3 on Nov. 10) and Princeton (L, 6-2 on Nov. 11).
- On the season, RPI is 2-4-5 overall and 1-4-1 in ECAC play.
- Rensselaer opened the season with a pair of 1-1 overtime ties at Ohio State, its only
 games against a Notre Dame common opponent.
- Sophomore forward Jacob Hayhurst leads the team with nine points on four goals and five assists.
- Junior forward Evan Tironese is tied for the team lead in goals with Hayhurst (4).
- Nine RPI players have at least four points on the season.
- In net, Detroit draft pick Chase Perry, a junior, has started eight of RPI's 10 games including both games last weekend.
- Perry has a 1-5-2 record to go along with a 3.28 goals against average and a .906 save percentage.
- Rensselaer is scoring 2.90 goals per game (31st overall) and is giving up 3.60 goals per game (55th overall).

NOTRE DAME HEADS TO CHICAGO

- Notre Dame and Wisconsin have agreed to play a pair of Big Ten games at the United Center in Chicago, beginning with this season's game on Jan. 21, 2018.
- The game is scheduled to start at 3 p.m. ET/ 2 p.m. CT and will air on NBCSN.
- The teams will also play one of Wisconsin's home games at the United Center in 2018-19.

EVANS AND GROSS HIT CENTURY MARK

- With a pair of third period assists against Denver (Oct. 14), senior captain Jake Evans hit
 the 100-career points plateau.
- Evans became the 52nd player in program history to reach 100-career points and the first since Anders Bjork did so during the 2016-17 season.
- Senior defenseman Jordan Gross then hit the 100-career points milestone in Notre Dame's 5-4 win over Omaha (Oct. 27), becoming the 53rd player in program history with 100 points.
- Gross is just the sixth defenseman in program history to reach the century mark and the first to do so since Bob Thebeau in 1985–86.

2017 FROZEN FOUR RUN

- Notre Dame concluded the 2016-17 season with an appearance in the Frozen Four at the United Center in Chicago (the University of Notre Dame also served as the host institution).
- It marked Notre Dame's third ever Frozen Four appearance as well as the third in a 10-year span (Boston College and North Dakota were the only other teams to make at least three Frozen Fours in that 10-year span).
- The Irish overcame deficits against both No. 1 seed Minnesota and No. 2 seed UMass Lowell to post back-to-back 3-2 victories at the Northeast Regional in

- Manchester, New Hampshire.
- In the combined 12 regional semifinal and regional games in the NCAA tournament last season, Notre Dame was the only team to trail in the second period or later and post a win - and the Irish did it twice.
- After trailing in the third period of the regional semifinal against UMass Lowell, the lrish tied the game late in the third when Cam Morrison scored on a feed from Anders Bjork.
- Andrew Oglevie then scored the dramatic game winner just 2:44 into the overtime period.
- The win over UMass Lowell was Notre Dame's first overtime win since defeating Miami 3-2 on Dec. 28, 2014, in the first round of the Florida College Hockey Classic in Estero, Florida.
- Notre Dame headed into the NCAA Tournament as a No. 4 seed and the Irish were the
 only team not seeded No. 1 to make it to Chicago.
- Cam Morrison scored the lone goal for the Irish in the Frozen Four contest, with assists from Jordan Gross and Jake Evans.

IRISH IN THE NHL

- Seven former Notre Dame players made 2017 NHL opening night rosters including, back-to-back defending Stanley Cup Champions Ian Cole and Bryan Rust (Pittsburgh), Anders Bjork (Boston), Stephen Johns (Dallas), Anders Lee (New York Islanders), Kyle Palmieri (New Jersey) and Riley Sheahan (Detroit).
- Bjork became the 17th former Irish player under Jeff Jackson to reach the NHL and the program's 31st overall when Boston opened the season with a home win against Nashville on Oct. 5 (Bjork had an assist in that win).
- Sheahan was traded to Pittsburgh on Oct. 21, where he joins Cole and Rust (at Notre Dame, he played with Cole during the 2009–10 season and with Rust during the 2010– 11 and 2011–12 seasons).
- Last season (2016–17), a program-record 10 former Notre Dame hockey players played in the NHL (nine was the previous high in 2011–12.
- The 2016-17 season also included several stretches where eight former Irish players
 were in the league at the same time, marking the first time in program history eight
 former players were on active NHL rosters at the same time.
- Prior to Bjork, Robbie Russo (Detroit) and T.J. Tynan (Columbus) were the most recent former Irish players to make their NHL debuts when they both did so on March 7, 2017.
- Also during the 2016–17 season, Rust became the third former Irish player to record an NHL hat trick, joining Palmieri (1) and Dave Poulin (5) and Lee totaled 34 goals to set the record for goals in an NHL season by a former Irish player.
- With Pittsburgh winning the 2017 Stanley Cup, Rust and Cole became the third and fourth former Irish players to win back-to-back Stanley Cup Championships, joining Bill Nyrop (Montreal '76-'77-'78) and Don Jackson (Edmonton '84-'85).

- Freshman defenseman Matt Hellickson was chosen in the seventh round (214th overall) by the New Jersey Devils in the June 2017 NHL Draft hosted (United Center).

- The 2017-18 hockey season marks University of Notre Dame hockey coach
 Jeff Jackson's 13th season behind the Irish bench. The highly regarded
 Jackson now has over 30 years of coaching experience.
- Notre Dame's Jeff Jackson era began in 2005 when the University searched for a man who could move the program among the elite hockey schools in the country.
- During his now 13-year run, Notre Dame has become one of the nation's top teams, winning the Central Collegiate Hockey Association's (CCHA) regular-season title twice (2006–07 and 2008–09) while earning three Mason Cup championships (`07, `09 and the final one in 2013)
- Since his arrival at Notre Dame, the Irish skaters have accumulated an overall record of 268-167-52, including eight trips to the NCAA Tournament (2006-09, 2010-11, 2012-14 and 2016-17), three Frozen Four appearances (2008, 2011 and 2017) and one national championship berth (2008).
- The 2017-18 season begins Notre Dame's hockey tenure in the Big Ten Conference. Since the introduction of hockey to the Big Ten, Jackson's Irish hold a 4-7-1 record against members of the conference.
- Between 2006–09, the Irish turned in win totals of 32, 27 and 31 for three consecutive seasons of 25 or more wins and three consecutive NCAA tournament appearances, a first in program history.
- Jackson's success on the ice also has had a major impact off the ice for the Irish. With the wins came a commitment from the University that led to the new home of Irish hockey - The Compton Family Ice Arena - one of the finest college hockey facilities in the nation. The new venue opened on Oct. 21, 2011.
- The Irish have seen 34 players selected in the National Hockey League Entry
 Draft during Jackson's tenure, including three first round selections. Since
 his arrival on campus, Notre Dame has also seen 21 products from USA
 Hockey's National Team Development Program reach the Irish ranks.
- Jackson has coached six Irish players to All-America honors Anders Bjork (2017) Robbie Russo (2015), Anders Lee (2013), Ian Cole (2009), Erik Condra (2009) and David Brown (2007).
- In addition, 16 of his players have gone on to play in the NHL, including most recently Robbie Russo (Detroit) and T.J. Tynan (Columbus), who each made their NHL debuts on March 7, 2017.
- Jackson's Notre Dame teams have played with poise, discipline, team speed and have also featured strong goaltending and excellent special teams play.
- Having led the Lake Superior State Lakers to an NCAA Division I title in 1992 and 1994, Jackson became the first coach to have won the championship prior to joining Notre Dame's hockey staff.
- As a head coach, Jackson has led teams to 14 NCAA Tournament appearances and seven conference championships (1991–93, '95, '07, '09 and '13).

 Cup playoffs. The following season all games were canceled due to the unresolved 2004-05 NHL lockout, and at the end of the year Jackson left the
 Islanders to join the Fighting Irish as head coach for the 2005-06 season.
- Jackson is a member of the USA Hockey Coaches Achievement Program, the American Hockey Coaches Association and the National Hockey League Coaches Association.
