An All-ACC First Team Selection, Colson also is among the final 15 in consideration for the 2017 John R. Wooden Award, given to college basketball's player of the year and a finalist for the Karl Malone Award (top power forward in the nation). |
| 1.70 | Assist-to-turnover ratio for Notre Dame this season, the second-best in the nation behind UCLA (1.90). |
| 4 | Notre Dame is the only ACC program to have four players mentioned on the All-ACC team this season. Bonzie Colson was a first-team selection while seniors V.J. Beachem and Steve Vasturia , along with junior Matt Farrell , all earned honorable mention. The four player awards also mark the most all-conference mentions the Notre Dame program has ever received. |
| 6 | Notre Dame has won six consecutive games at the Barclays Center, including two games in the NCAA tournament last season and two wins earlier this season when the Irish claimed the Legends Classic title. See page 2 for more details. |
| 8 | Notre Dame has earned a double bye in a conference tournament six of the last eight seasons. The Irish advanced to the semifinals of the conference tournament each time they have earned a double bye. Notre Dame has earned a double-bye in the ACC tournament three out of its four years in the league. |

IRISH REACH ACC SEMIFINALS FOR THE THIRD CONSECUTIVE SEASON:

The University of Notre Dame men's basketball team (24-8) will face Florida State (25-7) in the ACC Championship semifinals on Friday, March 10 at the Barclays Center in Brooklyn, New York. The Irish have advanced to the ACC semifinals for the third consecutive season, winning the entire tournament in 2015 and falling to eventual tournament champion North Carolina in the semifinals last season.

NOTRE DAME IN THE ACC TOURNAMENT:

Notre Dame is making its fourth appearance in the ACC tournament this week at the Barclays Center in Brooklyn, New York. The Irish have earned a double-bye for the tournament in the past three seasons and advanced to the semifinals each time they have earned that right - including claiming the 2015 ACC Championship with victories over Miami, Duke and North Carolina in Greensboro, North Carolina.

FARRELL LOVES NEW YORK/NEW JERSEY:

Junior guard Matt Farrell has made a claim as one of the most improved players in the nation this season, leading the team in assists (65, 5.9 per game) while scoring 13.8 points-per-game and converting on all 27 of his free throw attempts.

Farrell's stellar play in the 2016 Legend Classic tournament games at Barclays Center in Brooklyn, New York, earned him the tournament MVP award and his impressive performance against No. 1/1 Villanova on Dec. 10 in the Never Forget Tribute Classic in Newark, New Jersey, proved that the Bridgewater, New Jersey, native loves to compete in front of his hometown fans.

IRISH EXTEND THREE-YEAR WIN MARK RECORD:

Notre Dame's victory over Virginia Thursday night pushed the program's win record over the past three seasons to 80. The Irish already posted the best two-year stretch of victories last season, winning 56 combined games in 2014-15 and 2015-16.

SIX-FOOT-FIVE WITH A SEVEN-FOOT WING SPAN:

Junior forward Bonzie Colson has been labeled as 'under-sized,' due to his listed 6-5 height measurement. The New Bedford, Massachusetts, native does boast a 7-2 wing span, however, which helps the Irish captain lead the ACC in rebounding at 10.4 per game.

Should Colson continue to lead the league in rebounding, he will become the shortest ACC player to lead the league in rebounding since South Carolina's Grady Wallace grabbed 14.4 rebounds per game in 1957 - a span of 60 years.

Since 1958 (Pete Brennan, North Carolina) Colson would be the only player under 6-7 to lead the ACC in rebounding.

WINNINGEST CLASS AT NOTRE DAME?

The 2016-17 senior class of Steve Vasturia, V.J. Beachem and Austin Torres (Torres will return for a fifth-year of eligibility in 2017-18) could become the winningest class in Notre Dame basketball history.

The '16-'17 class has compiled 94 wins over the past four years, putting the all-time mark of 97 by the 2012-13 group in reach (Notre Dame has at least two games remaining this season - in the ACC tournament semifinals and the NCAA tournament - with the possibility of advancing to earn more games).

COLSON POURS IN 33 POINTS VS. FLORIDA STATE:

Junior forward Bonzie Colson led the Irish to victory over No. 14/15 Florida State on Saturday, Feb. 11, with a career-high 33 points. It was the second 30-point game of Colson's career (he posted 31 points in a victory at Duke on Jan. 16, 2016) and the first 33-point game at Notre Dame since Matt Carroll's 33-point effort against DePaul on Dec. 14, 2002.

Colson's 33 points mark the 50th time that an Irish player has reached at least 30 points in a game during the Mike Brey era (2000-01 to present). It is the most points scored in a game by an Irish player since Luke Harangody posted 37 against Cincinnati on Feb. 4, 2010.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE WATCH:

Junior forward Bonzie Colson continues to post impressive scoring and rebounding numbers this season. His ACC-leading 18 double-doubles are the sixth-most in a single season at Notre Dame during the Mike Brey era (2000-01 - current).
