

NOTRE DAME BASEBALL GAMEDAY NOTES

(at South Florida; April 8, 2006)

TODAY'S GAME – Senior LHP Tom Thornton takes the mound as the Irish (20-8, 6-1 BIG EAST) look for their 11th straight win and 14th in the past 15 overall games vs. BIGE AST teams (dating back to 2005).

IRISH OPEN SERIES WITH 9-6 WIN – Notre Dame won Friday's game behind the strong efforts at the top of the order from Craig Cooper (3-for-5, 2 RBI, 3 R, HR) and Brett Lilley (4-for-4, BB, 2 R) ... Jeff Samardzija overcame a shaky first inning to get the win (5.1 IP, 6 R, 6 H, 5 BB, 5 Ks), improving to 4-1 this season and 17-5 in his ND career ... Mike Dury retired all seven batters he faced to set up Kyle Weiland's ninth save of the season.

ON A ROLL – The Irish are riding an extended streak of 18 wins in their past 21 games, after opening with a 2-5 record that included losses vs. two of the nation's top-ranked pitchers (Nebraska's Joba Chamberlain and Arizona's John Melancon), a pair of extra-inning losses (vs. Memphis and Arizona) and two losses by one run (vs. Memphis and Oklahoma, plus the 2-0 loss to Arizona in 12 innings).

BULLPEN BOOST – Notre Dame lost two of its top relief pitchers (junior RHP Dan Kapala/shoulder and sophomore RHP Tony Langford/elbow) before the 2006 season even began but the Irish bullpen has responded with a solid season that now includes a 3.57 ERA, a .244 opponent batting avg., nearly a 2-to-1 K-to-walk ratio (70/36) and 10 more innings pitched (85.2) than hits allowed (76) ... the ND relievers have allowed one-third (16-of-48) of inherited baserunners to score but have struggled vs. first batters faced, allowing a .383 batting avg. (18-for-47) with 8 runs scored, 3 walks and 3 hit-batters among those 63 first batters (9 Ks):

GIVING BACK THE INHERITANCE – Junior RHP **Joey Williamson** has taken the mound with nine batters on base this season and has allowed just one of them to score (vs. Wright State), stranding five inherited baserunners since that game ... Williamson has been particularly strong versus his first batter faced, allowing just 1-for-8 batting with six strikeouts in those situations (BB, HBP, R).

SUPER SAVER – Closer **Kyle Weiland** has saved ND's past three games (four of the past five) and already has tied Aaron Heilman's ND record for saves by a freshman (9, in '98) ... Weiland has converted all nine of his save chances and ranks fifth on the ND season saves list, behind J.P. Gagne (13, in '03), Ryan Doherty (12, in '04), John Corbin (11, in '00) and Mike Coffey (10, in '98).

DOUBLE-DIGIT WIN STREAK – Notre Dame has posted the 11th double-digit win streak of the 12-year Paul Mainieri, with at least one in nine of those seasons.

RACKING UP THE HITS – The Irish are 15-2 this season when posting double-digit hits, including each of the past six games ... Friday (15) marked the fifth time this season that the Irish have totaled 15-plus hits.

FIRST-INNING FOCUS – The Irish on Friday continued their season-long production in the first inning by jumping out to a 3-0 lead, marking the 15th time this season Notre Dame has scored in the first ... the Irish now are batting .311 for the season but are hitting 60 points higher (at a .371 clip) in the first inning of '06 games, led by Cooper (.706; 12-for-17, 11 R, 4 BB, HBP), Gaston (4-for-9, 6 RBI, 2 R, 2 BB) and Brezovsky (3-for-7, 2 R, 5 RBI, 2 BB, HBP).

AROUND THE BIG EAST – The Irish now sit alone in second place in the BIG EAST standings, trailing only unbeaten St. John's (6-0). The Red Storm were winning Friday at Pittsburgh (2-1, in the 5th) when that game was postponed due to rain, to be concluded on Saturday ... West Virginia (5-2) dropped to 3rd-place in the BIG EAST standings after a 10-6 loss at Rutgers ... 4th-place UConn (6-3) also was postponed in its Friday home game vs. Villanova (1-5), to be made up Sat. at noon ... Cincinnati (4-3) won 5-1 at Seton Hall (2-8) and now is tied with Louisville for fifth in the BIG EAST (UL dropped a 7-4 road game to Georgetown, with the Hoyas now 2-5) ... Pitt entered its series vs. SJU with a 2-7 record (now 10th in the standings).

LILLEY BACK IN FORM – Brett Lilley steadily has returned to his all-BIG EAST form, after easing back from an offseason back injury and overcoming a .205 batting average three weeks into the season ... the sophomore third baseman now has boosted that batting average to .310,

BIG EAST'S BEST – Craig Cooper had a hand in four of the Irish runs, including a two-run blast in the fourth, while raising his career batting average in BIG EAST games to .430 – still third-best in the history of BIG EAST baseball, just shy of former Rutgers player Joe Cirrone's .432 ... the senior first baseman singled in the first inning, marking the 15th time in 19 plate appearances that he has reached base as Notre Dame's first hitter of the game.

HIT STREAKS – Sophomore second baseman Ross Brezovsky joined Ctaig Cooper in pushing his hitting streak to nine games, batting 2-for-3 with a pair of walks and a two-run single in the third ... Cooper now has compiled two nine-game hitting streaks this season ... he also had a 13-game hitting streak late in the 2005 season and could become the ninth Mainieri-era player with multiple double-digit hit streaks in his career ...

KEEPING 'EM IN THE PARK – The ND pitching staff still has allowed just three home runs all season and now has logged 23-plus games without allowing a home run, spanning 893 batters faced ... teams that have hit a home run in games involving ND this season are 12-1 (the Irish are 9-1 when hitting a HR this season but have lost all three games when the opponent has homered) ... there has been only one game this season when ND and its opponent have homered (the loss to Oklahoma) ...

RECORD WHEN ... – ND also improved to 11-4 when scoring in the first inning, 18-1 when leading at the end of the seventh and 18-3 when outhitting the opponent.

BEATING THE BIG EAST – ND is 13-1 in its past 14 games vs. BIG EAST teams, including 3-0 in the 2005 BIG EAST Tournament.

LOVING IT IN FLA. – The senior class is 16-4 in Florida during their careers, with the losses coming vs. Jacksonville in a 2003 extra-inning game (9-6, in 10), at Central Florida in a tight 2005 early-season game (2-1) and in a pair of games at the '05 NCAA Gainesville Regional (5-1 vs. UNC and 23-3 vs. the host Gators).

HOME RUN SURGE – All three of Craig Cooper's home runs this season have come during the past eight games ... he now owns 20 career home runs to go along with 39 stolen bases and 40 doubles.

CENTURY MARK – Brett Lilley (103) has eclipsed 100 career hits, doing so in his 88th game with the Irish.

SUNSHINE KID – Brett Lilley now is batting .448 (13-for-29) in nine career games played within the state of Florida (.579 on-base pct., 8 HBP, BB, 9 R, 2 RBI, 2 Ks) ...

RARE DPs – Prior to Friday's game, Dressman had totaled 38 at-bats with runners on base without grounding into a double play (he then had 2 GDPs vs. USF) ... Dressman and Craig Cooper both have struck out just seven times all season.
