Deanna Gumpf

Deanna Gumpf is entering her fifth year as Head Softball Coach for the Notre Dame Softball team. The 2001 season began Gumpf's era as Associate Head Coach for the Irish.

In 2005 at Notre Dame, Gumpf coached the Irish to a 46-15 record. The Irish won their tenth consecutive regular season Big East Championship in 2005. Gumpf and her staff have been named the Big

East Staff of the Year as well as the Mideast Staff of the Year two times during her tenure. The Irish finished with a strong performance at the NCAA Regional in 2005, where they hosted the NCAA Regional Tournament for the first time ever in Notre Dame Softball history. The appearance was the seventh consecutive NCAA Post-Season appearance for the Irish and fourth consecutive for Head Coach Deanna Gumpf.

Gumpf has served as a pitching coach for Long Beach State University and private Pitching instructor. The La Palma, California native starred at Nebraska from 1989-1992. Before playing at Nebraska, her club the Gordon's Panthers, won four straight national championships from 1982-85 and were runners-up in 1987 and 1988.

Pitchers will hear about fundamentals and techniques of pitching. Gumpf will also demonstrate each technique. Pitchers will divide into small groups—receiving individual instruction from Gumpf, Volunteer Assistant Coach Dawn Austin, Assistant Coaches and Notre Dame Players.

Kris Ganeff

Kris Ganeff is beginning her fifth year as an assistant coach for the Irish. Ganeff is responsible for the Notre Dame catchers, infielders and shares the hitting duties with assistant coach Lizzy Lemire. Ganeff came to Notre Dame after spending two seasons at the University of Nevada Las Vegas.

Ganeff is an alumnus of the University of Notre Dame where she was a successful catcher for the Irish from 1996-99. In her tenure, Ganeff (formerly

McCleary) was named to the All Big East Conference Team and Mideast Regional team and was team captain of the 1999 Big East Conference undefeated squad.

Catchers will hear about the fundamentals and techniques of catching. Ganeff will also demonstrate drills which will enhance your skills behind the plate. Catchers will divide into small groups and will receive individual instruction from Ganeff, Staff and Notre Dame Players

Lizzy Lemire


