BY THE NUMBERS: IRISH IN BROOKLYN

2	Notre Dame is appearing in the ACC Championship game for the second time in the last three seasons - and second time in its four seasons as a member of the ACC.
3	The Irish are the third-seeded team in the ACC Championship field this season. The last time the Irish were the third seed in 2015, they won the league title with a win over fifth-seeded North Carolina. Duke enters Saturday night's game as the fifth seed in this year's tournament.
4	Notre Dame is the only ACC program to have four players mentioned on the All-ACC team this season. Bonzie Colson was a first-team selection while seniors V.J. Beachem and Steve Vasturia , along with junior Matt Farrell , all earned honorable mention. The four player awards also mark the most all-conference mentions the Notre Dame program has ever received.
5	Notre Dame has claimed victories in five of the seven meetings with Duke as an ACC member, including a 2-0 record in the conference tournament. See page 4 for more details.
7	Notre Dame has won seven consecutive games at the Barclays Center, including two games in the NCAA tournament last season, two wins earlier this season when the Irish claimed the Legends Classic title and two wins in the 2017 ACC tournament. See page 2 for more details.
10	Mike Brey has led the Irish to a top-four conference finish in 10 of his 17 years on the Irish bench.
11	Sophomore Matt Ryan scored 11 points off the bench against Florida State in the ACC semifinal victory on Friday night and is shooting 5-for-7 (.714) from three-point range at the Barclays Center this season.
12	Notre Dame boasts a program record 12 post season victories over the past three seasons, including ACC and NCAA tournament games.
17.0	Points-per-game average for Bridgewater, New Jersey, native Matt Farrell in Notre Dame's five games played in New York/New Jersey this season (two Legends Classic games, vs. Villanova at the Prudential Center, two ACC tournament games). Farrell boasts a 4.67 assist/turnover ratio in those five games. See page 2 for more details.
18	Points scored by senior Steve Vasturia in the ACC semifinal victory over Florida State. Vasturia shot 7-of-13 from the field, 4-of-5 from three point range and posted a team-high three steals.
23	Junior Matt Farrell has connected on at least one three-point field goal in 23 consecutive games, the second-best streak of any ACC player (L. Kennard, Duke, 36 games).
96	The 2016-17 senior class (Steve Vasturia, V.J. Beachem) has helped Notre Dame earn 96 victories over the past four seasons. A victory in the ACC Championship game will match the school record for wins in a four-year span with the 2012-13 senior group of Garrick Sherman, Scott Martin, Tom Knight, Mike Broghamer and Jack Cooley.
381	Victories at Notre Dame for head coach Mike Brey , the second-most in Notre Dame history and 12 away from the all-time record (393).

IRISH AND BLUE DEVILS CLASH FOR A BANNER SATURDAY NIGHT:

The University of Notre Dame men's basketball team (25-8) will face Duke (26-8) in the ACC Championship Final on Saturday night at the Barclays Center in Brooklyn, New York. The Irish are appearing in the ACC Championship final for the second time in three seasons and are matching up with the Blue Devils for the third consecutive conference tournament. Notre Dame is 2-0 in those previous ACC tourney meetings, defeating Duke in the 2015 semifinals and 2016 quarterfinals.

NOTRE DAME IN THE ACC TOURNAMENT:

Notre Dame is making its fourth appearance in the ACC tournament this week at the Barclays Center in Brooklyn, New York. The Irish have earned a double-bye for the tournament in the past three seasons and advanced to the semifinals each time they have earned that right - including claiming the 2015 ACC Championship with victories over Miami, Duke and North Carolina in Greensboro, North Carolina.

IRISH EXTEND THREE-YEAR WIN MARK RECORD:

Notre Dame's victory over Virginia Thursday night pushed the program's win record over the past three seasons to 80. The Irish already posted the best two-year stretch of victories last season, winning 56 combined games in 2014-15 and 2015-16.

SIX-FOOT-FIVE WITH A SEVEN-FOOT WING SPAN:

Junior forward Bonzie Colson has been labeled as 'under-sized,' due to his listed 6-5 height measurement. The New Bedford, Massachusetts, native does boast a 7-2 wing span, however, which helps the Irish captain lead the ACC in rebounding at 10.4 per game.

Should Colson continue to lead the league in rebounding, he will become the shortest ACC player to lead the league in rebounding since South Carolina's Grady Wallace grabbed 14.4 rebounds per game in 1957 - a span of 60 years.

Since 1958 (Pete Brennan, North Carolina) Colson would be the only player under 6-7 to lead the ACC in rebounding.

WINNINGEST CLASS AT NOTRE DAME?

The 2016-17 senior class of Steve Vasturia, V.J. Beachem and Austin Torres (Torres will return for a fifth-year of eligibility in 2017-18) could become the winningest class in Notre Dame basketball history.

The '16-'17 class has compiled 96 wins over the past four years, putting the all-time mark of 97 by the 2012-13 group in reach (Notre Dame has at least two games remaining this season - in the ACC tournament finals and the NCAA tournament - with the possibility of advancing to earn more games).

614 AND COUNTING

Notre Dame has made at least one three-pointer in 614 straight contests dating back to the 1998-99 campaign. The Fighting Irish have made at least one three pointer during every game of the Mike Brey era. The last time an Irish team failed to hit a three-pointer in a game was in a 101-70 loss to Connecticut at the Hartford Civic Center on Jan. 12, 1999. Notre Dame finished 0-7 from beyond the arc in that contest.

NOTRE DAME VS. DUKE SERIES HISTORY:

Duke leads the all-time series with Notre Dame 21-7, but the Irish have won five of the seven meetings between the two teams since they became conference opponents for the 2013-14 season. Notre Dame also is 2-0 against Duke in the ACC tournament, including a 84-79 overtime victory in the quarterfinals last season.

IRISH PICKED SEVENTH IN PRESEASON ACC POLL, FINISH IN A TIE FOR SECOND PLACE:

On Oct. 26, 2016, during Operation Basketball for the ACC (media day) the league announced its preseason poll. The Irish were selected to finish seventh in the conference this season.

Here is a breakdown of Notre Dame's projection, final position and conference record in its three full years in the ACC.

LEGENDS CLASSIC CHAMPIONS:

Notre Dame claimed its first in-season tournament title since 2010 with a 70-66 victory over Northwestern on Tuesday, Nov. 22, in the championship game of the 2016 Legends Classic at the Barclays Center in Brooklyn, New York.

The four victories for the Irish in the tournament (over Bryant, Seattle, Colorado and Northwestern) mark the most the Irish have ever won in an in-season tournament. The trophy was the first in-season award claimed by the Irish since they won three games in 2010 to claim the Old Spice Classic at Disney's Wide World of Sports. Previous to the 2010 Old Spice victory, Notre Dame's most recent in-season tournament title came at the Hawaii-Pacific Thanksgiving Classic in 2001.

LEGENDS CLASSIC MVP:

Bridgewater, New Jersey, native Matt Farrell enjoyed his return to the Barclays Center, not far from the area where he played during his prep career, for the Legends Classic semifinal and final victories over Colorado and Northwestern, respectively.

Farrell, whose first two career starts came in Notre Dame's two NCAA tournament victories over Michigan and Stephen F. Austin in the Barclays Center during March of 2016, played a career-best game in the semifinal over Colorado, scoring 20 points with six assists and three steals.

He followed up that performance with 18 points and six assists against Northwestern in the championship game, including scoring Notre Dame's final five points in the come-from-behind victory.

With a 19 point-per-game average in the two games at Barclays Center, along with 6.0 assists and 2.0 steals per game, Farrell was the easy choice as the tournament's most valuable player.
