Monica Gerardo – currently an assistant coach in the BIG EAST at the University of Pittsburgh, after playing in the WUSA and with the Mexican National Team – posted a pair of four-goal games in her career and held Notre Dame career records for points (190) and goals (73) before those records were bested one year later by 1999 teammates Jenny Streiffer (211) and Jenny Heft (80).



Susie Zilvitis is one of nine all-time Notre Dame players to appear in every game of her four-year career, totaling 43 goals (now 11th in ND history) and 26 assists in 82 games played from 1988-91.

Rosella Guerrero remains the only Notre Dame freshman ever to record a hat trick in her first game with the Irish, doing so vs. North Carolina State in 1992. She added four more hat tricks in her career.

Hat Trick History: Notre Dame has scored 49 hat tricks in the program's previous 16 seasons, including at least once every year from 1988-2000. Jenny Heft scored three of those hat tricks in 1998 to bring her career total to five, tying her with Monica Gerardo and Rosella Guerrero for the most in school history. Heft then broke the school record with a hat trick in 1999 against Georgetown. Amy Warner in 2000 set the record for earliest hat trick by a Notre Dame freshman, based on date (Sept. 3, vs. Providence), while Rosella Guerrero remains the only Irish freshman to notch a hat trick in the season opener (vs. North Carolina State in 1992).
