* Korpi has allowed just 3 earned runs in the 1st-4th innings (0.84 ERA, .193 opp avg., 41 Ks, 9 BB, 22 H, 32 IP) ... he also has yet to allow a run after the 6th inning (6 IP, 10 Ks, 2 BB, 2 H/105)

IN THE ND RECORD BOOKS – Wade Korpi's 1.56 season ERA would rank 8th in the ND record book and best since David Sinnes finished 2nd in the nation with a 1.05 ERA in 1990 ... Korpi's .198 opp. batting avg. would rank 3rd-best in the ND record book (stat kept since '91), behind Sinnes (.163, in '92) and Aaron Heilman (.173, in '01) ... he is on pace for 113 strikeouts this season, which would be 3rd in ND history and just shy of Aaron Heilman's record of 118 (in '99 and '00) ... his 11.94 Ks per 9 IP would rank 5th in ND history and 2nd in the Mainieri era, behind Ryan Doherty's 12.18 in '04), with three of the top marks being more than 40 years old (Frank Carpin's 12.63 in '58; Dan McGinn's 12.18 in '65 and Rick Rusteck's 12.14 in '63) ... his season 4.31 K-to-walk ratio would rank 8th in the ND record book and 4th in the Mainieri era, behind Danny Tamayo (6.24, in '01), Scott Cavey (5.88, in '99) and Chris Niesel (4.58, in '03).

IRISH PUSH BIG EAST WIN STREAK TO 16 – Notre Dame has won 16 consecutive BIG EAST games, just two shy of the longest conference winning streak ever by a BIG EAST team (an 18-game tear by Notre Dame's talented 2001 squad) ... that 2001 team started 2-2 in BIG EAST play (2-0 vs. Pitt, 0-2 vs. Virginia Tech) before rattling off the 18 straight wins.

STRONG STARTERS – The Irish are off to their best one-loss start in 11 years of BIG EAST play, besting the 1998 team's 14-1 start in BIG EAST play that ended with an 11-9 loss to West Virginia.

KNOCKING OFF DEFICITS – Notre Dame now has won 25 times in 26 games spanning the past six weeks, overcoming 19 of 20 total deficits during that span.

IRISH EXTEND WIN STREAK VS. HUSKIES TO 11 – ND now has won 11 straight games vs. UConn, after losing four straight to the Huskies spanning the '01 and '02 seasons.

EXTENDED RUN – The Irish own a 23-1 record in their past 24 overall games versus BIG EAST teams, stretching back to the final two weeks of the 2005 regular season (21-1 win at Pitt, sweep of West Virginia and 3-0 record at BIG EAST Tournament) ... the Irish have averaged nearly 9 runs per game in the past 24 games vs. BIG EAST teams (8.7) while allowing just 4.0 runs in that stretch (209-96).

MIGHTY MOUSE SAVES THE DAY AGAIN – Sophomore 2B Ross Brezovsky, dubbed "Mighty Mouse" by one of the ND radio announcers during the first week of the 2006 season, was a late-inning hero several times in the recent 23-game winning streak – including an 8th-inning home run vs. Ball State and a 9th-inning triple that helped beat St. John's ... the lefthanded batter added another clutch hit to ultimately win the series opener vs. UConn, jumping on the first pitch from Ted Garry and sending a single into left field (scoring Brett Lilley) for the team's third opposite-field hit of the inning.

DRESSMAN TRIPLES HIS DOUBLES – Danny Dressman batted just .267 while serving as a role player during his first two seasons with the Irish but the junior outfielder has been among the team's most valuable players throughout the '06 season ... his three doubles in the opener vs. UConn led the way each time that the Irish erased leads by the Huskies – including the hit that scored Craig Cooper for a 6-6 game in the 9th.

SHARK NEARLY GOES 6-0 IN BIG EAST – Junior RHP Jeff Samardzija overcame another bumpy start and likely would have improved to 6-0 in BIG EAST action this season, if not for a series of timely UConn hits that included several that snuck through the infield and a key late single off the bat handle ... Samardzija ultimately had no-decision, allowing six runs (five earned) on nine hits, three walks and a hit batter in 7.2 innings ... the two-sport star located 70 of his 11 pitches for strikes while his 23 outs included three strikeouts (two "looking"), 13 groundball outs and two balls that were lined out or popped up to the infield.

Notre Dame's other top-50 draft prospects took the mound in game-2 and Manship (6-1) remained among the top contenders for BIG EAST pitcher of the year, allowing three runs on six hits and just one walk in 7.0 innings. His eight strikeouts marked the seventh time in 10 starts this season that Manship has posted eight-plus Ks, with 64 strikes among his 101 pitches.

TWO-OUT TERRORS – Two-out batting proved to be a key factor in Saturday's doubleheader, as the Irish batters combined to hit 11-for-32 (.344; 7 RBI) with 2-outs while UConn was just 6-for-32 (.188; 4 RBI) when down to its final out of the inning ... Samardzija (2-for-9) and Manship (0-for-7) combined to limit the home team to .125 batting (2-for-16) with 2-outs.

COOPER POSTS FIVE CAREER FIVE-HIT GAME – Cooper hit 5-for-5 with an RBI and three runs scored in the second game vs. UConn, negating his 0-for-3 effort (with a walk and hit-by-pitch) in the opener ... Cooper joins two of his teammates – junior C Sean Gaston (in '04) and the sophomore 3B Brett Lilley (in '05) – among the 31 all-time Notre Dame players who are known to have posted five-plus hits in a game ... Cooper opened game-2 with a single to left on a 1-1 count vs. LHP Rich Sirois ... he then started the 3rd inning with a full-count single to center and picked up his third hit of the game after sending a 2-2 pitch to the right side ... Cooper added another full-count single to start things in the 7th (through the left side) and completed the 5-hit day in the 8th, sending a 1-0 pitch up the middle for a 1-out RBI (vs. RHP Joe Smeraglino).

STILL THE BEST – Craig Cooper entered the weekend with the best career conference batting average in the 22-year history of BIG EAST baseball, with his 5-for-8 day pushing that mark from .445 to .451 (103-for-228).

DURY DOES GOOD – Junior LHP Mike Dury (1-0; 6-0 career) was the pitcher of record in the opener vs. UConn, before picking up his third career save (first of '06) game-2 ... Dury retired all three batters he faced in the doubleheader, including one via strikeout.

SUPER SAVER – Kyle Weiland came on to retire the final two batters in game-1, delivering his 12th save of the season (in 13 chances) ... the 12 saves tie Ryan Doherty's 2004 total for second-most in Notre Dame history, one behind the record-setting 13 saves posted by J.P. Gagne in 2003 (Gagne's father, Greg, was one of numerous ND fans on hand to cheer on the Irish during the doubleheader).

KILLER B's LEAVE THEIR STING – Several ND players whose first or last names begin with B played key roles in the sweep of the Huskies ... Ross Brezovsky hit 4-for-9 in the two games (3 RBI, BB), including the go-ahead single in the 9th inning of the opener that proved to be the winning run (7-6) ... Jeremy Barnes was 2-for-8 (2B, BB) with a pair of RBI in each game ... Matt Bransfield – riding an 8-game hit streak – went 2-for-10 and helped fuel the late surge in game-2 (RBI, R) ... finally, Brett Lilley was 2-for-6 with 2 walks, 3 runs scored and 2 sac. bunts.

BEATING THE BEST – Notre Dame took the doubleheader despite facing pitchers ranked 1st (Tim Norton, 1.20) and 5th (Rich Sirois, 2.79) among the BIG EAST's ERA leaders ... the first nine teams to face Norton this season had totaled just nine runs (eight earned) vs. the UConn ace but the pesky Irish scored six times (five earned) in Norton's 8.1 innings (7 H, 3 BB, 3 HB, 7 Ks), as his ERA climbed to 1.71 ... the Irish scored six runs on 12 hits and a walk in the 6.2 innings logged by Sirois (3 Ks).
