## IUP QUICK LOOK

IUP returns all four of its double-digit average scorers from last season in junior guard Carolyn Appleby, senior forward Megan Smith, redshirt junior guard Lauren Wolosik and junior forward Brittany Robinson. Appleby led the way with her 14.7 ppg on 40.5 percent shooting, while Smith and Wolosik followed right behind with 14.1 ppg and 12.5 ppg , respectively. Both Smith and Wolosik were prolific from three, each shooting over 41 percent last season.

## AT THE HELM

Karen and Kevin Keyes head coach Muffet McGraw embarks on her 31st season at the helm of the lrish (765-227) and 36th overall (853-268) as a head coach. McGraw ranks 10th all-time among NCAA Division I coaches in career wins and sixth among active coaches.

McGraw is also just one of six coaches (men's or
women's basketball) in NCAA Division I history with 800 wins, seven Final Fours and five NCAA title games. The prestigious list includes Pat Summitt, Geno Auriemma, Duke men's coach Mike Krzyzewski, the late North Carolina men's coach Dean Smith and current North Carolina men's coach Roy Williams.

This past fall, McGraw took her rightful place among the game's elite when she was enshrined into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame, becoming the 32nd woman ever to do so.

## THREE'S COMPANY

The Notre Dame bench will slightly be more crowded for the 2017-18 season after torn ACL injuries claimed two members in the year 2017.

Starting last March, the lrish lost three-time All-American Brianna Turner to a torn ACL in the NCAA Championships. Later, in September, in a decision to come back stronger and be able to compete in a full season, Turner chose to redshirt the 2017-18 season.

Next, senior guard Mychal Johnson tore her ACL in practice on 0 ct . 23, just weeks before the start of the 2017-18 season.

## 1,000-POINT MILESTONE WATCH

Notre Dame returns three veteran starters in junior guards Arike Ogunbowale and Marina Mabrey, along with senior forward Kathryn Westbeld. The upcoming 2017-18 season could potentially witness all three joining the 1,000-career point club with Ogunbowale ( 986 pts) and Mabrey ( 916 pts) near certainties. Furthermore, Westbeld sits at 792 career points.

The last time Notre Dame had at least two players reach 1,000 career points in the same season was in 2013 when Kayla McBride and Natalie Achonwa each hit the mark. Seven other Irish teams also saw two players hit the milestone while the record of three was set back in 1985 by Trena Keys, Mary Beth Schueth and Carrie Bates.

## IRISH \#5 IN PRESEASON COACHES POLL

On Oct. 26, USA Today released its preseason top25 coaches poll with the lrish landing in the No. 5 spot with 648 points.

Thursday's poll also solidified the fact that Notre Dame's 2017-18 schedule will undoubtedly rank among the top in the country. Currently, the Irish will challenge a total of 12 schools ranked inside the top- 25 , and a total of 18 different opponents either ranked or receiving votes, including nine in the ACC.

Fellow ACC schools joining Notre Dame inside the top- 25 were No. 10 Louisville, No. 12 Duke, No.
14 Florida State and No. 24 Miami, as the league boasted the second most ranked teams with five (Pac-12 had six).

## K-MACIN THE RING OF HONOR

Come the Nov. 11 season opener, Notre Dame's Ring of Honor will have a new addition in the form of 2014 graduate Kayla McBride, joining the likes of Ruth Riley, Skylar Diggins-Smith, Niele Ivey and Beth (Morgan) Cunningham.

McBride played a pivotal role in one of the most successful four years in Notre Dame history. She helped lead the Irish to four consecutive Final Fours (2011-14), including three title game appearances.

In addition, her senior class recorded the sec-ond-most wins (138) of any other class in history.

A two-time All-American, including a consensus first team choice in 2014, McBride made the most of her four years at Notre Dame to develop into the pro player she is today. Her continued improvement was on full display her senior year when she reeled in the following major accolades: Wade Trophy Finalist, Wooden Award Finalist, WBCA Coaches' All-Region II Team, ACC Player of the Year, All-ACC Tournament First Team, NCAA Regional All-Tournament selection and NCAA Final Four All-Tournament Team honoree.

When all was said and done, McBride ranked first all-time in career free-throw percentage (.882) and sixth in scoring with her 1,876 career points. The Erie, Pennsylvania, native went on to be drafted No. 3 overall by the San Antonio Stars (now Las

Vegas), earning WNBA All-Rookie Team honors in 2014 and was named a WNBA All-Star in 2015.

## IFIT AIN'T BROKE, DON'TEIXIT

On Oct. 19, the ACC Blue Ribbon Panel and head coaches'poll were in agreement - Notre Dame women's basketball returns as the preseason favorite for the 2017-18 season.

For the fourth consecutive year, Notre Dame was recognized as the team to beat in the ACC. The Irish claimed 35 first-place votes and 858 points to claim the top spot. Meanwhile, Louisville (5 firstplace votes, 809 points), Duke ( 10,799 ) and Florida State $(10,752)$ followed in said order.

Since joining the conference for the 2013-14 season, the lrish have posted an impressive 62-2 record in regular season league play.

Last season, the lrish secured their fourth consecutive conference regular season and tournament title sweeps, and if the lrish were to claim their fifth straight in 2018, a new record would be set.

In addition, Notre Dame junior guards Arike Ogunbowale and Marina Mabrey received Preseason All-ACC nods for the first time in their respective careers while senior transfer Lili Thompson was named to the Newcomer Watch List.

Ogunbowale returns after leading the lrish in scoring last season with her 15.9 points per game (ppg). The Milwaukee native started in $36-0 \mathrm{f}-37$ games, where she tallied seven $20+$ scoring performances along with three double-doubles. Ogunbowale finished the year ranked fifth in the ACC in total points (588), 13th in field goal percentage (.449) and 15th in three-point field goals made (64).

Mabrey followed right behind with 14.6 ppg in 37 games played ( 36 started), registering nine games of $20+$ points. The Belmar, New Jersey, native ranked fifth in the league in three-point field goal percentage (.383), 10th in field goal percentage (.471), 11th in three-point field goals made per game (2.0) and 14th in points per game.

## CHANGING OF THE GUARD

Over the past eight years, there was one spot in particular in which Coach McGraw did not have to stress over - the point guard position. All-Americans and now WNBA standouts Skylar Diggins-Smith and Lindsay Allen each provided four years of stability as Coach McGraw's floor general. Now, the lrish turn to fifth-year transfer Lili Thompson along with sharpshooter Marina Mabrey.

After transferring from Stanford, Thompson looks to bring plenty of veteran leadership and experience to this year's squad. A two-time All-Pac-12 selection, Thompson became the 36th Stanford player to reach 1,000 career points during the 2015-16 season after averaging 14.7 ppg on 37.5 percent shooting. The Mansfield, Texas, native ranked fourth in the Pac-12 in free-throw percentage (.777), eighth in three-pointers made per game (2.0), 11th in scoring and 11th in assists (3.6).

## EYES ONTHEIRISH

Fans will have at least six opportunities to catch Notre Dame on ESPN/ESPN2, squaring off with the likes of UConn, Louisville, Tennessee, Florida State, Duke and NC State in the national spotlight.

Up first, Notre Dame renews its rivalry with UConn on Dec. 3 in the Jimmy V Classic on ESPN. The Irish
then return to the flagship station on Jan. 11 at Louisville, then again versus Tennessee at home on Jan. 18.

Meanwhile, three more games appear on ESPN2 this season, including at Florida State on Jan. 28, at Duke on Feb. 4 and Senior Day vs NC State on Feb. 25.

## MUFFET MCGRAW RADIO SHOW

Back by popular demand, the Muffet McGraw Radio Show Presented by TireRack.com returns to 0'Rourke's Public House for at least five showings for the 2017-18 season. Be sure to mark your calendars for the following dates: Nov. 20, Dec. 11, Jan. 22, Feb. 12 and Feb. 26.

The hour-long show will once again be hosted by Bob Nagle, now in his 13th year as the voice for lrish women's basketball.

The show will broadcast live locally on 92.1 Pulse FM and also be available over the internet at WatchND.

Each episode will feature interviews with two current student-athletes, a member of the lrish coaching staff and also a feature on a select former player. Fans will have an opportunity to ask questions of Coach McGraw and her guests along with winning prizes.

## ABSOLUTELY TREY-MENDOUS

The Irish knocked down a school record 217 three-pointers last season, besting the previous top mark of 207 set in the 2015-16 season. Collectively Notre Dame shot .395 from beyond the arc, which ranked as the sixth best in school history.

Marina Mabrey led the charge ranked fifth in the ACC in three-point field goal percentage (.383) and 11th in three-point field goals per game (2.0).

Ultimately, Mabrey's 402 career three-point field goal percentage ranks seventh in ACC history and sixth best at Notre Dame.

## CLUTCH PERFORMERS

Marina Mabrey produced her biggest scoring performances on the biggest stage last season. Of the 10 games in which she scored at least 20 points, nine of those games came either against ACC opponents or during the NCAA Tournament.

Fellow junior Arike Ogunbowale also thrived on the big stage, averaging 22.5 points per game during Notre Dame's NCAA Championship run. The scoring average was top in the nation among players whose team reached at least the Elite Eight.

Ogunbowale dropped a career high 32 points against Ohio State in the Sweet 16, tying for the third-most in a Notre Dame NCAA game. She was later named the Lexington Regional Most Outstanding Player.

## A GLANCE BACK

When the curtain closed on the 2016-17 season, the lrish finished $33-4$ overall, marking the seventh consecutive 30 -win campaign. Notre Dame also continued its dominance within the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC), compiling a 15-1 mark before sweeping the league's regular season and tournament titles for the fourth straight year.

Notre Dame rode a 17-game winning streak into the NCAA's Elite Eight, which stood as the second-longest active winning streak nationally at game-time, behind only UConn.

After making its 22nd straight appearance in the NCAA Championships (fourth-longest streak in the nation), the lrish fell $76-75$ to Stanford in the Elite Eight, missing what would have been its eighth Final Four appearance all-time.

## ANOTHER $30+$ WIN CAMPAIGN

Notre Dame claimed its 30th win of the season when the lrish beat Duke to win the ACC championship on March 5, 2017. It marked the seventh consecutive 30 -win season for Notre Dame and the ninth in school history, joining the 1996-97 and 2000-01 squads.

Nationally, only UConn has a longer active streak of 30 -win seasons at 12 . Baylor matches the lrish with a streak that began in 2010-11.

The 2010-11 team was the last one to win fewer than 30 of its first 33 games and that squad still stood at a solid 26-7 at that late-season juncture.

Last season marked the 11th year in a row and the 23 rd time in the past 24 years in which Notre Dame has won at least 20 games. It also marked the 12th lrish team to win at least 25 games in a season, all coming under Muffet McGraw's tutelage.

The lrish also won at least 10 league games last year. Notre Dame has claimed double-digit league wins in 20 of its 21 years in the BIG EAST and ACC combined, going 8-8 in 2005-06 league play for the lone exception.

## CONSISTENT WINNERS

Notre Dame has been one of the best teams in the nation on an annual basis. In fact, over the past six years, only UConn (220) has won more games than Notre Dame's 209. Baylor has claimed 208, while Stanford (186) and Maryland (183) round out the top-five.

## SHAKE DOWN THE THUNDER

Notre Dame proved to be one of the best shooting teams in the nation last season, ranking fourth in the country in field goal percentage (.395). The pure shooting led to Notre Dame's 11th national rank in scoring offense at 80.1 points per game, which also ranked as the fourth best average in school history.

Furthermore, Notre Dame became the second team to lead the ACC in field goal percentage four years in a row, joining Duke's eight-year run from 1999-2006.

However, the lrish weren't done there, topping the ACC as a team in assists, assists per game, assist-to-turnover ratio, scoring offense, threepoint field goal percentage and fewest turnovers per game.

## PLENTY OF NEW FACES

As each season brings in a new crop of freshmen, the 2017-18 campaign will also witness several more new faces. Joining the duo of freshmen, Danielle Patterson and Mikayla Vaughn, will be fifth-year transfer Lili Thompson (Stanford) and junior transfer Jess Shepard (Nebraska). It marked the first time in program history that Coach McGraw welcomed in transfers to boost the roster. Furthermore, adding to the depth of this year's squad, the team took on two walk-on's in junior Maureen Butler and sophomore Kaitlin Cole.

## HOME COURT ADVANTAGE

When playing at home, Notre Dame enjoyed its typical home court advantage as provided by its incredibly loyal lime green-clad fans, ranking sixth nationally in average attendance $(8,104)$.

Notre Dame was second nationally for operating at
$88.58 \%$ of capacity at 9,149 seat Purcell Pavilion at the Joyce Center, not far behind Gonzaga's $93.63 \%$.

This advantage has played itself out particularly notably in conference play. Notre Dame has won a school-record 42 consecutive home conference games, beginning with a 66-47 win over Providence on Feb. 14, 2012, in BIG EAST play.

Notre Dame is 32-0 at Purcell Pavilion in ACC play, going 8-0 in 2013-14, 2014-15, 2015-16 and 201617. In fact, the lrish have never lost at home to an (active at game time) ACC team in Muffet McGraw's 30 years at the helm. The last time Notre Dame lost at the Joyce Center to a team representing the ACC was a $69-48$ setback against No. 20 Maryland on Jan. 10, 1987.

The lrish outscored foes by an average of 22.5 points per game in 17 home games last season and just 11.6 ppg in 14 road games. Likewise, the lrish saw their rebounding margin shoot up to +9.2 at home from +5.9 on the road and the squad's turnover margin sprang up to a +4.7 at Purcell Pavilion from a +0.6 on opposing home floors.

Last season, Notre Dame picked up four sellout crowds, moving the total to 52 sellouts in history.

## FAST STARTS KEY

Notre Dame was at its best this year when getting off to a fast start to games last year. Out of the four quarters of a game, Notre Dame scored the most points (799) and had the widest scoring margin $(+219)$ in the first quarter of any single stanza.

In 37 games this year, Notre Dame only trailed seven times after 10 minutes of play. Not completely by coincidence, those seven games (UConn, NC State, Duke, Syracuse, Purdue, Ohio State and Stanford) included three of the team's four losses.

## OGUNBOWALE BRINGS HOME MORE GOLD

This past summer, Arike Ogunbowale not only made the U23 USA team roster for the Four Nations Tournament, but also entered the international competition with the most gold already on the squad with four. Ogunbowale then added more to her collection, leading Team USA to a 3-0 sweep over Canada, Australia and host Japan. Ogunbowale spearheaded the victory over Canada, pouring in a team-high 17 points.
