NOTRE DAME AND PURDUE TANGLE IN THE CROSSROADS CLASSIC:

The University of Notre Dame men's basketball team (9–1), ranked 21st in both national polls, faces #15/16 Purdue in the Crossroads Classic at BankersLife Fieldhouse on Saturday, Dec. 17, 2016 (2:00 p.m. ET, ESPN2). The Irish and Boilermakers meet in the first game of the annual doubleheader which will feature Butler and Indiana in the second game. Notre Dame will be appearing in the Crossroads Classic for the sixth time and boasts a 3–2 record in the event.

NOTRE DAME VS. PURDUE SERIES HISTORY:

Notre Dame and Purdue will be meeting for the 43rd time on Saturday afternoon in the Crossroads Classic and the first time that both teams are in the national rankings. The Irish lead the all-time series 22-20, 10-4 at neutral sites and have won the last three most recent meetings (in the 2012, 2014 Crossroads Classic and the 2004 National Invitational Tournament).

Mike Brey and Matt Painter have met twice as head coaches at Notre Dame and Purdue, with both of those meetings also occurring in the Crossroads Classic.

The Notre Dame – Purdue series began in 1916 and the two teams met regularly thorughout the 1930s, 40s, 50s and 60s, including the Hoosier Classic – an in-season tournament that featured Butler, Indiana, Purdue and Notre Dame at Hinkle Fieldhouse. That tournament ended in 1960, but the Crossroads Classic harkens back to that era and will continue through the 2019 season.

IRISH LOOKING TO BOUNCE-BACK AGAIN:

Over the past three seasons, Notre Dame has developed a strength of bouncing back from a loss. Dating back to the end of the 2013-14 season, the Irish have lost back-to-back games just once - a Feb. 27, 2016 loss at Florida State followed by a March 2, 2016 loss at home to Miami.

Those two losses ended a record-matching streak of 67 consecutive games without suffering a back-to-back losses for the Irish, matching the teams from 1924-28 (March 3, 1925 - Dec. 15, 1928) and the 1983-86 teams (Feb. 22, 1984 - Nov. 21, 1986).

THE ULTIMATE WEAPON - GETTING TO THE FREE THROW LINE:

Notre Dame is first in the country (as of Dec. 13) in free throw percentage, shooting 86.4 percent (165-191) from the charity stripe this season. Here are some of the superlatives for the team from its free throw shooting -

· Junior Matt Farell was tied with two other players in the country with a perfect 1.000 shooting percentage from the free throw line (24-24) last week. Without a FT attempt in the Villanova game, Farrell is currently just behind the average attempt per game needed to qualify as the national leader (2.5).

• Dating back to the 2015-16 season, Farrell has connected on 28 consecutive free throws.

Farrell is the first Notre Dame player in the Brey era to begin the season connecting on his first 24 free throw attempts.

· Steve Vasturia is currently third in the nation for free throw shooting percentage at .970 (32-33).

• Vasturia combines with Bonzie Colson (25th, 45-49, .918) to give Notre Dame the only team in the country with two players in the top 35 for free throw shooting.

 Colson's 12-for-12 effort at the free throw line against lowa tied four other ND players with the fourth-best in school history.

 Notre Dame has missed three or less free throws in eight of nine games this season and hit all 14 attempts in the victory over North Carolina A&T and all six attempts against Villanova.

 Over the course of the three games with lowa, North Carolina A&T and Fort Wayne, Notre Dame combined to hit 31 consecutive free throws as a team.

VASTURIA REACHES CAREER MILESTONE:

Senior captain Steve Vasturia entered the Legends Classic final against Northwestern needing 18 points to reach 1,000 points in his career

Not only did Vasturia reach that milestone, he might have played the best all-around game of his career against the Wildcats. The Medford, New Jersey, native grabbed eight rebounds to go along with 18 points, three assists and three steals.

Vasturia is the 59th Notre Dame player to reach the 1,000-point plateau.

USE INK TO PUT VASTURIA IN THE STARTING LINEUP:

Senior guard and team tri-captain Steve Vasturia, who head coach Mike Brey has said keeps him calm on the sidelines while in the lineup, has started 91 consecutive games for the Irish. As a freshman guard, Vasturia's first start came at Maryland on Jan. 15, 2014, but he entered the starting line up permanently on February 16, 2014, playing 30 minutes and scoring seven points in a victory at Boston College. The Philadelphia, Pa., native has not left the Irish starting five since that game.

Vasturia is on pace to become just the fourth Notre Dame player to start 100 consecutive games in a career at Florida State on Jan. 18, 2017.

Pat Connaughton, a former teammate of Vasturia's in 2013-14 and 2014-15, holds the school record for consecutive games started at 139. Chris Thomas (2002-05) started all 128 games of his career at Notre Dame and Pat Garrity (1995-98) was in the starting lineup for all 111 games of his career with the Irish.

VASTURIA ON A ROLL:

Senior captain Steve Vasturia has started the 2016-17 season strong, in similar fashion to his junior season. Entering the game against Purdue, Vasturia is on a seven-game run of double-digit scoring efforts, the second-best stretch of his career dating back to the start of the 2015-16 season when he logged double-digit scoring games in the first nine games of the year.

Farrell's stellar play in the 2016 Legend Classic tournament games at Barclays Center in Brooklyn, New York, earned him the tournament MVP award and his impressive performance against No. 1/1 Villanova on Dec. 10 in the Never Forget Tribute Classic in Newark, New Jersey, proved that the Bridgewater, New Jersey, native loves to compete in front of his hometown fans.

NOTRE DAME REACHES 1800-WIN MILESTONE:

Notre Dame's 84-79 victory at Illinois on Dec. 2, 2015 marked the 1800th win in program history. The Fighting Irish are 1828-985 (.649) all-time in 112 seasons.

Notre Dame ranks seventh in Division I in all-time program wins behind Kentucky, Kansas, North Carolina, Duke, Temple and Syracuse (see top 10 wins list, page three of this notes package). The Irish have improved five spots in the all-time wins list since Mike Brey took over the program for the 2000-01 season, surpassing Indiana, Oregon State, Pennsylvania and St. John's.

Notre Dame is the only NCAA program to rank in the top 10 for men's basketball and football victories.

IRISH CONTINUE TRADITION FOR GREAT SEASON STARTS IN THE BREY ERA:

Notre Dame's 9–0 record to begin the 2016–17 season marked the best start of the Mike Brey era at Notre Dame and continued the tradition of starting off the season in impressive fashion since 2000–01.

In 13 of 17 seasons, the Irish have started the year under Mike Brey with two losses or less in the team's first 10 games. A victory over Purdue on Saturday would give the Irish a 10-1 record over the first 11 games of the season for the sixth time under Brey.

POSTSEASON SUCCESS:

Not only did Notre Dame advance to the NCAA Championship Elite Eight for the second consecutive season for the first time since 1978-79, but the Irish combined for six NCAA tournament wins over the past two seasons - the most in program history over a two-year stretch. The previous high was Notre Dame's three wins in 1978 (the team's lone appearance in the Final Four) and two victories the next season.

The Irish were the only team in the nation to advance to the Elite Eight in both the 2014–15 and 2015–16 seasons and the back-to-back regional final games are a first for the program since the NCAA touranment expanded to 64 or more teams in 1985.

FORMER STANDOUTS RETURN TO THE IRISH BENCH:

For the first time in the Mike Brey era, the Irish head coach was tasked with replacing two assistant coaches in the same season. Long time aides Martin Ingelsby accepted the Delaware head coaching job (the same first-time Division I job Brey assumed in 1995-96) while Anthony Solomon joined the Georgetown coaching staff in the offeseason.

Brey immediately looked to his former players, hiring 2002 Notre Dame graduate and All-American Ryan Humphrey and 2009 stand out shooting guard Ryan Ayers to fill his two coaching vacancies. Three-time team captain Eric Atkins, a 2014 Notre Dame graduate, then came aboard as the video coordinator.

Joining long time director of basketball operations Harold Swanagan (2002 Notre Dame graduate), Brey's staff now features four of his former players on the game day bench.

Notre Dame joined the ACC at the start of the 2013-14 basketball season. The Irish ended up 0-3 in the state of North Carolina that year (65-58 loss at Wake Forest, 63-61 loss at North Carolina, 81-69 loss to Wake Forest in the ACC Tournament in Greensboro).

LEGENDS CLASSIC CHAMPIONS:

Notre Dame claimed its first in-season tournament title since 2010 with a 70-66 victory over Northwestern on Tuesday, Nov. 22, in the championship game of the 2016 Legends Classic at the Barclays Center in Brooklyn, New York.

The four victories for the Irish in the tournament (over Bryant, Seattle, Colorado and Northwestern) mark the most the Irish have ever won in an in-season tournament. The trophy was the first in-season award claimed by the Irish since they won three games in 2010 to claim the Old Spice Classic at Disney's Wide World of Sports. Previous to the 2010 Old Spice victory, Notre Dame's most recent in-season tournament title came at the Hawaii-Pacific Thanksgiving Classic in 2001.

LEGENDS CLASSIC MVP:

Bridgewater, New Jersey, native Matt Farrell enjoyed his return to the Barclays Center, not far from the area where he played during his prep career, for the Legends Classic semifinal and final victories over Colorado and Northwestern, respectively.

Farrell, whose first two career starts came in Notre Dame's two NCAA tournament victories over Michigan and Stephen F. Austin in the Barclays Center during March of 2016, played a career-best game in the semifinal over Colorado, scoring 20 points with six assists and three steals.

He followed up that performance with 18 points and six assists against Northwestern in the championship game, including scoring Notre Dame's final five points in the come-from-behind victory.

With a 19 point-per-game average in the two games at Barclays Center, along with 6.0 assists and 2.0 steals per game, Farrell was the easy choice as the tournament's most valuable player.

BARCLAYS CENTER SUCCESS:

Notre Dame's victory over Northwestern in the 2016 Legends Classic championship game marked the program's fifth-straight victory in the home of the 2017 ACC Championship.

NOTRE DAME HELPS LEAGUE WIN THE ACC/BIG TEN CHALLENGE:

Notre Dame boasts a 3-1 record in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge and avenged its only loss in the event with a 92-78 victory over lowa on Tuesday, Nov. 29.

The Irish hosted the event for just the second time at Purcell Pavilion in the win over the Hawkeyes, with their other two victories coming last season at Illinois, where the Irish spoiled the dedication game of the State Farm Center with a victory over the Illini and in 2014 over #19/18 Michigan State in overtime at home.

The ACC ended up taking the ACC/Big Ten Challenge with a 9-4 record, claiming a victory in the event for the first time since 2008.




