### BY THE NUMBERS: IRISH IN BROOKLYN

<b>1</b>	Notre Dame leads the country in personal fouls per game (13.0) and fewest fouls committed (415).
<b>7</b>	In five ACC tournaments, Notre Dame has compiled a 7-3 record, including appearances in the 2015 (W) and 2017 (L) championship games.
<b>8</b>	Notre Dame is 8-2 all-time at the Barclays Center, which includes a six-game win streak that was snapped in the ACC Championship game last season (see page 4 for more details). The 10 games played by the Irish in the Barclays Center are the most for any ACC team.
<b>11</b>	Earning his 500th career win against Pittsburgh on Tuesday, <b>Mike Brey</b> became the 11th active coach to reach that career milestone coaching at just one or two institutions.
<b>16.7</b>	Points-per-game average in ACC play for All-ACC Third Team selection Matt Farrell. The Bridgewater, New Jersey, native also posted 5.5 assists per game in conference play.
<b>18</b>	Rebounds combined for senior <b>Martinas Geben</b> and sophomore <b>John Mooney</b> in the first game of the ACC tournament against Pittsburgh. Mooney grabbed nine off the bench, while Geben scored four points with his nine rebounds.
<b>22</b>	Notre Dame made 22 free throws in the second half against Pittsburgh, a high for the Irish against an ACC team.
<b>31</b>	Combined games missed due to injury this season by <b>Bonzie Colson</b> (15), <b>Matt Farrell</b> (5) freshman forward <b>D.J. Harvey</b> (11) and junior <b>Rex Pflueger</b> (1).
<b>31.7</b>	Points-per-game average combined for <b>Bonzie Colson</b> (17.8) and <b>Matt Farrell</b> (13.9) at the Barclays Center in seven career games in the facility.
<b>89</b>	Free-throw percentage for <b>T.J. Gibbs</b> in ACC play (75-84), the best in the league for conference-only games.
<b>101</b>	The 2017-18 senior class has set the mark as the all-time winningest four-year class in Notre Dame basketball history and became the first group to win 100 games in four seasons against Pittsburgh on Feb. 28.
<b>148</b>	Career blocked shots for Bonzie Colson, already fifth all-time at Notre Dame as he looks to become the fifth Irish player to block 150 shots in a career.
<b>863</b>	Career rebounds by <b>Bonzie Colson</b> , the 11th Notre Dame player to collect 850 rebounds in a career. He also is just the seventh Irish player to reach the 1,500-point / 850-rebound statistical plateaus.

## IRISH MATCH UP WITH VIRGINIA TECH IN SECOND ROUND OF ACC TOURNAMENT

The University of Notre Dame men's basketball team (19-13, 8-10 ACC) will play its second game in the 2018 ACC Championship against No. 7 Virginia Tech (21-10, 10-8 ACC) at Barclays Center on Wednesday, March 7, 2018 at 7 p.m. ET. The Irish are hoping to boost their post season resume with win over the Hokies, who are firmly in the NCAA tournament field and claim their 20th victory of the season.

## NOTRE DAME - VIRGINIA TECH SERIES HISTORY

Notre Dame and Virginia Tech will be meeting for the 10th time on Wednesday evening and the first time in the ACC tournament. The Irish and Hokie met on Jan. 27, 2018 at Purcell Pavilion. Virginia Tech prevailed 80-75, in a game that the Irish played without Bonzie Colson or Matt Farrell in the line up.

Notre Dame leads the all-time series 7-2.

## WINNINGEST CLASS AT NOTRE DAME

The 2017-18 senior class of Bonzie Colson, Matt Farrell, Martinas Geben, Matt Gregory and graduate student Austin Torres has set the mark as the all-time winningest senior class at Notre Dame.

The 2016-17 senior class of Steve Vasturia, V.J. Beachem and graduate student Patrick Mazza and the the 2012-13 group of Joey Brooks, Mike Broghammer, Jack Cooley and Scott Martin previously held the school record with 97 wins.
