BY THE NUMBERS: IRISH IN BUFFALO

1	Junior Bonzie Colson is the only player in the ACC to finish the season averaging a double-double (17.5 ppg, 10.1 rpg). An All-ACC First Team selection, Colson also is among the final 15 in consideration for the 2017 John R. Wooden Award and the 2017 Karl Malone Trophy (best power forward in the nation).
3	Notre Dame has advanced to the second round of the NCAA tournament in the past three seasons, the first time the Irish have won an NCAA first round game for three consecutive years since Mike Brey's first three seasons at Notre Dame (2001, 2002 and 2003). Notre Dame has never won its first two games in three consecutive NCAA tournament appearances.
5	The Irish are 5-1 in their last six games in the NCAA tournament decided by five points or less (see page 2 for more details).
7	Notre Dame has won seven NCAA tournament games over the past three seasons, matching the school record for the most over a four-year span. See page 2 for more details.
8	Notre Dame is the only school in the country to advance to the Elite Eight in the past two seasons.
9	Notre Dame is ninth all-time in NCAA Tournament appearances with 36 and has a 39-38 (.506) all-time tournament record (see page 5 for a complete history of Notre Dame in the NCAA tournament).
10	Mike Brey and Bob Huggins will be meeting for the 10th time as opposing head coaches on Saturday. Brey leads the all-time series 5-4 (1-0 vs. Huggins at Cincinnati, 4-4 vs. Huggins at West Virginia).
12	The Irish are making their 12th NCAA Tournament appearance in 17 years under head coach Mike Brey .
19	Notre Dame has played in the city of Buffalo, New York 19 times in the history of the program, including Thursday's victory over Princeton. Prior to Thursday the most recent trip occurred in Mike Brey's second year, an 84-73 Irish victory over Canisius at KeyBank Center. Current Notre Dame assistant coach Ryan Humphrey (14 pts, 11 reb) and Director of Basketball Operations Harold Swanagan (15 pts, 5 reb) played in that game.
25	Junior Matt Farrell has connected on at least one three-point field goal in 25 consecutive games, the second-best streak of any ACC player (L. Kennard, Duke, 37 games).
82	Program-record number of victories over the past three seasons for the Irish.
97	Wins over the past four years for the senior class of 2017, matching the school-record. See page for more details.
382	Victories at Notre Dame for head coach Mike Brey , the second-most in Notre Dame history and 11 away from matching the all-time record (393).

IRISH OFF TO BUFFALO FOR THE NCAA TOURNAMENT:

The University of Notre Dame men's basketball team (26-9) looks to advance to the NCAA Sweet 16 when it faces fourth-seed West Virginia (27-8) on Saturday, March 18 at xxx. The Irish advanced to the second round of the NCAA tournament for the third consecutive season with a 60-58 win over #12 Princeton on Thursday. The Mountaineers defeated 13-seed Bucknell 86-80 in the first round.

NOTRE DAME NCAA TOURNAMENT QUICK FACTS:

- Notre Dame is making its 36th NCAA tournament appearance, the ninth-most in the history of the event.
- Notre Dame is 39-38 all-time in the event, including seven victories over the past three seasons.
- Notre Dame is the only team to advance to the NCAA Elite Eight in the past two seasons.
- Since the field expanded to 64 or more teams in 1985, Notre Dame has advanced to the Sweet 16 four times (1987, 2003, 2015 and 2016) and the Elite Eight twice (2015 and 2016).
- Regardless of the number of teams in the field, Notre Dame has advanced to the Sweet 16 15 times (10 times since the field expanded to at least 32 teams).
- Notre Dame has been among the final eight teams in the tournament, regardless of the number of teams in the field, eight times (five times since the field expanded to at least 32 teams).
- Notre Dame has reached the Final Four one time (1978).

NCAA POSTSEASON SUCCESS:

Not only did Notre Dame advance to the NCAA Championship Elite Eight for the second consecutive season in 2015-16, but the Irish victory on Thursday over Princeton was the seventh NCAA tournament wins over the past three years - matching the The Irish were the only team in the nation to advance to the Elite Eight in both the 2014-15 and 2015-16 seasons and the back-to-back regional final games are a first for the program since the NCAA tournament expanded to 64 or more teams in 1985.

NCAA WINS RECORD IN SIGHT:

The senior class of V.J. Beachem and Steve Vasturia, along with graduate student walk on Patrick Mazza, who could become the winningest graduating class in school history, could also claim their place as the winningest class in terms of NCAA victories.

Notre Dame has matched the senior class of 1979 with seven NCAA tournament wins over the past four years. A victory on Saturday and the current Irish seniors will hold the school record for most NCAA wins during their time on campus.

NOTRE DAME - WEST VIRGINIA SERIES HISTORY:

Notre Dame and West Virginia will be meeting for the 40th time on Saturday. The Irish lead the all-time series 27-12, 16-3 at home and 9-7 on the road. The series is even at 2-2 at neutral sites and Notre Dame led the series 17-6 when both teams were a member of the Big East Conference.

West Virginia head coach Bob Huggins was 1-1 against the Irish as a player at WVU, falling 97-77 at Notre Dame in 1976 and claiming a home court victory 81-68 in 1977.

Overall, Notre Dame head coach Mike Brey is 5-4 against Bob Huggins, 4-4 while Huggins has been at WVU and 1-0 at Cincinnati (69-51 in the 2000 Wooden Tradition at BankersLife Fieldhouse in Indianapolis, Indiana).

IRISH EXTEND THREE-YEAR WIN MARK RECORD:

Notre Dame's two victories on the run to the ACC Championship game, pushed the program's win record over the past three seasons to 81. The Irish already posted the best two-year stretch of victories last season, winning 56 combined games in 2014-15 and 2015-16.

SIX-FOOT-FIVE WITH A SEVEN-FOOT WING SPAN:

Junior forward Bonzie Colson has been labeled as 'under-sized,' due to his listed 6-5 height measurement. The New Bedford, Massachusetts, native does boast a 7-2 wing span, however, which helps the Irish captain lead the ACC in rebounding at 10.2 per game.

Should Colson continue to lead the league in rebounding, he will become the shortest ACC player to lead the league in rebounding since South Carolina's Grady Wallace grabbed 14.4 rebounds per game in 1957 - a span of 60 years.

Since 1958 (Pete Brennan, North Carolina) Colson would be the only player under 6-7 to lead the ACC in rebounding.

Notre Dame has made at least one three-pointer in 616 straight contests dating back to the 1998-99 campaign. The Fighting Irish have made at least one three pointer during every game of the Mike Brey era. The last time an Irish team failed to hit a three-pointer in a game was in a 101-70 loss to Connecticut at the Hartford Civic Center on Jan. 12, 1999. Notre Dame finished 0-7 from beyond the arc in that contest.

COLSON A FINALIST FOR THE 2017 KARL MALONE TROPHY:

Junior forward Bonzie Colson has been named one of five finalists for the 2017 Karl Malone Trophy, presented to the nation's best power forward by the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame.

Colson joins Arizona's Lauri Markkanen, Baylor's Johnathan Motley, Purdue's Caleb Swanigan and UCLA's T.J. Leaf in the running for the award.

Among those finalists, Colson separates himself as the only player averaging over 15.0 ppg, 10.0 rpg, 1.0 bpg and 1.0 spg.

COLSON WOODEN AWARD FINAL 15 SELECTION:

Junior forward Bonzie Colson has been named to the Final 15 list for the 2017 John R. Wooden Award and will be in contention for the Wooden All-America team and the national player of the year trophy.

Colson, who leads the Atlantic Coast Conference in rebounds per game (10.1) and double-doubles (19) while leading the Fighting Irish in scoring (17.5 points-per-game) and he is the only player shooting .500 from the field, .800 from the free throw line and averaging over 10.0 rebounds per game. He also is the only candidate with over 40 blocked shots (49).

Colson has helped the Irish post their best start (9-0), conference start (5-0) and ACC winning streak (six games) of the Mike Brey era so far this season. He also has been named one of five finalists for the 2017 Karl Malone Award for the nation's top power forward and was on the Naismith Award's Top 30 as of February 9.

Players on the final ballot have proven to their universities that they are also making progress toward graduation and are maintaining at least a cumulative 2.0 GPA. Voting begins at the end of the season, and voters, consisting of nearly 1,000 members of the national college basketball media, will take into account the opening rounds of the NCAA Tournament.

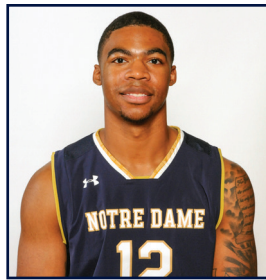
