The Marquette University men's basketball team (13-6, 4-2 BIG EAST) hits the road this weekend when the squad travels to No. 16/16 Notre Dame on Saturday. The BIG EAST Network will feature the 6 p.m. CT broadcast, with Jim Barbar (play-by-play) and Anthony Buford (analyst) calling the action.

## Strength Of Schedule Receiving Big Boost

The Golden Eagles are currently in the midst of the most difficult stretch of their 2010-11 campaign.

Dating back to the team's Jan. 8 outing at Pittsburgh, MU's schedule features seven matchups against nationally ranked opponents in a span of just eight games. That run (Jan. 8-Feb.2) includes five outings versus top-10 squads and a total of four contests on the road against top-25 opponents.

The Golden Eagles are 1-2 thus far versus those ranked squads, having fallen at No. 5/5 Pittsburgh and No. 18/17 Louisville and defeating No. 9/11 Notre Dame 79-57 on Jan. 10. MU is 100-152 all-time versus nationally ranked squads and 8-19 under third-year head coach Buzz Williams.

Based on the most recent Jan. 10 polls, 10 of Marquette's 16 league games will feature a top-25 squad. A total of just four will come in the friendly confines of the Bradley Center.

Of the 16 teams in the BIG EAST, only Connecticut will go longer into the conference campaign before playing back-to-back league games at home. MU hosts Syracuse on Jan. 29 to wrap up a two-game homestand and the Huskies will welcome Louisville on Feb. 2.

## Marquette-Notre Dame Series Spans Program's Duration

Saturday night's matchup with No. 16/16 Notre Dame will mark the 115th meeting between the two teams in a series that dates back to the 1919-20 campaign.

Marquette claimed the first meeting, earning a 23-22 road victory in the program's third season of competition. MU will face the Fighting Irish as a nationally ranked opponent for the 19th time on Saturday, with the Golden Eagles owning an 9-9 record in those contests. MU has claimed six of the nine meetings since the team joined the BIG EAST in 2005-06.

Rival Wisconsin is the only opponent Marquette has faced on more occasions (117) than Notre Dame.

## DePaul Victory Provides Rare Winning Margin

While Marquette and DePaul have met 110 times in the series history, Tuesday's 94-64 win by the Golden Eagles marked a first-ever accomplishment by either squad.

MU's 30-point margin of victory is the largest spread by either program in a series that dates back to 1918. The previous top spread was 29 points on Feb. 6, 1971 when MU was able to collect an 84-55 decision at DePaul. That game occurred during a time frame in the series where Marquette posted 19-straight wins over the Blue Demons.

Marquette defeated Cincinnati by 34 points (84-50) on Jan. 4, 2009 to record the largest margin in BIG EAST competition to date. MU has also downed both Providence (93-63, Jan. 17, 2010) and Rutgers (78-48, Feb. 23, 2008) by 30 points in league action.

## Butler Set To Deliver Milestone Accomplishment

In just his third year at Marquette, senior forward Jimmy Butler is set to add his name to an elite list of fellow Marquette players on the school's 1,000-point club.

The Tomball, Texas, native is currently just 13 points short of becoming the 42nd player in school history to score at least 1,000 points during his career. He owns a career scoring average of 11.2 points per game and has improved his production with each passing campaign.

Butler is also on pace to surpass the 500-rebound mark and is currently in possession of 479 career boards. Should he maintain his current season average of 15.4 points per outing, Butler has a chance to finish among the school's top-30 all-time leading scorers. He will also become just the 19th player at MU to finish with 1,000 points and 500 rebounds.

## Crowder Rebounds With Impressive Effort

One game after finishing with just eight points (4-of-11 from the field) and five rebounds in 27 minutes of action in the loss at Louisville, junior forward Jae Crowder responded with arguably his best game as a Golden Eagle.

In 32 minutes of action against DePaul, Crowder was literally all over the court. He finished the game with 18 points on 7-of-13 shooting from the floor and also chipped in nine rebounds, six assists, three blocks and a steal. Six of his boards came at the offensive end and he did not commit a turnover on the night.

One of the league's top newcomers, Crowder is ranked among the league leaders in five different categories (scoring, rebounding, field goal percentage, 3-point field goal percentage and offensive rebounds per game).

## Cadougan Settling In With Start Of League Play

Sophomore guard Junior Cadougan, who missed all but 12 games in 2009-10 with an achilles injury, has seen his role increase since the start of BIG EAST play.

In an average of 19.2 minutes per game through the first six BIG EAST outings in 2010-11, Cadougan has collected an impressive assist-to-turnover ratio (3.33) and is tied with DePaul's Jeremiah Kelly for the top spot in that category among BIG EAST performers in league outings. He owns a team-best assist total (20) and has turned it over on just six occasions. Cadougan has posted career-best marks in a total of seven different categories since the conference lidlifter on Jan. 1.

## Buycks Making Early Bid For Most Improved Player

Senior guard Dwight Buycks is playing the best basketball of his short tenure at Marquette.

A junior college transfer who made his MU debut in 2009-10, Buycks concluded the year averaging 6.3 points, 3.0 rebounds and 2.1 assists while shooting 41.8 percent from the field and 27.3 percent from behind the 3-point line.

It's been a different story in 2010-11. The Milwaukee, Wis., native is currently chipping in 10.8 points, 3.6 rebounds and 4.1 assists per contest and has raised his shooting percentage to 52.9 percent from the floor overall and 44.2 percent from long distance.

Buycks' shooting touch has really caught fire in BIG EAST play. In the first six games, he is knocking down 57.4 percent (27-of-47) from the field and 12-of-20 (60.0 percent) from behind the line. He has started each of the six outings and is averaging just 28.0 minutes per contest.

## MU Racks Up Long-Distance Charges In Notre Dame Win

Junior guard Darius Johnson-Odom drained a 3-pointer from the left wing to open the team's scoring in the 79-57 victory over Notre Dame, beginning a trend that would continue through the entire night.

Marquette finished 12-of-17 (70.6 percent) from behind the line, marking a season high in 3-pointers made. The previous best total (9) came Jan. 5 at Rutgers. MU's single-game record of 80.0 percent (12-of-15) came Jan. 27, 2001 against Tulane.

A trio of MU players accounted for all of Marquette's baskets from behind the line. Johnson-Odom knocked down three, junior Jae Crowder added four and senior Dwight Buycks connected on all five of his attempts from distance. The Golden Eagles outscored the Fighting Irish 36-9 from 3-point land.

## Johnson-Odom Picks Up Scoring In League Play

Struggling with his perimeter shot for a majority of the non-conference campaign, junior Darius Johnson-Odom has picked up his offensive production in recent weeks.

That trend has magnified itself through the first six BIG EAST games this season. The Raleigh, N.C., native is averaging a team-best 19.8 points per game in the last six outings. He is shooting 46.3 percent (38-of-82) from the field and 44.7 percent (17-of-38) from behind the 3-point line. He has also found time to chip in 3.3 assists and 3.2 rebounds in an average of 33.0 minutes per contest.

Through games of Jan. 20, Johnson-Odom ranks fourth in scoring in league games and is fifth in 3-pointers made per game (2.83).

Johnson-Odom scored 20-or-more points in each of the team's first three conference games (vs. West Virginia, at Rutgers and at Pittsburgh). Tony Smith was the last Marquette player to accomplish that feat, reaching the 20-point plateau in a trio of outings (Loyola, Xavier and Dayton) in 1989-90. That season marked the first for MU with a conference affiliation, with the team participating in the Midwestern Collegiate Conference.

## MU Protects The Ball At Pittsburgh

Against one of the better defensive units in the BIG EAST, Marquette was forced into just a pair of turnovers at Pittsburgh on Jan. 8.

The first miscue didn't occur until almost midway through the second half. Thanks to 16 assists on 27 baskets, the squad's assist-to-turnover ratio (1.45) is now 11th in the nation and fourth in the league.

The two miscues marked the lowest single-game total since turning it over on just three occasions in a 70-68 victory at Connecticut in 2009-10. Prior to the UConn contest, the last time MU finished with less than three turnovers (1 total) came in a 90-70 win over Butler on March 3, 1990. Former MU standout Tony Smith had 43 points in that contest.

## MU Follows Crowder's Lead In Win Over WVU

A 5 a.m. wakeup call on New Year's Day didn't keep junior forward Jae Crowder from making an impressive league debut in Marquette's victory over West Virginia in the BIG EAST opener.

Crowder, the 2009-10 junior college player of the year at Howard College, netted a career-high 29 points on 12-of-14 shooting to lead all scorers. In 39 minutes of action, he also found time to chip in eight rebounds, five assists, four steals and a block. His final steal led to an intentional foul by WVU and sealed the MU win in the closing seconds.

## Balanced Scoring Leading Offensive Attack

Marquette ranks seventh in the nation (through games of Jan. 20) in field goal percentage (.492) and 15th in scoring (80.8 ppg.) thanks in large part to a well-balanced offensive attack.

The Jan. 18 outing versus DePaul marked the fourth time this season Marquette has had five players finish with double figures in points, and in 10 of the squad's 19 contests at least four players have reached the 10-point plateau. A season-best six scorers netted 10-or-more points in the win over Green Bay.

Senior Jimmy Butler has reached double figures in all but one game (Longwood) in 2010-11 and has been joined on at least one occasion by Vander Blue, Dwight Buycks, Jae Crowder, Davante Gardner, Darius Johnson-Odom, Jamail Jones, Chris Otule and Erik Williams.

## Free Throw Line Continues To Provide Advantage

The ability to consistently get to the free throw line, as well as convert on those opportunities, has been a team focus since third-year head coach Buzz Williams took over prior to the 2008-09 campaign.

The focus has been evident early in 2010-11, where once again the Golden Eagles have made more free throws (339) than their opponents have even attempted (288). As a result, MU is outscoring its opponents by an average of over eight points per game (17.8-9.4) from the line.

In 2008-09, the Golden Eagles knocked down 668 free throws, while opponents attempted just a total of 600 in 35 outings. Last season, Marquette made a total of 489 charity tosses and enemy shooters attempted 542 as a group, but MU was able to average almost four more points per outing at the free throw line.

Since the start of the 2008-09 season, Marquette is 1,496-of-2,068 (72.3 percent) from the free throw line and opponents are 951-of-1,430 (66.5 percent).

## Offense Produces Impressive Halftime Total

The Golden Eagles shot 57.1 percent (20-of-35) from the field in the first half against Mississippi Valley State, finishing the opening 20 minutes with 56 points.

The squad's point total marked the highest in any half since the team netted 57 points in the second half at Villanova on Jan. 9, 2010. The Dec. 21 effort was the best first-half score since Marquette collected 54 points prior to halftime against Eastern Illinois on Nov. 26, 2002 in a 97-74 victory.

## Is Key To Victory Field Goal Percentage?

Head coach Buzz Williams has stressed defense since he took over the reigns of the program and that focus, along with offensive efficiency, has played a key role in the team's success during his tenure.

Dating back to the start of 2008-09, the Golden Eagles are 44-3 when finishing the game with a field goal percentage even-or-better than their opponents. That includes an 13-2 mark thus far in 2010-11 and a 14-1 record in 2009-10. The only losses came March 6, 2010 versus Notre Dame, Dec. 11, 2010 against Wisconsin and Dec. 29 at Vanderbilt.

Since 2008-09, MU has finished 50 percent-or-better from the field on 31 occasions and owns a 28-3 record (at Villanova in 2008-09, vs. Washington in 2009-10, at Vanderbilt in 2010-11) in those outings.

## Golden Eagles Use 24-0 Run To Rally Past Bison

Trailing 57-45 with 10:22 remaining in the second half against Bucknell, the Golden Eagles put together an impressive 24-0 run to take control of the game.

A layup by junior forward Jae Crowder got things started for MU, which didn't allow the Bison to add to their game total until netting a free throw with 1:41 left in regulation and the Golden Eagles up 12 points.

## Singleton and Wilson To Sit & Watch In 2010-11

Transfers Dave Singleton and Jamil Wilson will redshirt in 2010-11 after transferring from High Point and Oregon, respectively.

Singleton, who will have two seasons of eligibility beginning in 2011-12, was a two-year letterwinner at HPU and appeared in 60 career games. He averaged 5.2 points, 3.4 rebounds and 2.1 assists per game under head coach Bart Lundy, who is now the director of operations at MU.

Wilson, a native of Racine, Wis., appeared in 26 games as a freshman with the Ducks and earned 14 starting assignments. He averaged 4.7 points and 3.2 rebounds per game, helping Oregon to a 16-win campaign.

## Anderson, Wilson Latest To Join MU Family

Marquette head coach Buzz Williams announced the signing of a pair of prep stand-outs in Juan Anderson (Castro Valley, Calif./Castro Valley HS) and Derrick Wilson (Anchorage, Alaska/The Hotchkiss School) for the 2011-12 campaign.

As a junior at Castro Valley High School under head coach Nick Jones, Anderson averaged 14.0 points, 8.0 rebounds and 2.9 assists per game. He helped the Trojans to a 23-7 overall record and was named honorable mention all-metro. Anderson served as team co-captain and the squad made its first-ever appearance in the state playoffs. He was also a unanimous first-team all-conference selection.

Anderson, who was recently named to the 15-member Long Beach Press-Telegram's 32nd Annual Best in the West squad, is rated 69th in the country by Rivals.com among all 2011 recruits.

Wilson averaged 23.0 points, 8.0 assists, 8.0 rebounds and 5.0 steals per game as a junior at The Hotchkiss School in Lakeville, Conn., under head coach Fred Benjamin. He was named first team all-league in 2009-10 for the third time in his career and claimed player of the year accolades in the tri-state area for the second-straight season.

As a sophomore, Wilson chipped in 19.0 points, 10.0 rebounds and 6.0 assists per outing and helped lead the team to the semifinals of the tri-state tournament. He was tabbed to the tri-state first team squad and claimed a pair of most valuable player honors during regular season tourney action.

## Golden Eagles Claim 10th BIG EAST Win, Again

MU claimed the team's 10th league victory of 2009-10 with an 84-83 decision over Seton Hall on Feb. 28, reaching the 10-win mark for the fifth-straight year.

Of the 16 teams in the BIG EAST since 2005-06, only MU and Pittsburgh have captured at least 10 victories in each of the the last five campaigns.

Marquette finished with 12 league victories in 2008-09, which marked the highest total since the program joined the BIG EAST.

**Character Revealed.**

Those two words have served as the foundation of the Marquette University men's basketball team under third-year head coach Buzz Williams ever since he was officially

named program mentor on April 8, 2008.

The 2009-10 Golden Eagles were a perfect illustration of Williams' core system of values, working hard on a daily basis to ensure the team's accomplishments on the court and in the classroom would bring a sense of pride to all of the University's supporters.

The team's character was tested from start to finish, beginning with low preseason expectations from the

national pundits and concluding with a heartbreaking post-season loss. No team in the nation played in more one-possession games than MU, but that didn't stop

the squad from collecting the program's fifth-straight NCAA Championship appearance and 20-win season. Marquette finished 22-12 overall, including an 11-7 mark in the BIG EAST Conference, which was good enough for fifth-place in the 16-team league.

Lazar Hayward (Second Team All-BIG EAST) finished second all-time in scoring at MU and four of the program's top-10 all-time scorers have now graduated within the past two seasons. Junior forward Jimmy Butler was one of the most improved players in the country and as a result was tabbed honorable mention all-league.

Williams directed MU to a 25-10 overall record in 2008-09, which included a school-record 12 BIG EAST victories. The Golden Eagles advanced to the second round of the NCAA Championship and were ranked among the nation's top-25 teams the entire campaign. A pair of players, Jerel McNeal and Wesley Matthews, claimed all-league accolades and McNeal also claimed All-America honors.

Off the court, Williams and his staff assembled a consensus top-25 recruiting class in each of the last two years, including a group rated as high as No. 1 in the country by HoopScoopOnline.com (2008-09). The program's community service efforts have also reached new heights under Williams, highlighted by "Buzz's Bunch." This group, founded by Williams, focuses on providing opportunities for special needs children to attend games and summer camps. The Golden Eagles have also continued and strengthened their long-standing relationships with Children's Hospital as well as Special Olympics.

In 2007-08, Williams served as an assistant coach with the Golden Eagles in his first season at Marquette. MU concluded the year 25-10 and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2003.

His coaching career has included stints as an assistant, associate head and head coach. He has over 15 years of experience at the NCAA Division I level. Williams has recruited and coached over 20 players who have earned all-conference accolades, including one league player of the year, two conference freshmen of the year and two Associated Press All-Americans

(McNeal and Hayward).

Williams arrived in Milwaukee after serving for one season as the head coach at the University of New Orleans. He guided the Privateers to a 14-win campaign in 2006-07 and his roster featured Bo McCalebb, the Sun Belt Conference Player of the Year. UNO claimed fourth place in the Sun Belt's Western Division and advanced to the league tournament quarterfinals. The squad claimed as many victories on the road that season as it had in the previous three seasons combined. His recruiting class for the 2007-08 season was ranked in the top 50 nationally by HoopScoopOnline.com.

Prior to UNO, Williams served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Texas A&M for two seasons (2004-05/2005-06) under head coach Billy Gillispie. Both of his recruiting classes with the Aggies were ranked among the best in the nation and featured some of the top-ranked talent at the prep level. The squad made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 25 years in 2005-06 and the previous team posted the top turnaround in the nation, improving its win total in 2004-05 by 14 games compared to 2003-04.

Williams spent four seasons (2000-01/2003-04) at Colorado State, serving as an assistant the first three seasons before being promoted to associate head coach in 2003-04. Two of his recruiting classes were ranked among the 40-best in the nation, including the 2003 group, which was tabbed No. 1 in the Mountain West Conference.

Colorado State made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 13 years during his tenure and he was named one of the top assistants in the country by HoopScoopOnline.com. Williams was previously an assistant at Northwestern State (1999-2000), Texas A&M-Kingsville (1998-99) and Texas-Arlington (1994-98).

Williams signed the highest-rated recruiting class in the history of the Southland Conference while at Northwestern State. The Demons advanced to their first ever NCAA tourney the following season and two of his recruited players were named all-conference, while one was tabbed Southland Conference Tournament MVP.

His accomplishments at Texas A&M-Kingsville include signing the 1998-99 Lone Star Conference Freshman of the Year and a third team All-America guard. At Texas-Arlington, Williams recruited a Southland Conference Freshman of the Year and signed the first Academic All-American in the school's history. Williams

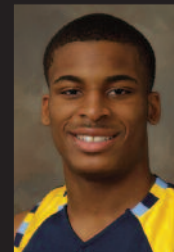

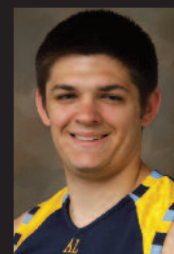
