MARQUETTE CLOSES NON-CONFERENCE PLAY AT NO. 2 NOTRE DAME

The Marquette University women's basketball team will travel to No. 2 Notre Dame on Wednesday, Dec. 20 for a 2 p.m. Central time tipoff, which will close out the non-conference slate.

The Golden Eagles (6-4) most recently took down cross-city foe Milwaukee, 83-68, on Sunday evening. Junior Allazia Blockton led four Marquette players in double digit scoring with a season-best 29 points. Natisha Hiedeman tallied 15 points, bringing her within seven points of the 1,000career-points plateau, while Erika Davenport and Amani Wilborn also chipped in 14 apiece. Blockton earned BIG EAST Player of the Week honors for her stellar performance.

MU boasts five players that average double digits led by 18.2 from Blockton with all five in the top-30 in scoring in the BIG EAST Conference. Hiedeman averages 15.3 points and ranks eighth, while Danielle King checks in at 11.6 points per game and is 23rd. Davenport is 26th (11.5 ppg) and Wilborn

is 30th (10.9).

The Fighting Irish (10-1) boast a 3-0 home record and most recently edged BIG EAST opponent DePaul, 91-82, in South Bend on Sunday evening. Notre Dame's lone loss came against No. 1-ranked UConn to culminate a seven-game road stint. The team is led by junior Arike Ogunbowale, a Milwaukee native averaging 20.7 points per game. Like Hiedeman, Ogunbowale is nearing 1,000 career points at 986.

Marquette's first home win in program history came against Notre Dame over 40 years ago. Nearly 10 years ago, MU edged the Fighting Irish, 75-65, for their first win over a top-10 team (Jan. 13, 2009). Notre Dame owns the series history 32-8.

Following the storied matchup, the Golden Eagles will open BIG EAST play hosting St. John's on Thursday, Dec. 28 at 7:30 p.m. CT at the Al McGuire Center.

Last Time Out

A slower first half paved way to an explosive second, as the Marquette women's basket-ball team toppled crosstown foe Milwaukee, 83-68 on Sunday evening at the Klotsche Center.

Junior Allazia Blockton led four Marquette (6-4) players in double digits with a season-best 29 points, while classmate Natisha Hiedeman connected for 15 points and is now just seven points away from reaching 1,000 career points. Erika Davenport and Amani Wilborn each tallied 14 points.

The Golden Eagles played tough defense, forcing Milwaukee (8-3) into 31 turnovers and held leading scorer Steph Kostowicz to just 10 points. MU also snapped an eightgame win-streak by the Panthers and extended the all-time series record to 20-3.

Quotable

Coach Kieger after the victory at Milwaukee: "The biggest thing that I am most excited about was our defensive energy," head coach Carolyn Kieger said. "We came in with a goal to force 30 turnovers and we forced 31 tonight, so we are really happy about that. We knew going into the game that we wanted to pressure and do full-court defense and our team really bought into that in the second half. I was really excited about our ball screen defense as well. We were trapping that and I think our team did a phenomenal job being disciplined in the traps and rotating out, so that was the number one thing we wanted to accomplish tonight and I think we did a great job of that."

"Allazia Blockton had a fantastic game with 29 points, but a lot of it was that she was making the right read and making smart attacks and paying attention to the game plan, so it really was a great night for her," Kieger said. "I give a lot of credit to her teammates for giving her the ball. Amani Wilborn had great adjustments in the second half and stepped up to knock down some open shots. A player that might not show up on the stats sheet was Selena Lott. She had 10 deflections for us tonight, which is phenomenal for a freshman to go in and get her hands on that many balls."

Series History

Notre Dame leads the all-time series 32-8, incuding four-in-a-row. The two teams have not met since Feb. 17, 2013 when the squads were both members of the BIG EAST and the Fighting Irish topped Marquette 87-49.

The Golden Eagles last defeated the Irish, 75-65 on Jan. 13, 2009.

Blockton is BIG EAST Player of the Week

Blockton was the BIG EAST's top scorer last week as she tallied a season-high 29 points at Milwaukee on Sunday. The Milwaukee native made 12-of-17 attempts from the floor for a 71-percent success rate, including 2-of-4 from beyond the arc, while adding four rebounds.

Marquette in the NCAA

The Golden Eagles rank in the top-25 nationally in three statistical categories. MU is averaging 83.3 points per contest, ranking 25th and is also 25th in field goal percentage, shooting at a 46.4 percent clip. The Golden Eagles are also swiping 11.7 steals per game, which is 24th in NCAA Division I.

Approaching 1,000

Natisha Hiedeman and Erika Davenport are the next MU players on pace to reach 1,000 career points. Hiedeman currently sits at 993 heading into the game at Notre Dame, while Davenport is at 899. The duo will become the Golden Eagles' 26th and 27th 1,000-point scorers, respectively.

Conference Leaders

The Golden Eagles have five players in the top-30 of BIG EAST scoring leaders. Hiedeman averages 15.3 points and ranks eighth, while Danielle King checks in at 11.6 points per game and is 23rd. Davenport is 26th (11.5 ppg) and Wilborn is 30th (10.9).

DePaul is the only other school with five players in the top-30.

Marquette Battles In-State Rivals

Marquette played three in-state schools during the non-conference portion of the schedule and walked away with a 2-1 record. The Golden Eagles earned wins over Wisconsin and Milwaukee, while falling on the road at Green Bay.

Double-Doubles

A pair of Golden Eagles have already notched double-doubles on the young season. Erika Davenport has already recorded two in the first five games and Allazia Blockton recorded her second at Michigan on Dec. 7.

Golden Eagles Set New Vicory Margin

The women's basketball team rolled past Loyola Chicago 92-30 on Nov. 28. The 62-point win on Tuesday marked a program record for largest margin of victory as the Golden Eagles surpassed the previous record of 56 points in a victory over Ball State, 97-41, back on Dec. 21, 1993.

Double-Digit Dominance

Marquette's offense has been evenly distributed this season, with seven games seeing at least four players record double figures. At Green Bay, against Wisconsin and at Michigan, MU had three players record double figures.

The Golden Eagles have also had four games that five players have entered double-digit scoring. Marquette accomplished this feat versus New Mexico, Loyola Maryland, Tennessee and most recently in a 30-point victory over Army on Dec. 10.

Home Sweet Home

Marquette has won 10 straight games at the Al McGuire Center dating back to last season. The Golden Eagles last fell in an 82-72 decision to St. John's on Feb. 5, 2017.

Twice the 20

The Golden Eagle's shooting ability can also be displayed through the multiple games of two players reaching 20+points. Lauren Van Kleunen (23) and Allazia Blockton (20) both posted 20-ormore points during the season lidlifter versus New Mexico. Van Kleunen's 23-point performance showed the promise of Marquette's young talent, as this was her first game in representing the Golden Eagles. Blockton (28) and Natisha Hiedeman (23) reached the mark against No. 12 Tennessee.

NCAA Career Leaders

With 17.9 points per game in her career

average, Allazia Blockton ranks ninth in the NCAA among active leaders, while Erika Davenport is 19th in Division I, averaging 57.2 percent shooting from the field.

Blockton's Numbers

In just her junior season, Allazia Blockton is already the BIG EAST's career active leading scorer with 1,308 points, which ties for 13th all-time in Marquette history.

Kieger's Leadership

In women's basketball history head coach Carolyn Kieger is the 36th to coach and play for a ranked team, and the 11th to do this at her alma mater.

Three-Point Success

In the Carolyn Kieger era of Marquette women's basketball, the Golden Eagles have had success from beyond-the-arc, hitting a three-point basket in 86 consecutive games since going 0-for-6 at Villanova on Jan. 4, 2015. MU has sank a season-best 13 treys on two occasions this season, in the opener at New Mexico and against Montana in the Cancun Challenge.

80-point Threshold

Marquette has scored 80-or more points in eight-of-10 games this season and has dropped just two games while reaching 80+ points.

MU Will Be Challenged in Non-Conference Play

After setting a 9-2 mark in last season's non-conference slate, Marquette will face a tough schedule this season, with match-ups against three teams ranked in the preseason poll and all but four games on the road. The Golden Eagles face an early test in the Cancun Challenge, where they will take on No. 14/18 Tennessee in only the third game of the season. From there, Marquette will have a three-game stint in Wisconsin before heading back on the road to play last year's NIT Champions and No. 23/24 Michigan. Marquette wraps up non-conference play in one of the biggest games of its season when the team travels to South Bend to battle No.5/6 Notre

Dame.

Last season's non-conference record was the best for the team since 2013-14 when the Golden Eagles also started the year 9-2.

Golden Eagles Honored by BIG EAST

After last season's strong showings, three Golden Eagles earned preseason recognition from the BIG EAST. Junior guard Allazia Blockton is unanimous conference player of the year after making first team all-conference last season. Davenport and Hiedeman join their classmate on the awards list, as both made the All-BIG EAST Preseason team, highlighted by Davenport's unanimous selection.

Marquette Adds Tori McCoy

The Golden Eagles added sophomore forward Tori McCoy from Ohio State during the offseason. The talented Illinois native will sit out the 2017-18 season due to NCAA transfer rules. McCoy averaged 8.1 points and 5.9 rebounds per game in her sole year as a Buckeye and led the team with 59 blocks. She was a member of the Big Ten All-Freshman team and was a consensus top-10 player out of high school while being named a McDonald's All-American.

Chloe Marotta Inks with MU

Carolyn Kieger and Marquette earned a commitment from Chloe Marotta as a member of the 2018 class. Marotta hails from Mequon, Wisconsin where she is a two-time first team all-conference selection and was named the No. 1 player in Wisconsin for 2018 by WisSports. At Homestead High School Marotta reached her 1,000th point as a junior, was Co-Player of the Year in the North Conference and earned First Team all-state accolades. She ranks No. 14 at her position and ESPNHoopGurlz listed her as one of 100 players to watch.

Marotta has Marquette ties, as her brother Cam is a member of the men's basketball team and her father Marc also played for the men's team in his time at Marquette. She will join the Golden Eagles in the summer of 2018.

Cleaning the Glass

Led by Erika Davenport's 9.2 boards a game, the Golden Eagles topped the BIG EAST with a +5.2 rebounding margin last season. Marquette also was second in the conference with a 34.8 rebounding defense and 40.1 rebounding offense.

Protect the Ball

The Golden Eagles averaged 13.2 turnovers per game last season (12th in the NCAA) and notched a conference-high 1.4 assist to turnover ratio (ninth in the nation).

The Century Mark

Marquette reached 100 points in three games last season and owns a 3-0 record when this outburst occurs. MU topped St. Francis in the second game of the season, 104-91 and defeated DePaul 102-101 in overtime on Jan. 21. Most reently the squad rolled past Seton Hall 103-60 on Feb. 3.

The Triple-Double

Natisha Hiedeman recorded just the second triple-double in MU program history last season on Dec. 2 with 12 points, a career-best 18 rebounds and 10 assists. She is one of eight players in Division I this season to tally a triple-double and her 18 boards is the most by a BIG EAST player this season.

A Daily Double

Junior Erika Davenport recorded a BIG EAST-best 14 double-doubles in 33 games last season and finished just shy of averaging one at 13.2 points and 9.2 rebounds. She has 22 career double-doubles after picking up eight as a freshman and ranked at 32nd in the NCAA with 14 tallied last year.

Gaining Experience

MU's head coach Carolyn Kieger enters her fourth year in the position. The Golden Eagles return all but one starter and are bolstered by the strong junior class.

It's Good to Play at Home

MU racked up a 15-3 home record last season, highlighted by three straight victories at the Al McGuire Center in the BIG EAST Tournament.

MU Picked First in BIG EAST Poll

Last season, the Golden Eagles were picked 3rd in the BIG EAST Preseason Poll, but following last seaon's tournament championship, Marquette was a unanimous selection for the top spot. No. 25 DePaul is ranked second while Villanova rounds out the top three.

Sizable Junior Class

Seven juniors are listed on the roster for MU, the largest class on the team. Shantelle Valentine represents the lone senior.

Lone Senior

Shantelle Valentine is the only senior on the roster after McKayla Yentz represented the lone senior on last year's team. Valentine played in all 33 games last season, averaging 2.5 points and 2.2 rebounds in 11.8 minutes of action.

Marquette on National Television

The Golden Eagles will play on national television for five BIG EAST games this season beginning, Dec. 28 when MU hosts St. John's at 7:30 p.m. CT on FS2. Marquette will be on FS1 two times and FS2 three times this season.

BEDN to Air Conference Games

The BIG EAST Digital Network will provide coverage of 73 additional women's basketball conference games. BEDN, launched in September 2014, is its own dedicated section within FOX Sports GO, the mobile app that provides live streaming video of FOX Sports content at home or on-the-go. Carolyn Kieger Head Coach 4th Season Career Record: 54-50

Former Marquette University women's basketball standout Carolyn Kieger became the program's fifth head coach on May 1, 2014 and begins her fourth year at the helm of the Golden Eagles in 2017-18.

After just three seasons, Kieger has taken the Golden Eagles to new heights after a widely successful 2016-17 campaign that saw Marquette earn the BIG EAST Tournament title on its home floor for the first time in program history, while also earning a program-best fifth seed in the NCAA Tournament, as MU returned to the Big Dance for the first time since 2011 and the 10th time in team history.

Kieger's record stands above .500 at 48-46 after she led Marquette to a 25-8 record last season, the first 20+ win season for the Golden Eagles since 2013-14, while coaching Allazia Blockton to a WBCA All-American honorable mention honor.

Blockton earned unanimous All-BIG EAST first team honors as a sophomore and became the youngest player in program history to surpass the 1,000-point plateau and Marquette's 25th all-time. Fellow classmate Erika Davenport was a second-team all-con-

> and ference selection Natisha Hiedeman earned honorable mention accolades as the Golden Eagles earned notoriety around the BIG EAST.

> Kieger's offensive style of run-and-gun showed yet again as the Golden Eagles finished the season ranked 14th in NCAA Division I averaging 78.8 points per game. Marquette also finished the year a perfect 6-0 against teams ranked in the top-25.

> Kieger made her collegiate head coaching debut on Nov. 15, 2014 when Marquette hosted Green Bay in the 2014-15 season opener and she earned her first career victory on Nov. 17, 2014 when Marquette defeated Loyola Chicago, 86-71, at the Al McGuire Center. She completed her first year with a 9-22 overall record, but saw three student-athletes earn individual accolades in the BIG EAST with three all-conference selections.

> In her second year at the helm of the Golden Eagles Kieger had the youngest program in NCAA Division I with eight freshmen on the roster. She took the program to a 14-16 overall record and improved her BIG EAST record to 9-9 and earned the league's No. 6 seed in the BIG EAST Tournament.

> Kieger coached Allazia Blockton to become the BIG EAST Freshman of the Year, a program-first for Marquette, and saw junior McKayla Yentz named BIG EAST Most Improved Player after tripling her scoring output in 2015-16.

> Kieger spent six seasons as the assistant coach at the University of Miami.

She was the Director of Operations for the Golden Eagles during the 2007-08 season and spent a year at Miami as the coordinator of basketball operations from 2006-07.

As a player at Marquette, Kieger was a four-year starter, three-year captain and is MU's all-time assists leader. She is the only player in program history with at least 1,200 career points, 400 career rebounds and 600 assists. For her career, Kieger averaged 10.3 points per game and was a second team All-BIG EAST selection for the 2005-06 season, as well as, a second team All-Conference USA selection for the 2003-04 and 2004-05 seasons. During her senior campaign, she was a finalist for the Nancy Lieberman Award, given to the nation's top point guard.

In addition to her athletic accomplishments, Kieger received the BIG EAST Conference's Sportsmanship award as a senior.

A native of Roseville, Minn., Kieger graduated Cum Laude from Marquette University with a bachelor's degree in broadcasting and electronic communications in 2006. In 2007, she received the McCahill Award given to a graduated MU senior student-athlete who demonstrated the highest performance in scholarship, leadership and athletics.
