## bump, set, spike

• the irish have claimed nine big east championships titles with a pair of second-place finishes ... pittsburgh's 10 titles (1982, 1984, 1986, 1988-94, 2003) are the most by any school in front of notre dame's nine ... however, the panthers reached their total through 26 seasons as a league member and have only won one title since notre dame joined the big east in 1995 ... the joyce center has played host to the big east tournament three times (1995, 2000, 2003) ... adrianna stasiuk was the tournament's mvp in 2005, joining eight other irish players to earn the honor: lauren brewster (2004), emily loomis (2002), malinda goralski (2001), denise boylan (2000), marcie bomhack (1998), jaimie lee (1997), lindsay treadwell (1996), and angie harris (1995) ... the irish have also won 10 regular-season league crowns.

• notre dame is no stranger when it comes to big east championship action hosted by pittsburgh ... the irish have won five of six league tournaments played in the steel city while carrying a 12-1 record ... the lone loss came to georgetown in 1999 ... the irish have faced connecticut on four occasions in the big east championship within the pittsburgh city limits, and three times in the tournament's first round and sport a 4-0 mark.

• with a 9-5 big east conference record the irish have now won at least nine contests in league play for the 14th consecutive season ... notre dame was victorious in nine big east matches in 1998, 2004 and 2007 ... the most wins came in 2005 (13-1) as the irish went on to post a 30-4 overall record en route to an appearance in the ncaa tournament's round of 16.

# last time out

facing a four-point deficit in the fifth set of sunday's match against connecticut, notre dame rattled off eight unanswered points to deal the huskies a 3-2 (26-28, 25-21, 20-25, 25-23, 15-11) defeat at the joyce center ... notre dame trailed, 11-7, but was aided by five uconn errors over the final stretch to earn the big east conference win and the league tournament's fifth overall seed ... senior justine stremick played a pivotal role in snapping the huskies' seven-match win streak. stremick totaled a season-best 17 kills on a .364 clip and five blocks ... seven of her kills came in the fourth set to swing momentum into notre dame's favor and four more kills were racked in the final frame ... sophomore kellie sciacca had seven kills and six blocks, but more importantly, remained a steady pillar at the net to help the irish limit the huskies to respective hitting averages of .000, .073 and .059 in the last three sets of the match.

**[media credentials]** credentials are only issued to accredited members of the working media. requests for credentials should be directed to alan george of the notre dame sports information office.

**[radio broadcasts]** visiting radio stations planning to originate from the joyce center must contact alan george at least 72 hours prior to each joyce in order to obtain approval for the broadcast and proper credentials.

**[press row services]** programs, media guides and flip cards will be available prior to the start of each match. box scores will be distributed to the media after each set, with final stats and play-by-play packets available at the end of the match.

**[post-game press conferences]** notre dame head coach debbie brown and players, along with the visiting head coach and players, will be available to the media following a 10-minute "cooling-off" period. media members should submit player requests for post-game interviews to alan george within an appropriate time frame.

**[in-season interview policy]** all requests for notre dame player or coach interviews must be made through alan george at 574.631.3397. please provide at least 24 hours notice for all interview requests and be aware that the student-athlete's academic obligations will always take precedence. interviews may also be done in person before or after practice. since practice times vary, please contact alan george for an updated schedule. on match days, no interviews will be granted prior to competition.

## notre dame and the BIG EAST

though all 16 members of the big east conference field women's volleyball teams, providence college ceased its league participation in the sport after the 2002 season. the other 15 schools take part in round-robin play during the regular season, and the top eight teams then participate in the big east championship, a single-elimination tournament with the winner receiving the conference's automatic berth to the ncaa tournament. this championship format is a departure from the traditional four-team event that had been in place since the irish joined the league (with the exception of 1999, when the league experimented with an expanded three-day, six-team event).

notre dame has experienced unprecedented success in the 13 years since joining the league in 1995. the irish have compiled a 148-21 (.897) regular-season mark, highlighted by nine tournament titles and winning streaks of 45 and 35 consecutive matches. notre dame once earned 58-straight victories at home in big east regular-season play. irish volleyball squads carried a home conference winning streak of 74 straight matches from 1991 to 2004, which includes wins over both midwestern conference and big east opponents.

the irish have won nine big east tournament championships, posting a 25-4 (.862) mark in the event while reaching the final match in its first 12 tournaments. notre dame has also dominated the league's postseason awards, winning player-of-the-year honors six times and coach-of-the-year award on five occasions. on nine occasions, irish players have been named the league tournament's most outstanding player. notre dame student-athletes have garnered 46 all-conference accolades - including 26 first-team honors - which accounts for nearly one-third of the total first-team honors handed out during the span.

prior to joining the big east, notre dame was a member of the north star conference from 1983-87 and the midwestern collegiate conference from 1990-94. the irish won regular-season and tournament titles in the nsc in 1986 and 1987, then captured both the regular-season and tournament championships in the mcc from 1991-1994. in 23 years of conference participation, notre dame has won 16 regular-season crowns and 15 league tournaments while compiling a 196-29 (.891) mark in regular-season conference matches.

## the BIG EAST conference

the 2008-09 academic year will be the 30th for the big east conference. the league has gone through membership changes since its birth, it has never been stronger. this academic year will mark the conference's fourth year as the nation's largest division i-a conference.

the goals of the big east have never changed. the league aims and expects to compete at the highest level and does so with integrity and sportsmanship. the student-athletes of the member schools continue to maintain the league's proud tradition of success.

big east teams earned their share of recognition at the highest levels in 2007-08. four women's teams advanced to their respective ncaa final fours: connecticut field hockey and women's basketball, notre dame soccer and syracuse lacrosse.

individually in men's sports, villanova's bobby curtis was the ncaa outdoor track champion in the 5,000 meters. connecticut's o'brian white won the m.a.c. hermann trophy, the highest individual honor in soccer. two years ago, big east male and female student-athletes were hermann trophy winners.

in men's basketball, the big east tied its own record set in 2006 by earning eight ncaa championship bids. big east women's teams have received eight ncaa invitations in each of the past two years. the combined 16 men's and women's berths in 2008 was an ncaa first.

the quality of big east football has never been more balanced. six of the league's eight squads were nationally ranked in 2007. for the third straight year, the big east representative in the bowl championship series won its bcs bowl game.

the big east continued to produce student-athletes who were at the forefront of athletic and academic achievement. nineteen big east players were chosen to their respective espn the magazine academic all-america teams, including eight first-team selections.

the big east became the nation's largest division i-a group in 2005-06 when five new members began competing. the new schools were: university of cincinnati, depaul university, university of louisville, marquette university and the university of south florida.

big east institutions reside in nine of the nation's top 34 largest media markets, including new york, chicago, philadelphia, washington, d.c., tampa, pittsburgh, hartford, milwaukee and cincinnati. with its newest members, big east markets contain almost one fourth of all television households in the u.s.

since opening its doors in 1979, the league has won 25 national championships in six different sports and 125 student-athletes have won individual national titles.

the big east has always been able to boast that some of its best students are also some of its best athletes. more than 370 student-athletes have earned academic all-america honors. last year in football, louisville quarterback brian brohm, who finished his career as the big east's career passing leader, was one of the league's eight first-team espn the magazine academic all-america team picks.

also, connecticut's rebecca lobo, one of the most heralded women's basketball players in the history of the sport, was named to the cosida academic all-america hall of fame in 2008. lobo, a two-time big east player of the year, led the huskies to the 1995 ncaa national championship.

the big east has enjoyed tremendous basketball success, especially in this decade. in 2003-04, connecticut became the first school in ncaa history to win the men's and women's ncaa titles in the same season. in '02-03, the big east became the first conference in ncaa history to win the men's and women's titles in the same year when the syracuse men and the connecticut women captured their respective national championships. in men's basketball, big east squads have won three of the last 10 ncaa championships. big east women's teams have taken five of the last nine ncaa titles.

proactive movement has been a signature strategy for the conference that was born in 1979. the big east continually turns challenges into opportunities to become stronger.

more than 550 big east student-athletes have earned all america recognition and dozens have won individual ncaa national championships. the big east has been well represented in u.s. or foreign national and olympic teams. several athletes earned gold medals in each of the last six summer olympiads. the big east has its headquarters in providence where the conference administers to more than 5,500 athletes.

## notre notes

### series history ...

friday's big east championship matchup between notre dame and connecticut will be the 20th time the irish and huskies have faced off on the volleyball court ... the irish rattled off 13 straight wins in the series before losing a four-set affair in 2007, but bounced back with a five-set win to end the 2008 regular season ... the teams have four times played in five-game affairs, with connecticut gaining the first of its two victories over notre dame in 1998 ... that was notre dame's first loss to a big east school since becoming a league member, ending a 41-match winning streak (35 regular season and six tournament matches) ... in the semifinals of that season's big east championship, connecticut won the first two sets before notre dame won three straight to ignite a 12-match winning streak against the huskies ... the irish have won 54 of 68 sets ... notre dame dropped a 3-1 decision to the huskies in 2007 despite justine stremick's 13 kills on a .306 clip ... stremick had four blocks - including two solo stops - and adrianna stasiuk turned in 21 digs for the second time in as many contests ... serinity phillips had a team-high 14 kills to go along with 18 digs ... in fact, phillips led an irish attack with a match-high 16 kills in notre dame's 2006 win over connecticut ... christi gordon had 31 kills in the 2000 match, the third-highest total ever by an irish player and the last 30-kill match recorded at notre dame.... former irish standout and current volunteer assistant emily loomis was an assistant coach for the huskies in 2007 ... loomis spent 2001-04 playing for the fighting irish and was named honorable mention avca all-america in 2003, finishing her career with 1,321 kills to rank fifth on the irish all-time kills list ... she stands as the only notre dame student-athlete ever to earn all-big east honors in two distinctly different sports (excluding track and field and cross country), as she is a four-time all-big east performer in the high jump for the irish track and field team, winning the 2003 outdoor big east title in that event.

### irish dealt honor by big east ...

first-year outside hitter kristen dealy earned the big east conference's freshman of the week award (nov. 17) ... the santa barbara, calif., native punched in a pair of double-doubles from nov. 14-16 to bring her team-high total to 10 ... dealy was all over the court during a 3-2 win against uconn (nov. 16), finding 17 digs and spiking home 16 kills in the win ... dealy collected 12 kills and matched a season high with 18 digs in notre dame's 3-2 loss to st. john's on nov. 14.

### alive in five ...

this season marks the 10th time since 1980 that the irish have played in at least seven five-set matches in a solo campaign ... the 1991 squad took part in a program-high 11 lengthened battles, finishing 6-5 in such bouts ... four of notre dame's last five contests - and five of the previous seven - have been decided in five sets ... the irish are 10-2 in three-set matches and 2-6 in four-setters.

### standing tall ...

justine stremick helped the irish hold one of the league's top offensive units at bay with a season-high 10 blocks - three solo - in a nov. 14 match versus st. john's ... the irish recorded 19 blocks versus the red storm, the highest team total of the season ... stremick also tagged on 11 kills with only one error for a .455 clip in the five-set match ... she then came back two days later with 17 kills and a .364 average against uconn (nov. 16) and added five blocks against the huskies ... her efforts helped the irish snap the huskies' seven-match win streak ... seven of her kills came in the fourth set to swing momentum into notre dame's favor and four more kills were racked in the final frame ... the irish limited the huskies to respective hitting averages of .000, .073 and .059 in the last three sets of the match ... stremick's career block total now stands at 422, moving her into eighth place on notre dame's all-time blocks list ... zanette bennett (1985-88) is seventh with 434 blocks ... stremick is the 11th player in program history to record at least 400 stuffs ... her 1.19 bocks/set average is fifth on the career list.

## notre notes

### statistically stacking up ...

looking at the big east conference's statistical leaders, notre dame litters many of the lists ... in conference play, notre dame is fourth in hitting percentage (.261), fifth in opponent hitting percentage (.183), second in assists/set (12.85) and third in both kills/set (13.73) and digs/set (13.82) ... kellie sciacca is second overall with a hitting percentage of .376 while christina kaelin is fifth with 3.57 kills/set ... jamel nicholas ranks third with 10.93 assists/set and kristen dealy is tied for sixth with .350 aces/set ... on the national level, notre dame is 56th with 2.35 blocks/set with justine stremick sitting 54th among individual players with 1.16 blocks/set.

### the rutgers rout ...

setting a program record for the largest margin of victory in the 25-point era, notre dame posted a 38-point win over rutgers (nov. 9) ... it was the largest margin of victory during the 2008 campaign for the irish, exceeding the previous best of 32 set earlier this season against west virginia ... the set scores went 25-13, 25-16 and 25-8 ... the scarlet knights struggled with their hitting by posting a -.079 clip, the lowest by an irish opponent this season and the strongest defensive effort from notre dame since holding depaul to -.110 in 2005 ... the irish fell behind again in the final set, 1-0, but it had minimal effect on the outcome ... notre dame posted runs of 4-0, 7-0 and 5-0 to help rock the scarlet knights to sleep ... the action in the last frame was highlighted by the hot hands of the irish swingers who connected for 12 kills on 29 attempts without a fault for a .414 average.

### stremick stays sharp in classroom ...

for the third time in as many seasons senior justine stremick was named to the espn the magazine academic all-district v first team (nov. 6) ... stremick was a second-team choice in 2007 and a third-team selection as a sophomore in 2006 ... the langdon, n.d., native boasts a 3.79 cumulative grade-point average as a math and life science major and was the only big east conference player to collect first-team honors this season ... she plans on attending medical school next fall ... after surgically repairing her anterior cruciate ligament in april, stremick returned to the court one month ahead of schedule with the help of team trainer chantal porter ... stremick's twin sister and army outside hitter, briana, also notched first-team honors.

### phillips fills up stat line ...

serinity phillips narrowly missed out on notching notre dame's first triple-double since 2004, finishing with 25 kills on a .375 average, 10 digs and a career-high nine blocks against marquette (nov. 2) ... phillips' kill total was her best of the season and the most since she pounded villanova 26 times in 2007 ... she had a double-double with 16 kills and 13 digs against syracuse (nov. 1) with a .375 clip ... phillips averaged 4.10 kills/set and cleanly fielded 33 serves for a perfect average over the weekend ... she was named to the league's weekly honor roll on nov. 3 ... notre dame's last triple-double came in 2004 against illinois state ... in the 3-2 win, lauren brewster (17 kills, 13 digs, 11 blocks) and adrianna stasiuk (14 kills, 11 digs, 11 blocks) each accomplished the feat ... there have been 21 triple-doubles in program history, four of which were recorded by zanette bennett from 1987-88 ... phillips accounted for 30.5 of notre dame's 88.0 points in the match ... it was the highest point total for any player since 2005 when lauren kelbley (loyola-chicago) and lauren brewster (arizona state) finished with 31.0 points ... kelbley's total came during a three-set match ... phillips had a pair of double-doubles and narrowly missed out on a third from oct. 21-oct. 26 ... she finished with 11 kills and 10 digs at long beach (oct. 21) ... also notched 11 kills and a career-high 22 digs at villanova (oct. 25) ... the 22 digs tied her for team-high honors on the season and the most of any outside hitter ... in a three-set match at seton hall (oct. 26), phillips wrapped up the match with seven kills with only one error for a .316 average, 11 digs and two solo blocks.

## notre notes

### juicing the orange ...

needing five sets to secure a win over syracuse (nov. 1) for the first time since 1990, notre dame prevailed over the orange with a 3-2 victory ... nonetheless, the home team posted a .377 hitting percentage to set a school record for a five-set match ... the previous notre dame record for hitting percentage in a five-set match was .346, set versus san francisco in 1991 ... it was the first five-set win of the season in four tries and just the second five-period contest between notre dame and syracuse in the 17-match series history ... five irish players finished with at least 10 kills for the first time since a 2007 date at pittsburgh ... traffic was directed by setter jamel nicholas and her career-high 68 assists.

### marked by marquette ...

playing in its second five-set match in as many days, notre dame stumbled in a 3-2 matchup versus marquette (nov. 2) ... the match marked the first time notre dame played in consecutive five-set contests against a conference opponent since joining the big east in 1995.

### the offensive engineer ...

setter jamel nicholas has had at least 20 assists in each of notre dame's matches this season with the irish switching between a 5-1 and 6-2 offensive attack ... nicholas had a career-high 68 assists against syracuse (nov. 1) ... it was the first time an irish player had 60+ assists since ashley tarutis registered 63 in a three-set win over usf in 2007 ... nicholas currently ranks eighth on the school's all-time assists list with 1,661 ... she reached a noteworthy milestone at the idaho volleyball classic (sept. 5-6) by surpassing the 1,000-assist plateau ... nicholas shared time with tarutis during her first two seasons with the fighting irish and now mentors freshman setter beth wildermuth.

### catch us if you can ...

the irish have posted several impressive scoring streaks this season, most recently a 9-0 run during the fourth set of a five-frame loss at villanova (oct. 25) ... the team boasted a 9-0 run at georgetown (sept. 28) and went on 10-0 jaunt against west virginia (oct. 11) ... notre dame also posted 10 unanswered points in a home win over nevada (aug. 30), which covered the first and second sets ... facing a four-point deficit (7-11) in the fifth set against connecticut (nov. 16), notre dame rattled off eight unanswered points to help deal the huskies a 3-2 defeat ... in 2007, the irish scored on 12 consecutive rallies versus depaul (oct. 2007).

### the real deal(y) ...

freshman kristen dealy registered four double-doubles from oct. 21-nov 1, bringing her team-high total to eight ... dealy had 16 kills on a .286 average with 11 digs at long beach (oct. 21) and added a pair of assists and six blocks – four of which were solo – versus the 49ers ... she followed that with 15 kills, 15 digs and three aces with four blocks at villanova (oct. 25) ... 10 of those digs came in the first set alone ... dealy's four consecutive matches with a double-double tied her for sixth with four others on the all-time list ... she is the first since adrianna stasiuk did so in 2005 ... it is longest streak ever by a freshman.

### are we there yet?

fall break may have meant classes were out of session at notre dame, but volleyball was in full swing ... notre dame covered over 6,000 miles, caught six flights and hit ground in five states over the course of one week with matches at long beach (oct. 21), villanova (oct. 25) and seton hall (oct. 26) ... notre dame went 1-2 on the road trip.

### irish reach 600 ...

eight team aces and 13 kills by freshman kristen dealy powered notre dame to win no. 600 in program history against west virginia (oct. 11) at the joyce center ... following the win the irish sported a 600-343 (.636) overall record in their 29th season of varsity action.



## notre notes

### take a bow ...

christina kaelin was part of the big east conference's honor roll on oct. 6 and again on oct. 13 ... kaelin had 11 kills with only one error for a .500 clip to lead an irish team that hit .370 in an oct. 11 contest with wvu ... the irish received 21 kills from kaelin in the team's next match versus pittsburgh (oct. 12) ... that performance put her in a four-way tie for 10th place on notre dame's career list for matches with 20+ kills (6) ... she had 20 against eastern washington earlier this season ... she averaged 4.57 kills/set over the two-match stretch ... she also led the irish in kills and hitting percentage in each of the team's two matches from oct. 4-5 ... kaelin fired in 14 kills on a .344 average during her homecoming match against the cardinals ... the louisville native also added one dig and one block versus the cardinals ... she finished with a match-high 17 kills on a .467 average at cincinnati with one ace and five digs in the four-set affair ... she totaled 18.0 points in the irish loss ... the junior averaged 4.43 kills/set on the weekend with a .403 average.

### sciacca strikes again ...

sophomore middle blocker kellie sciacca was named the league's top player on sept. 29 for her performances during irish wins at usf (sept. 26) and georgetown (sept. 28) ... sciacca had 20 kills in her first big east match of the season while posting a .643 average against usf ... she recorded 16 kills versus the bulls before recording an error and finished with only two faults on 28 attempts ... her hitting percentage in the contest was the fourth highest ever in school history for a four-set match ... she followed that performance with nine kills on 15 swings with three errors for a .400 average at georgetown ... sciacca also added an ace and one solo block against the hoyas ... for the weekend, she averaged 4.14 kills/set with a .588 hitting clip ... the monument, colo., native was part of the league's honor roll on sept. 1 ... the big east named sciacca its freshman of the week three times in 2007 - the most among league rookies - as she was a part of the league's honor roll on four occasions ... sciacca was also the american volleyball coaches association's (avca) northeast region freshman of the year last season.

### going solo ...

senior middle blocker justine stremick made her presence felt after seeing action for the first time this season during her debut at the diet coke classic (sept. 12-14) ... stremick, who missed the first six matches of the season while nursing an injured knee, had eight blocks against no. 16 cal poly (sept. 12) and seven kills versus no. 4 california (sept. 13).

### the bigger they are ...

it had been a while since notre dame faced three consecutive ranked opponents before doing so at the diet coke classic (no. 16 cal poly, no. 4 california, no. 11 minnesota) ... the last time notre dame challenged ranked foes in consecutive matches was in 2001 when they went to battle with no. 7 ucla, no. 1 nebraska and no. 15 pepperdine at the u.s. bank / arby's tournament in lincoln, neb. ... notre dame dropped each of the three matches on both occasions.

### pocket aces ...

notre dame served a season-high eight aces against washington state (sept. 6), but raised the bar one week later against no. 4 california (sept. 13) with 10 aces ... serinity phillips, jamel nicholas, tara enzweiler and beth wildermuth each had two for the fighting irish against washington state ... wildermuth added a career-high four aces against california.

### on top of the summit ...

in 29 seasons of varsity volleyball, notre dame earned just its first win over a summit league opponent with a 3-0 sweep of ipfw (aug. 29) ... the league changed its name from the mid-continent conference to summit in june 2007 ... before the season-opening win over the mastodons the irish were 26-8 all-time against the conference and 14-3 under head coach debbie brown.

### it's good to be home ...

head coach debbie brown earned her 200th home victory at notre dame with a 3-1 win against nevada (aug. 30) ... the win moved brown to 200-38 (.843) within the walls of the joyce center ... last season she picked up her 400th overall win as the irish skipper.

### give silva the shovel ...

freshman libero frenchy silva averaged 4.27 digs/set in four matches during the shamrock invitational (aug. 29-31) ... that clip ranked fourth in the big east conference and the best among league rookies ... silva scooped 21 shots against valparaiso (aug. 31), the first 20-dig effort by an irish player since adrianna stasiuk posted an identical total at connecticut (oct. 27) in 2007.

### brown honored by former team ...

head coach debbie brown was honored on sept. 4 during the university of southern california's match versus oklahoma as part of the program's all-time great night ... brown, a former trojan standout, was joined during the ceremony with longtime friend and teammate sue woodstra ... permanent banners with woodstra and brown's name and numbers are now displayed in the galen center ... after graduating from el segundo high school (calif.), brown captained the university of southern california to a 72-1 two-year record and national titles in both 1976 and 1977, including a 38-0 run in 1977 that, until 1998, was the only unbeaten season in division i women's volleyball history ... her 1977 squad is still considered one of the all-time greatest at any level of volleyball ... brown (then debbie landreth) twice was named a collegiate all-american and received the mikasa award as the "nation's best all-around player" in 1976 and 1977 ... the 5-8 outside hitter left usc prior to her junior year, accepting an invitation to train full-time with the u.s. national team ... she co-captained the team to a fifth-place finish at the 1978 world championships ... a year later, she and her teammates - including debbie green, flo hyman, rita crockett and woodstra - qualified for the olympics in moscow and were considered serious medal contenders before the united states elected to boycott the games.

### early experience ...

freshmen kristen dealy and frenchy silva each cracked the starting lineups in their collegiate debut versus ipfw (aug. 31) ... last season, first-year players kellie sciacca and angela puente started in the season opener ... setter beth wildermuth also saw significant action on the court in the season's first weekend of play ... silva and dealy earned starting nods in each of notre dame's three matches ... dealy led the irish with 31 kills (2.82 kills/set) while silva averaged 4.27 digs/set ... not to be outdone, wildermuth split time with starting setter jamel nicholas and posted 3.73 assists/set.

### enzweiler energizes irish ...

junior middle blocker tara enzweiler set career-high marks in virtually every statistical category during the shamrock invitational (aug. 29-31) ... enzweiler logged a pair of starts and matched or exceeded single-match personal bests in kills (5), attempts (13), aces (2), solo blocks (1), block assists (7), total blocks (8) and points (8.5).

### kaelin christens court ...

junior outside hitter christina kaelin returned from an injury that sidelined her for the duration of the 2007 campaign with three starts at the shamrock invitational (aug. 29-31) ... her weekend was highlighted by 13 kills for a .480 clip versus valparaiso (aug. 31) ... kaelin was one of notre dame's top offensive threats throughout her freshman campaign.

### shamrock stars ...

junior outside hitter serinity phillips and sophomore middle blocker kellie sciacca were each named to the shamrock invitational all-tournament squad ... phillips had 13 kills and 12 digs in the season opener against ipfw (aug. 29) and scooped at least 10 digs in each of the invite's three matches ... sciacca secured a double-double – the second of her career – against nevada (aug. 30) with a 14-kill, 10-block effort.

### big east honors sciacca ...

sophomore middle blocker kellie sciacca was selected to the league's weekly honor roll (sept. 1) ... sciacca totaled 30 kills (2.73/set) on a .359 average through three matches at the shamrock invitational (aug. 29-31) ... she led notre dame with 20 blocks over the course of three matches (1.82 blocks/set) and also registered one ace ... sciacca had 14 kills on a .464 average against nevada (aug. 30) along with 10 blocks for a double-double ... she had seven blocks against valparaiso (aug. 31) ... she finished with nine kills on 18 swings versus ipfw (aug. 29).

### head coach debbie brown

debbie brown is one of only a handful of coaches in the volleyball ranks that has been able to parlay a dominating playing career with an equally impressive coaching resume.

a two-time winner of the mikasa award as college volleyball's best all-around player, brown notched her 500th career win as a head coach during the 2006 campaign, and her 524 win total ranks her 27th in that category among active coaches. in fact, only two active coaches have more wins in as many seasons than the co-captain of the 1980 united states olympic team.

while her credentials are virtually unmatched among collegiate coaches and players across the country, brown – who signed a multi-year contract extension in the summer of 2006 – has turned into one of the nation's elite mentors, leading her teams to 21 consecutive winning records, 13 finishes in the top 25 of the avca national rankings, and 20 invitations to the ncaa championship (including a streak of 15 consecutive bids from 1192-2006).

now in her 18th season at notre dame and 24th overall as a collegiate head coach, brown has compiled a 524-232 (.693) career record, including a 407-149 (.732) mark at notre dame. her squads have reached the round of 16 in the ncaa championship six times, highlighted by a trip to the 1993 quarterfinals. fourteen regular-season conference championships and 13 league tournament titles are among the accomplishments of brown-led teams, which have won 20 or more matches 17 times in the last 21 seasons.

when taking over the reigns at notre dame, brown inherited a program that had just five winning seasons in its first 11 years of varsity volleyball action but has since turned it into a perennial big east powerhouse. nine of her teams have been ranked in the avca's final poll. during regular season play, the irish have cracked the top 10 in consecutive campaigns under brown, while peaking at an all-time best fifth in 1995 and sixth in 1996 in the volleyball magazine rankings. in 2005, her squad achieved its highest-ever listing in the avca poll, moving up to fifth after entering the season unranked (it was the first time any school had ever cracked the avca top five after being unranked in the preseason).

she has helped notre dame to a variety of dominating performances, including a 166-15 (.917) record in regular season action against conference teams (27-0 vs. midwestern collegiate conference, 139-15 vs. big east conference). that includes an 88-3 (.967) record at home and, at one point, a 79-match winning streak against conference foes (regular season and postseason) which ranks as the third-longest conference winning streak in division i volleyball history (aiaw or ncaa). the longest losing streak suffered by any irish squad stands at four matches, which happened only once over the past 17 seasons.

overall, the irish are 198-37 (.843) in the joyce center under brown, including winning streaks of 36 and 27 matches. against unranked teams at home, notre dame holds a 187-13 (.935) record in the brown era.

since becoming a member of the big east conference in 1995, notre dame has opened league play with an 11-0 run in all but three seasons (with 11+ matches on the league schedule), going on to win 10 regular-season titles to go along with the nine tournament championships. the irish have won 45 team big east statistical crowns, as well as 27 individual statistical championships. the league's player of the year has been from notre dame six times, while irish student-athletes have garnered 46 all-conference accolades, including 26 first-team honors.

brown has seen her irish players gain all-america accolades on 12 occasions, with brewster becoming the first notre dame player to be selected as an avca all-american (third team in 2004 and second team in 2005). three of the last five seasons have seen multiple irish players earn all-america recognition from the avca, a feat never previously accomplished in program history.

brown and her husband of 26 years, dennis, have two sons, connor and ryan.
