BACK ON THE ROAD – The Notre Dame baseball team (12-12) returns to the road this weekend for a three-game series at Pittsburgh (March 30-April 1; games at 6:00, 3:00 and noon) ... the Irish rotation again will include sophomore RHP **David Phelps**, junior LHP **Wade Korpi** and senior RHP **Dan Kapala** ... the Panthers are slated to throw junior LHP Rob Brant, senior RHP Paul Nardoizzi and newcomer Nate Reed ... the games will air live in the South Bend area on EPSN Radio 1490 AM (available free online at und.com, through Irish All-Access) ... GameTracker live stats, in-game Irish Alert text updates and a postgame ND Sports Hotline recap (574-631-3000) also are available.

SERIES NOTES – ND owns a 26-8 series edge vs. Pittsburgh, including 6-5 margin at Trees Field ... the 11 previous BIG EAST series between the teams have included six won by the Irish, two won by the Panthers and three splits (2-game series) ... ND swept Pitt at Eck Stadium early in the 2006 season (6-1, 4-3, 9-8) ... the Irish dropped a Sunday doubleheader at Trees Field in 2005 (1-4, 5-8) – after a big rainstorm had washed out Saturday – but ND took the series finale on Monday in a 21-1 offensive explosion ... ND also beat Pitt twice at the 2005 BIG EAST Championship (4-2, 11-4).

PHELPS EMERGES AMONG BIG EAST'S TOP PITCHERS

- ND sophomore RHP **David Phelps** was named BIG EAST pitcher of the week after throwing a 3-hit shutout in the 1-0 pitchers duel with USF's Danny Otero on March 23 ... it was the longest outing of his young career, with Phelps also posting a career-high 10 strikeouts while facing just five batters over the minimum (32; BB, HB) and not allowing any baserunner past first base.
- It marked the first time since 2002 (J.P. Gagne, vs. BYU) that an ND righthander has logged a solo 9-inning shutout and also was the first 9-inning, 1-0 game involving the Irish since that 2002 win over BYU.
- Phelps currently ranks 2nd among BIG EAST regulars in season ERA (0.92, tops among full-time starters) ...Phelps and Louisville's Zack Pitts are the only pitchers ranked among the BIG EAST top-10 for ERA, strikeouts (Phelps is 6th with 36) and low opponent batting avg. (also 6th, at .251) ... USF's Jason Delaney (5-0) is the only BIG EAST pitcher with more wins than Phelps (4-1).
