DEACS LOOK TO EXTEND WIN STREAK AT NOTRE DAME

- Wake Forest travels to Notre Dame in search of its third straight victory
- With a win, the Demon Deacons would have their first three-game ACC win streak since a four-game streak in 2009-10
- Wake Forest is looking to win consecutive ACC road games for the first time since 2008-09 and win three ACC road games in a season for the first time since winning four in 2008-09

SERIES HISTORY

- Series tied 3-3 (Notre Dame has won the previous two meetings at Purcell Pavilion)
- The Fighting Irish won both meetings last season and have won three straight in the series
- Wake's last win in the series was an 81-69 victory in the first round of the 2014 ACC Tournament

LAST TIME OUT

- Wake Forest posted an 81-69 victory over Georgia Tech on Saturday
- John Collins had 20 points, 11 rebounds and a career-high five blocks
- Mitchell Wilbekin scored an ACC career-high 16 points (tying a career high with four 3-pointers), while also grabbing a season-high five rebounds and tying a career high with five assists

20 FOR NO. 20

- John Collins enters today's game with six straight 20-point games, the longest streak in ACC play this season and longest in the league since 2013-14 (NC State's T.J. Warren - 15 games)
- He is the first Deac with a six-game streak of 20-point games in ACC play since Skip Brown had a 10-game streak in 1974-75
- His seven 20-point games in ACC play are the most by a Demon Deacon in a season since Justin Gray had eight in 2003-04
- He has three 20 point-10-rebound games in ACC play, the most by a Demon Deacon in a season since Al-Farouq Aminu had three in 2009-10

UP NEXT

- The Demon Deacons return home to host NC State on Saturday
- Tipoff at the LJV Coliseum is noon and the game will air on RSN
- The Deacs won the first meeting of the year, 93-88, in Raleigh on Jan. 21 as John Collins had 21 points and nine rebounds

POSTGAME INTERVIEWS

Head Coaches: Both head coaches will appear in the media room following brief cool-down periods. In most cases, the visiting head coach will appear first, followed by Wake Forest head coach Danny Manning.

Wake Forest Players: Requested players will be available in the media room following both head coaches' press conferences. The Wake Forest locker room is closed to the media.

Opponent Players: Please see the visiting SID. If that team's locker room is closed to the media, interviews are usually held outside in the hallway near the entrance to the visitors' locker room.

ACC TELECONFERENCE

The 15 ACC basketball head coaches will be featured on a weekly teleconference each Monday beginning at 10:30 a.m. The teleconferences will begin on Jan. 9, 2017 and conclude on Feb. 27, 2017. Each coach will have 10 minutes to answer questions.

There will be an instant replay of the teleconference on the ACC's website, theACC.com, each Monday afternoon.

MID-WEEK INTERVIEWS

All interviews with head coach Danny Manning and/or Demon Deacon players should be arranged through Steve Kirkland in the Athletic Communications Office. Interview requests should be made at least 24 hours in advance.

Interviews will be arranged to accommodate players' academic and basketball schedules. Players will not do interviews on gameday, except for postgame interviews.

DANNY MANNING SHOW

Every Thursday (team schedule permitting) from 7-8 p.m., Wake Forest head coach Danny Manning and the Voice of the Deacons, Stan Cotten, host The Danny Manning Show. The one hour-long show originates from the IMG College Studios in Winston-Salem. The show airs locally on 98.1 WBRF-FM and on the Internet at WakeForestSports.com.

MEDIA CREDENTIALS

- Media credentials for Wake Forest home games should be requested by contacting Steve Kirkland in the Wake Forest Athletic Communications Office. Please make your requests in writing or via email, at least 48 hours prior to tip-off.
- Priority is given to daily newspapers, radio/TV sports directors and other media who cover the Demon Deacons and their opponents on a regular basis, in addition to national print and electronic media. Spouses, non-workers and anyone 16 years-of-age or younger are not permitted in any working media area.
- Credentials will not be mailed if credential request is received one week or less prior to the game. Credentials can be shipped overnight if a FedEx shipping number is provided.

MEDIA WILL CALL

- The media entrance to the Coliseum is located at the rear of the facility in close proximity to the media parking area. Media members can enter here and follow the hallway to the media workroom. This also serves as the primary exit for media staying to file stories.
- The main media parking lot is located off of Deacon Boulevard in the Deacon Tower Lot. The secondary media lot is located off Deacon Boulevard in the BB&T Field Gold Lot. Only media with valid parking passes will be allowed to park in these areas.
- There is a "will call" desk for media credentials located at the media entrance.

PHOTOGRAPHERS

- Photographers are restricted to either baseline area and are not permitted along courtside during game activity. Photographers will be assigned areas on the baseline.
- The facility is lighted by 42 LED lamps with a vertical illumination of 102 footcandles and a horizontal illumination of 139 footcandles.
- Use of strobe lights can be purchased at the cost of \$50 per set, per game. To purchase, contact Steve Kirkland in the Wake Forest Athletic Communications Office.

MEDIA SERVICES

- Pre-game statistics, game notes and roster cards are provided prior to tip-off. Final stats, play-by-play and postgame quotes will be available in the media workroom.
- Statistical monitors will be provided for live TV and the home and visiting team radio crews. Live stats can also be accessed by the media via the Internet. See a member of the Wake Forest Athletic Communications staff for the web address.
- Wireless internet access is available in the media workroom and on press row. For user name and password information, check the posted signs in the workroom or ask a member of the Wake Forest Athletic Communications staff.

MEDIA SEATING

- Media will be assigned seats at the press row tables along the visitors' baseline or in the five rows of seating in Section 113. Please check the media seating assignments posted in the media workroom.

2016-17 WAKE FOREST BASKETBALL GAME NOTES

LET'S GET OFFENSIVE

- The Deacs have had one of the most efficient offenses in the nation this year
- Wake is in the top 15 in KenPom offensive efficiency for the first time since leading the nation in 2004-05
- Wake Forest enters the game ranked 11th nationally in offensive efficiency (2nd in the ACC, behind North Carolina)
- The Deacs' FG% is their best since 2008-09; PPG, 3FG% and KP Off. Eff. are best since 2004-05; A/TO ratio is best since 1986-87 (Muggsy Bogues' senior season) and FT% is on a school-record pace
- Wake Forest has six 90-point games this season, its most since eight in 2008-09

50-40-75 GAMES

- In five games this season, Wake Forest has had a 50-40-75 game (shooting at least 50 percent from the field, 40 percent from behind the arc and 75 percent from the free throw line)
- Prior to this season, the Deacs' last 50-40-75 game came against Notre Dame in the 2014 ACC Tournament
- The five 50-40-75 games are one shy of the school record for most 50-40-75 games in a season (six in 2001-02)
- No other ACC team has more than four 50-40-75 games this year

SHOOT TO THRILL

- Wake has shot 50.0 percent or better in eight games this season, a feat it accomplished just seven times all of last year
- Against Bucknell, UTEP, Villanova and Charleston, the Deacs posted a four-game streak of shooting 50.0 percent or better, their longest streak since a six-game stretch spanning the end of the 2003-04 and start of the 2004-05 seasons

LONG-RANGE BOMBING

- Wake Forest ranks fourth in the ACC and in the top 40 nationally in 3-point percentage at 38.5 (190-493)
- Last season the Deacs were 301st nationally at 31.6 percent
- Wake has made double-digit 3-pointers seven times this season, a feat it accomplished just six times the previous two seasons combined
- Wake Forest has four players (Arians, Wilbekin, Crawford, Woods) with at least 30 3-pointers this season, the most Deacs to make at least 30 triples in a season since 2006-07 (four)

DEACS FROM THE LINE

- Wake Forest ranks second in the ACC and in the top 10 nationally in free throw percentage at 77.4 (411-531)
- The 77.4 percentage is on pace to break the single-season school record of 77.1 from the line during the 1968-69 season
- Each of the Deacs' seven leading scorers are shooting at least 72 percent from the line this season, including four over 80 percent
- Against Duke on Jan. 28, Bryant Crawford went 15-of-15 from the line, the 3rd best performance in school history from the line (best since 1970) and the best performance from the line in an ACC game since Miami's Jack McClinton went 16-of-16 against NC State in 2009
- Crawford has two steaks this season of at least 20 consecutive makes, 24 (Jan. 24 to present) and 20 (Dec. 6-Jan. 3)
- Mitchell Wilbekin made his first 16 attempts this season, capping a streak of 31 made consecutive FTs dating back to last season, the longest streak since Darius Songaila made 33 straight in 1999-00
- Brandon Childress started his freshman season by making his first 16 attempts from the line before his first miss, the best start to a career by a Deac (Chris Paul made his first 14 FT attempts in 2003-04)

THE MOST EFFICIENT MAN IN THE ACC

- Sophomore John Collins leads the ACC and is second nationally to Wisconsin's Ethan Happ in Player Efficiency Rating (PER), a formula ESPN's John Hollinger developed that calculates a rating of a player's per-minute statistical production. The league average is 15.00 every season. (see chart on page 12)
- Collins is at 34.73 through 23 games this season to lead the ACC
- Since Hollinger began applying his NBA formula to NCAA stats in 2009, season leaders have included Stephen Curry of Davidson, DeMarcus Cousins and Anthony Davis of Kentucky, Kelly Olynyk of Gonzaga and Frank Kaminsky of Wisconsin
- He's averaging 28.1 points and 14.8 rebounds per 40 minutes this year

COLLINS RISES TO THE OCCASION

- John Collins leads the Deacs in scoring (17.6 ppg) and rebounding (9.3 rpg) and is the only player in the league in the top 10 of scoring and rebounding
- Collins leads the ACC in field goal percentage, both overall (60.7) and in conference games (61.9)
- His 10 double-doubles this season ranks third in the ACC
- His six-game streak of double-doubles (Nov. 23-Dec. 17) was the longest by a Deac since Tim Duncan ended his career with 11 straight double-doubles in 1996-97
- He scored a career-high 27 points vs. Miami on 9-11 FGs and a career-best 9-9 from the FT line
- Collins had 24 points on 9-10 FGs against UTEP, the highest FG% by a Deac (min 10 attempts) in three seasons
- Collins grabbed a career-high 16 rebounds at Northwestern, including eight offensive rebounds (most by a Deac in three seasons)
- He had his first career 20-and-15 game with 22 points and 15 boards vs. Charlotte

CRAWFORD, THE PASSER...

- Bryant Crawford is second in the ACC in assists at 5.87 per game
- His 135 assists has already eclipsed his freshman total of 133
- He is fifth in the ACC with a 2.41 assist-to-turnover ratio this season, an improvement from a 1.25 ratio during his freshman season
- In Wake Forest's 14 victories this season, he has 95 assists to just 22 turnovers (4.32 A/TO ratio)
- Crawford has 11 games this season with one or fewer turnovers and the Deacs are 10-1 in those games
- His 268 career assists rank 17th in school history
- He has two double-digit assist games this season (11 vs. LSU, 10 at Richmond)
- He joins Chris Paul, Ish Smith and Derrick McQueen as the only Deacs with at least 130 assists in each of their first two seasons

CRAWFORD, THE SCORER...

- Crawford is one of two players in the league to rank in the top 20 in scoring in addition to being in the top five in assists (Dennis Smith)
- He has five 20-point games this season, matching his freshman total
- Against Duke, Crawford had a career-high 26 points, highlighted by a perfect 15-of-15 from the line, the 3rd-best perfect FT game in Wake history and the best since 1970
- He has scored in double figures in the last 15 games, the third-longest active streak in the ACC
- Crawford had his first career double-double with 20 points and a career-high 11 assists vs. LSU
- He sealed the win at UNCG with the game-winning three-pointer with 2.0 seconds remaining
- He averaged 16.3 points and 5.7 assists in three games at the Charleston Classic to be named to the All-Tournament Team

2016-17 Opponents

PASSING WITH A PURPOSE

- The Deacs are led by the best passing duo in the ACC
- Bryant Crawford (5.5) and Keyshawn Woods (4.1) are the only pair of teammates averaging over four assists per game in ACC play
- They are on pace to become the first Deacon duo to have at least 100 assists in a season since 2008-09 (Ish Smith & Jeff Teague)
- Both are ranked in the top five in assist/turnover ratio in ACC games
- Each had nine assists in the win at Boston College (Jan. 31), the first game in school history with two players recording at least nine dimes
- At Boston College, the Deacs assisted on 22-of-27 field goals (81.5 percent), their highest percentage since 1997-98 (84.6 vs. Coastal)
- The Deacs have assisted on 58.0 percent of their field goals this season (Wake assisted on 54.7 percent of field goals last season)

CHALLENGING SCHEDULE

- The Demon Deacons are once again playing one of the nation's toughest schedules in 2016-17
- Wake Forest's schedule is currently ranked No. 8 nationally by the ESPN BPI, No. 10 in the RPI and No. 16 by KenPom
- Of the 30 regular season games, nine are against teams currently ranked in the Associated Press or Coaches poll, with two others against teams currently receiving votes
- Wake Forest's 2016-17 opponents have a .651 winning percentage this season, the third highest in the nation

YOUTH WILL BE SERVED

- Of the 13 scholarship players on the 2016-17 roster, eight are either freshmen or sophomores
- Only two players on the roster have senior eligibility, Trent VanHorn and Austin Arians
- The Demon Deacons rank 268th nationally in experience (KenPom), which is 13th in the ACC (only Florida State and NC State are below)
- Wake Forest's top three scorers are all underclassmen (Fr. or So.), a feat the Deacs haven't accomplished since 2008-09 (Jeff Teague, Al-Farouq Aminu, James Johnson)

A "KEY" TO SUCCESS

- Redshirt sophomore Keyshawn Woods, who sat out 2015-16 as a transfer from Charlotte, has made an immediate impact for the Deacs
- He is averaging 12.6 points, 4.3 rebounds and 3.7 assists per game
- Against Bucknell, he scored a career-high 22 points on 8-9 FGs, including 5-6 from behind the arc
- Woods had 20 points (6-9 FG, 3-4 3FG) vs. Miami on Jan. 18
- He had a career-high nine assists and no turnovers at Boston College, the best assist-to-turnover ratio game in the ACC this season
- He is the only Deac to rank in the top three on the team in scoring, rebounding and assists
- Woods led Conference USA in 3-point percentage in 2014-15 as a freshman at Charlotte and is shooting 46.0 percent (75-163) from behind the arc in his career

WILBEKIN & MITOGLU FOR THREE

- Juniors Mitchell Wilbekin and Dinos Mitoglou are already among the school leaders in career 3-pointers
- Wilbekin is 9th with 138 3-pointers, while Mitoglou is 13th with 117 career 3-pointers
- Mitoglou had eight 3-pointers against LSU, the most by an ACC player this season and the most by a Deac since 2003-04 (Justin Gray - eight at Texas)

ARIANS ARRIVES

- Graduate transfer forward Austin Arians made his Wake Forest debut against Radford, scoring the Deacs' first points of the season on a 3-pointer
- Arians has scored in double figures eight times this season, including season-high 15 points at Richmond and against LSU
- He is shooting 40.2 (39-97) from behind the arc this season
- Arians played his undergraduate career at Milwaukee, leading the Panthers to the 2014 Horizon League Championship
- Against College of Charleston, Arians recorded his 1,000th career point over his two-school career

OFFENSIVE EXPLOSIONS

- Twice this season the Demon Deacons have had a strong offensive performance to eclipse the 100-point mark
- The Demon Deacons downed UTEP 103-81 in the first round of the Charleston Classic, a game that marked Wake Forest's first 100-point game since 2008-09 (120-88 vs. UNC Wilmington), a span of 253 games
- Wake posted a 110-76 win over LSU to record their most points against a Power 5 non-conference foe in school history
- The 67 second half points against LSU was one shy of the school record for points in a half (68 in the first half vs. Saint Joseph's in 1975-76), while the 63 first half points vs. UTEP ranks T-6th in school history for points in a half
- Both of those halves featured a field goal percentage over 73 percent, ranking them in the top 20 in school history for a half

COLLINS NAMED PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- John Collins was named ACC Player of the Week on Jan. 23 after leading the Deacs to wins over Miami and NC State
- Collins averaged 24.0 points and 8.0 rebounds in the wins, shooting 77.3 (17-22) from the floor and 93.3 (14-15) from the line
- It was the first honor of Collins' career and the first for a Deac since Travis McKie in 2013-14

DEACS PICKED 13TH

- The Demon Deacons were picked to finish 13th during the preseason poll of media attending ACC Operation Basketball in October
- Duke was the preseason favorite, followed by North Carolina, Virginia, Louisville, Syracuse, NC State, Notre Dame, Florida State, Miami, Virginia Tech, Clemson, Pitt, Wake Forest, Georgia Tech and Boston College

BAHAMA SUMMER

- The Demon Deacons took a five-day trip to The Bahamas in August, taking advantage of the NCAA rule allowing a foreign exhibition tour once every four years
- The Deacs won all three games on the tour, defeating the University of Toronto 93-72, the CTG Knights 90-78 and the Real Deal Shockers 104-57
- Four players averaged double figure scoring during the trip: Bryant Crawford (15.0 ppg), Keyshawn Woods (14.3), Austin Arians (12.3) and John Collins (11.3)

FUTURE DEACS SIGN ON

- Wake Forest signed two players to a National Letter of Intent on Nov. 9 to form its 2017 recruiting class
- Chaundee Brown, a 6-5 guard from Orlando, Fla., is a consensus top-40 player and at No. 29 in the ESPN rankings is the highest ranked player to sign with the Deacs since 2008 (Al-Farouq Aminu)
- Melo Eggleston, a 6-7 forward from Upper Marlboro, Md., is a three-star commit and is ranked among the top 50 small forwards in the nation by 247 Sports

DEACS IN THE NBA

- Despite the retirement of the legendary Tim Duncan, the Deacs are still well-represented in the NBA, having five players on opening night rosters
- Nine-time All-Star Chris Paul is in his 12th NBA season and his sixth with the Los Angeles Clippers
- 2015 All-Star Jeff Teague is in his first season with his hometown Indiana Pacers after an off-season trade from the Atlanta Hawks, where he played his first seven NBA seasons
- Al-Farouq Aminu is in his second season with the Portland Trail Blazers and his seventh overall in the NBA
- James Johnson signed a free agent deal with the Miami Heat to begin his eighth NBA season following two seasons in Toronto
- Ish Smith is playing for his 10th franchise in his seven-year NBA career, signing with the Detroit Pistons over the summer

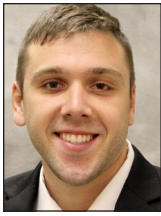
