Though all 12 members of the BIG EAST Conference field women's volleyball teams, Providence College ceased its league participation in the sport after the 2002 season. The other 11 schools take part in round-robin play during the regular season, and the top four teams then participate in the BIG EAST Championship, a single-elimination tournament with the winner receiving the conference's automatic berth to the NCAA Championship. In 1999, the league experimented with an expanded three-day, six-team event. For more information on the BIG EAST Conference, see page 124.

Notre Dame has experienced unprecedented success in the nine years since joining the league in 1995. The Irish have compiled a 98-5 (.951) regular-season mark, highlighted by eight titles and winning streaks of 45 and 35 consecutive matches. Notre Dame is 56-0 in BIG EAST regular-season matches in the Joyce Center, extending its home regular-season winning streak (which dates back to 1990) to 72. The Irish have won seven BIG EAST tournament championships, posting a 17-2 mark in the event and reaching the final every year. Notre Dame also has dominated the conference awards, winning player-of-the-year honors six times and the coach-of-the-year award on four occasions. In seven instances, Irish players have been named the league tournament's most outstanding player. Also, Notre Dame student-athletes have garnered 32 all-conference accolades, including 20 first-team honors, which account for more than one-third of the first-team selections during the span.

Prior to joining the BIG EAST, Notre Dame participated in the North Star Conference from 1983-87 and in the Midwestern Collegiate Conference from 1990-94. The Irish won regular-season and tournament titles in the NSC in 1986 and '87, and captured both the regular-season and tournament championships in the MCC in 1991, '92, '93, and '94. In 19 years of conference participation, Notre Dame has won 14 regular-season crowns and 13 league tournaments, while compiling a 155-18 (.896) mark in regular-season conference matches. The Irish won 78 consecutive matches against league opponents from 1990-98 and currently have not lost at home in a regular-season conference tilt since 1990, a stretch of 72 straight victories.

The most prestigious honor awarded to a Notre Dame student-athlete, the Byron V. Kanaley Award has been presented each year since 1927 to the senior monogram athletes who have been most exemplary as both students and leaders.

The awards, presented by the Faculty Board on Athletics, are named in honor of a 1904 Notre Dame graduate who was a member of the Irish baseball team as an undergraduate. Kanaley went on to a successful banking career in Chicago and served the University as a lay trustee from 1915 until his death in 1960.

The Notre Dame volleyball team has had six of its players honored with the Kanaley Award, which is presented at the spring athletic department awards dinner: Terese Henken (1984), Alicia Turner (1993), Julie Harris (1994), Jaimie Lee (1998), Keara Coughlin (2003), and Kristen Kinder (2004).





Jessica Fiebelkorn was the first Irish player ever to register 1,000 kills and 1,000 digs, finishing her career in 1992 with 1,299 kills and 1,324 digs.

Irish in the NCAA & BIG EAST Leaders

Notre Dame has been regularly represented since the NCAA began keeping national volleyball statistics in 1994, and the Irish have exhibited unprecedented dominance in the BIG EAST Conference statistical leaders since becoming a league member in 1995.

Notre Dame has posted 11 top-15 results in the national team statistics over the past 10 years and has had 12 individuals finish among the top 20 in Division I. In 2003, the Irish finished first in the country in team blocking (3.72) after being second and fifth in the two previous years. Sophomore Lauren Brewster, who was fourth in the NCAA as a freshman in the category, led the nation in individual blocking (1.78). Both crowns marked program firsts.

In conference action, the Irish have won a total of 62 statistical titles in nine years of league membership, 38 in team categories (21 in conference-only categories and 17 in overall categories) and 24 in individual statistics (14 in conference play and 10 in overall). Among the highlights are the Irish finishing first in hitting percentage in league play seven times, including in each of the last five seasons and Notre Dame taking first in opponent hitting percentage in all of the five years it has been kept. Through just half of her collegiate career, Brewster already leads all Irish players with five career BIG EAST statistical titles, having led the conference in blocking in both overall and conference play in both 2003 and '04, and also finishing first in hitting percentage in league action last season.

Irish in the NCAA Championship

After making just one prior appearance, the University of Notre Dame has been a staple in the NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball Championship since the arrival of head coach Debbie Brown. The Irish have earned 12 consecutive bids to the NCAAs, a streak dating back to 1992. Notre Dame is one of just nine schools to have appeared in each of the last 12 NCAA tournaments. The Irish have an 11-13 record in all-time NCAA play, highlighted by five trips to the round of 16 and a 1993 quarterfinal finish.

The Irish earned their first-ever berth in the NCAAs in 1988, when they upset #20 Penn State in the opening round. Notre Dame then traveled to #4 Illinois for the round of 16 and took the Illini to five games before falling. The '93 squad put together the deepest Irish postseason run, upsetting #8 Nebraska at home in three games and then winning in five (15-13 in the fifth game) at Minnesota to reach the national quarterfinals. Notre Dame's run ended against #7 Penn State. The Irish also were among the final 16 in each of the next two seasons (1994 and '95) and completed a stretch of four round-of-16 appearances in five years by upset-

ting #18 Arkansas in the '97 second round.

Notre Dame has played host to NCAA tournament action on six occasions, going 6-2 on its home court. The Irish were home for first-round play in 1988, '93, '94, and '95 before being a first- and second-round site in 1996 and 2002.

The NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball Championship began in 1981 with a 20-team field. From 1982-85, 28 teams gained invitations, and the field expanded again to 32 teams in 1986. In 1993, the invitation list was enlarged to 48 with 16 teams gaining first-round byes. After one year of experimentation with a 56-squad event (1997), with the top eight seeds receiving opening byes, the current 64-team format was adopted in 1998. First- and second-round action takes place at 16 campus sites, with the winners advancing to four pre-determined regional sites. In 2004, the opening rounds will be Dec. 2-5, and the regionals - to be played in Louisville, Ky.; Minneapolis, Minn.; Seattle, Wash.; and Green Bay, Wis. - are slated for Dec. 10-11. The semifinals and final will be contested Dec. 16 and 18 in Long Beach, Calif.
