SETTING THE STAGE ...

No. 19 Notre Dame will play host to Green Bay on Thursday, Nov. 19 at 7:30 p.m. (ET) in the first round of the NCAA Championship. The Fighting Irish will be making their ninth straight NCAA Championship appearance and the 13th trip overall in program history. This will be Green Bay's first NCAA Tournament appearance since 1983. The Irish are 2-1 all-time against the Phoenix.

GAME WATCH ...

Thursday's match can be seen live and for free on und.com ... Tom Staudt will handle playby-play duties, while Michael Scholl will provide color commentary ... live stats via Gametracker also are available on und.com.

FIGHTING IRISH AGAINST THE PHOENIX ...

Notre Dame is 2-1 all-time against Green Bay ... the last meeting occurred during the 1994 campaign and Green Bay won that match 2-1 at Notre Dame ... Notre Dame won at Green Bay, 3-2 in overtime, in 1985 and captured a 2-1 home victory over the Phoenix in 1988.

IRISH IN THE NCAA CHAMPIONSHIP ...

First Varsity Season1977

The Irish are making their ninth straight NCAA Championship appearance and the 13th trip overall in program history ... the Irish have a 9-11-1 record all-time in the NCAA Championship ... Notre Dame's high-water mark in the NCAA Tournament were quarterfinal trips in 2006 and 2007 ... last season, the Irish fell at home to Northwestern, 2-1, in the second round ... the Irish have made the tournament's Round of 16 on five occasions (1996, 2003, 2005, 2006, 2007) ... Notre Dame owns a 5-2-1 mark at home and a 4-9-0 record on the road in the NCAAs.

FIRST ROUND HISTORY ...

Thursday will be Notre Dame's first first-round NCAA Championship game since the 2005 season ... the Fighting Irish have received a first-round bye in each of the past three seasons ... Notre Dame topped Western Illinois, 2-0, in the first round of the 2005 tournament ... Notre Dame is 6-6 all-time in its first game of an NCAA Championship.

WHAT'S AT STAKE ...

The winner of Thursday's NCAA Championship first-round match between Notre Dame and Green Bay will advance to play at Northwestern in the second round on Sunday, Nov. 22 ... the match in Evanston, Ill. is slated for a 1:00 p.m. (CT) kickoff ... Northwestern is the tournament's No. 9 seed.

ABOUT THE IRISH ...

Notre Dame is 10-7-4 on the season ... the Fighting Irish fell to St. John's on Sunday in a penalty kick shootout, 5-3, in the title game of the BIG EAST Championship ... the match ended as a scoreless draw ... Notre Dame posted an 8-3 record in the BIG EAST Conference to finish second in the Blue Division ... senior forward Bright Dike, the BIG EAST Offensive Player of the Year, leads the team in goals (10) and points (23) ... senior midfielder Michael Thomas, a first-team all-league honoree, has a team-best six assists ... Notre Dame is averaging 1.43 goals per game, while surrendering 0.95 goals per contest ... Philip Tuttle has started 11 games in goal, while Andrew Quinn has started nine matches ... Tuttle is 7-3-2 with five shutouts ... the senior boasts a 0.71 goalsagainst average and a .743 save percentage ... Quinn, a fifth-year senior, is 3-4-2 with two shutouts ... Quinn has a 1.15 goals-against average and a .750 save percentage ... head coach Bobby Clark is in his ninth season with the Irish ... he has a 116-52-26 (.665) record during his Notre Dame tenure.

SCOUTING GREEN BAY ...

Green Bay captured the Horizon League title with a 3-2 shootout victory over Butler on Sunday ... the match ended as a scoreless draw ... the Phoenix will carry a 14-2-3 record into Thursday's match ... Green Bay has allowed one goal in its past five matches ... the Phoenix offense averages 2.42 goals per game, while the defense allows 0.89 per contest ... JC Banks leads the team in goals (13), assists (9) and points (35) ... David Znaty has eight goals, while David Prochazka is tied for the team lead with nine assists ... Ryan Wehking has started every match in goal and carries a 0.87 goals-against average with a .761 save percentage and nine shutouts ... head coach Tom Poitras is in his sixth season with the Phoenix ... this is Green Bay's first trip to the NCAA Championship since 1983.

COMMON OPPONENTS ...

Notre Dame and Green Bay have played two common opponents this season (DePaul and Pittsburgh) ... both the Irish and Phoenix topped DePaul 2-1 and Pittsburgh 1-0.

QUOTING CLARK ...

Notre Dame head coach Bobby Clark discusses the upcoming match against Green Bay ...

"This game certainly won't be easy for us. Green Bay is a very well-coached team and they've only lost two games all season. No game at this stage is easy. Every team in the tournament has had a good season. It's a testament to our guys that we've made the tournament nine straight times, but the trick now is to advance."

BEEN HERE BEFORE ...

Head coach Bobby Clark has led the Fighting Irish to an NCAA Championship berth during all nine of his seasons at Notre Dame ... the Irish have advanced to the Round of 16 on four occasions and the quarterfinals twice under Clark (2006 & 2007) ... Clark carries an 8-7-1 record in the NCAA Championship during his Notre Dame tenure ... Clark steered Dartmouth to the NCAA quarterfinals on two occasions (1990 & 1992) during his nine-year stint with the Big Green ... during Clark's five seasons at Stanford, he led the Cardinal to the NCAA title game in 1998 and to the quarterfinals in 2000.

IRISH AGAINST THE NCAA FIELD ...

Notre Dame faced eight teams that made this year's NCAA Championship ... the Fighting Irish went 2-5-4 against those squads ... the Irish squared off against BIG EAST foes USF, Louisville and St. John's twice each ... a total of five BIG EAST schools received a berth to the NCAA Championship ... St. John's was the highest seeded team from the league as the Red Storm earned the No. 13 seed.

SHOOTING IT OUT ...

All three of Notre Dame's BIG EAST Championship matches went to a penalty kick shootout ... the Irish bested USF in penalty

kicks, 5-4, in the quarterfinals after both teams were tied 2-2 following regulation and two overtime periods ... the Irish defeated Louisville in a shootout, 4-3, in the semifinals after a scoreless draw ... in the final, Notre Dame fell to St. John's in a shootout, 5-3, following a 0-0 tie.

WORKING OVERTIME ...

Notre Dame's past four matches have gone to overtime ... that marks the first time the Fighting Irish have played four consecutive overtime games since the 1998 season when Notre Dame played in five straight contests that went to overtime.

CLOSE ENCOUNTERS ...

Five of Notre Dame's past eight matches have been decided by one goal ... the other three games in that stretch were draws ... the Fighting Irish have played a total of 11 one-goal games this season ... the Irish are 6-5 in those contests.

ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM ...

Jeb Brovsky, a junior midfielder, Michael Thomas, a senior midfielder, and sophomore Aaron Maund, a sophomore defender, were named to the BIG EAST Championship all-tournament team.

DIKE NAMED BIG EAST OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE YEAR ...

Notre Dame senior forward **Bright Dike** was named the 2009 BIG EAST Offensive Player of the Year ... Dike, who was voted the conference's preseason offensive player of the year, leads the league in points (23) and is tied for the lead in goals (10) ... Dike is the second Notre Dame player ever to be tabbed as the BIG EAST Offensive Player of the Year ... Joseph Lapira took home the honor in 2006.

IRISH HONORS ...

Six Notre Dame players garnered all-BIG EAST honors at the league's annual awards banquet on Nov. 12 ... joining Bright Dike, the league's offensive player of the year, on the all-BIG EAST first team was Irish senior midfielder Michael Thomas ... fellow senior Justin Morrow, a defender, was a second-team pick ... junior forward Jeb Brovsky and sophomore defender Aaron Maund were selected to the third team ... freshman midfielder Dillon Powers was named to the BIG EAST All-Rookie

NOTRE DAME IN BIG EAST PLAY ...

Notre Dame owns an overall record of 91-53-18 (.617) in BIG EAST regular-season play since joining the conference in 1995 ... the Irish have posted nine straight winning seasons within the conference, including this season's 8-3-0 mark ... the eight wins in BIG EAST play tied for the most ever for the Fighting Irish ... Notre Dame also won eight BIG EAST matches in 2004 (8-1-1) and 2006 (8-3) ... the Irish have three regular-season BIG EAST titles ... Notre Dame won the championship outright in 2004 and 2008 (Blue Division) and shared the Blue Division trophy with Connecticut in 2007 ... the Fighting Irish captured BIG EAST tournament crowns in 1996 and 2003.

THOMAS NAMED ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICAN ...

Fighting Irish senior midfielder Michael Thomas has earned third-team Academic All-America honors from ESPN the Magazine and the College Sports Information Directors of America (CoSIDA) ... Thomas becomes the seventh player in program history to be selected as a CoSIDA Academic All-American ... Notre Dame has produced an Academic All-American in four of the past five seasons.

IRONMAN ...

Notre Dame senior left back Justin Morrow has played in a team-best 66 consecutive games, including 52 straight starts.

COMING BACK ...

Despite falling behind USF by two goals, Notre Dame came back to force a 2-2 draw in their BIG EAST Championship quarterfinal match on Nov. 8 ... it was the first time Notre Dame had come back from a two-goal deficit since Oct. 13. 2007 when the Irish fell behind Connecticut 2-0 before claiming a 3-2 lead ... that match would end in a 3-3 tie.

DOUBLE DIGITS ...

Since head coach Bobby Clark took over the Fighting Irish program in 2001, he has steered the Irish to a double-digit win total in each of his nine seasons ... Notre Dame currently is 10-7-4.

GOLDEN MOMENTS ...

Notre Dame has netted a golden goal three times this season ... Bright Dike produced a game winner in the 110th minute against Providence on Oct. 10 ... junior right back Bilal Duckett tallied a golden goal in the 97th minute versus Georgetown on Oct. 21 ... Dike then delivered his second golden tally of the season when he scored in the 91st minute against Connecticut on Oct. 31.

SETTING THE PACE ...

Notre Dame is 6-1-1 this season when Bright Dike scores a goal ... Dike leads the Irish in goals (10) and points (23) ... the Irish are 5-0-1 when Michael Thomas nets a goal ... Thomas is second on the Irish squad with six goals to go along with a team-high six assists.

AMONG THE LEAGUE LEADERS ...

Senior forward Bright Dike, the BIG EAST Offensive Player of the Year, leads the league with 23 points ... Dike's 10 goals ties him for the BIG EAST lead with Louisville's Colin Rolfe.

CORNERING THE MARKET ...

The Fighting Irish have gained 39 more corner kicks (132-93) than their opponents ... Notre Dame's 132 corner kicks lead the BIG EAST.

FIRST TIMERS ...

Four Notre Dame players have scored their first career goal in recent matches ... junior right back **Bilal Duckett** tallied the golden goal in the 97th minute in a 2-1 win at Georgetown on Oct. 21 ... sophomore midfielder Michael Rose netted the lone goal (48th minute) in Notre Dame's 1-0 win at Pittsburgh on Oct. 24 ... sophomore midfielder Adam Mena scored the only Irish goal (37th minute) in a 2-1 setback against Michigan State on Oct. 28 ... sophomore central defender Aaron Maund netted the equalizer in the 83rd minute in a 2-2 draw against USF in the BIG EAST Championship quarterfinals on Nov. 8.

SECOND HALF SUCCESS ...

Notre Dame has out scored its opponents 22-11 in the second half and overtime periods this season.

SHOOTING DOWN THE COMPETITION ...

Notre Dame has out shot 17 of its 21 opponents so far this season ... the Irish hold a 305-210 advantage in shots, including 126-83 in shots on goal, over their opponents ... Notre Dame's 305 shots lead the BIG EAST.

NIGHT OWLS ...

Notre Dame is 5-1-2 this season when playing at night ... last season, the Fighting Irish were 7-4-2 during night games.

TAKING DOWN A TOP-FIVE ...

The 2-1 overtime win against fifth-ranked Connecticut on Oct. 31 marked Notre Dame's first victory over a top-five team since they defeated No. 5 USF 5-0 last season (Sept. 7, 2008).

TOUGH SLATE ...

Notre Dame faced four teams this season that were ranked in the top-five nationally at the time of the match ... the Irish took on #3 Wake Forest (T, 1-1) and #1 St. John's (L, 0-2) at the adidas/IU Credit Union Classic (Sept. 4 & 6) ... the back-to-back games against Wake Forest and St. John's was the first time ever the Fighting Irish had faced back-to-back top-three teams ... Notre Dame fell at #5 South Florida, 2-1, on Sept. 20 ... the Fighting Irish took down #5 Connecticut, 2-1 in overtime, on Oct. 31 ... Notre Dame is 3-3-4 this season versus teams ranked in the national top-25.

IRISH EXPLOSION ...

The four goals scored in the second half against Louisville on Sept. 25 were the most goals scored in a single period by the Irish since they netted four in the first half in a 5-0 win over USF last season (Sept. 7, 2008).

OFFENSE AT ALUMNI ...
