FOR STARTERS

- This weekend, Notre Dame plays its first home Big Ten series as Penn State visits the Compton Family Ice Arena for the second consecutive season and the teams will be meeting for the third consecutive season.
- The Irish are coming off a road sweep at Ohio State (Nov. 3-4) in their first ever Big Ten series, while the Nittany Lions split a home series versus Mercyhurst (Nov. 3-4) last weekend
- Cale Morris played both games in the Notre Dame net against Ohio State and stopped 62 of the 65 shots he faced in the two games (.954) en route to being named the Big Ten's Second Star of the Week.
- Penn State (38) and Notre Dame (36) rank first and second in the country, respectively, in goals scored this season.
- Eighteen of Notre Dame's 36 goals have come in the second period.

QUICK HITS

- Jake Evans enters the weekend as the NCAA leader in points (18), assists (14) and faceoff wins (147), while his 1.80 points per game average ranks third.
- Evans also leads the country with 12 even strength points and he has the most games with at least three points (4).
- Evans has 10 points (1–9–10) over Notre Dame's last four games.
- Cal Burke has a four-game points streak (3-3-6), while Andrew Peeke (0-3-3) and Dylan Malmquist (2-1-3) have two-game point streaks.
- Jordan Gross (4-8-12) is tied for the NCAA lead in points by defensemen with Jimmy Schuldt of St. Cloud State,
- Gross' 42 shots on goal lead all defensemen and rank tied for third overall, while his 4.20 shots on goal per game average ranks second among defensemen.
- Bobby Nardella (2-8-10) is tied for fifth in scoring among defensemen, while his seven power-play points (1-6-7) are tied for first.

- Notre Dame and Penn State will be meeting for the third consecutive season and for the first time as conference foes.
- Last season in a tightly contested series at the Compton Family Ice Arena, the teams skated to a 3–3 overtime tie in game one (Oct. 21) and then the Nittany Lions posted a

- 3-2 overtime win in game two (Oct. 22).
- In the game one tie, the Irish erased a 3-1 deficit on goals by Andrew Oglevie and Jordan Gross for the eventual tie.
- This weekend will mark the third all-time series between the teams as Notre Dame opened the 2015-16 at Penn State.
- The teams split that 2015–16 series, including a 7–4 win in the season opener, which was keyed by a Steven Fogarty hat trick (remains the most recent hat trick by a Notre Dame player).
- Before Penn State became an NCAA Div. I program starting with the 2012–13 season, the Irish also played the Nittany Lions four times between the 1983-84 and 1984-85 seasons, with the Irish posting a 3-0-1 record in those four games.
- Notre Dame's current stat leaders against Penn State include Jake Evans (4 GP, 1-4-5), Jordan Gross (4 GP, 1–5–6), Andrew Oglevie (3 GP, 1–2–3), Dylan Malmquist (4 GP, 1–1–2) and Joe Wegwerth (4 GP, 2-0-2).

PENN STATE AT A GLANCE

- The Nittany Lions are coming off a home series split with Mercyhurst, dropping game one, 7-4 (Nov. 3) and rebounding to take game two, 7-5 (Nov. 4).
- James Robinson had a hat trick in the game two win.
- Peyton Jones started both games of the Mercyhurst series in the Penn State goal and he was relieved in game one by Chris Funkey.
- Penn State is 5-5-0 overall and 2-2-0 in Big Ten play, having split both a road series at Minnesota and a home series versus Michigan.
- Jones is 5–3–0 on the season with a 4.02 goals-against average and a .869 save
- As a team, Penn State is scoring 3.80 goals per game, which ranks seventh in the country, but the Nittany Lions are also giving up 3.90 goal against per game, which ranks 57th.
- Andrew Sturtz leads the offense with six goals and seven assists for 13 points and he is the Big Ten's second leading scorer (all games) behind Jake Evans.
- Colorado draft pick Denis Smirnov is second on the team with 11 points (5–6–11) and he also is tied for the NCAA lead with three game-winning goals this season.

POWER PLAY YIELDING RETURNS

 The Irish enter the weekend with the Big Ten's highest ranked power play (all games), converting at a 25.7% rate (9-for-35).

- Andrew Oglevie (3), Jordan Gross (2), Jake Evans (1), Bobby Nardella (1), Joe Wegwerth (1) and Colin Theisen (1) have accounted for Notre Dame's nine power-play goals.
- Oglevie's three power-play goals were scored in the first six games of the season as he
 missed the Omaha and Ohio State series with an injury.
- Bobby Nardella has totaled seven power-play points (1-6-7) on the season, which is tied for the NCAA lead among defensemen.
- Four of Wegwerth's 11 career goals have come on the power play

MORRIS EARNS B1G SECOND STAR

- Goaltender Cale Morris was named the Big Ten's Second Star of the Week the conference announced on Tuesday morning (Nov. 7).
- Morris led the Fighting Irish to a weekend sweep at 16th-ranked Ohio State, posting a 2-0-0 record to go along with a 1.50 goals-against average and a .954 save percentage in the two games (stopped 62 of the 65 shots he faced).
- In the 3-2 game two win, he made 22 of his career-high 39 saves in the third period as
 Ohio State was only able to beat the sophomore with a pair of extra attacker goals,.
- It marks the first career weekly award for Morris, who is now 5-1-0 on the year with a .925 save percentage and a 2.22 goals against average.

EVANS AND GROSS HIT CENTURY MARK

- With a pair of third period assists against Denver (Oct. 14), senior captain Jake Evans hit the 100-career points plateau.
- Evans became the 52nd player in program history to reach 100-career points and the first since Anders Bjork did so during the 2016-17 season.
- Senior defenseman Jordan Gross then hit the 100-career points milestone in Notre Dame's 5-4 win over Omaha (Oct. 27), becoming the 53rd player in program history with 100 points.
- Gross is just the sixth defenseman in program history to reach the century mark and the first to do so since Bob Thebeau in 1985–86.

EVANS A SENIOR CLASS CANDIDATE

- Senior captain Jake Evans was named one of 20 2017–18 Senior CLASS Award ® candidates (Nov. 1).
- To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I
- senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence: community, classroom, character and competition.
- The 20 candidates will be narrowed to 10 finalists in February, and those 10 names will be placed on the official ballot for a nationwide vote by media, coaches and fans.
- The Senior CLASS Award winner will be announced during the 2018 NCAA Men's Frozen Final Four® in April.

QUICK STRIKE GOALS

- In Notre Dame's 5-4 win over Omaha on Oct. 27, Cam Morrison and Jack Jenkins scored goals just 11 seconds apart in the second period.
- The 11 seconds between goals was just three seconds over the Notre Dame record of eight seconds, set by Erik Condra and Tom Sawatske in the third period of Notre Dame's game at Northern Michigan on Jan. 21, 2006.
- Then in Notre Dame's 3-2 win at Ohio State on Nov. 4, Dylan Malmquist and Jake
 Evans scored just 34 seconds apart to stake the Irish to a 3-0 lead midway through the
 second period.

OGLEVIE'S BUZZER BEATERS

- Junior forward Andrew Oglevie scored a pair of buzzer-beating goals in Notre Dame's 4-0 win over Alabama Huntsville (Oct. 7).
- Both of Oglevie's goals were scored with under 1.0 second remaining in the first and second periods, respectively.

LEADERSHIP QUARTET

- Senior Jake Evans will serve as the team captain in 2017–18, while seniors Jordan Gross and Luke Ripley, as well as junior Andrew Oglevie, will serve as alternate captains for the year.
- Evans and Ripley were alternate captains in 2016–17.
- Evans becomes the 13th Canadian born captain of the Irish and the first since two-year captain Steve Noble (1996-98).

YEAR ONE IN THE B1G

- Notre Dame is in the midst of its first season as an affiliate member of the Big Ten Conference in 2017-18.
- Coach Jackson will oversee the Fighting Irish in a third conference, having spent his first eight seasons with the Irish in the CCHA and the previous four seasons in Hockey East.
- Big Ten hockey features seven teams this season and each team will play 24 conference games.
- For all conference games as well as home non-conference games, the Irish will follow B1G protocol and if the game remains tied after a five minute overtime, there will be a shootout (three players per team).
- In a league game, the results of the shootout count towards league standings. In non-conference games, the results are for exhibition purposes.

2017 FROZEN FOUR RUN

- Notre Dame concluded the 2016–17 season with an appearance in the Frozen Four at the United Center in Chicago (the University of Notre Dame also served as the host institution).
- It marked Notre Dame's third ever Frozen Four appearance as well as the third in a 10-year span (Boston College and North Dakota were the only other teams to make at least three Frozen Fours in that 10-year span).
- The Irish overcame deficits against both No. 1 seed Minnesota and No. 2 seed UMass Lowell to post back-to-back 3-2 victories at the Northeast Regional in Manchester, New Hampshire.
- In the combined 12 regional semifinal and regional games in the NCAA tournament last season, Notre Dame was the only team to trail in the second period or later and post a win - and the Irish did it twice.
- After trailing in the third period of the regional semifinal against UMass Lowell, the Irish tied the game late in the third when Cam Morrison scored on a feed from Anders Bjork.
- Andrew Oglevie then scored the dramatic game winner just 2:44 into the overtime period.



- The win over UMass Lowell was Notre Dame's first overtime win since defeating Miami
 3-2 on Dec. 28, 2014, in the first round of the Florida College Hockey Classic in Estero,
 Florida
- Notre Dame headed into the NCAA Tournament as a No. 4 seed and the Irish were the
 only team not seeded No. 1 to make it to Chicago.
- Cam Morrison scored the lone goal for the Irish in the Frozen Four contest, with assists from Jordan Gross and Jake Evans.

IRISH IN THE NHL

- Seven former Notre Dame players made 2017 NHL opening night rosters including, back-to-back defending Stanley Cup Champions Ian Cole and Bryan Rust (Pittsburgh), Anders Bjork (Boston), Stephen Johns (Dallas), Anders Lee (New York Islanders), Kyle Palmieri (New Jersey) and Riley Sheahan (Detroit).
- Bjork became the 17th former Irish player under Jeff Jackson to reach the NHL and the program's 31st overall when Boston opened the season with a home win against Nashville on Oct. 5 (Bjork had an assist in that win).
- Sheahan was traded to Pittsburgh on Oct. 21, where he joins Cole and Rust (at Notre Dame, he played with Cole during the 2009-10 season and with Rust during the 2010-11 and 2011-12 seasons).
- Last season (2016-17), a program-record 10 former Notre Dame hockey players played in the NHL (nine was the previous high in 2011-12.
- The 2016-17 season also included several stretches where eight former Irish players were in the league at the same time, marking the first time in program history eight former players were on active NHL rosters at the same time.
- Prior to Bjork, Robbie Russo (Detroit) and T.J. Tynan (Columbus) were the most recent former Irish players to make their NHL debuts when they both did so on March 7, 2017.
- Also during the 2016-17 season, Rust became the third former Irish player to record an NHL hat trick, joining Palmieri (1) and Dave Poulin (5) and Lee totaled 34 goals to set the record for goals in an NHL season by a former Irish player.
- With Pittsburgh winning the 2017 Stanley Cup, Rust and Cole became the third and fourth former Irish players to win back-to-back Stanley Cup Championships, joining Bill Nyrop (Montreal '76-'77-'78) and Don Jackson (Edmonton '84-'85).

NOTRE DAME IN THE 2017 NHL DRAFT

- Freshman defenseman Matt Hellickson was chosen in the seventh round (214th overall) by the New Jersey Devils in the June 2017 NHL Draft hosted (United Center).
- Future Irish defenseman and NLI signee Nicky Leivermann was also selected in the seventh round (187th overall) of the 2017 Draft by the Colorado Avalanche.
- Leivermann and Hellickson became the 80th and 81st Irish players selected in the NHL Draft.

HEAD COACH JEFF JACKSON



- The 2017-18 hockey season marks University of Notre Dame hockey coach
 Jeff Jackson's 13th season behind the Irish bench. The highly regarded
 Jackson now has over 30 years of coaching experience.
- Notre Dame's Jeff Jackson era began in 2005 when the University searched for a man who could move the program among the elite hockey schools in the country.
- During his now 13-year run, Notre Dame has become one of the nation's top teams, winning the Central Collegiate Hockey Association's (CCHA) regular-season title twice (2006-07 and 2008-09) while earning three Mason Cup championships (`07, `09 and the final one in 2013)
- Since his arrival at Notre Dame, the Irish skaters have accumulated an overall record of 268–167–52, including eight trips to the NCAA Tournament (2006–09, 2010–11, 2012–14 and 2016–17), three Frozen Four appearances (2008, 2011 and 2017) and one national championship berth (2008).
- The 2017–18 season begins Notre Dame's hockey tenure in the Big Ten Conference. Since the introduction of hockey to the Big Ten, Jackson's Irish hold a 4–7–1 record against members of the conference.
- Between 2006–09, the Irish turned in win totals of 32, 27 and 31 for three
 consecutive seasons of 25 or more wins and three consecutive NCAA tournament appearances, a first in program history.
- Jackson's success on the ice also has had a major impact off the ice for the Irish. With the wins came a commitment from the University that led to the new home of Irish hockey - The Compton Family Ice Arena - one of the finest college hockey facilities in the nation. The new venue opened on Oct. 21, 2011.
- The Irish have seen 34 players selected in the National Hockey League Entry
 Draft during Jackson's tenure, including three first round selections. Since
 his arrival on campus, Notre Dame has also seen 21 products from USA
 Hockey's National Team Development Program reach the Irish ranks.
- Jackson has coached six Irish players to All-America honors Anders Bjork (2017) Robbie Russo (2015), Anders Lee (2013), Ian Cole (2009), Erik Condra (2009) and David Brown (2007).
- In addition, 16 of his players have gone on to play in the NHL, including most recently Robbie Russo (Detroit) and T.J. Tynan (Columbus), who each made their NHL debuts on March 7, 2017.
- Jackson's Notre Dame teams have played with poise, discipline, team speed and have also featured strong goaltending and excellent special teams play.
- Having led the Lake Superior State Lakers to an NCAA Division I title in 1992 and 1994, Jackson became the first coach to have won the championship prior to joining Notre Dame's hockey staff.
- As a head coach, Jackson has led teams to 14 NCAA Tournament appearances and seven conference championships (1991–93, '95, '07, '09 and '13).

 during the 2003 season in which they earned a spot in the 2004 Stanley
 Cup playoffs. The following season all games were canceled due to the unresolved 2004–05 NHL lockout, and at the end of the year Jackson left the
 Islanders to join the Fighting Irish as head coach for the 2005–06 season.
- Jackson is a member of the USA Hockey Coaches Achievement Program, the American Hockey Coaches Association and the National Hockey League Coaches Association.
