## series notes

### miami

- series: notre dame leads, 3-1 (1-1 big east)  
- first meeting: 11.15.02 – at miami – miami, 3-2  
- last meeting: 11.22.03 – big east championship (notre dame, ind.) – notre dame, 3-1  
- notre dame and miami were members of the big east conference from 2002-2003 and met twice in the league tournament ... the irish have won each of the last three meetings ... this will be the third time in the series that notre dame has not been ranked ... the hurricanes are the first of four schools from the sunshine state appearing on notre dame's 2009 schedule (along with florida state, usf and florida) ... miami's lone losses this season have come to instate rivals usf and florida international ... in their most recent action, the hurricanes downed albany, 3-0, last weekend ... it was the third 2008 ncaa tournament participant miami had played in as many days (after playing fiu and middle tennessee state) ... two weeks ago, miami defeated host northern colorado to claim the title at the hampton inn & suites tournament ... sophomore outside hitter lane carico was named the tournament mvp ... coming off the second-best season in school history and its best acc record in school history in 2008, miami returns four starters including its libero in 2009 ... last season, the hurricanes opened the year with a 13-0 record that included three in-season tournament championships ... their 26-6 record (14-6 acc) was not quite enough for an ncaa tournament appearance, but was bought miami a share of third place in the final acc standings ... irish assistant coach matt botsford held a similar position with the hurricanes from 2004 through the 2007 season.

### florida state

- series: notre dame leads, 2-1  
- first meeting: 10.9.92 – golden dome invitational (notre dame, ind.) – notre dame, 3-2  
- last meeting: 9.15.00 – lady seminole classic (tallahassee, fl.) – notre dame, 3-1  
- this is the fourth time in the series history that either team has carried a ranking into the matchup as florida state is currently ranked 19th ... notre dame was ranked 25th in 1992, 12th in 1994 and 25th in 2000 ... in 1992, notre dame held the seminole to one point in the fourth set (15-1) during a 3-2 irish win and just two points (15-2) in the final frame of a 3-1 win in 2000 ... currently on a five-match winning streak, florida state has moved up to no. 19 in the latest avca poll ... florida state was ranked no. 22 but jumped in the polls after earning a victory in all three of its matches played at last weekend's fiu / miami invitational ... by winning the event, the seminole is off to the program's best start since the 2000 campaign ... prior to last week, florida state had not been placed in the national rankings since being pegged as the no. 21 team in the usa today coaches poll on sept. 22, 1998 ... the program's highest ranking was a no. 17 position on oct. 12, 1993 ... the seminole's only loss on the season came aug. 31 at fifth-ranked florida.

**next week:** notre dame begins big east play with a two-match trip to connecticut (sept. 25) and st. john's (sept. 27).

## bump, set, spike ...

- notre dame went 2-0 on its home floor last week while hosting the notre dame / adidas invitational ... a 3-1 win over wisconsin (sept. 11) came two days before a sweep of new mexico state, 3-0.
- in the month of september, notre dame is 301-124 (.708) overall, 44-43 (.506) on the road and 59-44 (.573) on neutral floors.
- irish head coach debbie brown has shelved over 400 wins with notre dame and won five big east conference coach of the year awards since joining the league in 1995 ... the 2009 season is her 19th at the helm of the fighting irish program ... with a career record of 544-249 (.686) in her 25th season as a head coach, brown has a 427-166 (.720) mark at notre dame.

**[joyce center]** notre dame plays all of its home games at the joyce center on the university of notre dame campus.

**[post-game press conferences]** notre dame head coach debbie brown and players, along with the visiting head coach and players, will be available to the media following a 10-minute "cooling off" period ... media members should submit player requests for post-match interviews to alan george within an appropriate time frame.

**[photo credentials]** photo passes will be issued by alan george to accredited members of the media and those individuals on special assignment ... all requests must be made at least 24 hours prior to each match ... during live action photographers are not allowed to shoot while stationed in front of or behind team benches, the scorer's table or press row ... photographers wishing to use strobes must contact alan george at least 72 hours prior to each match to obtain approval.

## notre notes

### upward bound ...

notre dame is receiving votes (27) in the avca top 25 poll for the third consecutive week ... richkern.com deemed notre dame the 35th-best team in the nation according to its sept. 14 poll ... notre dame is the highest ranked big east conference team in each poll.

### just swing and hit it ...

notre dame ranks 38th nationally with a .265 team hitting percentage ... the irish are 30th overall with 13.77 kills/set ... notre dame is second in both of those categories among big east teams, while kristen dealy (9th – 3.50) and serinity phillips (10th – 3.38) rank among the league leaders in kills/set.

### irish earn stripes at notre dame / adidas invite

the irish hosted the notre dame / adidas invitational and swept the competition with wins over wisconsin (sept. 11) and new mexico state (sept. 13) ... after dropping the first set of the matchup against wisconsin, notre dame rallied to take the final three periods en route to a 3-1 win ... not only was it the first win against the badgers for irish head coach debbie brown in six tries - and notre dame's first since 1987 - but it was just the second win overall for notre dame against a wisconsin program that eliminated the irish from their last three ncaa tournament appearances (2004, 2005 and 2006) ... it was the first time notre dame lost the first set in a win since nov. 22, 2008, against st. john's.

### trio find spot on adidas all-tournament team ...

sophomore kristen dealy and seniors serinity phillips and jamel nicholas were each named to the notre dame / adidas all-tournament team for their performances against wisconsin (sept. 11) and new mexico state (sept. 13) ... dealy, the tournament mvp, averaged 4.43 kills/set and 2.57 digs/set ... phillips went for 3.86 kills/set and 1.71 digs/set while nicholas put up stellar numbers with 11.14 assists/set and 2.57 digs/set while leading notre dame to a .324 hitting percentage ... in playing pivotal roles for notre dame in the opening match against the badgers, dealy and phillips slammed down 19 kills apiece, a career-high for dealy and season-high for phillips.

### hang it on the fridge ...

sophomore outside hitter kristen dealy was named the big east conference player of week on sept. 14 ... the santa barbara, calif., native earned the honor on the heels of being named mvp of the notre dame / adidas invitational after leading the irish to wins over wisconsin (sept. 11) and new mexico state (sept. 13) ... dealy posted a season-best 19 kills with 13 digs for a double-double and three aces in the tournament's opening match against the badgers ... dealy added 12 kills against new mexico state while cleanly fielding 24 serves in the tournament finale.

### aces by irish ...

notre dame showed signs of improvement in its serving as is evident by its 14 aces and 12 errors in two matches at the notre dame / adidas invitational (sept. 11-13) ... heading into the event, notre dame had just 30 aces and 68 service errors ... five players – kristen dealy, jamel nicholas, megan dunne, stephanie slatt and frenchy silva – had multiple aces during the tournament ... in fact, a career-high four aces came off the stroke of slatt after she went back-to-back from behind the stripe on a pair of occasions during pivotal irish runs against new mexico state (sept. 13).

### nicholas cracks national rankings ...

senior jamel nicholas ranks 21st nationally with 11.12 assists/set while notre dame's team mark of 12.58 assists/set is 39th ... nicholas' average is third overall in the big east ... she is the lone setter on the irish roster and cracked the program's all-time assists list last year by bringing her total to 1,958 ... she has since eclipsed the 2,000-assist mark after notching 100 in nine sets played during the season-opening shamrock invitational (aug. 28-30).

### queen city queens ...

senior outside hitter serinity phillips and senior setter jamel nicholas both earned all-tournament nods at the xavier invitational (sept. 4-6) ... phillips poured in a season-high 20 kills against xavier (sept. 4) on a .459 average and had 11 digs against tennessee (sept. 5) ... she averaged 3.40 kills/set while nicholas punched in 11.10 assists/set ... for her efforts, phillips was named to the big east conference's weekly honor roll.

### fresh start ...

freshman middle blocker hilary eppink made the first start of her career against no. 7 michigan (sept. 6) ... she came through with eight kills on a .438 swinging average and two blocks – one of the solo variety.

### point irish, point wolverines ...

notre dame and michigan combined for 60 points in the second set of a sept. 6 matchup at the xavier invitational, setting the irish record for scores in the 25-point set era ... the set had 13 tie scores and three lead changes ... notre dame stared at set point after a lexi zimmerman attack error (24-23) and michigan would eventually get the win after converting its sixth set point ... previously, notre dame and valparaiso combined for 58 points in the third set of an aug. 31, 2008, meeting ... valparaiso won the set, 30-28, while escaping with the match victory.

## notre notes

### scoops by silva ...

second-year libero frenchy silva had a career-high 23 digs against xavier (sept. 4) ... her previous career-best (21) came on aug. 31, 2008, against valparaiso ... it was the 12th double-digit dig performance of her young career.

### conquering the cardinal ...

for just the second time in program history - and the first since 1993 - notre dame earned a win over a top-five opponent, as the irish dealt no. 5 stanford a 3-0 loss on aug. 29 ... notre dame's last win over a ranked opponent came at home against louisville on nov. 11, 2007, while the lone win versus a top-five opponent came on sept. 25, 1993, when the 14th-ranked irish defeated no. 3 nebraska at the joyce center ... the irish and cardinal last met in 2003 with stanford pulling out a 3-0 win ... the 2008 ncaa championship runner-up had never dropped a match to notre dame in six tries until this season ... the irish have earned 32 wins against ranked teams and 13 victories over top-10 teams ... furthermore, the 1,843 fans in attendance to watch notre dame knock off stanford made up the largest crowd to view a game in the joyce center fieldhouse and the 15th-largest crowd overall in irish history.

### big east deals honor to dealy ...

sophomore kristen dealy was named to the big east honor roll (aug. 31) one day after being tabbed to shamrock invitational all-tournament team ... the outside hitter narrowly missed out on a pair of double-doubles during irish sweeps over denver (aug. 28) and no. 5 stanford (aug. 29) ... dealy had nine kills against both the pioneers and cardinal before peppering lsu with 15 on a .400 average ... she also cleanly fielded 40 consecutive serves through three matches before committing an error ... dealy led notre dame with 3.67 kills/set and 2.78 digs/set over the three matches.

### all-tournament nods ...

senior serinity phillips joined sophomore kristen dealy on the shamrock invitational all-tournament team ... dealy led the irish against the tigers with 15 kills while narrowly missing out on double-doubles in notre dame's first two matches ... phillips steadied the irish attack with 3.11 kills/set and 2.89 digs/set in the three matches ... lsu's michele williams, who was named the tournament's most valuable player, finished the three-match event with 37 kills (2.85/set) and 19 blocks (1.46/set) ... brittnee cooper (lsu), cassidy lichtman (stanford), gabi ailes (stanford) and emmy davidsmeyer (denver) rounded out the all-tournament team.

### smacks by sciacca ...

early into her third season with the irish, junior middle blocker kellie sciacca already sits second on notre dame's career list for hitting percentage ... sciacca's mark of .332 still significantly trails malinda goralski's ('01) best of .361 ... sciacca has totaled 622 kills on 1,276 attacks with 199 errors ... on the program's single-season chart, sciacca's averages of .343 (2007) and .332 (2008) rank eighth and tenth, respectively.

### preseason honors ...

senior outside hitter christina kaelin and junior middle blocker kellie sciacca both earned all-big east preseason nods, as voted upon by the league's coaches ... the duo brought home second team all-big east honors at the conclusion of last year's regular season ... kaelin went on to rack up all-region and honorable mention all-america honors from the avca in 2009 ... notre dame was picked alongside cincinnati to finish second in the big east standings.

### all in the family ...

senior tara enzweiler will be joined on campus this year by a few familiar faces ... two of her brothers, thomas and matthew, are also undergraduates at the university ... moreover, each of the three were valedictorians at cardinal gibbons high school in raleigh, n.c.

### bringing 'em back ...

the irish added two new - but recognizable - members to their coaching staff during the offseason in assistant coach robin davis and volunteer assistant coach adrianna stasiuk ... davis was named assistant volleyball coach in june 2009 ... davis, who spent the last three seasons as the head coach at boise state, rejoined the irish after spending five seasons with the notre dame program from 2001-2005 ... with the arrival of davis in 2006, boise state got an immediate boost to its program ... in his first season with the program, davis posted the largest win increase for a first-year coach in bronco history in leading the squad to 13 wins, five more than the 2005 edition of the broncos ... as an assistant coach with notre dame for four seasons and an associate head coach for one season, davis helped lead the fighting irish to five consecutive big east conference regular-season championships and appearances at the ncaa tournament, reaching the round of 16 in 2005 ... notre dame also finished that year with its highest-ever final national ranking - no. 12 in the avca poll and no. 11 in the volleyball magazine poll ... stasiuk was a four-time monogram winner with the irish volleyball team from 2004-2007 ... a three-time all-big east honoree, stasiuk also copped all-american honors as a sophomore and was twice named to the espn the magazine academic all-district first team ... she also became only the seventh irish player ever to register 1,000 kills and 1,000 digs in a career.
