### DEACS CLOSE OUT 2017 WITH ACC OPENER

- The Wake Forest women's basketball ring in the New Year and open ACC play on Sunday, Dec. 31, as the Demon Deacons welcome Notre Dame to town. Tip is set for 1 p.m. on ACC Network Extra.
- The Deacs are looking to notch their seventh victory in a row, which would be the longest winning streak since a 12-game streak to begin the 2008-09 season.
- Wake Forest will be looking to complete its first undefeated month of play since an undefeated November (6-0) in the 2009-10 season.

### LAST TIME OUT

- The Demon Deacons won their sixth consecutive game, cruising to a 77-40 victory over College of Charleston.
- Charleston native Amber Campbell shined in her return home, finishing with 18 points, nine rebounds and four steals.
- Alex Sharp filled the stat sheet once again, bringing in 10 rebounds while adding nine points and six assists.

### WAKE FOREST STORYLINES

- Senior Amber Campbell continues her rise up the Wake Forest scoring charts as she currently ranks 12th all-time in program history with 1,293 career points.
- The Deacs have outrebounded their opponent 9-of-13 games to start the season and rank first in the league and 14th nationally with 17 offensive rebounds per game. Their 44.2 rebounds per game are 26th-best in the country.
- The team tied a program record with 12 blocks against Appalachian State on Dec. 7. Wake Forest's 72 total blocks are fourth-best in the ACC and 19th in the country.

### SCOUTING THE OPPONENT

- Notre Dame enters Sunday's contest second nationally in both major polls and sits at 12-1 overall and 1-0 in ACC play following a victory over Syracuse last time out.
- Arike Ogunbowale leads the high-powered offense with 20.2 points per game

### NEXT TIME OUT

- The Demon Deacons head on the road for their first ACC road contest on Jan. 4 at Pittsburgh. Tip is set for 7 p.m. on ACC Network Extra.

## SENIOR LEADER

- Wake Forest's lone senior, Amber Campbell, continues to climb up the Demon Deacon record books in a number of categories.
- Campbell is currently 11th all-time on the Wake Forest scoring list with 1,311 career points, having surpassed the 1,000-point mark midway through her junior season. She began her senior year 19th on the all-time scoring list.
- The senior has also started and played in all 111 games during her career at Wake Forest and now holds the program record in career starts. She is within reach of the program record for career games played, which is 130 set by Lakevia Boykin (2009-13).
- Campbell has played 3,535 career minutes, eighth-most in program history, and is on pace to break the program record of 3,979 set by Nicole Levesque (1991-94).

## HOOVER COLLECTS CAREER WIN NO. 100

- Head coach Jen Hoover earned her 100th career win as a head coach on Dec. 9 in the Demon Deacons' victory over Maryland Eastern Shore.
- At Wake Forest, Hoover has amassed 80 career wins, third-most in program history. Hoover joined the Deacs following one year as the head coach at High Point where she posted a 20-13 record.

## WINNING THE CLOSE ONES

- The Demon Deacons own a 4-1 record this season in games decided by single digits. In three of those wins, the Deacs have scored the go-ahead basket with under 20 seconds remaining.
- In the team's 85-81 win at Richmond (Nov. 15), Amber Campbell hit a layup with 16 seconds to play to ensure the team's first road win of the season.
- Then, the team snapped its season-long four-game losing streak thanks to Campbell's game-winning layup that sealed a 53-51 home win over Elon (Dec. 2).
- Wake Forest won its fifth consecutive game thanks to Ariel Stephenson's layup with two seconds remaining that gave the team a 71-69 win over Charlotte (Dec. 18) on School Day at LJVM Coliseum.

## SHE'S BAAAAACK

- After missing the season's first six games with an injury, junior forward Elisa Penna has returned to all-conference form.
- Penna leads the team with 12.9 points per game. She has scored in double figures in 4-of-7 games since returning to the lineup, including a career-high 24 points against Charlotte (Dec. 18).
- Penna also leads the team in three-point field goal percentage (32.0) and ranks second in free throw percentage (83.3).

## TRIPLE-DOUBLE WATCH

- Alex Sharp has showcased her versatility early this season, as she ranks third on the team in scoring (9.8 ppg) while leading the team in rebounding (7.8 rpg) and assists (3.8 apg).
- Sharp has flirted with a triple-double on two occasions this season. She recorded 14 points to go with nine rebounds and eight assists at Richmond (Nov. 15).
- Against Charlotte (Dec. 18), Sharp added 10 points with eight rebounds and eight assists.
- She has recorded at least 10 points, five rebounds and four assists six times on the season.

## WINNING STREAK TRENDS

- Wake Forest is currently in the midst of a season-best six-game winning streak.
- During the streak, Wake Forest has outscored its opponents by 19.5 points per game.
- The Demon Deacons have relied on an aggressive offense, as they have made 81 free throws while their opponents have attempted just 69 during the streak.
- The Deacs have also been aggressive on defense, forcing 17.7 turnovers per game, recording 8.3 steals per game and delivering 7.3 blocks per game.
- Against Appalachian State (Dec. 7), Wake Forest tied the school record for blocks in a game with 12. Then, in the team's next game against Maryland Eastern Shore (Dec. 9), the team rejected 11 shots.

## POST PRESENCE OFF THE BENCH

- Sophomore forward Tyra Whitehead has given the team steady production in the post over the past three games.
- Whitehead has scored in double figures in three-straight games off the bench, including her second career double-double against App State (Dec. 7).

## TRIO OF DEACS COMPETE INTERNATIONALLY

- Three members of the Wake Forest women's basketball team represented their respective countries this summer in international competition.
- Junior Elisa Penna was named to the Italian National Team for the first time in her career for Eurobasket Women 2017. Over the course of seven games played, Penna averaged 3.6 points and 2.9 rebounds per game while playing 13.5 minutes a game.
- Sophomore Alex Sharp represented Australia at the World University Games in Chinese Taipei. Sharp helped Australia to a 5-1 record and an 85-78 victory over Japan to claim the gold medal, the second all-time for Australia in the event.
- Prior to arriving to campus, freshman Ivana Raca helped Serbia's U20 team to a silver medal at the U18 Women's European Championships. Raca averaged 9.6 points and five rebounds a game while playing 23.5 minutes per contest. In the championship game, Raca finished with a game-high 18 points, six rebounds, two steals, two blocks and a plus-24 player efficiency.

## LAST TIME IT HAPPENED...

## Jen HOOVER

Jen Hoover enters her sixth season at the helm of the Wake Forest women's basketball program in 2017-18. She was named the school's 10th coach in program history in May of 2012. Hoover came to Wake Forest after one season as the head women's basketball coach at High Point.

Hoover returned to Wake Forest to lead the program after starring for the Demon Deacons from 1987-91. She was a three-time All-ACC selection and is second on the school's career record charts for points (1,728) and rebounds (1,006). Hoover was a member of the ACC Academic Honor Roll and a member of the South team that won the bronze medal at the 1989 Olympic Festival in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. She also led the Deacs to their only NCAA Tournament appearance in 1988. Hoover was inducted to the school's Athletic Hall of Fame in 2007.

Hoover guided the Demon Deacons to the postseason for the second consecutive season in 2016-17, as Wake Forest advanced to the second round of the WNIT. The postseason berth marked just the second time in program history in which the team advanced to postseason play in back-to-back seasons. Hoover led the Deacs to a road victory over No. 15/18 NC State on Feb. 19, the first road win over a ranked opponent since the 2012 season. Additionally, the Demon Deacons earned their highest ACC Tournament seed (No. 9) since 2012 while Alex Sharp was named to the ACC All-Freshman Team.

Under Hoover's guidance, the Demon Deacons have continued their successful run in ACC Tournament play. In 2015-16, Wake Forest won an ACC Tournament game for the eighth-straight year, which was the longest active streak in the ACC. The Deacs won one game in 2016 and earned two victories as the No. 13 seed in the 2015 ACC Tournament, marking just the second time in program history Wake Forest had two wins in the league championship.

In 2015-16, Hoover helped guide the Demon Deacons to new heights as they won 17 games overall and six ACC regular-season contests. Both totals are the highest since Hoover took over as head coach in 2012 and the six ACC victories tie for the third-most in a single season in program history. Wake Forest finished tied for ninth in the ACC after being picked 14th in the preseason polls by both the Blue Ribbon Panel and the ACC's Head Coaches and beat Duke, North Carolina and NC State in the same season for the first time since her freshman campaign in 1988.

At season's end, Wake Forest earned its first post-season tournament berth since the 2011-12 campaign in earning an at-large bid to the WNIT. The Demon Deacons went on the road to top Charlotte in the first round before being eliminated by Florida Gulf Coast in the second round.

Hoover had the rare opportunity to coach a player that broke her own program records. In 2014-15, Dericia Hamby broke her coach's records for career points and rebounds. Hamby went on to become the first

Demon Deacon to ever be selected in the WNBA Draft when she was taken sixth overall by the San Antonio Stars.

In Hoover's first two seasons leading the program, Wake Forest went 13-19 in year No. 1 in 2012-13, but she did guide the Deacs to an upset road victory over No. 18 Florida State. The win marked the school's first victory on the road over a ranked team since 1996. In 2013-14, the Deacs finished with an overall record of 15-16 with five ACC wins, including another victory over a ranked FSU team as the Deacs knocked off No. 23 FSU in Winston-Salem in convincing fashion, beating the Seminoles 78-54.

Prior to coming back to Wake Forest, Hoover guided High Point to a 20-13 record in her one season with the Panthers and led the team to a WNIT appearance. The 20 wins tied for the most in a single season since High Point moved to Division I in 1999. Hoover was named the 2012 Spalding Maggie Dixon Division I Rookie Coach of the Year after the season.

Hoover's assistant coaching career began in 1994 and included stints at California, Virginia, Memphis, James Madison, East Carolina, VCU and Missouri-Kansas City.

In three seasons as an assistant at California, from 2008-11, she helped the Golden Bears to a cumulative 69-36 record while Cal went to the program's first-ever Sweet 16 in 2009 and won the 2010 WNIT Championship. A post player herself during her playing days, Hoover has an impressive reputation for developing forwards at the highest level. Hoover was named one of the ACC's top-50 all-time players and is still one of only two Demon Deacons to surpass 1,000 career points and 1,000 career rebounds. Among the post players Hoover coached at Cal were All-Americans Ashley Walker and Devanei Hampton as well as All-Freshman selections DeNesha Stallworth and Gennifer Brandon. At Cal, Hoover worked with all aspects of the program, including on-court coaching, recruiting and scouting and helped the Golden Bears to postseason appearances in all three of her seasons. She helped bring in back-to-back top 10 recruiting classes, including the No. 1 class in 2009.

Hoover went to Berkeley after spending the 2007-08 season as the associate head coach at Memphis and helped the Tigers make significant improvements in her one season. After her first stint as an assistant coach at Memphis in 2002-03, Hoover spent four seasons at the University of Virginia and became the Cavaliers' recruiting coordinator for her final two years. She helped sign top-15 recruiting classes in 2005 and 2006 and helped the team to two 20-win seasons, an NCAA ap-



pearance and two WNIT berths. She helped Virginia ink junior college All-American center Aisha Mohammed and the 2006-07 ACC Rookie of the Year, Monica Wright. Wright also was a McDonald's All-American. While at Virginia, Hoover coached under Hall of Famer Debbie Ryan.

Hoover started her coaching career at the University of Missouri-Kansas City from 1994-96, then became an assistant at Virginia Commonwealth for two seasons (1996-98). She then spent two seasons at East Carolina (1998-00) before moving on to James Madison (2000-02), where she helped the Dukes to the WNIT Final Four. Hoover then made her first stop at Memphis in 2002-03, where she recruited and coached the Lady Tigers' post players. She also oversaw academics and the mentor program until she left in August of 2003 to join Ryan's staff at Virginia.

As a player, Hoover played professionally overseas following her Wake Forest career for Solna IF Basketball Team in Stockholm, Sweden, from 1991-92. She played the 1993 season with Athletes in Action on the USA Fall Exhibition Tour and the Australian spring tour before starting her coaching career.

Hoover married her husband, John, in 2001 and the two have one daughter, Maggie.
