

NOTRE DAME BASEBALL GAMEDAY NOTES

(at South Florida; April 9, 2006)

IRISH LOOK FOR RARE ROAD SWEEP – Junior RHP Jeff Manship takes the mound today as Notre Dame looks to post the sweep of South Florida ... ND previously has turned in a 3-0 sweep on the road eight times during 11 seasons of BIG EAST play – including three in the '04 season – and has totaled 23 full sweeps (3-0) of BIG EAST series, with 15 coming at Eck Stadium ... USF would become the eighth different BIG EAST team that ND has swept 3-0 on the road (others are BC, Georgetown, Rutgers, St. John's, Seton Hall, West Virginia and UConn):

* ND's 3-0 sweeps at home (15) have come vs.: Seton Hall in '96 and '01; Georgetown in '97, '98 and '02; Villanova in '97 and '04; Pittsburgh in '99 and '06; BC in '02; UConn in '02 and '05; Rutgers in '04; and West Virginia in '04 and '05.

THIS ONE GOES TO 11 – Notre Dame's current 11-game winning streak represents the 11th double-digit win streak of the 12-year Paul Mainieri, with at least one in nine of those seasons ... a win over USF on Sunday would give the Irish a winning streak of 12 games for the sixth time in the Mainieri era (17 in '03, 16 in '01 and '02, 13 in '98, 12 in '04) and 16th time in the program's 114-year history (also 18 in '91, 17 in '07, 16 in '88, 15 in '10, 14 in '93, 13 in '08 and '92, and 12 in 1902, '63 and '80).

CONFERENCE COMMAND – Notre Dame now has won 69 all-time BIG EAST series (of 96), with 14 series ties and 13 series losses ... the Irish have won nearly 75% of their all-time games during the BIG EAST regular season (178-64-1; .735).

ON A ROLL – The Irish are riding an extended streak of 19 wins in their past 22 games, after opening with a 2-5 record that included losses vs. two of the nation's top-ranked pitchers (Nebraska's Joba Chamberlain and Arizona's John Melancon), a pair of extra-inning losses (vs. Memphis and Arizona) and two losses by one run (vs. Memphis and Oklahoma, plus the 2-0 loss to Arizona in 12 innings).

LEFTOVERS – Notre Dame is batting 39 points higher this season when facing lefthanded pitchers (.353), as opposed to RHPs (.304), with USF slated to start LHP Davis Villardello in Sunday's game ... three of ND's four regular lefthander hitters actually are batting higher this season vs. LHPs than RHPs (the other, Danny Dressman, is batting .375 vs. LHPs) while two of the righthanded batters (Jeremy Barnes and Craig Cooper) have a higher batting avg. vs. RHPs:

OH BOY OPS – West Virginia's Justin Jenkins enters today's action with the best OPS number (on-base pct. plus slugging pct.) among BIG EAST players, at 1.154 (.463 OB, .691 slugging) ... ND's **Craig Cooper** is among five players who are next on that list and who have near-identical OPS numbers (each ranking from 1.080-1.154).

AMONG THE BIG EAST LEADERS – Junior RHP Jeff Manship enters today's game ranked 5th in the BIG EAST with a 2.13 overall ERA, also 4th in opponent batting avg. (.199) and 3rd in strikeouts (50) ... his 18 Ks "looking" are most by any BIG EAST pitcher.

IN THE ND RECORD BOOKS – Manship's 2.13 season ERA would rank 18th in the ND record book and sixth-best among Mainieri-era pitchers, behind Aaron Heilman (1.61, in '98; 1.74 in '01), Tom Thornton (1.81, in '03), Grant Johnson (1.87, in '04) and Peter Ogilvie (1.90, in '01) ... Thornton and Ogilvie both compiled those ERAs while serving mostly as midweek starters ... Manship is averaging 8.33 Ks per 9.0 innings and is on pace to total 125 Ks (with two postseason starts), which would best Heilman's ND record of 118 (set in 1999 and matched in 2000) ... Manship's .199 opp. batting avg. would rank 6th-best by an ND pitcher (since '91), behind David Sinnes (.163, in '92; .198, in '93), Heilman (.173, in '02; .198, in '98) and Johnson (.188, in '04) ... Manship's 11.84 Ks per 9 IP would rank 5th-best in the ND record book and 2nd-best in the past 41 seasons (Ryan Doherty averaged 12.18 Ks per 9 IP in '04) ... his 5.56 season K-to-walk ratio would rank 5th in the ND record book and 3rd-best by a Mainieri-era pitcher, behind Danny Tamayo (6.24, in '01) and Scott Cavey (5.88, in '99).

RACKING UP THE HITS – The Irish are 16-2 this season when posting double-digit hits, including each of the past seven games (first time since April 1-10, 1999) ... the first two games of the USF series (15, 17) marked the fifth and sixth times this season that the Irish have totaled 15-plus hits.

FIRST-INNING FOCUS – Notre Dame has scored in the first inning 16 times this season, going 12-4 in those games ... the Irish now are batting .315 for the season but are hitting 67 points higher (at a .382 clip) in the first inning of '06 games, led by Craig Cooper (.722; 13-for-18, 12 R, 4 BB, HBP, HR, 5 2B), Ross Brezovsky (4-for-8, 2 R, 6 RBI, 2 BB, HBP, 3B, 2B) and Sean Gaston (4-for-9, 6 RBI, 2 R, 2 BB, 3B, 2B).

HIT STREAKS – Sophomore second baseman Ross Brezovsky joined Craig Cooper in pushing their hitting streak to 10 games, ... Cooper also had a 13-game hitting streak late in the 2005 season and is the ninth Mainieri-era player with multiple double-digit hit streaks in his career ...

KEEPING 'EM IN THE PARK – The ND pitching staff still has allowed just three home runs all season and now has logged 24-plus games without allowing a home run, spanning 927 batters faced.

RECORD WHEN ... – ND is 12-4 when scoring in the first inning, 19-1 when leading at the end of the seventh and 19-3 when outitting the opponent.

BEATING THE BIG EAST – ND is 14-1 in its past 15 games vs. BIG EAST teams, including 3-0 in the 2005 BIG EAST Tournament.

LOVING IT IN FLA. – The senior class is 17-4 in Florida during their careers, with the losses coming vs. Jacksonville in a 2003 extra-inning game (9-6, in 10), at Central Florida in a tight 2005 early-season game (2-1) and in a pair of games at the '05 NCAA Gainesville Regional (5-1 vs. UNC and 23-3 vs. the host Gators).

RARE DPs – Notre Dame's leading hitters Craig Cooper (94 ABs) and Danny Dressman (86) both have struck out just seven times all season.

BULLPEN BOOST – Notre Dame lost two of its top relief pitchers (junior RHP Dan Kapala/shoulder and sophomore RHP Tony Langford/elbow) before the 2006 season even began but the Irish bullpen has responded with a solid season that now includes a 3.76 ERA, a .247 opponent batting avg., nearly a 2-to-1 K-to-walk ratio (74/41) and nine more innings pitched (88.2) than hits allowed (80) ... the ND relievers have allowed one-third (16-of-48) of inherited baserunners to score but have struggled vs. first batters faced, allowing a .388 batting avg. (19-for-49) with 9 runs scored, 4 walks and 3 hit-batters among those 66 first batters (9 Ks):

GIVING BACK THE INHERITANCE – Junior RHP **Joey Williamson** has taken the mound with nine batters on base this season and has allowed just one of them to score (vs. Wright State), stranding five inherited baserunners since that game ... Williamson has been particularly strong versus his first batter faced, allowing just 2-for-9 batting with six strikeouts in those situations (BB, HBP, 2 R).

SUPER SAVER – Closer **Kyle Weiland** saved three straight games this week (four of the past six) and already has tied Aaron Heilman's ND record for saves by a freshman (9, in '98) ... Weiland has converted all nine of his save chances and ranks fifth on the ND season saves list, behind J.P. Gagne (13, in '03), Ryan Doherty (12, in '04), John Corbin (11, in '00) and Mike Coffey (10, in '98).
