### Notre Dame Invitational

The 49th running of the Notre Dame Invitational, one of the nation's oldest and largest intercollegiate cross country races, is scheduled for Oct. 1, 2004, at the University of Notre Dame Golf Course. The invitational was started by former Irish coach Alex Wilson in 1956, which makes it one of the oldest cross country invitationals in the nation.

## National Catholic Meet

For the 25th consecutive year, Notre Dame will play host to the National Catholic Cross Country Championship — Sept. 17, 2004, at the University of Notre Dame Golf Course. The race was conceived by current Irish coach Joe Piane and implemented in the fall of 1980. It features teams from prominent Catholic institutions throughout the United States.

The Notre Dame men will be looking for their 10th consecutive team victory in '04, while the women's team will look to claim their 11th title in 13 years.

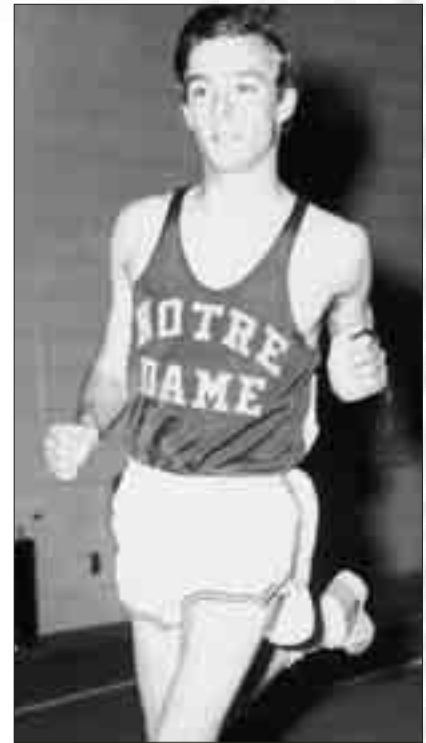
