

Host School: Colorado Teams Participating: Auburn, Colorado, Denver, Notre Dame. Format: Hidden dual

ND History in Tournament: This is Notre Dame's second appearance in the Colorado Invitational. In 2000-01, the Irish won 30 of their 37 matches in the event.



Riviera/ITA All-American Championships

October 7-10 Pacific Palisades, Calif. Riviera Tennis Club

Format: A 64-player single-elimination singles draw and a 32-team singleelimination doubles draw, with four singles players and four doubles teams advancing from pre-qualifying rounds and eight singles players and four doubles teams advancing from qualifying rounds. The remainder of the spots in the main draw are awarded based on the preseason ITA national rankings.

ND History in Tournament: Irish student-athletes have made nine singles and five doubles appearances since 1991. Wendy Crabtree and Lisa Tholen advanced to the doubles semifinals in 1993. The top singles performance came from current assistant coach Michelle Dasso, who reached the quarterfinals in 2000.



Eck Classic

October 15-17 Notre Dame, Ind. • Eck Tennis Pavilion

Host School: Notre Dame Teams Participating: Kansas, Michigan State, Notre Dame, Ohio State, Virginia Format: Hidden dual

ND History in Tournament: The tournament debuted as the Eck Doubles Classic in February of 1988, the first season of competition for the Eck Tennis Pavilion. The event moved to fall in 1992-93 and eventually became more than just a doubles tournament. Its format has changed multiple times, with the 2001 event featuring hidden-dual action and the '02 tournament having flights of singles and doubles. There was no Eck Classic in 2003.



ITA Midwest Championships

October 21-26 Minneapolis, Minn. Baseline Tennis Center

Host School: Minnesota

Teams Participating: Midwest Region teams, which include the Big Ten Conference schools other than Penn State, as well as other area squads

Format: A 64-player singles draw, with a 64player qualifying round feeding in eight players, and a 64-team doubles draw

ND History in Tournament: The Irish have won seven titles since 1991. In singles: Michelle Dasso in 2000 and 1997, Wendy Crabtree in 1993, and Melissa Harris in 1991. In doubles: Dasso and Becky Varnum in 1999 and 2000 and Crabtree and Holyn Lord in 1994.



National Intercollegiate Indoor Championships

November 4-7 Ann Arbor, Mich. Varsity Tennis Center

Host School: Michigan

Participants: Singles quarterfinalists and consolation champion, as well as doubles semifinalists from the Riviera/ITA All-American Championships plus singles finalists and doubles champions from each of the eight ITA regional championships held in October, plus at-large selections

Format: A 32-player single-elimination singles draw and a 16-team singleelimination doubles draw.

ND History in Tournament: Notre Dame has made 10 singles and three doubles appearances since 1991. In 2001, Michelle Dasso advanced to the semifinals in singles. Dasso and Jennifer Hall advanced to the doubles semifinals in 1996.



Indiana Invitational

November 5-7 Bloomington, Ind. • IU Tennis Center

Host School: Indiana

Teams Participating: DePaul, Indiana, Notre Dame, Purdue

Format: Hidden dual

ND History in Tournament: This will be Notre Dame's second appearance in the Indiana Invitational and its sixth trip to Bloomington for a fall tournament. In 1999, the Irish won three flight championships, as Lindsey Green claimed the #1 doubles (with Kelly Zalinski) and #2 singles titles, and Katie Cunha won the #4 flight. Notre Dame also went to IU for a fall tournament for four consecutive years from 1986, as the event changed from the Midwest Fall Invitational to the Hoosier Converse Classic.
