

# AWARD WINNERS

#### BYRON V. KANALEY AWARD

Perhaps the most prestigious honor awarded to Notre Dame student-athletes is the Byron V. Kanaley Award. Presented each year since 1927 at commencement exercises, the Kanaley Awards go to the senior monogram athletes who have been most exemplary as students and leaders. The awards, selected by the Faculty Board on Athletics, are named in honor of a 1904 Notre Dame graduate who was a member of the baseball team as an undergraduate. Kanaley went on to a successful banking career in Chicago and served the University in the Alumni Association and as a lay trustee from 1915 until his death in 1960.

# FRANCIS PATRICK O'CONNOR AWARD

The University of Notre Dame began presenting the Francis Patrick O'Connor Awards in 1993, named in honor of a former Notre Dame wrestler who died in 1973 following his freshman year at the University. He was the son of Jane and the late William "Bucky" O'Connor (he played football at Notre Dame in 1942, "46 and "47) from Tulsa, Oklahoma.

The award — which goes to one female and one male graduating senior student-athlete — is presented upon nomination of their head coaches, to the student-athlete who best displays the total embodiment of the true spirit of Notre Dame as exemplified by their contributions and inspiration to their teams. Among the qualities considered in nominating individuals — as attributed to Pat O'Connor — are caring, courage, confidence, encouragement, humility, humor, kindness and patience.

#### NAISMITH BASKETBALL HALL OF FAME

Six former representatives of the University of Notre Dame's basketball program have been inducted into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame in Springfield, Massachusetts:

1961	George E. Keogan
1973	Elmer H. Ripley

Keogan spent 20 seasons as Notre Dame's head coach between 1923 and 1943 and amassed 327 victories, more than any other coach in Irish basketball history.

Ripley served Notre Dame as head coach in only one season, finishing 17-4 in '45-'46. He played for the Original Celtics and coached at Georgetown, Yale, Columbia, Army and Regis. He coached the '60 Canadian Olympic team and also coached the Harlem Globetrotters for three seasons.

Krause began as a three-time All-American as Notre Dame's center in the early 1930s, won 98 games as Irish head coach for six years — and spent 32 years as Notre Dame's athletic director.

Meyer, a '38 Notre Dame graduate, was a two-time Irish basketball captain as a guard on the '36-'37 and '37-'38 squads, was named head coach at DePaul in 1942 and treid following the '83-'84 season after 42 seasons in that position. His 724-354 career record makes him one of only nine coaches in Division I history to reach the 700-victory plateau.

Kennedy, a '34 Notre Dame graduate, served as Notre Dame's sports



information director prior to a 12-year stint as commissioner of the National Basketball Association.

Dantley, '78, was the national player of the year as a junior in 1976 and was a member of the United States Olympic basketball team that won the gold medal in Montreal. He enjoyed a 15-year NBA career and still stands third on the Notre Dame all-time career list with 2,223 points.

#### COLLEGIATE BASKETBALL HALL OF FAME

2007 Austin Carr

Former Irish great Austin Carr was inducted into the National Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame on Nov. 19, 2007, at the College Basketball Experience next to the Sprint Center in Kansas City, Missouri.

Carr, who remains Notre Dame's career scoring leader with 2,650 points and a career scoring average of 34.6 points per game, became part of the second class that was inducted into the Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame.

Carr played for the Irish for three seasons (1968–71) and more than 40 years following his graduation he remains the school's all–time career scoring leader. A consensus All–American during his senior season in 1970–71, Carr was the National Player of the Year by both Associated Press and United Press International in '71. He ranks as the greatest scorer in NCAA Championship history, thanks to his 41.3 career scoring average in NCAA games. Carr still holds the NCAA Championship single–game scoring record with 61 points against Ohio University in '70, one of six NCAA Championship marks he holds. He has posted three of the top five single–game scoring efforts.

While at Notre Dame, he played in 74 career contests and scored 40 or more points on 23 occasions. A three-year starter, he averaged 22.0 points as a sophomore, 38.1 points as a junior and 37.9 points as a senior. Carr's 34.6 career scoring average ranks second all-time on the NCAA list.

Carr was the first player chosen in the 1971 National Basketball
Association Draft by the Cleveland Cavaliers and played 10 seasons in the
NBA.

# **OLYMPIANS**

Vince Boryla, who led the Irish in scoring as a freshman in 1944-45, became the first Notre Dame player to wear the Olympic basketball jersey in 1948 in London. After playing two seasons for the Irish, the 6-4 center from East Chicago, Indiana, enlisted in the Army and eventually earned a spot on the Olympic squad through his play with the Denver Nuggets AAU team.

The 1948 United States squad rolled easily to the gold medal, winning eight games by an average margin of 33.5 points and trouncing France 65-21 in the finals.

Adrian Dantley, who ranks as the number-three career scorer in Notre Dame history, became the second Irish Olympian in 1976. The powerful forward and two-time All-American played a key role in helping the United States to the gold medal at the '76 Summer Games in Montreal. Led by coach Dean Smith of North Carolina, the Americans utilized team play and a rugged defense to defeat Italy, Puerto Rico, Yugoslavia, Czechoslovakia and Canada en route to the championship tilt. Dantley tallied 30 points for top scoring honors in the final game as the U.S. blasted Yugoslavia, 95-74, for the gold.

Bill Hanzlik was selected to the 1980 U.S. Olympic team. Although the United States boycotted the Summer Games in Moscow, the Olympic squad, coached by Dave Gavitt, played five contests against teams comprised of NBA stars.

The Olympians won four of the five matchups. Hanzlik played in all five games of the Gold Medal series and contributed 11 points, seven assists and five steals
