Johnny Moir, graduating forward who has been named all-American for three years, holds the Notre Dame single season record of 290 points, two-year record of 550 points, three-year record of 780 points, and single game record of 25 points.

Paul Nowak, center from South Bend, has also been named all-American three years running, and also the best center to play in Madison Square Garden each of his three year. Both he and Moir got the latter distinction during the past year.

Tommy Wukovits, South Bend guard, with a total of 161 points for the past season, established himself as one of the highest scoring defense men in Notre Dame annals.

The 1938-39 team established several records in winning 15 of its 21 games. It broke the Notre Dame scoring record twice the same week-end, defeating Canisius, 72 to 36, and John Carroll, 74 to 36. The 110 points scored is an all-time Notre Dame high, as is the total of 74 for the latter game. Notre Dame made 22 out of 23 free throws in defeating Kentucky, 42 to 37, another Notre Dame record.

At one stage of the campaign, Notre Dame won 10 straight games. The average of 45 points a game was a new record. The total of 985 points for 21 games is another record.

Marquette gave the Irish their worst defeat, 47 to 22, in the 16 years George Keogan has been coaching at Notre Dame. The Hilltoppers won the return game, 58 to 50, the first double victory they ever scored over Notre Dame, and Notre Dame's first defeat while scoring as many as 50 points.

Coach George E. Keogan's all-time percentage suffered a drop of only two points from last year's .778 despite the six defeats. He ranks as one of the outstanding coaches in the history of the game in major schools.

Graduation losses of three regulars--Capt. Earl Brown, DuCharme, and Sadowski--plus the weakness of the reserves during the past season make the 1939-40 outlook dark. The freshman squad lacked height. Lack of experience will also be an adverse factor.
