**Tournament Notes:** Notre Dame has participated in all three years the Gopher Invitational has been in existence, posting two top-five finishes (fifth in 2005) ... the Irish three-round total of 891 was two shots better than its previous low score at the Gopher Invitational (893, +29 in 2005) ... senior tri-captain Greg Rodgers picked up where he left off at last year's BIG EAST Championship (tie-11th), collecting his first career top-10 finish with his highest individual showing ever (the '07 BIG EAST placement had been his best) ... Rodgers' opening-round 69 matched his lowest 18-hole mark, previously carded twice (last in the final round at the '07 BIG EAST Championship) ... sophomore Doug Fortner notched his second career top-20 finish and first since a fourth-place outing in the 2007 Triumph at Pauma Valley ... freshman Connor Alan-Lee was making his collegiate debut ... Irish assistant coach Steve Colnitis piloted the team at the tournament while head coach Jim Kubinski was home for the birth of his first child, daughter Kelly.

**Tournament Notes:** The Irish post their best team finish since last year's BIG EAST Championship, when they were the tournament runner-up ... the team score of 857 (-7) is the fifth-lowest in school history and best since that same '07 BIG EAST Championship, when Notre Dame shot 856 (-8) ... it was the first time this season the Irish have broken par in a single round, doing so in all three rounds at Duke ... freshman Tyler Hock made the most of his debut with the Notre Dame travel squad, sharing team-low scoring honors ... junior Josh Sandman tied his career-low 54-hole score, previously set in the 2006 Prestige at PGA WEST ... senior Greg Rodgers lowered his personal-best tournament mark, which had been 216, which he carded at the '04 Nelson Invitational on the par-69 Stanford Golf Course (under renovation) ... sophomore Doug Fortner picked up his third top-20 finish in as many starts this season.
