PROSPECTS FOR THE SEASON

This will mark the first year that swimming is a varsity sport at Notre Dame. The first attempt at a swimming club at Notre Dame was first made in 1941, the team losing both of its meets that year. Swimming was not reorganized again until three years ago under the direction of the Rev. Robert Pelton, C.S.C. and Gil Burdick, university swimming instructor, again in the form of a club. In the past three years, performing as the Notre Dame Swimming Club, the Irish swimmers actually had an intercollegiate schedule, competing against midwestern colleges and universities. The record of these three years was: 1955-56 four wins and one loss; 1956-57 five wins, and five losses; 1957-58 six wins and five losses. They were second in the Midwest Invitational Meet the past two years. Last spring, the sport was granted varsity status, with Dennis Stark of the Physical Education Department being appointed coach. The team will be headed by Co-Captains Tom Londrigan and Dick Nagle, who are the top freestyler prospects in the distance. Other prospects include: freestyle sprints---Bill Cronin and Chris Lund; backstroke---Jim Garrity and Dick Katis; breaststroke---Steve Sauer and George May; butterfly---Tony Haske and Dick Dunn; and divers---Paul Chestnut and Jim Carroll.

COACH DENNIS STARK

Coach Stark is a native of Detroit and was graduated from St. Casimir's high school, where he was a member of the basketball and baseball teams. He was graduated from Notre Dame in 1947 and obtained his Masters Degree from the university in 1949. He has served as Director of Aquatics for the South Bend YMCA and is now in his third year as member of the Physical Education Department at Notre Dame. He holds the rank of assistant professor. A veteran of both World War II and the Korean conflict, Stark holds the rank of Captain in the U.S. Marine Corps Reserves.

Prospects

The Notre Dame swimmers will be starting their second season as a varsity sport in the 1959-60 season with only five monogram winners returning. Lost to the squad through graduation are the top two back strokeers, the top two freestylers, and the top two in the breastroke from a team which in its first varsity season had a 5-5-1 record.

Captain Gene Witchger, a junior from Indianapolis, Indiana, leads the returning monogram winners. Witchger will team with Bill Cronin, a junior, in the freestyle dashes. Both divers return from last year's squad to give both depth and strength in the diving event. Paul Chestnut and Jim Carroll are both seniors. The other returning monogram winner is Tony Haske, a junior, who swims the butterfly events.

Irish Coach Dennis Stark is a 1947 graduate from Notre Dame and obtained a Masters degree from Notre Dame in 1949. He has been active in the South Bend YMCA swimming program for several years and is now in his fourth year as a member of the Notre Dame Physical Education department. Stark holds a reserve Captaincy in the Marine Corps.

PROSPECTS

Notre Dame's swimming team begins its 1961-62 season with the toughest schedule since becoming a varsity competitor. The Irish have twelve meets against nine of last year's opponents, and three new teams -- University of Western Ontario, Wayne State University, and Purdue.

The Irish ended the season last year with a 7-5 record, two of the defeats coming in the last two meets. Graduation has hit the team hard: Tony Haske, butterfly, has no one to replace him; freestylers Gene Witchger (Capt.), and Frank Dinger; and Les Duffy, No. 2 backstroker, were consistent starters for the Irish.

On the brighter side, there are ten returning monogram men, led by Co-Captains Joe Bracco and Dave Witchger -- both top breast-strokers. Freestylers for the dashes include Bob Lieb, John Macleod, and Bill Vasu; returning for the distance events are John Clark and Ray Stfani. Jim Grever will be competing in the backstroke, while Larry Temple and Tony Devine return for the diving events.

Leading candidates from last year's freshman team include amongst many: Charles Blanchard, freestyle and individual medley; freestylers Don Diebel and Al Weyman; and backstrokers Pat Flynn and Bob Manning.

COACH DENNIS STARK

Coach Dennis Stark, who has coached the four Irish varsity swimming teams, is a 1947 graduate of Notre Dame and obtained a Masters degree from that same school in 1949. He is a graduate also of St. Casimir's High School in Detroit, Michigan. His overall record going into the coming season is 19 wins, 13 losses, and one tie. Besides his work as swimming coach, Stark is also active in the South Bend YMCA swimming program, and is now in his sixth year as a member of the Physical Education department at Notre Dame. Stark is a veteran of both World War II and the Korean conflict, and holds a reserve captaincy in the Marine Corps.

PROSPECTS

The Notre Dame swimming team opens its 12 meet, 1962-63 season with a home contest against Wayne State University of Detroit. Irish coach Dennis Stark has eight men returning from last year's squad which compiled a 6-6 record. Graduated are five monogram winners, including co-captains Joe Bracco and Dave Witchger, breaststroke and individual medley; Jim Grever, backstroke; Ray Stefani, distance freestyle; and Tom Weber, diving.

Senior freestyler John MacLeod captains the '62-63 Irish as they go into their fifth season of varsity competition. MacLeod, from Greenwich, Conn., also anchored last year's sub-four medley relay team. In the sprint freestyle events, Coach Stark has Bob Lieb and Bill Vasu, both seniors. Behind these two are sophomores Ted Egan, Paul Drucker, and Tim O'Shaughnessy. Charles Blanchard and John Clark are back to dominate the distance freestyle events, with soph help from Tom West and Tom Oddo. Randy Wise, who won a monogram last year as a junior, is the top contender in the butterfly. Jim Remmers and sophomore Jim Smithwick take over breaststroke chores from ex co-captains Witchger and Bracco, while Terry Ryan, also a soph, competes in the backstroke. Other swimmers up from last year's freshman squad are breaststrokers Jim Giambalvo and John O'Connell, butterflymen John Woods and Tom Kristl, Bill Garcia and Rory Culhane in the individual medley, and Paul Devlin in his first varsity season of diving.

Coach Stark expects another tough season, with Big Ten power Wisconsin coming to Notre Dame after the opening meet with Wayne State. Dark horse of the year should be Pitt, who is highly regarded in the East this season. Bowling Green sports a perfect record against the Irish, while Ohio U., Purdue, and Kent State have proved rough in the past. The only new team on the Irish schedule is West Virginia, whom Notre Dame meets on March 1st.

PROSPECTS

For the second time in as many years, the Fighting Irish will open the season with eight returning monogram men. It is also the second straight time they return from a 6-6 season. Leading the returnees is Charles Blanchard, senior freestyler from Cleveland, Ohio, who holds the Notre Dame pool record in the 500 yard freestyle (5:33.8). Another distance freestyler is junior, Rory Culhane, who owns the varsity record for the 500 yard freestyle (5:27.9). Ted Egan, also a junior, is a freestyle sprinter and he shares the team record (:23.0) at 50 yards with graduated Bob Lieb. Also from last year is the number one butterfly man Tim Kristl, who as a sophomore last year established the varsity record (2:18.7) at 200 yards. The backstroking chores will be handled by a pair of juniors, Tom West and Terry Ryan. West is the varsity record holder at 200 yards (2:18.0). A returning diver is Tom Kennett, and the 200 yard record holder in the individual medley is Rocke Garcia (2:17.3). Both Kennett and Garcia are juniors. Among the swimmers up from last year's freshman team are freestylers Jack Stoltz and John Blum; butterflyer Keith Stark; diver Mike Schuck; backstroker John Frey; and breaststrokers Bill Ramis and Don Umhofer.

With the Big Ten powers, Wisconsin and Northwestern, visiting Notre Dame early in the year, Coach Stark expects a rugged season. In three years the Irish have yet to defeat Wisconsin, and while they have been more successful against Northwestern, they will be facing a much improved Wildcat team. At mid-season the Irish will meet Bowling Green, another swimming power. PROSPECTS

A strong group of sophomores will be in the thick of contention for vacated varsity spots. Coach Stark will be counting on backstroke Tom Bourke of Elmhurst, Ill., butterfly man Jim Brehm of Fremont, Ohio, breastroker Mike Cohen of Bala Cynwyd, Pa., individual medley specialist Bob Chiles from Memphis, Tenn., and Steve Dixon, a diver from Muncie, Ind.

COACH DENNIS STARK

Dennis Stark, a 1947 graduate of Notre Dame, is in his eighth year as the varsity swimming coach. He received his Masters degree from the University in 1949. An alumnus of St. Casimir's high school in Detroit, Mich., his overall record going into the 1965-66 season is 42 victories, 36 defeats, and one tie. Stark is a veteran of both World War II and the Korean conflict. He is presently active in the South Bend YMCA swimming program and is also in his eighth year as a member of the Physical Education Department at Notre Dame.
