Accomplished freestyler is just the second Notre Dame student-athlete in the last 25 years to serve as the team's lone captain ... ranks in the top seven in school history in the three longest freestyle events: fifth in the 1,000 (career-best 9:30.09), sixth in the 500 (4:31.44), and seventh in the 1,650 (15:51.62) ... also stands 12th in the 200 free (1:41.78) ... part of school-record 800 free relay (6:42.55), for which he earned all-BIG EAST honors ... precise and disciplined ... possesses good work ethic ... brings engineering mindset to the pool.

AS A JUNIOR: Ranked among top five on team in the four longest freestyle events ... swam third leg on 800 freestyle relay that broke the oldest school record on the books (12 years) at the Notre Dame Invitational by finishing first with α time of 6:45.44 ... improved on that time by nearly three seconds in resetting record (6:42.55) in third-place finish at the BIG EAST Championships ... that performance was the 45th-quickest time in Division I and gained all-conference honors ... season bests included 1:41.78 in the 200 (5th on team), 4:32.58 in the 500 (4th), 9:42.78 in the 1,000 (5th), and 16:07.72 in the 1,650 (5th) ... at the BIG EAST meet, finished 16th in both the 500 and 1650 free, scoring points in both of those events for the third consecutive year ... just missed consolation final by taking 18th in the 200 free ... swam on 400 free relay that finished first against Oakland.

AS A SOPHOMORE: Swam every freestyle event from 100 to 1,650, ranking as team's second-best performer in each of the three longest ... qualified for BIG EAST Championships in 200, 500, and 1650, posting season bests in the first two ... finished 15th in conference meet in longer two events ... top mile time came in the Notre Dame Invitational ... picked up dual-meet victory in 1.000 vs. Kalamazoo.

AS A FRESHMAN: Showed the ability to swim effectively in many of the freestyle distances ... ranked among the top five Irish swimmers in the 200 freestyle, 500 freestyle, 1,000 freestyle and 1,650 freestyle ... best efforts included 48.27 in the 100 free, 1:43.47 in



the 200 free (fourth on the team), 4:31.59 in the 500 free (third on the team), 9:30.09 in the 1,000 free (third on the team) and 15:51.62 in the 1,650 free (also third on the team) ... competed in the 200, 500 and 1,650 freestyle at the 2002 BIG EAST Championships ... placed seventh in the 500 free, ninth in the 1,650 free and 25th in the 200 free at the BIG EAST meet ... won his preliminary heat in the 500 freestyle at the 2001 Notre Dame Invitational ... earned first collegiate dual-meet race victory in the 200 free against Villanova (1:44.28) ... second dual-meet event victory was the 1,000 free against St. Bonaventure (9:43.39).

The fastest man in school history ... enters final season as the University recordholder in the 50 free (20.45) and the second-quickest ever in the 100 free (45.15) and 100 fly (48.92) ... prolific relay swimmer is part of three Irish-record relays, anchoring 200 medley relay (1:30.48), covering the butterfly portion in the 400 medley (3:19.45), and swimming second in the 200 free (1:21.30) ... in α ll, he has been a part of each of the top three Irish relays in both the 200 medley and 200 free, as well as the two fastest ever in the 400 medley ... holds two of the three sub-20.70 times ever posted by Irish swimmers in the 50 ... his career-best in the 100 is just .08 seconds off Ray Fitzpatricks's record (45.07) ... has scored 140 points in BIG EAST Championships, including reaching the evening finals in eight of nine individual events ... combines with teammates Tim Kegelman and Louis Cavadini to have posted all of the 19 best times in Irish history in the 100 fly, as he holds four of the top eight marks ... has been a part of the second-fastest time in school history in four relays: 200 and 400 medley, 200 and 400 free ...

earned all-BIG EAST honors in 2003 as part of third-place 200 medley relay ... loves to race ... brings a needed race-day enthusiasm and toughness to the team.

AS JUNIOR: One of top Irish sprinters again, finishing second on team in 50 free (20.86), 100 free (45.81), and 100 fly (49.00) ... αlso important part of Irish relays, taking part in four of them ... anchored 200 medley relay that broke school record in taking

fourth at the conference meet and posting the 30th-fastest time in Division I (1:30.48) ... swam second leg on school-record-setting 200 free relay that was 35th-quickest in the nation (1:21.30) and anchored 400 medley relay that posted the second-fastest time in program history in being 42nd nationally ... finished third on team in points scored (361) and first among nonrookies ... major part of Notre Dame's BIG EAST runner-up effort that featured the highest point total in school history, as he contributed 49 points at the conference meet (third-best on the team) ... finished fifth in the BIG EAST meet in the 100 fly after qualifying fourth ... took 13th in the 100 free and 14th in the 50 free ... also swam second leg of 400 free relay that turned in third-quickest time in school history in taking sixth place and clinching Notre Dame's runner-up finish in the team standings ... posted seven dual-meet race victories: five in the 50 free and a pair in the $100 \dots$ won the 50 free at North Carolina (23rd at NCAAs) and vs. Wyoming (22nd at NCAAs) ... anchored 200 medley relay team that set a Notre Dame

Invitational record in finishing first with a time of 1:31.62... also took part in first-place 200 free relay at NDI ... led off a pair of relays - 200 freestyle (1:25.55) and 400 butterfly (3:26.70) - that set meet



records at the Dennis Stark Relays ... also swam on 16 relays that posted first-place finishes in dual-meet action, including wins against #19 BYU in the 200 medley and vs. Wyoming in the 400 free.

AS A SOPHOMORE: Led Irish in points scored and was a part of five University records in 2002-03 ... broke own school mark in 100 butterfly (48.92) ... set Irish record in 50 free twice on same day of BIG EAST Championships, finishing seventh with time of 20.45 ... swam butterfly leg on 200 and 400 medley relays that set school records at BIG EAST meet ... earned all-BIG EAST honors for the former, which finished third ... also was part of 200 free relay that broke University mark ... led off 400 free relay that delivered second-best time in school history ... was seventh in 100 free and 100 fly ... had six individual wins in dual-meet action (three each in 50 free and 100 fly) ... also finished second or third 11 times ... swam 200 fly vs. Cleveland State ... one of three recipients of team's Most Improved award for improvement throughout the season.
