Senior Drew Pittman and the Irish will take on a total of seven teams this season that had student-athletes qualify for the 2004 NCAA Swimming & Diving Championships.

Since 1958-59, the Notre Dame men's swimming and diving team has traveled to 28 states, the District of Columbia, Ontario, Brazil, Mexico, and Ireland.
