ND History in Event: Notre Dame has had three student-athletes qualify for this meet: diver Bob Ebel in 1975, swimmer Tim Kegelman in 2005 and diver Michael Bulfin in 2006. Ebel placed 77th off the threemeter board. Kegelman finished 37th in the 200-yard fly (1:52.78) and 39th in the 200-yard IM (1:50.30). He was disqualified for an illegal turn in the 100-yard fly. Bulfin placed 18th in the prelims of the three-meter competition and 27th in the one-meter prelims. Notre Dame has yet to register a point in the meet.
