One of three team captains ... very versatile and effective swimmer ... three-time monogram winner ... former school record holder in the 500-yard free ... posted NCAA "B" cuts in the 500-yard freestyle during his freshman and sophomore seasons ... also swam a "B" cut in the 200-free as a sophomore ... member of school's 800-yard freestyle relay record-holding quartet (6:35.47) ... tabbed honorable mention Academic All-America by College Swim Coaches Association (CSCAA) his first three seasons ... honorable mention selection as a junior ... six-time all-BIG EAST honoree ... led Irish in points scored and dual-meet race victories in first collegiate season and was among Notre Dame's top three in four different events ... ranks second all-time in program history in the 500 free (4:25.83) ... one of the top middle-distance freestylers in school history ... third all-time in the 200 free (1:38.54) and fourth in 1,000 free (9:22.88) ... fifth in the 400 IM (3:56.95) ... also is fifth in

200 fly (1:49.75) and 12th in 1,650 free (15:53.17) ... extremely versatile swimmer had outstanding prep career, winning a pair of Indiana state titles and earning All-America honors five times ... can swim every event ... loves to be challenged ... also one of top students on Irish, carrying 3.707 cumulative GPA as a member of Notre Dame's Academic Honors Program for Student-Athletes ... three-time member of the BIG EAST Academic All-Star Team ... in 2003-04, ranked sixth in the U.S. among 17- and 18-year olds in the 500 free, as well as 11th in the 400 IM ... earned High Point Award for finishing in top four in all six of his events to earn 139 points in the 2004 Indiana Senior State Long-Course Championships ... won the 800-meter freestyle in that meet ... finished 22nd in 400-meter IM at 2004 USA Swimming Summer National Championships, becoming the first swimmer from Irish Aquatics club team to ever reach the evening finals ... also took 28th in 400 free.

ASA JUNIOR: BIG EAST champion in the 800 free relay with a school-record time of 6:35.47 ... also earned all-BIG EAST honors with a runner-up finish in the 200 free by posting a career-best time of 1:38.54 ... that mark was tops on the team during the season and ranks him third in school history ... also had the team's best 200 fly mark (1:50.36) ... had the fourth-best times on the team in the 500 and 1000 freestyles ... finished sixth in the 200 fly at the conference meet with a time of 1:50.65 ... his prelim mark of 1:50.36 was a season-best time in the event ... placed eighth in the 500 free at the BIG EAST in a time 4:34.55 ... swam his best 200 free time of the season (1:38.54) at the BIG EAST Championships ... collected 18 individual and eight relay wins on the season ... honorable mention Academic All-America by College Swim Coaches Association (CSCAA) ... named to the BIG EAST Academic All-Star Team ... earned a monogram.

AS A SOPHOMORE: One of five Irish swimmers to record NCAA cuts ... clocked NCAA "B" cuts in the 200-yard freestyle (1:38.64) and the 500-free (4:25.89) ... earned all-BIG EAST honors in those events as well ... his 200-free time was the fourth-fastest in school history and his 500-free time is second in Irish history, only behind his own mark of 4:25.83 in '04 ... led the team with seven BIG EAST "A" cuts ... registered other BIG EAST "A" cuts in the 1,650-yard free (16:12.42), 100-yard fly (51.78), 200-yard fly (1:49.75), 200-yard IM (1:53.35) and the 400-yard IM (4:03.48) ... swam a BIG EAST "B" cut in the 100-yard free (48.21) ... his top 1,000-yard free time of 9:22.88 is the fourth quickest time in Notre Dame history ... second in the 500-free at the BIG EAST Championships ... placed third at the conference meet in the 200-free ... part of 800-free relay squad that placed fourth at the BIG EAST Championships ... won a team-high 15 races in six different events ... claimed five 200-free victories and four more in the 500-free ... fifth on the team with 331.75 total points (279.5 individual, 52.25 relay) ... part of four winning relay teams ... won the 200 and 500 freestyles in a tight win over No. 17 Pittsburgh in the Rolfs Aquatic Center ... was part of a 1-2-3 Irish finish in the latter, to put Notre Dame back on top in the meet ... helped 800-free relay to a win at the Notre Dame Invitational ... won the 200 free at Utah ... victorious in the 200 and 500 free versus No. 22 BYU ... won the 200-yard butterfly at Louisville ... was also part of victorious 800 free relay team against the Cardinals ... captured two more wins (200 free and 500 free) in a dual meet at Iowa ... won the 1,000-yard freestyle versus Canisius and Cleveland State in the fastest unshaved time in program history (9:22.88).

AS A FRESHMAN: Most versatile swimmer on Irish roster excelled in multiple events en route to leading team in points scored and dual-meet race victories and





ing their freshman years prior to their deaths in a bus accident in 1992.

HIGH SCHOOL AND PERSONAL DATA: Four-year letterwinner at Western High School ... 2003 Indiana state champion in both the 200 individual medley and 500 freestyle ... recipient of the Herman F. Keller Mental Attitude Award given annually to one senior swimmer each year at the state championships ... a five-time National Interscholastic Swimming Coaches Association (NISCA) All-American — twice in the 200 and 500 freestyle and once in 200 individual medley ... set eight varsity records at Western, in addition to establishing six Mid-Indiana Conference marks and three sectional records during his career ... nominated for Wendy's High School Heisman Trophy Award ... received Gene Lee Award in '02 as Indiana's "Most Outstanding Male Swimmer" ... in his senior season, named to the

ranking among team's top three in four events ... broke University record en route to third-place finish at BIG EAST meet in 500 free ... time of 4:25.83 ranked 54th in Division I and was an NCAA "B" cut ... anchored 800 freestyle relay that broke school record for second time with a 6:42.55 that was good for third place in conference meet and 45th in the nation ... earned all-BIG EAST honors for both performances ... tabbed honorable mention Academic All-America by the College Swim Coaches Association (CSCAA) ... anchored 800 free relay that broke the oldest school record on the books (12 years) at the Notre Dame Invitational by finishing first with a time of 6:45.44 ... in addition to leading team in the 500 free, ranked second in 200 (1:39.76) and 1,000 (9:26.53), third in the 1,650 (15:53.17) and 400 IM (3:56.95), and fifth in the 200 butterfly (1:53.44) ... registered six of the team's top eight times in the 1,000 and four of the top seven in the 1,650 ... his 427 points in individual events were 148.5 more than any other Irish swimmer ... registered 465.5 total points, including 42 at the BIG EAST meet ... took eighth in the 200 free in league meet and 10th in the 1,650 free ... scored 154 points at Notre Dame Invitational, finaling in five events and finishing in the top three in four ... his 146 points in individual events were a meet high ... was second in the 500 free and 400 IM, third in the 200 and 1650 free, and sixth in the 200 fly, in addition to taking 14th in the 200 IM and anchoring

the first-place 800 free relay ... registered 20 dual-meet race victories in five different events ... among the highlights were winning the 500 free against #17 Pittsburgh, and Wyoming (22nd at NCAAs), taking the 1,000 free vs. the Cowboys and #19 BYU, and claiming the 200 free vs. #15 Northwestern ... his time of 9:26.53 in the 1,000 free against UC Santa Barbara and Wyoming on Jan. 9 stands as second-best unshaved time in program history ... also swam on 400 free relay that finished first at Michigan State ... qualified for BIG EAST Championships in team-high six events, also posting season-best 1:56.07 in 200 IM ... was seeded among top 13 in the conference in five of those events ... led off 800 freestyle relay that set meet record (7:05.76) in Dennis Stark Relays ... also combined with Patrick Davis to set a meet record in the 1,000 free relay (9:22.96) ... honored with the Meghan Beeler and Colleen Hipp Award, which is presented to an outstanding freshman who best exemplifies the vitality, competitiveness, and love for Notre Dame shown by its namesakes dur-

NISCA All-Academic Team ... competed in cross country and track during his freshman year and was named the school's Freshman Runner of the Year ... won top senior awards at Western in science, journalism and French ... named the school's Most Outstanding Athlete ... awarded Presidential Award for Excellence ... member of National Honor Society ... served for two years as editor-in-chief of school newspaper ... ranked third in his graduating class ... father Ted swam at Princeton ... oldest of three children ... born April 1, 1985, in Glen Ridge, N.J. ... son of Ted and Kim Brown ... enrolled in the College of Science as a biological sciences major with a double major in anthropology.

A factor for the Irish in distance freestyle events, as well as the 400 IM ... three-time monogram winner ... on Irish all-time top performers list, ranks sixth in 400 IM (3:57.43), 12th in 500 free (4:31.93), 11th in 1000 free (9:32.27), and eighth in 1650 free (15:46.14) ... versatile competitor can swim the entire program ... incredible consistency a key to his success ... works hard and maintains a positive attitude ... prep All-American was second-youngest U.S. Olympic Trials qualifier (behind Michael Phelps) in 2000, taking part in the 1,500-meter freestyle.

AS A JUNIOR: Swam career-best times in the 500 free (4:31.93), 1,000 free (9:32.27), 200 fly (1:55.87) and 400 IM (3:57.43) ... all of those marks were BIG EAST "A" cuts ... registered a fifth-place finish in the 400 IM at the BIG EAST Championships ... placed 10th in the 1,650 free and 14th in the 500 free at the BIG EAST meet ... his 1,650 time of 15:51.31 was a season-best mark ... won the 500 free in a dual meet against St.

Bonaventure for the second win of his career ... third on the team in the 400 IM ... named to the BIG EAST Academic All-Star Team ... earned a monogram.

AS A SOPHOMORE: Posted four BIG EAST "A" cuts (500-free, 1,650-free, 200-fly, 400-IM) and one "B" cut (200-IM) ... swam season-best times in the 500-yard free (4:32.46), 1,000-free (9:33.01), 1,650-free (15:46.14) and the 400-IM (4:00.86) at the BIG EAST Championships ... garnered 112.5 total points (107-individual, 5.5-relay) ... fifth on the team in the 1,000-yard free, third in the 1,650-free, fourth in the 400-IM ... completed 1-2-3 Fighting Irish sweep in the 1,000 free at St. Bonaventure along with Jay Vanden Berg and Rob Seery ... earned a monogram.

AS A FRESHMAN: Ranked among Notre Dame's top five swimmers in four different races: 1,000 freestyle (4th, 9:37.03), 1,650 free (4th, 15:59.50), 400 IM (4th, 4:00.05), and 500 free (5th, 4:33.58) ... scored 16 points in BIG EAST Championships, finishing seventh in 400 IM and 13th in 1,650 free ... missed consolation final in 500 free by .09 seconds in the conference meet, ending up 17th ... claimed victory in 400 IM in dual meet

against Oakland ... notched BIG EAST "A" cuts in four events and also had a "B" cut in the 200 IM (1:57.28) ... led off 400 individual medley relay that set meet record (3:40.39) at Dennis Stark Relays ... scored 120 points (114 in individual events) ... earned a monogram.

Another prolific cog in Notre Dame's powerful backstroke unit ... three-time monogram winner ... ranks fourth all-time in the 100-yard back (50.29) and fifth in the 200 back (1:49.54) and eighth in the 200 IM (1:52.03) ... talented and able to persevere ... nine-time first-team prep All-American ... swam the 800-meter freestyle as a member of the Irish Aquatics Swim Club at the 2005 ConcoPhillips Swimming National Championships ... finished 12th in the 100-meter back at 2004 USA Swimming Summer National Championships, representing Pittsburgh-area Jewish Community Center.

AS A JUNIOR: Clocked BIG EAST "A" times in the 100 back (50.95), 200 back (1:52.52) and 200 IM (1:52.55) ... all of those marks were registered at the BIG EAST Championships ... placed 10th in the 100 back, with his top time of 50.95 coming during prelims ... was 17th in the 200 back ... claimed a 14th-place showing in the 200 IM at the conference meet ... his preliminary time of 1:52.52 was a season-best ... third on the team in the 100 back ... notched two victories during the season as part of the 400-yard medley relay team ... wins came in dual meets against Pittsburgh and Evansville ... earned a monogram.

AS A SOPHOMORE: Clocked BIG EAST "A" cuts in the 100-back (50.29), 200-back (1:49.54) and the 200-IM (1:52.03) ... all three of those times were achieved at the Notre Dame Invitational ... also swam a BIG EAST "B" cut in the 100-yard freestyle with a time of 47.06 at the Notre Dame Invitational

... tallied 213 total points on the season (141 individual, 72 relay), which ranked him ninth on the team ... swam on three relay teams that notched victories ... placed second behind teammate Doug Bauman by one-tenth of a second in the 200-back at the Notre Dame Invitational ... fifth in that event at the BIG EAST Championships ... placed 13th in the 200-IM at the conference meet ... swam the team's third-fastest 100-back and 200-back times ... fourth-fastest in the 200-IM and fifth-fastest mark in the 100-free.

AS A FRESHMAN: Ranked among Notre Dame's top six in five different events: second in 100 back (50.59), fourth in 200 back (1:50.90), fifth in 200 IM (1:52.30), and sixth in 50 free (21.53) and 100 free (46.71) ... turned in three of the top six Irish times in the 100 back ... scored 224.5 points, including 146.5 in individual competition ... had 22 in the BIG EAST meet ... scored in all three of his events, ending up seventh in the 100 back, 10th in the 200 back, and 14th in the 200 IM ... finaled in three events at the Notre Dame Invitational, taking third in the 100 back, fifth in the 200 back, and sixth in the 200 IM ... was seeded in the top eight in his three major events heading into the conference meet ... took

part in three relays that set meet records at the Dennis Stark Relays: 400 medley (3:29.84), 400 free (3:09.34), and 400 back (3:29.41).

One of three team captains ... one of the top sprinters on the Irish is a key in relay fortunes ... three-time monogram winner ... ranks third all-time in the 100 butterfly (49.11), as well as third in the 50 free (20.65) and fourth in the 100 free (45.29) ... also a member of all three school-record freestyle relays, 200 (1:20.64), 400 (3:00.02) and 800 (6:35.47) ... BIG EAST champion in the 800-yard freestyle relay in 2006 ... three-time all-BIG EAST performer ... great competitor ... local product was 13-time All-American in high school ... finished 35th in 100-meter butterfly at 2004 USA Swimming Summer National Championships.

AS A SOPHOMORE: All-BIG EAST in the 200-yard freestyle relay and the 400-yard free relay ... member on all three school-record freestyle relays, which were established at the BIG EAST Championships ... swam the team's second fastest 50-yard (20.65) and 100-yard (45.62) free times ... clocked Notre Dame's third-fastest 100-yard butterfly time (49.39) ... all of those times were BIG EAST "A" cuts ... also swam an "A" cut in the 200 free (1:42.56) ... posted a conference "B" cut in the 500 free (4:47.51) ... placed sixth at the BIG EAST Championships in the 50 free and 10th in the 100 free ... finished seventh in the 100 fly at the conference meet ... member of 400-yard freestyle relay that took first-place by .04 to defeat No. 17 Pittsburgh in a meet in the Rolfs Aquatic Center ... placed second on the team with 371.25 total points (252.5 individual, 118.75 relay) ... claimed eight individual first-place finishes along with seven relay wins ... part of winning 200 medley relay team in a dual meet at Louisville ... won the 100 free versus Iowa ... victorious in the 200 free at St. Bonaventure.

(1:22.41) with first-place finish at Notre Dame Invitational, as well as the 400 free relay that notched the third-best mark in school history (3:02.43) en route to a sixth-place result at the BIG EAST Championships that clinched Notre Dame's second-place finish in the team standings ... ranked eighth on team in points scored with 236 ... scored 27.5 points in BIG EAST meet ... took fifth in the 100 fly ... lost a swimoff to finish 17th in the 50 free and was 19th in the 100 free ... posted first-place finish in 100 free against #15 Northwestern and won the 50 free vs. Villanova ... swam on eight relays that registered first-place finishes in dual meets, including the 400 free quartet that was first against Wyoming (22nd at NCAAs) ... swam on three meet-record relays at Dennis Stark Relays: 200 free (1:25.55), 400 free (3:09.34), and 400 butterfly (3:26.70).

board events, scoring 27 points in helping the Irish to their highest-ever point total and a runner-up result ... barely missed all-conference honors by taking fourth off the three-meter board with a season-best score of 459.35 points ... ended up seventh in one-meter action ... ranked seventh on the team in points scored in individual events, with 216 ... came in fourth in both springboard events at the Notre Dame Invitational ... after not registering a victory up to that point, finished first five times in the final three weeks of regular season ... that stretch was highlighted by winning the three-meter competition against #15 Northwestern and sweeping both boards in the final dual meet, vs. Oakland ... co-winner of the Most Improved Award for improvement throughout the season ... other

Veteran of Notre Dame's diving corps ... three-time monogram winner ... ranks as fifth-best Notre Dame diver (266.05) in one-meter championship action since the current six-dive format was adopted ... ranks eighth in dual-meet one-meter diving (302.78) and is fifth all-time off the three-meter board in dual-meet competition (321.45) ... improved a great deal during his first collegiate season ... as a freshman, was among BIG EAST's top eight divers in both springboard events ... has made some fundamental changes that have given him ability to dive at whole new level ... strong diver who can improve his consistency ... good finisher.

AS A JUNIOR: Placed seventh at the BIG EAST Championships off of the one-meter board (264.55) and 11th in the three-meter competition (410.35) ... top one-meter dual meet total of 296.70 came during the Holiday Break competition in Ft. Lauderdale, Fla. ... placed eighth off the one-meter board at the Notre Dame Invitational (276.40) ... was 12th in the three-meter (241.60) at the NDI ... earned a monogram.
