Notes: In the 43rd edition of the Dennis Stark Relays, the 2007-08 team posted 242 points to top the field en route to claiming the meet title for the 23rd time. The Irish have won the event on 11 occasions in the last 12 years.

Notre Dame cruised past runner-up Ball State (158), Oakland (156), Valparaiso (118), and Marquette (50), and at one point touched the wall ahead of the pack in seven-straight events.

The opening meet, previously known as the Notre Dame Relays, was renamed in 2004 to honor former Notre Dame head swimming coach Dennis Stark, who is a dedicated servant to the University and community.

Ten of the meet's 13 events went the way of the Irish, as the squad managed to shatter three meet records.

Notes: Notre Dame shipped six divers to the 2008 NCAA Zone C meet held in Columbus, Ohio ... the Irish were represented in the three-day event by Steven Crowe, Sam Stoner, Michael Bulfin, Nathan Geary, Eric Lex and Wes Villaflor ... Bulfin locked a third-place finish in the 3-meter event by totaling 666.35 points and was tailed by Stoner, who checked in at sixth with a score of 639.80 ... Crowe was the third Irish diver to finish in the top 15 by placing 13th with a combined score of 592.10 ... Bulfin also shelved a sixth-place showing in the 1-meter event by posting scores of 305.85 and 333.70 over the two rounds to total 639.55 points.

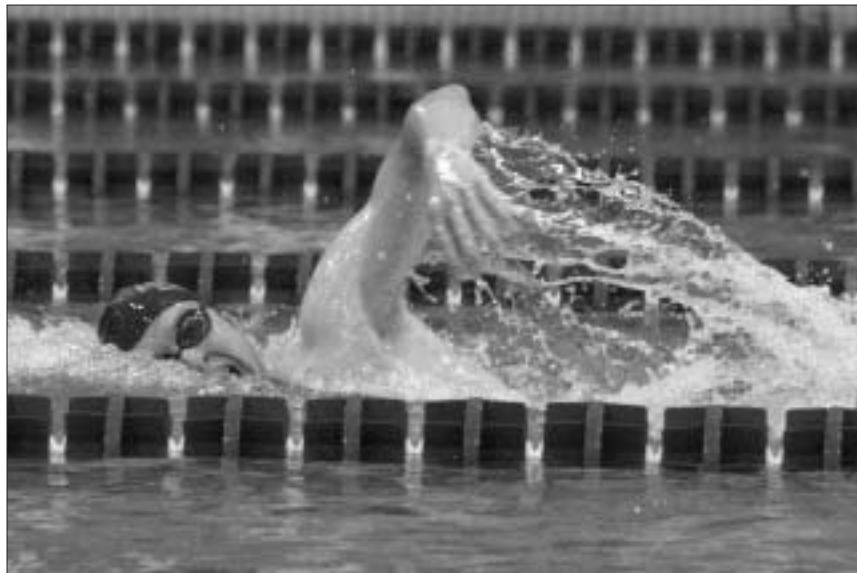

Notes: Diver Michael Bulfin made history by becoming the first member of the men's swimming and diving team to earn points at the NCAA Championships ... he notched a pair of points in the final round of the 3-meter competition to secure a top-20 finish ... the performance earned the junior the program's first individual All-American honor ... Bulfin finished 28th in the 1-meter with a count of 264.25 during the preliminary rounds ... he followed that with a stellar 319.55 and a 16th-place finish in the 3-meter event during the prelims to move into the final heat ... it was there that he moved up one spot to 15th with a score of 332.40 in the final round of the 3-meter to earn the first points for Notre Dame at the NCAAs in program history ... Bulfin is the first member of the Irish program to earn multiple trips to the NCAA Championships after previously competing at the national meet in 2006 ... diver Bob Ebel along with swimmer Tim Kelgelman are the only other two Notre Dame student-athletes to take part in the NCAAs ... Ebel, a native of St. Louis, Mo., did so in 3-meter diving event as a sophomore in 1975 ... he qualified with a record-breaking performance in a dual meet against Illinois State on Feb. 22 in the Rockne Memorial Pool ... Ebel's score of 302.65 stood as the school record for nearly 15 years ... Kelgelman competed at the 2005 NCAA Championships after earning his berth with a season-best time of 47.66 in the 100 Fly ... he also swam in the 200 Individual Medley and the 100 Fly at the national meet.



The 2008-09 campaign could be the first for a Notre Dame swimmer to advance to the NCAAs since Tim Kelgelman did so in 2005.
