Since 1980, the Notre Dame volleyball team has traveled to 34 states, the District of Columbia and six foreign countries (Austria, the Czech Republic, Germany, Italy, the Netherlands and Slovenia). Notes: The schools will meet for the fifth time in seven years and 12th time overall ... Notre Dame has won seven of the previous matches, but U-M prevailed 30-23, 30-25, 27-30, 32-30 in Ann Arbor last season ... this will be Michigan's first trip to ND since '02 and sixth overall (Irish lead 4-1)  $\dots$  the teams have played just one five-game match, an Irish victory (15-10 in the fifth) in Ann Arbor in 1996 ... ND and Michigan first met in 1982, with the Wolverines prevailing 2-0 on their home floor ... the Irish gained their first win over U-M in 1987 (3-0 in Ann Arbor), beginning a six-match winning streak ... Michigan then won consecutive contests in 1999 and 2000 before the Irish won in '02 ... the Irish lead 23-15 in games won ... Debbie Brown holds a 29-23 career record against current members of the Big Ten Conference, including 24-22 at Notre Dame ... freshman Madison Clark (Sturgis, Sturgis HS, Dunes VBC) is the latest Michigan product to play for the Irish ... Michigan has produced eight Irish volleyball players, ranking it behind only California (23), Indiana (18), Illinois (18), and Texas (9) ... in a three-game win in 1993, ND's Jenny Birkner had 10 kills and no errors on 12 attempts for an .833 hitting percentage, the thirdhighest in a three-game match in Irish history.

Notes: ND and UT will meet for the 2nd time in 3 seasons and the 10th time overall ... Texas holds a 7-2 advantage in the series, but ND won the most-recent meeting, 30-20, 36-34, 30-24 in the 2003 Longhorn Classic final in Austin ... this will be UT's 3rd all-time trip to the Joyce Center, but the 1st since 1995 ... the Longhorns are unbeaten at ND, winning 3-0 in 1989 and 3-1 in '95 ... at least one team has been ranked in the AVCA top 25 at the time of all of the previous 9 contests ... ND has been ranked higher in 4 of the last 5 meetings ... UT is 5-0 when ranked higher, while the teams have split the 4 meetings with the Irish listed higher ... Texas holds  $\alpha$ 22-11 advantage in games won ... the Longhorns won the only 5-game affair, staving off an upset bid in their own Whataburger Invitational in 1988 by winning the final game 15-7 (UT was ranked 6th; ND unranked) ... the schools first met in 1987 in Austin, when #10 UT prevailed in 3 games ... after 4 straight defeats (winning just 2 total games), #12 ND beat #15 Texas for the first time in 1994 in Austin in four games ... ND and UT played four times from 1987-90 and on four more occasions from 1994-97 before a six-year hiatus ... Debbie Brown holds a 17-14 career record against current Big XII Conference schools, including a 12-12 mark coaching ND ... 9 Texas natives (4th-most) have played volleyball for the Irish, including current senior Carolyn Cooper (Houston, Lutheran South Acad., Houston Jrs.) ... the '94 match saw ND's Angie Harris serve up eight aces, which is the most-ever for an Irish player in a four-game match and second-highest sum in any-length contest ... a 3-1 UT win in '95 still stands as the longest match in Joyce Center history (2:45) and the second-longest the Irish have ever participated in.

Notes: The Irish and Sun Devils will meet for the first time since 1993 and fourth time overall  $\dots$  ASU has won each of the previous matches ... this will be just the second trip to the Joyce Center for the Sun Devils and the first since 1985, when #11 Arizona State - coached then by current Irish mentor Debbie Brown - prevailed in three games  $\dots$  ASU has been ranked in the top 20 at the time of each of the previous contests ... the Sun Devils have won nine of the 10 games between the schools ... ND and ASU first met in 1983 at a Thanksgiving tournament in Baton Rouge, La., with the #13 Sun Devils prevailing in three games ... the mostrecent match saw the Irish earn their first-ever game victory against ASU (15-9 in the third), but the Sun Devils still prevailed in four games, in Tempe in 1993... following two years as an All-American at USC and a stint with the U.S. Olympic team, Brown completed her education at Arizona State, graduating in 1982 with a degree in physical education ... she then began her coaching career as an assistant at ASU under Dale Flickinger from 1980-82 before assuming the headcoaching duties in 1983 ... in six years leading the Sun Devils, Brown compiled a 117-83 record, while gaining five invitations to the NCAAs, finishing in the top 20 on four occasions, and being named Pac-10 Coach of the Year in 1986 ... other than the BIG EAST, Brown has more career victories against the Pac-10 (39) than vs. teams from any other conference ... current ND senior setter Kelly Burrell (Phoenix, Xavier College Prep, Arizona Irs.) is the third Arizona native to play volleyball for the Irish ... Notre Dame director of athletics Kevin White held that same position at ASU prior to taking his current position in 2000.

Notes: The Irish and Trojans, traditional rivals in many sports, will meet for just the sixth time in volleyball and first since 2000 ... the schools were slated to play last year in the Gamecock Invitational, but USC elected not to compete in the tournament due to travel concerns involving a hurricane ... USC has won four of the previous meetings, including the last match, a fivegame affair (15-11 in the fifth) in Los Angeles in 2000 ... ND's lone victory came in the 1995 Notre Dame Invitational, a 3-1 triumph ... this will be just the second neutral-site meeting between the schools, with S.C. winning the other, a four-game match in the 1987 Sportmart Mid-America Classic in Chicago ... each of the last four matches between the teams saw both schools carrying national rankings ... Notre Dame has never faced a USC team ranked lower than 12th ... S.C.'s win in 2000 is the only time the teams have played five games ... the Irish have visited USC three times (1992, '94, 2000) for matches over Thanksgiving weekend ... Troy has won 13 of the 19 games ... Irish head coach Debbie Brown (then Debbie Landreth) was a two-time first-team All-America outside hitter for USC from 1976-77, helping the Women of Troy to a 72-1 record and a pair of national championships before leaving to play for the U.S. national team ... Brown, who grew up in the L.A. suburb of El Segundo and graduated from El Segundo High School, also won the Mikasa Award as the nation's best all-around player in both '76 and '77 ... sophomore Ashley Tarutis (Long Beach, Los Alamitos HS) and freshman Mallorie Croal (Villa Park, Mater Dei HS), who both played for the Golden West Volleyball Club, are the latest Los Angeles-area products to play for the Irish ... ND has had more volleyball players from California (23) than from any other state ... the Trojans have twice snapped long Irish winning streaks, ending a 12-match victorious stretch in '94, as well as an 11-match winning streak in '00.



Notes: The Irish and Florida will play for the first time since 2001 and the sixth time overall ... the Gators have won four of the previous five matches, including each of the last three ... in the most-recent contest, #7 Florida prevailed 3-1 against #25 Notre Dame in the '01 Florida Volleyball Challenge in Buena Vista ... the lone Irish victory in the series came in 1994 in Gainesville, when #12 ND upset #9 Florida in four games ... this will be the third neutral-site match between the schools, with the Gators having won both of the others ... both schools have been ranked among the national top 25 in four of the five previous matches ... Notre Dame has never faced a Florida team ranked lower than 10th ... the Gators lead 13-5 in games won ... the first meeting between the squads came in 1992 in the Purdue High-IQ tournament in West Lafayette, Ind., which produced a 3-0 victory for #10 UF over #22 ND ... the Gators visited the Joyce Center once, when they were ranked #2 in 1997, beating #20 ND in four games ... a season later, eighth-ranked Florida won 3-0 at home against the Irish ...
