Notre Dame / Liberty Post-Game Notes NCAA Championship Raleigh Region - First Round

- This was the third meeting between Notre Dame and Liberty. With the victory the Irish now lead the series, 3-0.
- Notre Dame registered 24 assists in today's contest, the most of any Liberty opponent this season.
- This is only the second time this season where Liberty (the NCAA's rebounding-leader) has been outrebounded by their opponent, losing the battle on the backboard to the Irish, 38-29. The nine-rebound margin is the highest deficit of the season for Liberty, the previous and only rebounding deficit was one (High Point).

Notre Dame

- Liberty's 19 points in the opening half were the third-fewest allowed by the Irish in first half of an NCAA Championship contest.
- With the victory, the Irish lay claim to a victory in 15-separate tournaments during their 17consecutive NCAA appearance streak, dating back to 1996.
- Irish head coach Muffet McGraw and the Irish bettered their all-time NCAA record with the victory to 33-17.

Kayla McBride (So./G)

• With 15 points in her first postseason contest, McBride scored in double figures for the 23rdtime this season and the 30th time in her career.

Liberty

• With the loss, Liberty falls to 2-14 in the NCAA Tournament.

Devon Brown (Jr./G)

• With her 16 points, she has scored in double figures 28-times this season.

Avery Warley (Sr./C)

• Collected 10 boards against the Irish, which marked the 22nd time this season she has recorded ten or more rebounds in a contest.
