Notre Dame Notes:

-Notre Dame has reached the Sweet 16 for the 14th time in the past 20 seasons and the seventh straight time overall. The Fighting Irish are one of five teams to make the Sweet 16 the past seven years, along with Connecticut, Tennessee, Baylor and Stanford.

-Notre Dame has won 22 straight games against in-state teams since losing 54-51 to Indiana on Dec. 3, 2006.

-With the win, Notre Dame improved to 14-5 in NCAA tournament second-round games, including a 7-0 record at home.

-Notre Dame is now 27-4 (.871) all-time as a No. 1 seed in the NCAA Championship and 38-5 (.884) as the higher seed in NCAA postseason games.

-Notre Dame is 24-0 all-time in NCAA tournament games when scoring at least 80 points after notching 87 against Indiana on Monday.

Indiana Notes:

-Indiana finished the season with 21 wins, which tied for the most in school history. It was the sixth time an Indiana team has achieved 21 wins in a single season (last 2013-14).

-Indiana, appearing in its first NCAA Championship since 2002, reached a second weekend game for the first time since 1983 by playing Notre Dame on Monday night.

-Indiana's seven made 3-point field goals in the game are the most in school history in an NCAA Championship game.

-Indiana sophomore guard Tyra Buss scored in double figures in all 33 Hoosier games this season, draining a 3-pointer with two seconds left to finish with 10 points.

-Indiana finished the 2015-16 season with 212 more made free throws than its opponents (518-306), and made 59 more free throws than their opponents attempted.
