Tournament Notes: For the first time in the program's 28-year history, Notre Dame opened consecutive seasons with a tournament victory, while also winning its season-opening event for the sixth time overall and third time in head coach Susan Holt's 10-year tenure (2003-04, 2005-06, 2007-08, 2010-11, 2014-15 and 2015-16) ... the Fighting Irish successfully defended a tournament title in back-to-back seasons for the first time since they won the 2003 and 2004 BIG EAST Championships ... Notre Dame was the first school other than host Michigan State to win the Mary Fossum Invitational in consecutive years since 1979 and 1980, when Ohio State pulled off that feat ... this was Notre Dame's 15th tournament title in the Susan Holt era ... the Fighting Irish won their third Mary Fossum Invitational title overall (also 2010) and placed in the top three for the sixth time in seven seasons (10th in 2009; did not play in 2011) ... Notre Dame's score of 887 tied for the 15th-lowest mark in program history and lowest in 21 appearances at the Mary Fossum Invitational (also 887 in 2012-13) ... Campbell posted her fourth career top-five finish (eighth top-10 showing) and best since she was co-medalist at the 2013 BIG EAST Championship ... Ferreira turned in her best finish since a career-high tie for eighth in her college debut at the 2013 IU Fall Kickoff ... Bellville logged the best finish of her career and her first top-20 outing.

Tournament Notes: Due to thunderstorms on middle day. the tournament was shortened to 36 holes ... Notre Dame opened a season with consecutive top-five finishes for the first time since 2010-11 and fifth time in school history (third in the 10-year tenure of head coach Susan Holt) ... Notre Dame set a 36-hole school scoring record, smashing the old mark of 588 (+20) at the 2013 Mercedes-Benz Championship ... Notre Dame's final-round 281 tied the third-lowest single-round score in program history (lowest since 277 and 279 in closing two rounds at last year's Schooner Fall Classic played on a par-70 layout) ... this marked the third time in school history Notre Dame finished under-par for an entire tournament (first since 2013 BIG EAST Championship when the Fighting Irish shot 863/-3) ... Albrecht set a 36-hole school scoring record, topping Katie Brophy's total (141/-3) at the 2004 Jeannine McHaney Invitational ... Albrecht's final-round 68 tied the sixth-lowest single-round mark in program history ... Campbell logged her fifth career round in the 60s and a career-low 36-hole score (previous was 145 at the 2013 IU Fall Kickoff) ... Bellville's final-round 70 was a career-low mark, surpassing her previous low of 71, set on three occasions (most recently in the first round of the 2015 ACC Championship).

Tournament Notes: Notre Dame posted its largest margin of victory since a 35-shot win at the 2005 St. Croix Collegiate Classic in the U.S. Virgin Islands ... the Fighting Irish won their second tournament of year, first time since 2010-11 they have won two of their first three events (and finished in top five in all three) ... Notre Dame's 54-hole total was the second-lowest to par in school history (lowest since 858/-6 at 2008 Heather Farr Memorial) ... second-round score was lowest to par in school history (previous was 281/-7 in second round of 2008 Heather Farr Memorial) ... third-round score was fourth-lowest to par in school history ... DiLisio and Campbell tied school record for single-round score relative to par (also Lisa Maunu in first round of 2007 Cougar Classic and So-Hyun Park in second round of 2008 Heather Farr Memorial) ... Notre Dame set new Chip-N Club Invitational record for lowest team score, topping Kent State's mark of 872 set in 2001 ... DiLisio, Bellville and Hamilton posted career-low scores (Bellville's relative to par, as she shot 215 on par-70 course at 2014 Schooner Fall Classic) and each registered best finish of her career ... Ferreira shot season-low score and second career top-10 finish (first since 2013 IU Fall Kickoff) ... Albrecht also had a career-low score.

Tournament Notes: Notre Dame was making its second appearance in Louisville's fall tournament, and its first since winning the 2007 Cardinal Cup ... the Fighting Irish posted their fourth team round under par this season in the second round ... DiLisio earned her third top-10 finish of the season, while Albrecht collected her second top-10 showing of 2015-16 (tied her career-best finish set at the Mary Fossum Invitational), and Ferreira placed in the top 25 for the third time in four outings this year ... Albrecht tied her career-low 54-hole score, which she set in her previous event at the Chip-N Club Invitational ... two uncharacteristic statistics emerged from the tournament — Notre Dame had not shot a round higher than 298 prior to the tournament, and Campbell had logged only one round of 80 or higher in the past two seasons ... for Golfstat ranking purposes, the Louisville (B) team is considered five individual competitors and thus its placement is not factored into each team's cumulative season win-loss totals.
